Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.




• Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

Keep your child / children at bay during the assembly process.


Whenever lifting or moving the Table and to prevent damage to the Table, two adults may be needed to execute these actions.





Overview:




This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

<u>Step 1 :</u>



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Place End Table Top (B) and Center Table Top (C) facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface.

Then attach the Side Table Top (A) into the End Table Top (B) and Center Table Top (C) as direction above, secure the Side Table Top (A) to the End Table Top (B) and Center Table Top (C) by using Screws (1) with Allen Wrench (7) as shown above. **Do not fully tighten the Screws.**

Step 3 :


Attach the Support Bar (G) to the End Table Top (B) and Center Table Top (C) of assemble in step 2 using Screws (1) with Allen Wrench (7) as shown above. **Do not fully tighten the Screws.**



Insert the tenons of the Short Leg Support Bar (E) into the mortises of the Leg Panel (D) then sucure by using Bolt (6), Nut (5), Bolt (3) and Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.

Repeat the same process with remaining Leg Panel (D) and Short Leg Support Bar (E). **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**


<u>Step 5 :</u>



Attach the assemble in step 4 into the frame assembled in step 3, secure by using Bolt (4) and Allen Wrench (7) as shown above.


Repeat the same process with remaining assemble in step 4.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.



With the help of your adult partner, attach the Long Leg Support Bar (F) to the leg frame assembled in step 5, then secure by using Screw (②) and Allen Wrench(⑦) as shown above.


Do not fully tighten the Screws.



Align the Corner Block (H) to the Side Table Top (A) and Leg Panel (D) by using Screw $(\widehat{1})$ with Allen Wrench $(\widehat{7})$ as shown above.

Repeat the same process with others Corner Block (H).

Do not fully tighten the Screws.



With the help of your adult partner, stand the Table up.

Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands.

This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.

Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

When tightening the Bolts and Screws tighten sequentially.

Do not tighten any Bolt or Screw fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and Screws and excute the same above process.

Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
