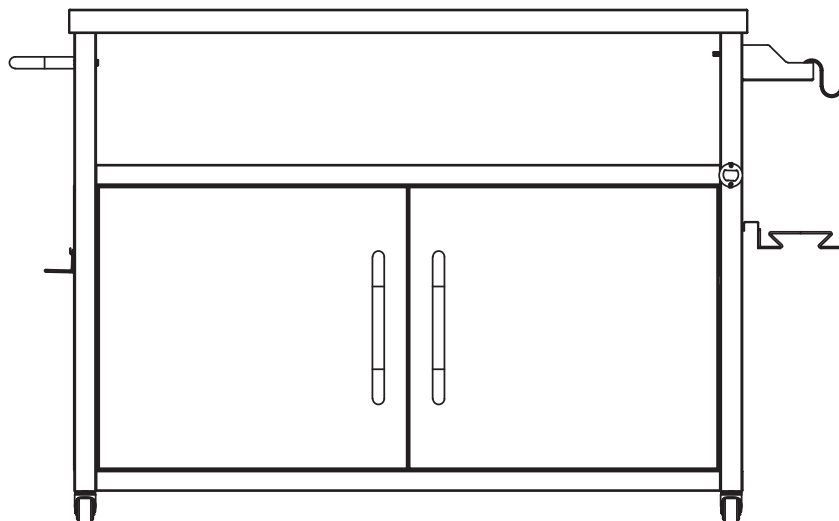



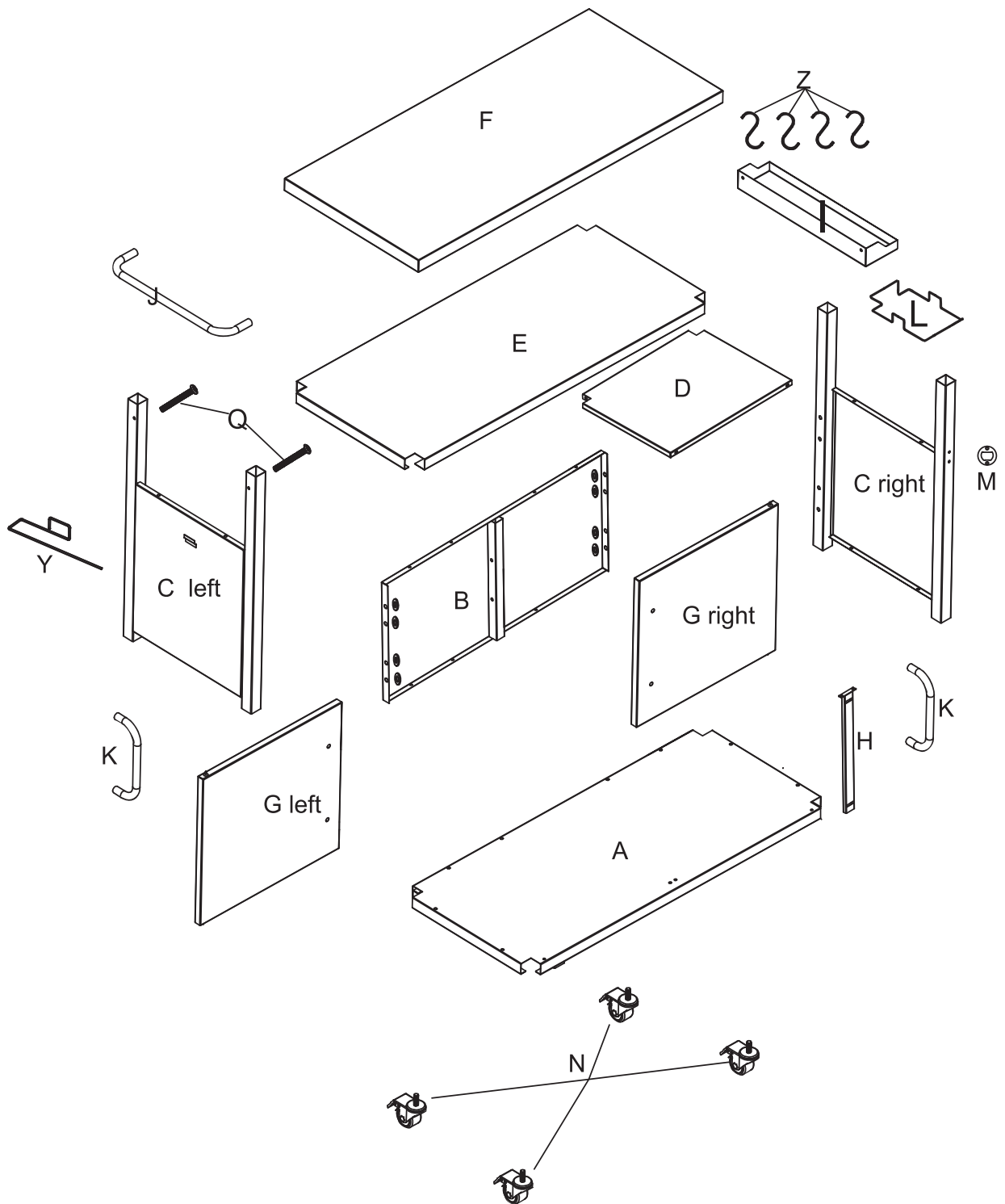
## Care & Maintenance

-  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
-  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.

-  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

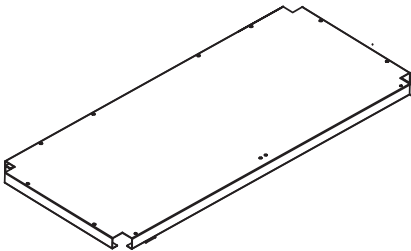

Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.



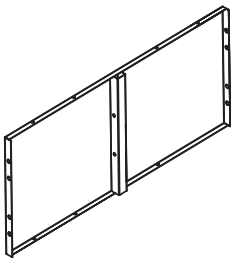

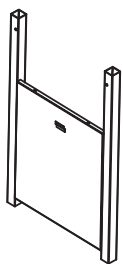
Step 1: Install Ⓗ on Ⓐ

As shown in picture1: First, put H and Ⓐ together, use screws Ⓞ to pass through the holes in both H and Ⓐ, connect H to Ⓐ, and then tighten the screws by the Allen wrench Ⓥ.

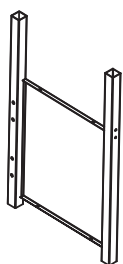
Note: All the corresponding hole positions and the screws must be concentric.

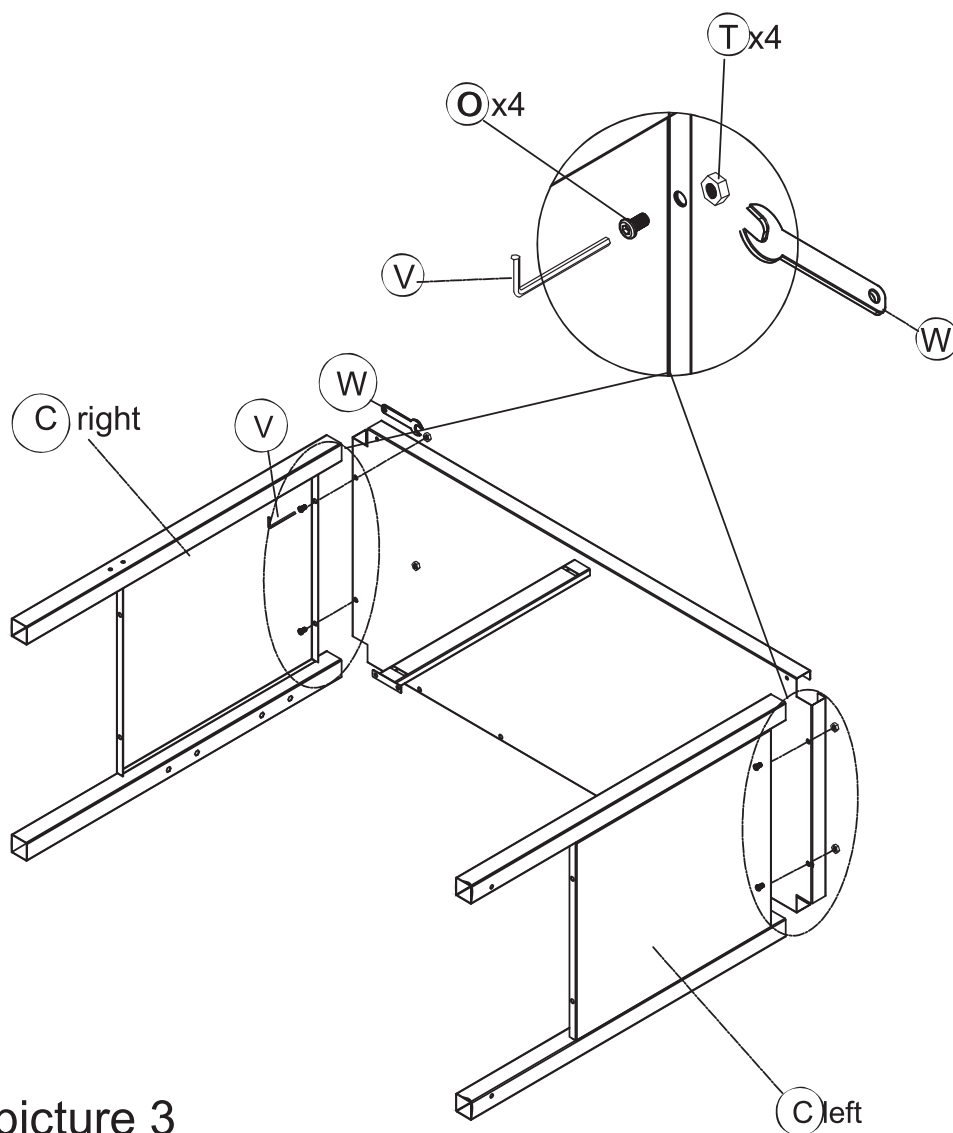

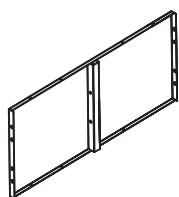
Step 2: Install both (C) left and (C) right

As shown in picture3: First, put (A) between (C) left and (C) Right , use screws (O) to pass through the holes in both (C) left and (A), connect them together with the nuts (T) and then tighten screws and nuts, by the Allen wrench (V) and the Small wrench (W). And you can connect (C) right to (A) too, using the same method.

Note: All the corresponding hole positions and the screws 、 nuts must be concentric.

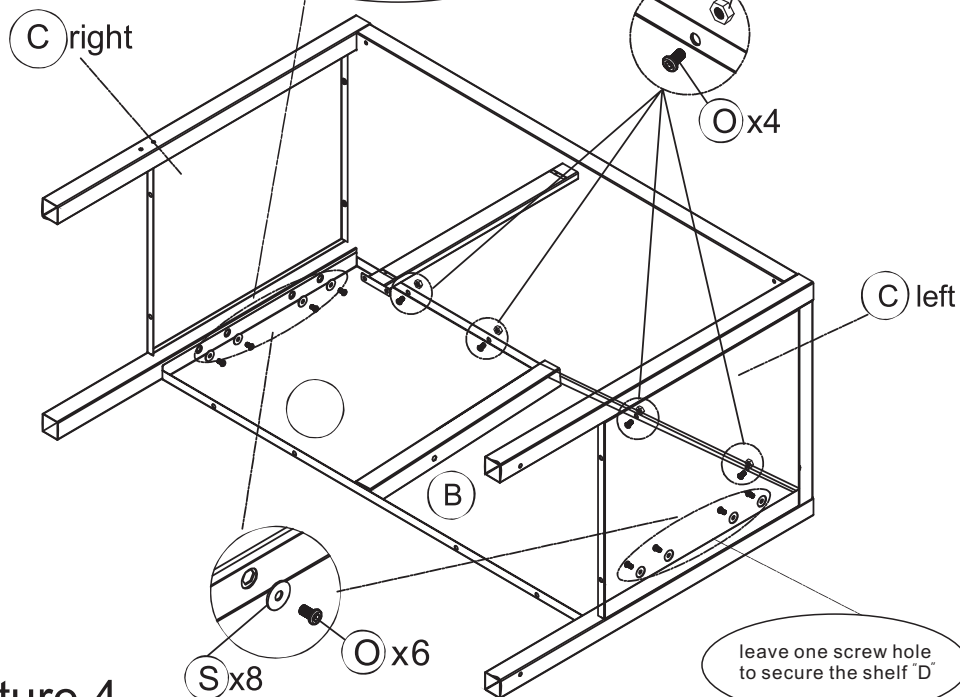

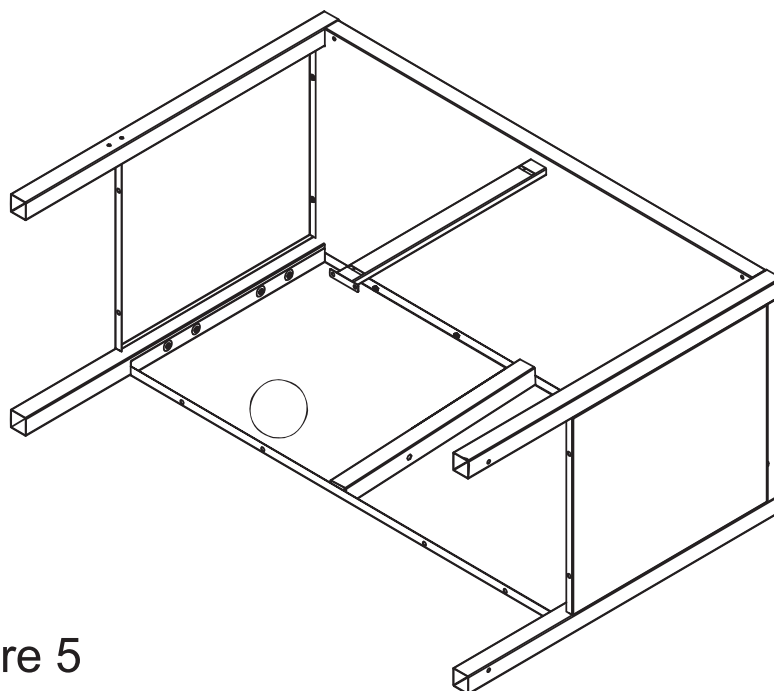

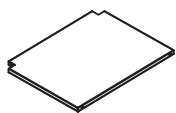

Step 3 : Install (B) part

As shown in the picture 4 to 5: Put B Between (C) left and (C) right, First, connect them by screws (O) and the shims (S). Tighten the screws. Then connect (B) and (A) together by screws and the nuts. Tighten them by the Allen wrench and the Small wrench. Note: All the corresponding hole positions must be concentric.

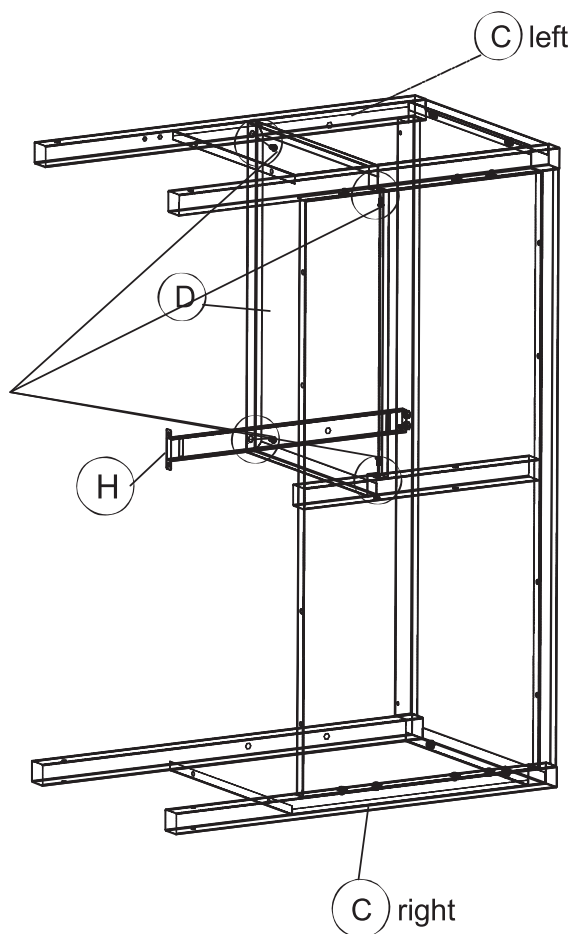
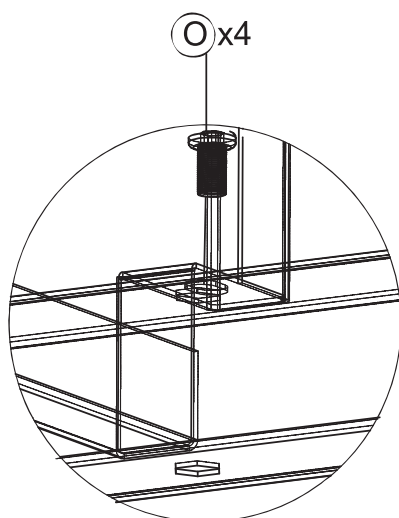

Step 4 : Install D part

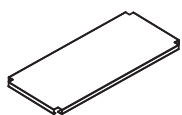
As shown in the picture 6: Put D between the C right and H connect them by screws O tighten the screws. you can put D in each of the other the position in under or to the lift. if you like.

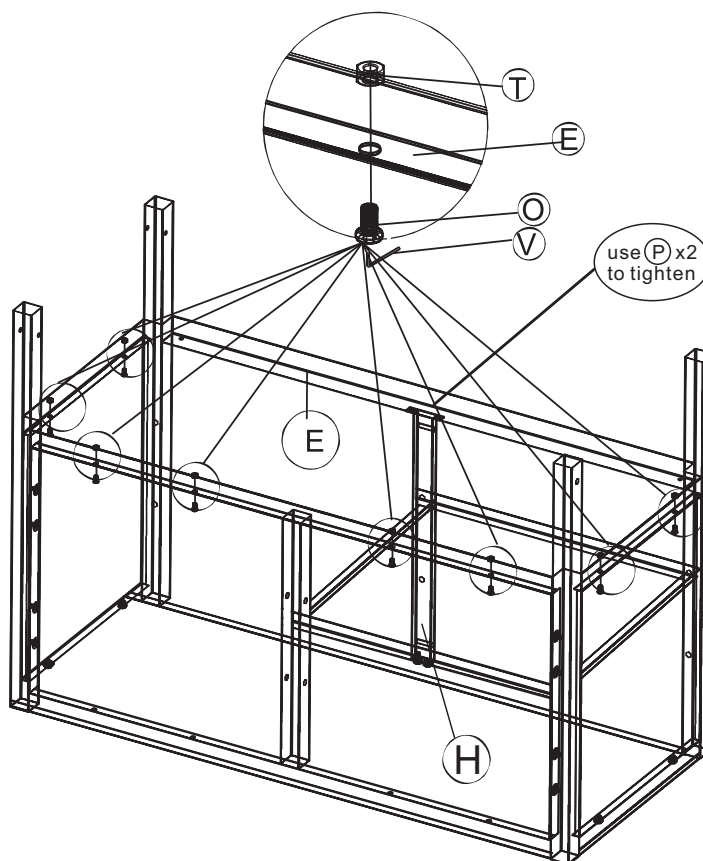

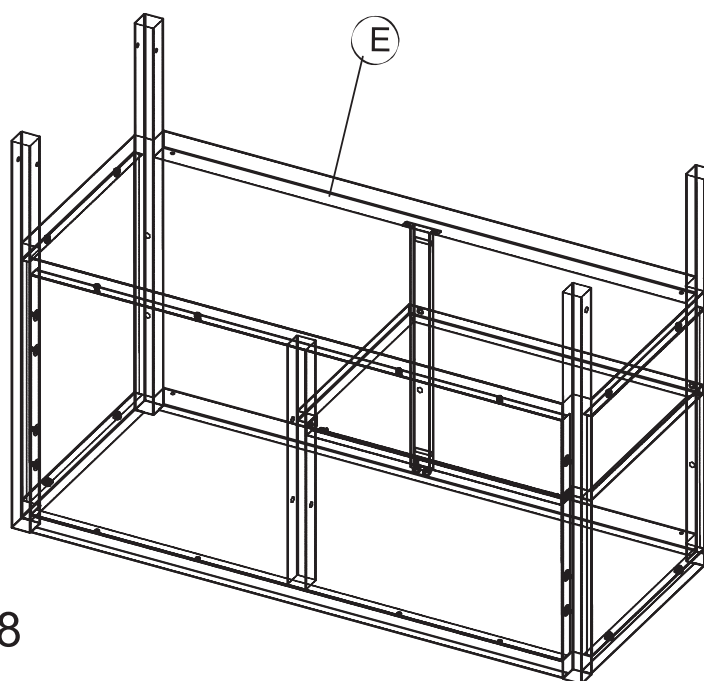

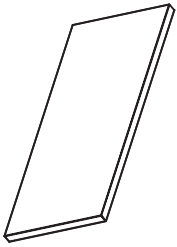
Step 5 : Install (E) part

Step 7: Install the universal wheels (N)

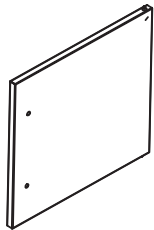

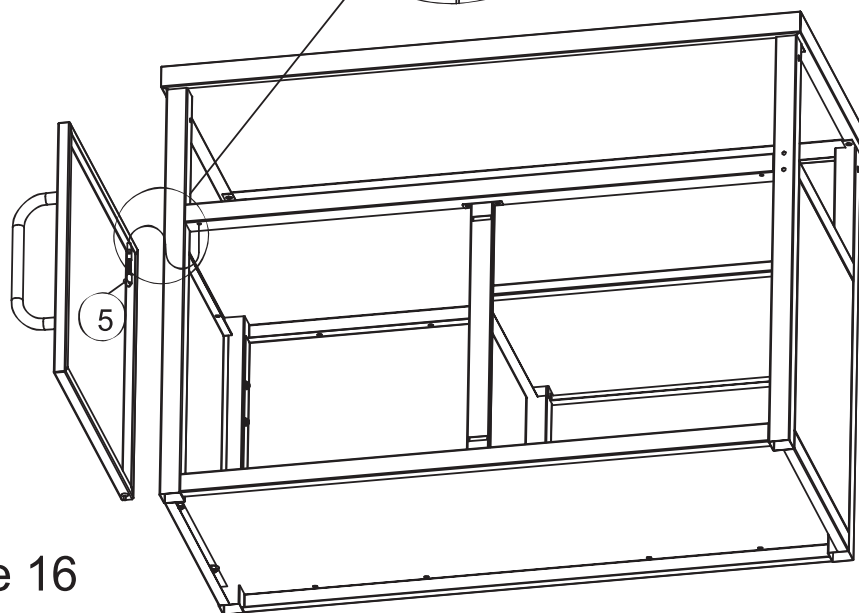
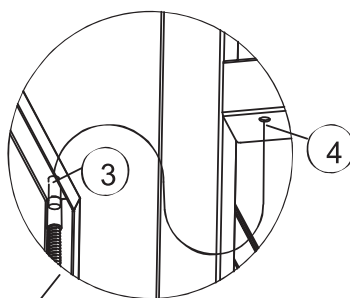
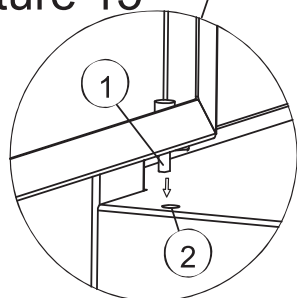
Step 8: Install the door handle (K)

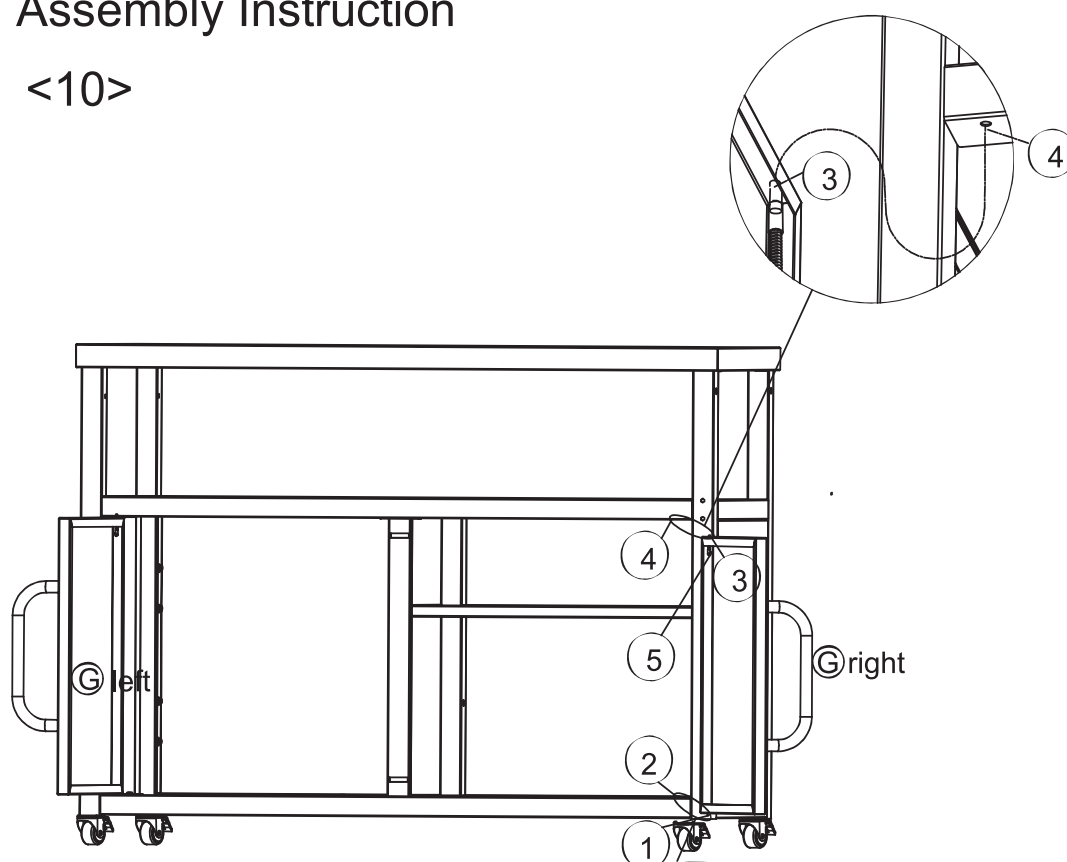
Step 9 : Install the doors

## Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
