Caution: You must read this before you proceed

Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

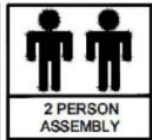
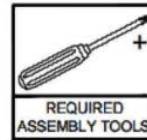
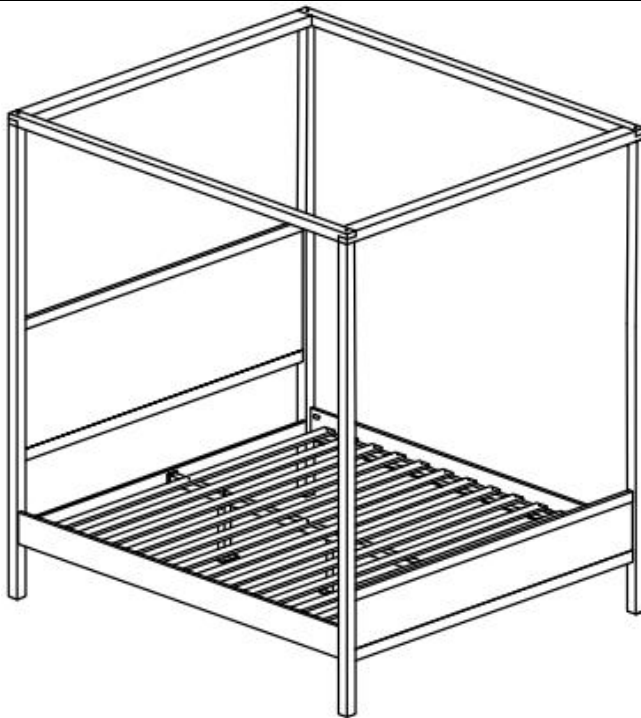


- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

WARNING

STRANGULATION HAZARD.

NEVER place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
NEVER suspend strings over bed.
NEVER place items with a string, cord, or ribbon, such as hood strings or pacifier cords, around a child's neck. These items may catch on bed parts.
ALWAYS follow assembly instructions.



WARNING!

Not intended for children under the age of six. INFANTS HAVE DIED FROM BECOMING ENTRAPPED IN BEDS. Openings in and between bed parts can entrap the neck and head of a small child. NEVER use bed for child under the age of six.

The mattress must be appropriately sized for the bed. If the mattress is undersized, dangerous gaps can exist and a person can become entrapped or entangled in the frame and suffocate.









The BED is HEAVY.

To prevent injury to yourself or damage to the product a minimum of two adults are required whenever moving or lifting it.










- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



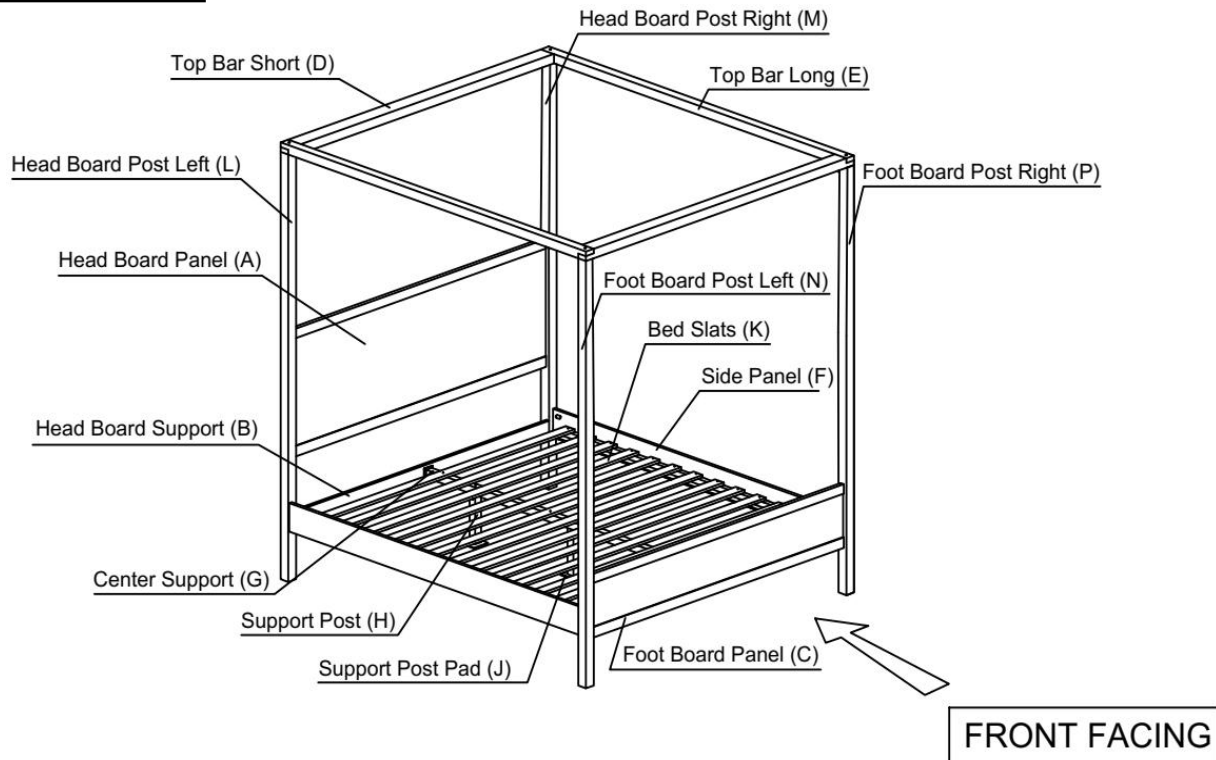
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

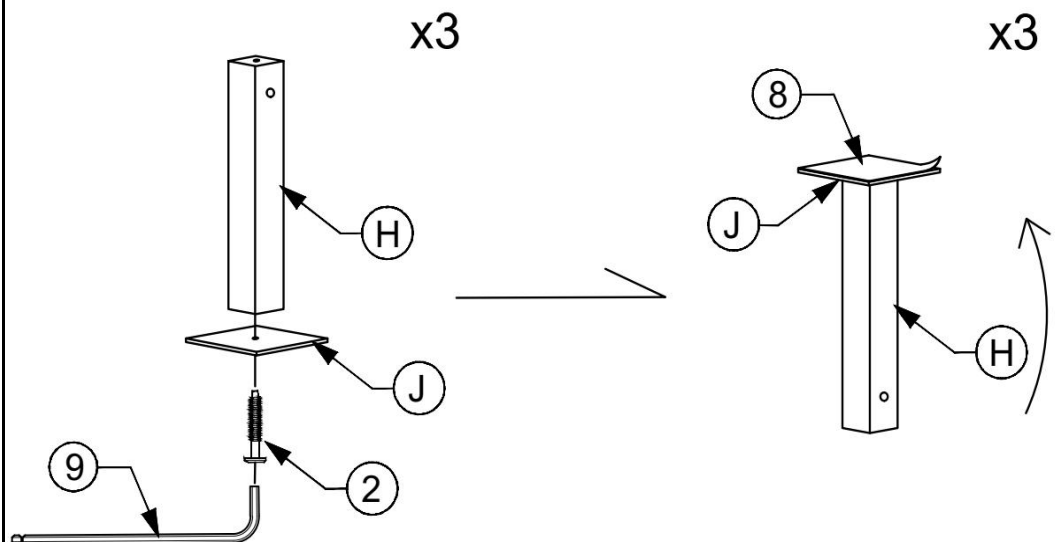
Assembly Steps

Overview



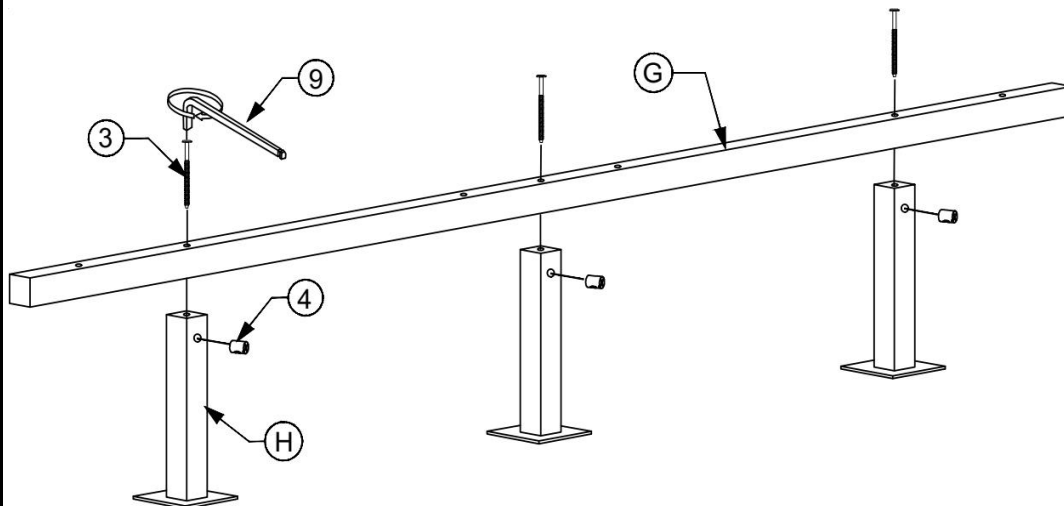
This Queen Bed has multiple parts and may require up to 60 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Queen Bed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



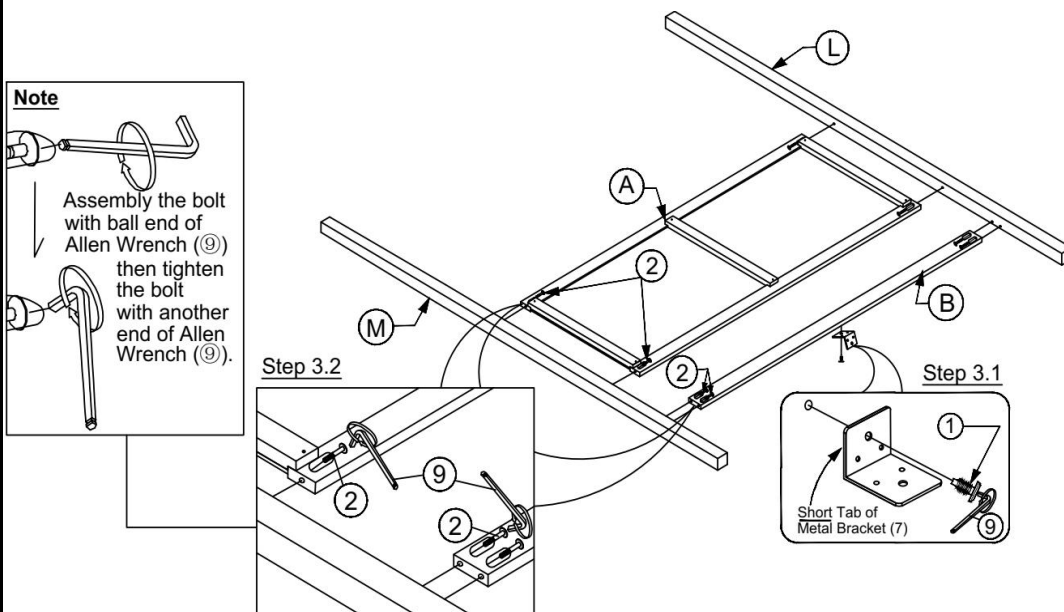
Attach Support Post Pad (J) to Support Posts (H) using JCBC Bolts (②) with Allen Wrench (⑨). Where indicated on the diagram above.
Using sticker Eva Pad (⑧) stick to Support Post Pad (J) as indicated on the diagram above.

Step 2



Attach Center Support (G) to Support Posts (H) using JCBC Bolts (③) and B/Nut (④) with Allen Wrench (⑨) as indicated on the diagram above.

Step 3



With the help of another adult.

3.1) Attach L/Bracket (⑦) to Headboard Support (B) Using JCBC Bolts (①) with Allen Wrench (⑨) as indicated on the diagram above.

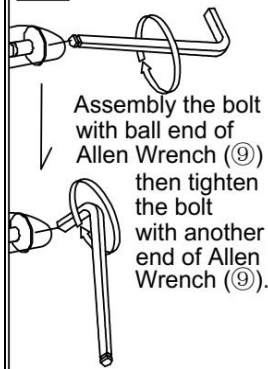
3.2) Attach Headboard Post Left (L) and Headboard Post Right (M) to Headboard Panel (A) and Headboard Support (B) using JCBC Bolts (②) with Allen Wrench (⑨) as indicated on the diagram above.

Note: For Step **3.2)** Assemble the bolt with ball end of Allen Wrench (⑨), then tighten the bolt with another end of Allen Wrench (⑨).

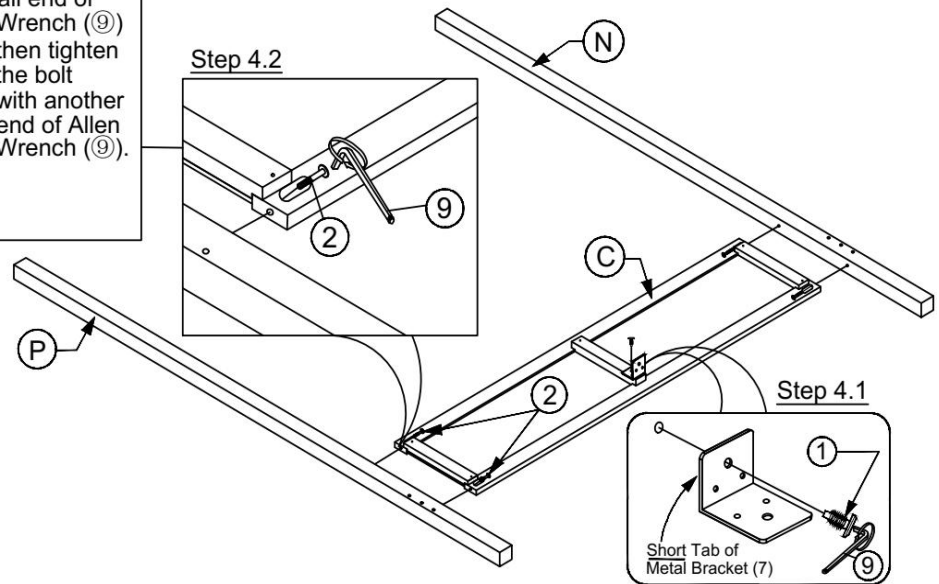

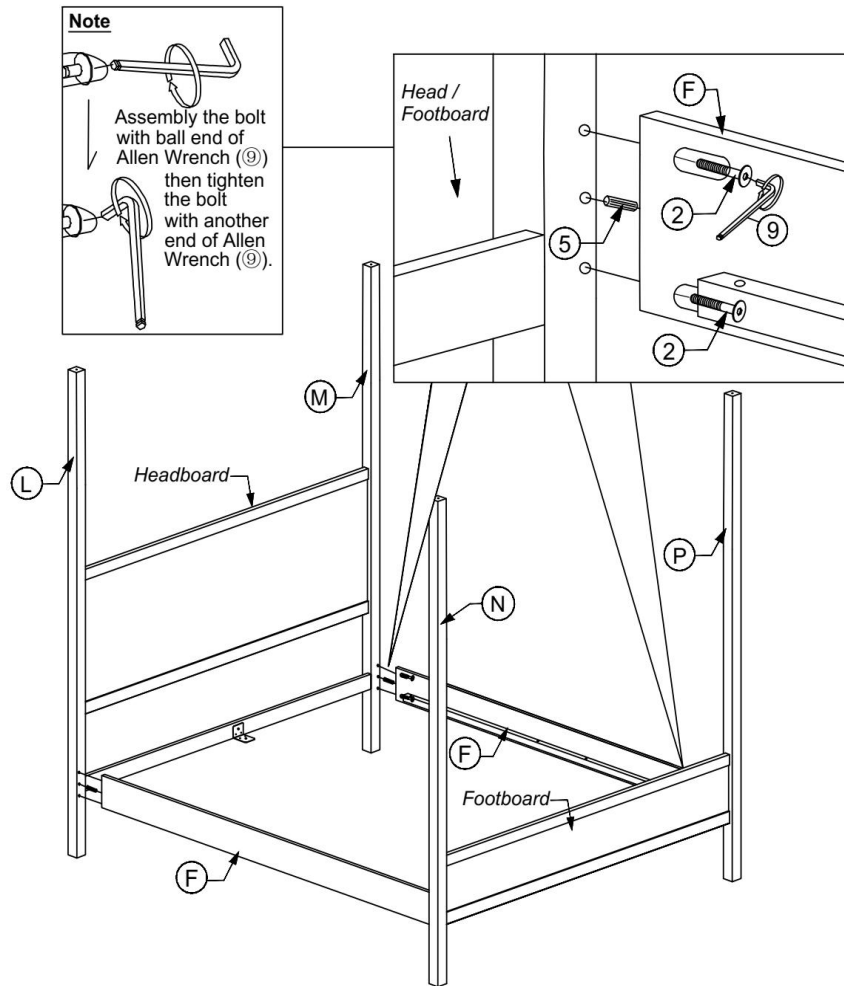
4.1) Attach L/Bracket (7) to Footboard Panel (C) Using JCBC Bolts (1) with Allen Wrench (9) as indicated on the diagram above.

4.2) Attach Footboard Post Left (N) and Footboard Post Right (P) to Footboard Panel (C) using JCBC Bolts (2) with Allen Wrench (9) as indicated on the diagram above.

Note: For Step **4.2)** Assembly the bolt with ball end of Allen Wrench (9), then tighten the bolt with another end of Allen Wrench (9).

DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.

Step 5

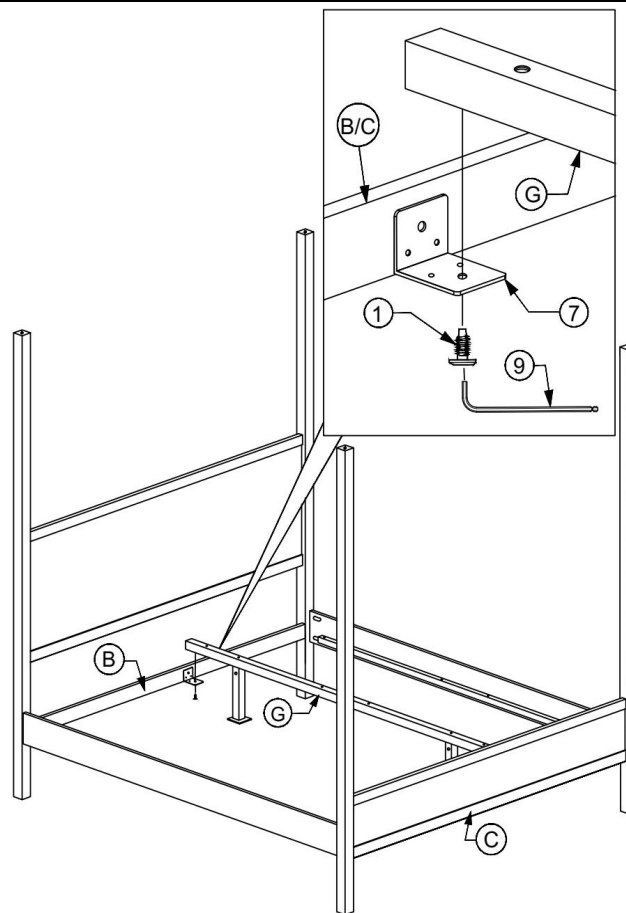


With the help of another adult, attach Side Panels (F) to Headboard Post Left (L), Headboard Post Right (M), Footboard Post Left (N) and Footboard Post Right (P) using JCBC Bolts (2) and Wood Dowels (5) with Allen Wrench (9) as indicated on the diagram above.

Note: Assembly the bolt with ball end of Allen Wrench (9), then tighten the bolt with another end of Allen Wrench (9).

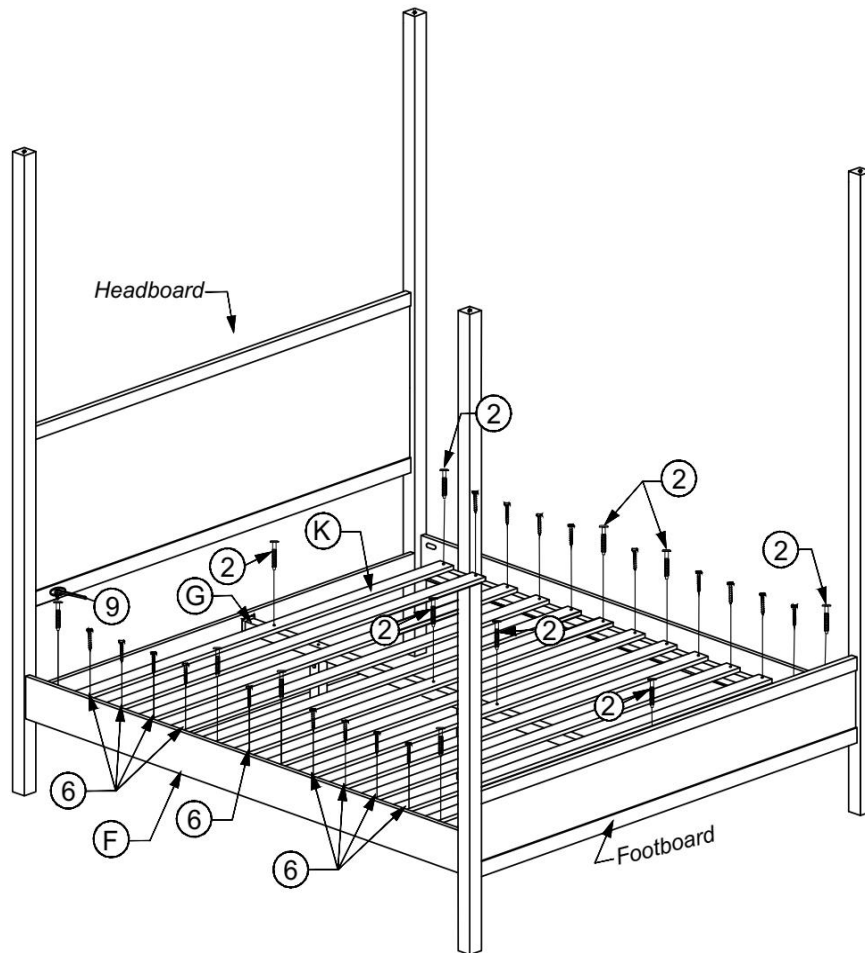
DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.

Step 6



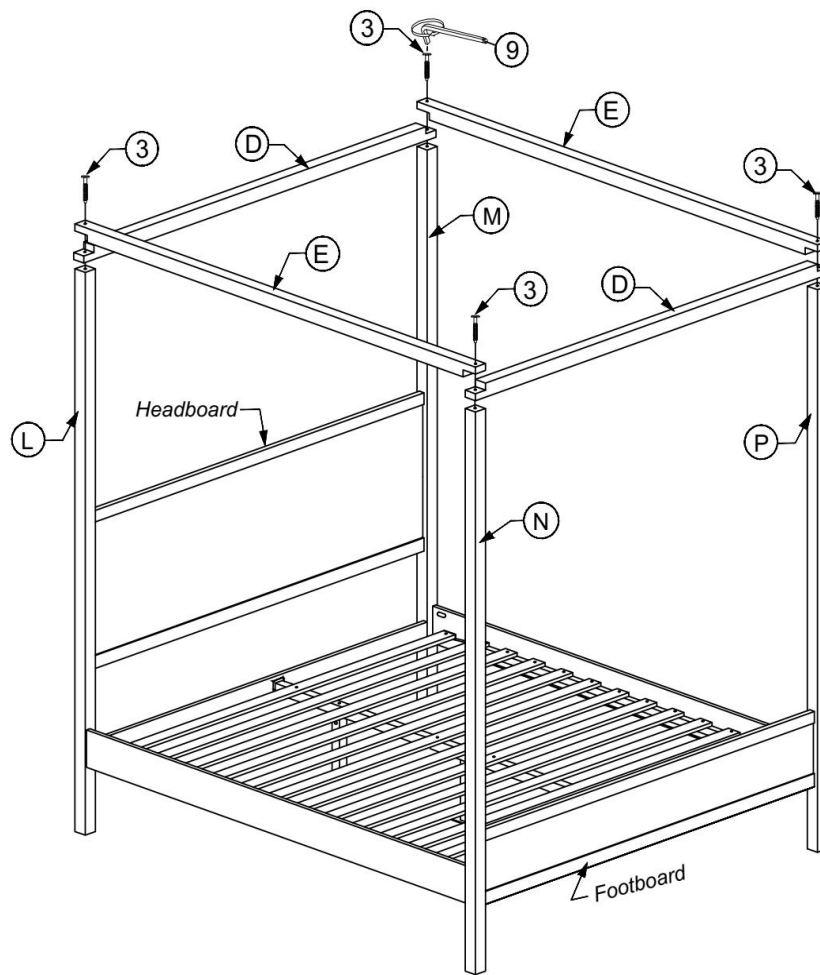
With the help of another adult ,attach Center Support (G) to Headboard Support (B) and Footboard Panel (C) using JCBC Bolts (①) with Allen Wrench (⑨) as indicated on the diagram above.

Step 7



With the help of another adult ,attach Bed Slats (K) to Side Panels (F) and Center Support (G) using JCBC Bolts (②) and CSK Screw (⑥)with Allen Wrench (⑨) as indicated on the diagram above.

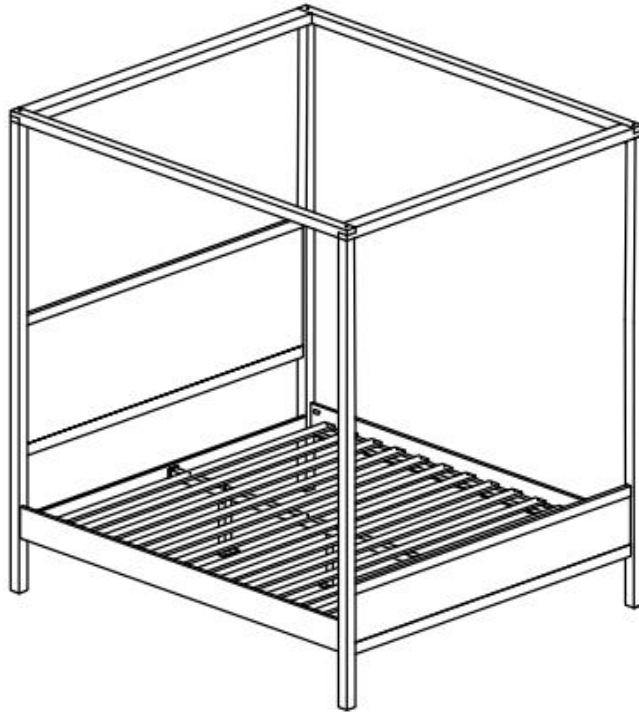
Step 8



A ladder is recommended for assembly on this step.

With the help of another adult, attach Top Bars Short (D) and Top Bars Long (E) to Headboard Post Left (L), Headboard Post Right (M), Footboard Post Left (N) and Footboard Post Right (P) using JCBC Bolts (3) with Allen Wrench (9) as indicated on the diagram above.

Step 9



Turn the Bed right side up.

Place the Bed on a LEVEL SURFACE.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

CAUTION 1: When tightening these screws, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

This would cause the frame to warp.

If there is still wobbles, loosen the screws and execute this same

process.DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

WARNING!! IF BED IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Ensure all screws are fully locked into position.

The bed is ready to be used.

Caution 2: This bed can only be used on a flat, level surface.
