• Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



• Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



• To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



• Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




Keep away from sources of ignition.


Keep your child / children at bay during the assembly process. For turning the Left Sofa and to prevent damage to the Left Sofa, 02 adults may be needed to execute this action


Before Beginning Assembly:














Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).



Save all packaging until finished.


Assembly Steps

OVERVIEW




This Left Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Left Sofa, we've provided the above picture to put the various parts in perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.






Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.



With assistance from your adult partner, place the seat frame (C) facedowwn onto a clean, non marring surface, then attach the Leg Frame (D) to the Seat Frame (C) using the Bolts (1), Washers (2) and the Allen Wrench (4).

Step 3



Turn the left sofa right side up.


Inspect the left sofa and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Screws and Bolts at all joints.

With assistance from your adult partner, adjust the Levelers to the desired height to avoid wobbles.

CAUTION: When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially. DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.




Place the Seat Cushion (F) and the Backrest Cushion (G) onto the Sofa as shown above. Tight Cushion ropes directly to the chair frame. Your Sofa is ready for use.

This Sofa can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Step 5 (Optional)



This is optional step in case we want to connect Left Sofa and Right Sofa in a set together and should be done before placing cushion. With assistance from your adult partners, Using the Velcro (3) to connect Left Sofa and Right Sofa.



Place the Seat Cushion (F) and the Backrest Cushion (G) onto the Sofa as shown above. Tight Cushion ropes directly to the chair frame.

Your Sofa is ready for use.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
