CAUTION: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.

Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine.
Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



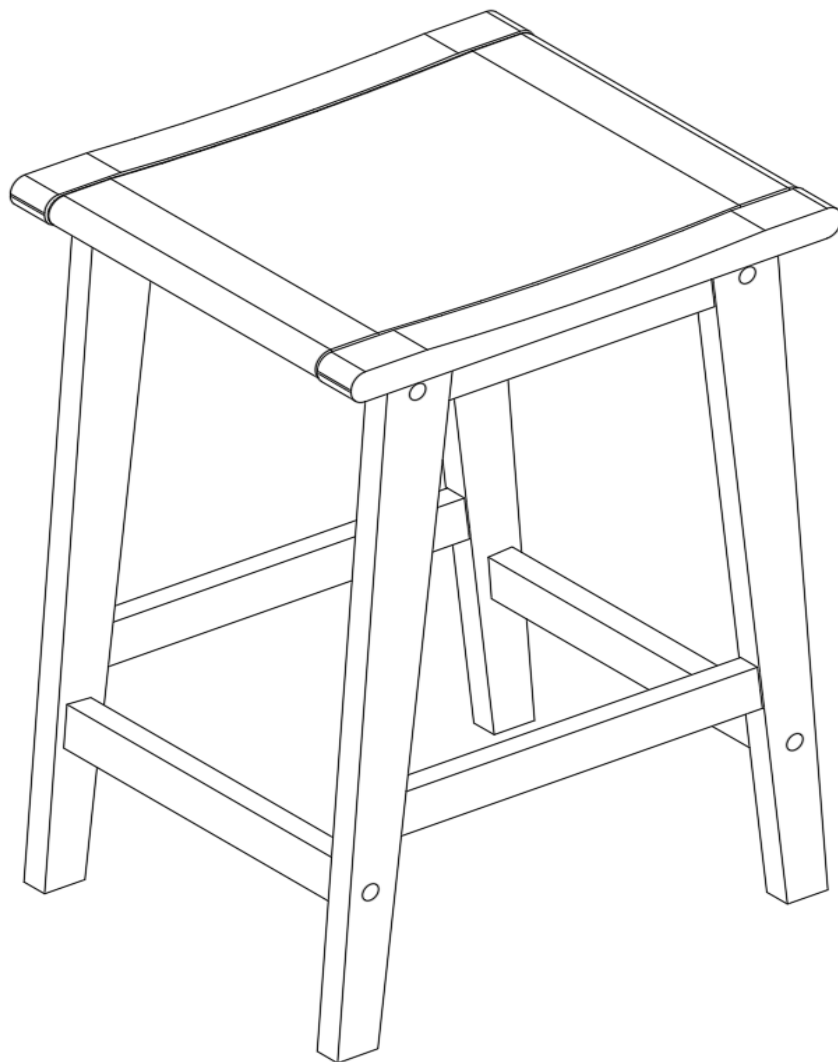
- Keep away from sources of ignition.







- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.

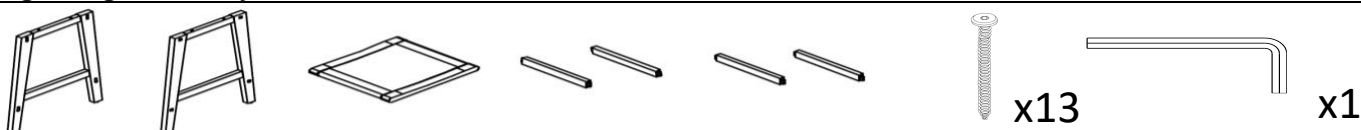

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



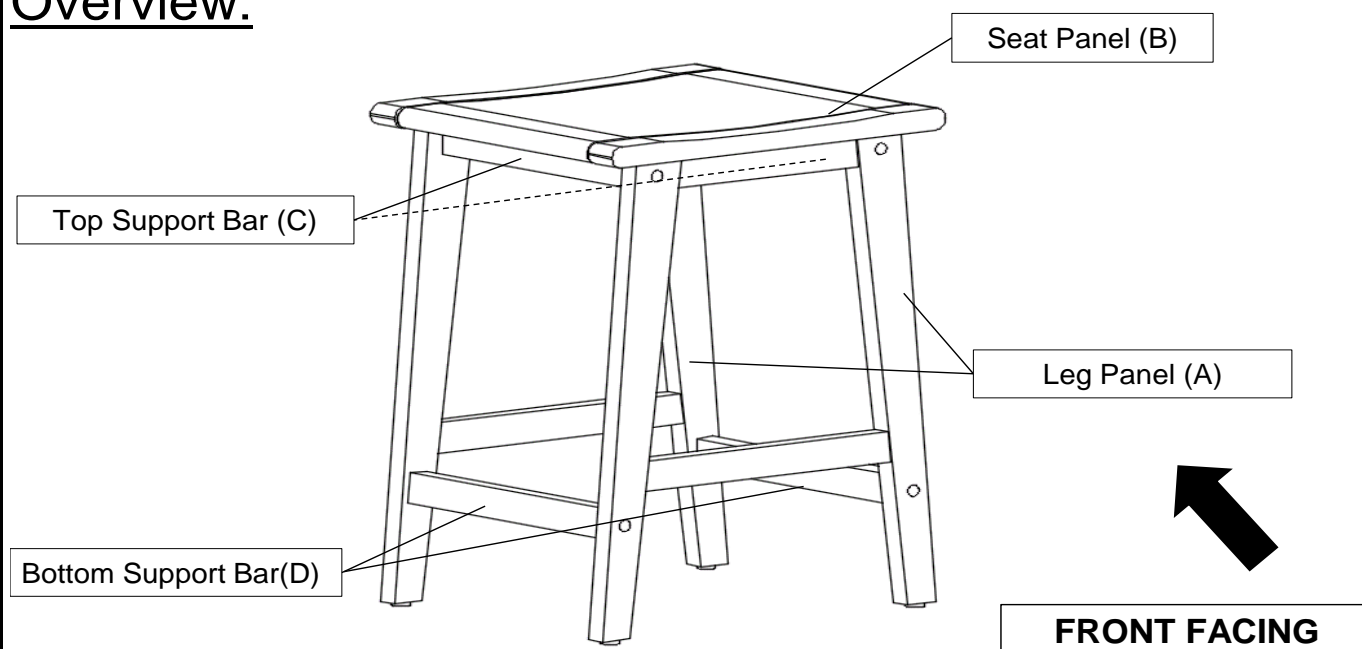
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

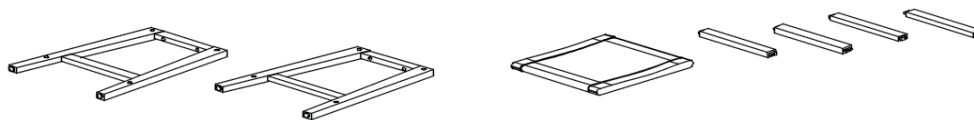
Assembly Steps

Overview:



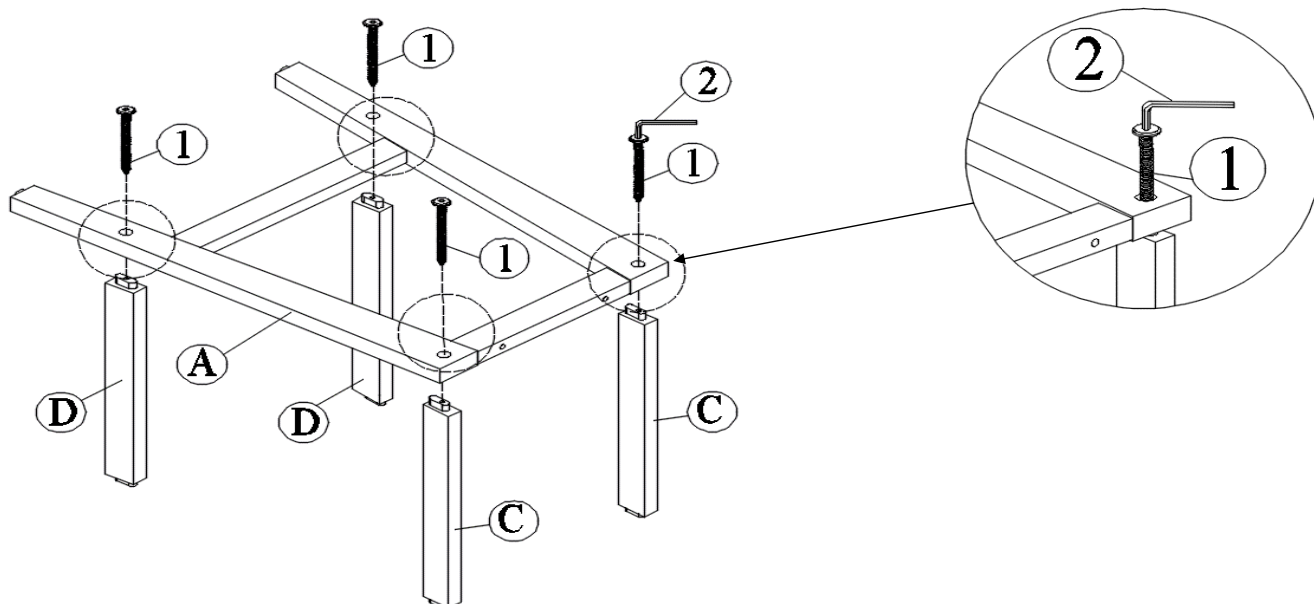
This Counter has multiple parts and may require up to 15 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Counter parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions herebelow to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

Step1:



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

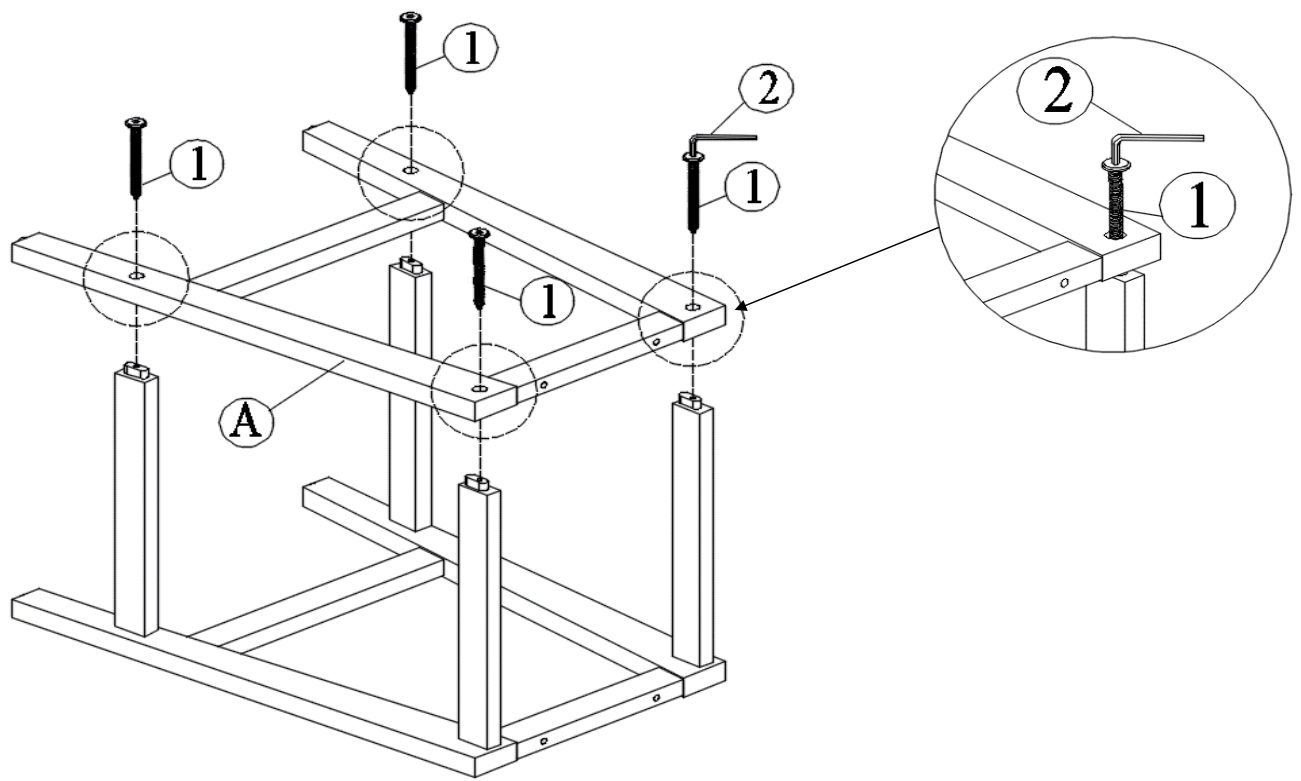
Step 2:



With the help of your adult partner, place the Leg Panel (A), Top Support Bars (C) and Bottom Support Bars (D) as shown in picture onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damages to the product. Then align the tenons of Top Support Bars (C) and Bottom Support Bars (D) into the mortises of the Leg Panel (A) and affix by using Screws (1) and Allen Wrench (2).

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

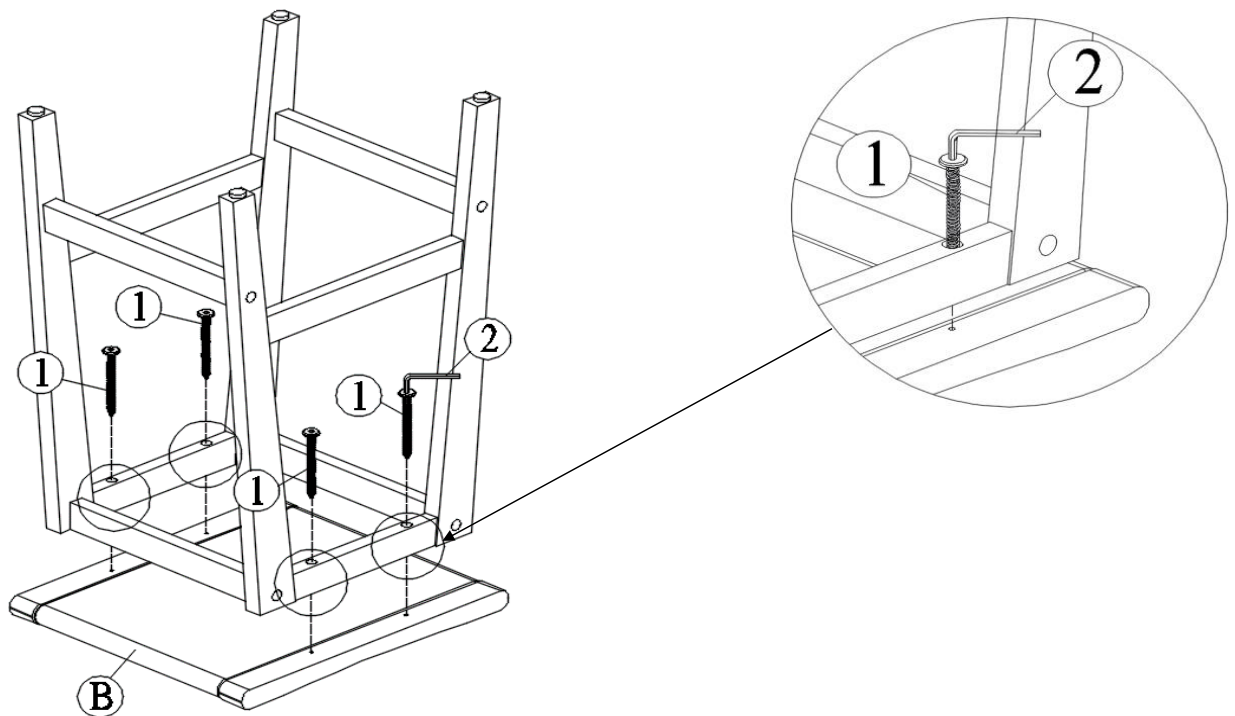
Step 3:



With the help of your adult partner, turn the assembled part in Step 2 to the opposite side and attach the remaining Leg Panel (A) to the Top Support Bars (C) and Bottom Support Bars (D) by using Screws (①) and Allen Wrench (②).

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 4:

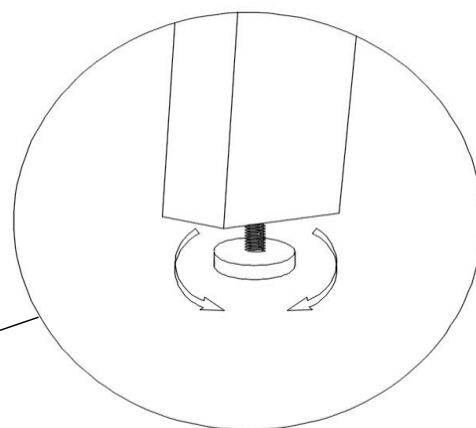
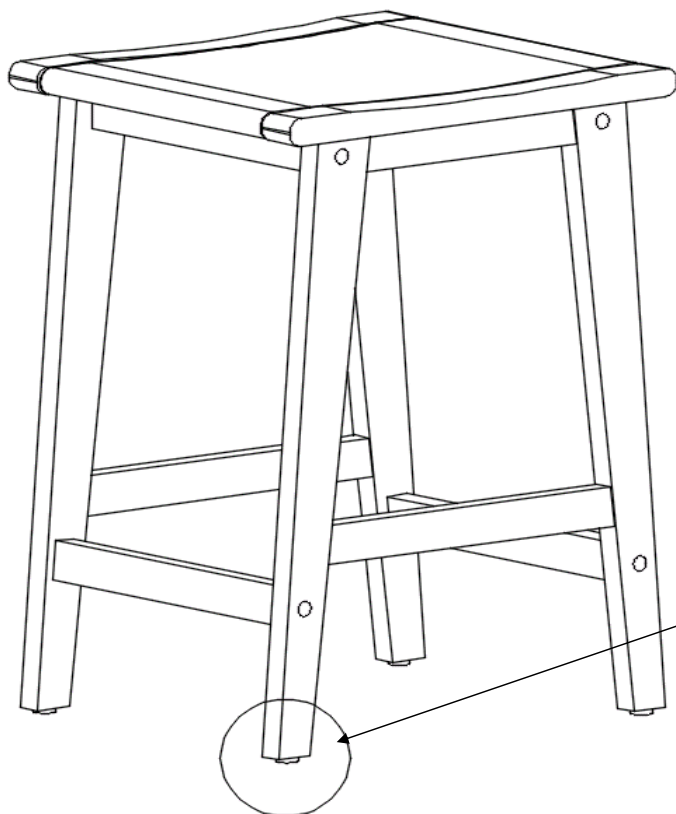


With the help of your adult partner, place the Seat Panel (B) facing down as shown above.

Attach the assembled part in Step 3 to the Seat Panel (B) and then secure by using Screws (①) and Allen Wrench (②).

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 5:



**Adjust Pre-installed Levellers
height for balance**

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Turn the Counter right side up.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Counter.

This will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

Then get off the Counter and in a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Screws at all joints until evenly connected.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Screws and execute this same process.

Adjust Pre-installed Leveler height for balance as shown above.

WARNING!! IF COUNTER IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.
