Assembly Preparation

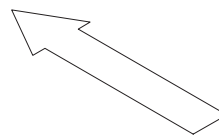
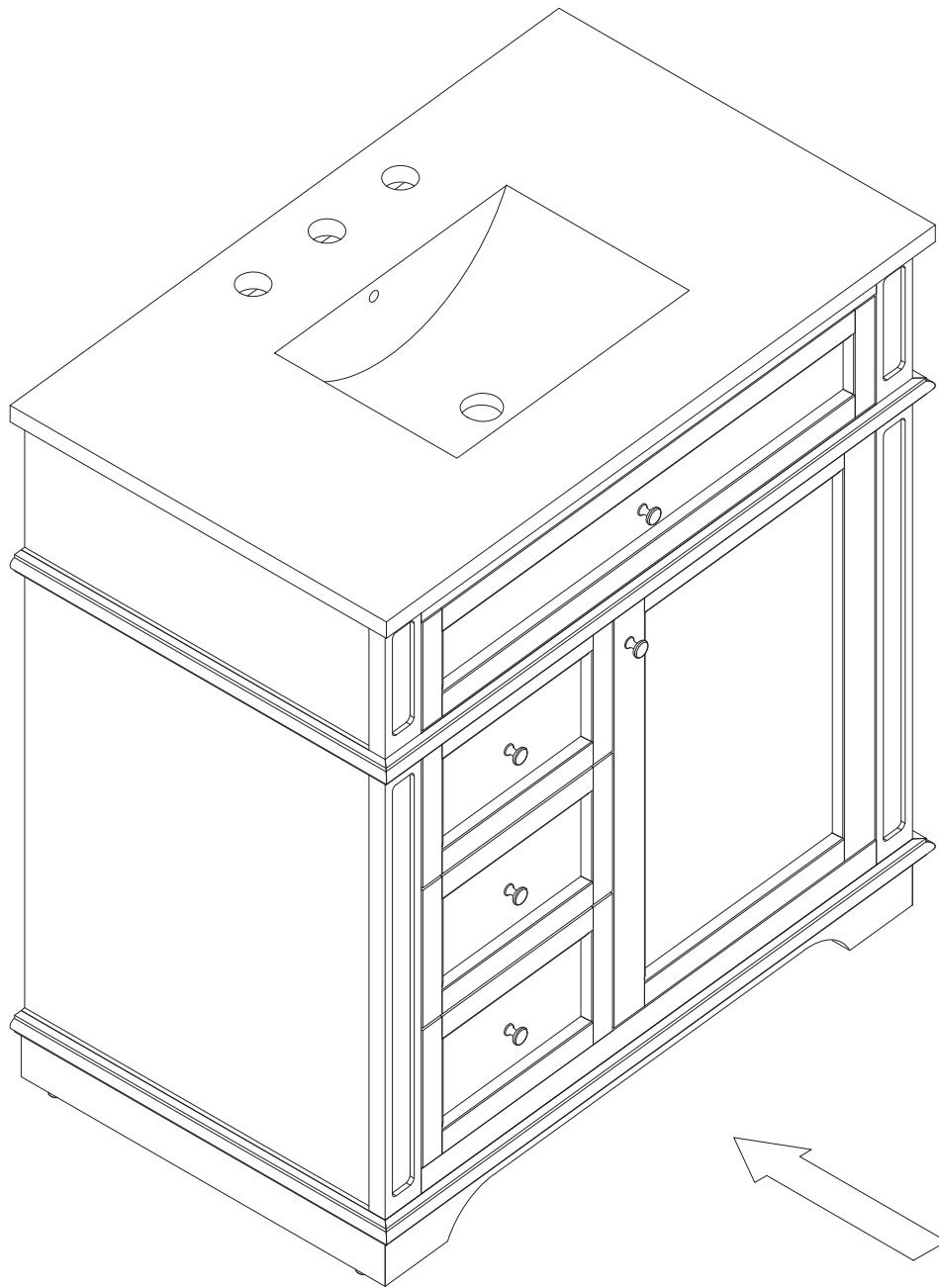
Before Beginning Assembly:

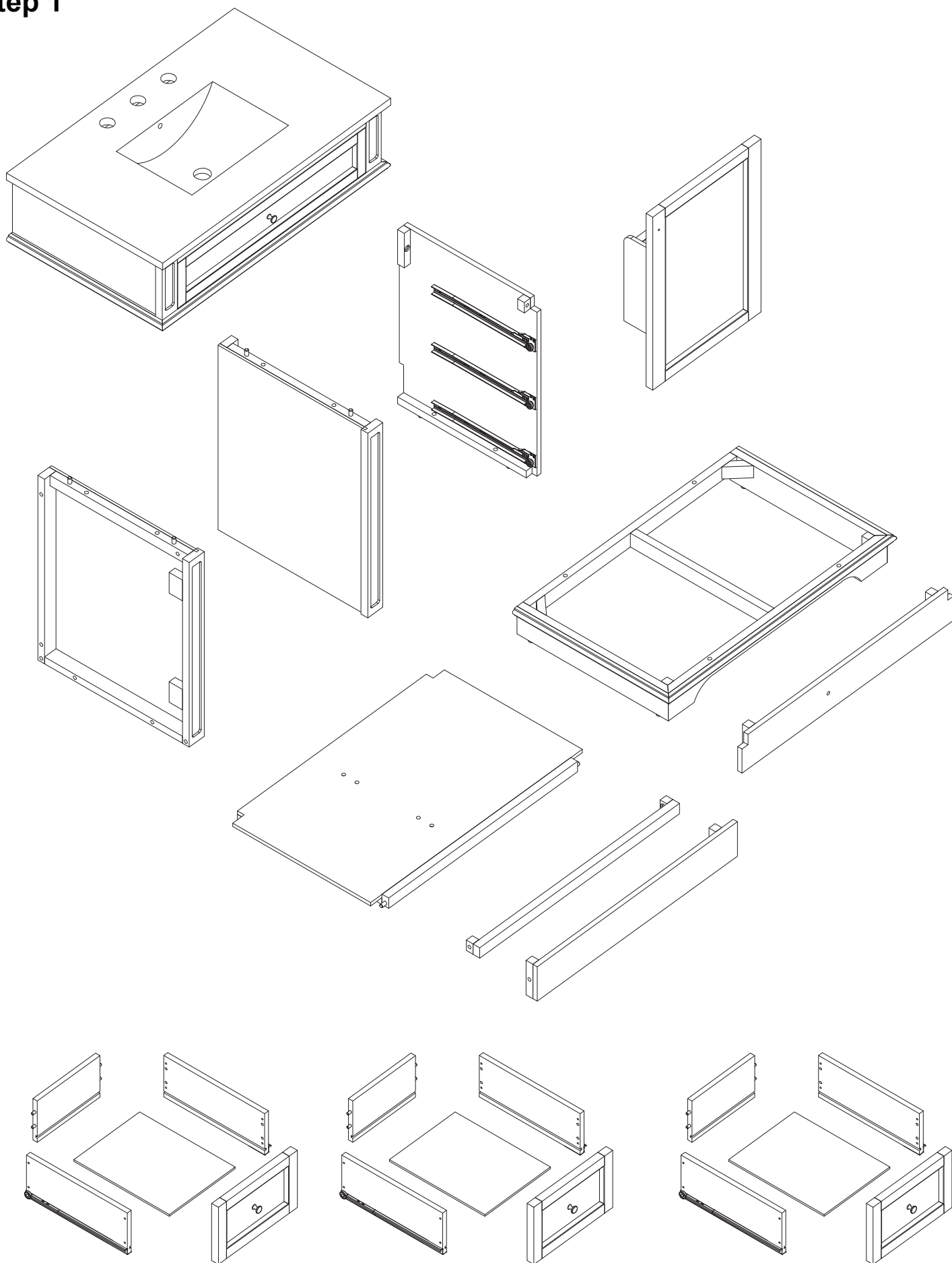

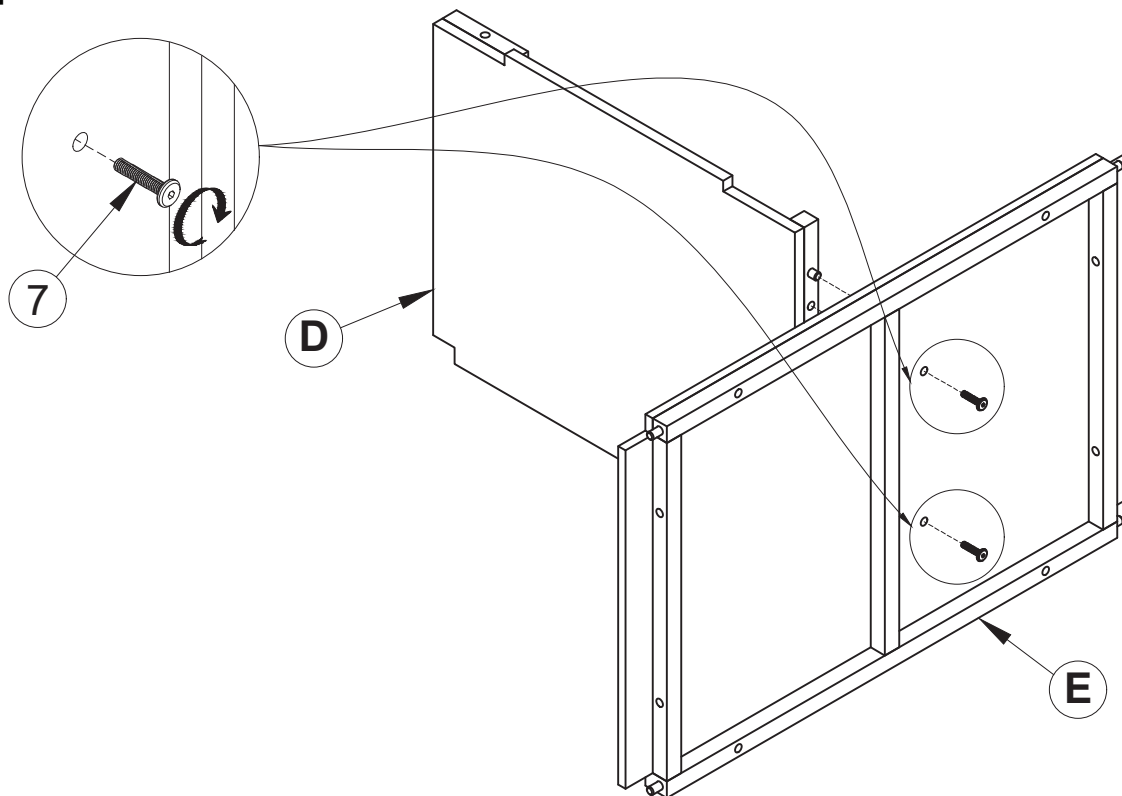
This Vanity has multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Vanity parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



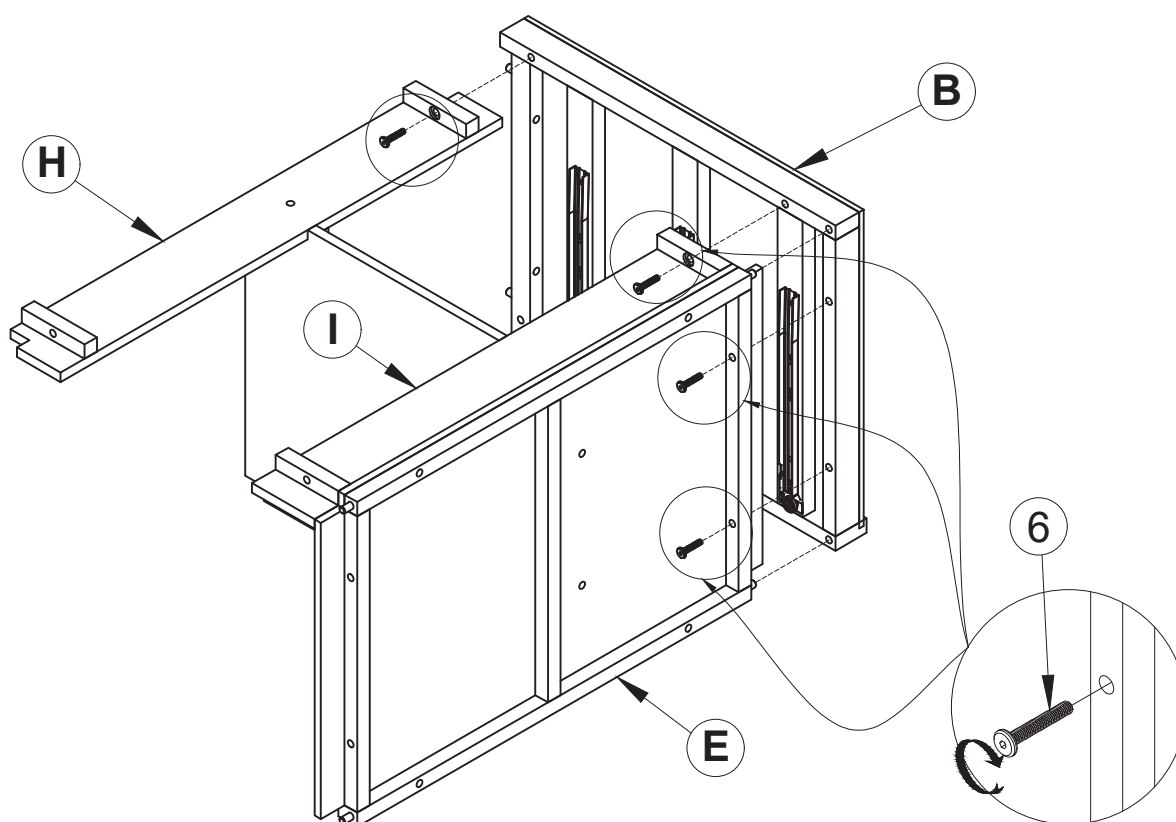
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



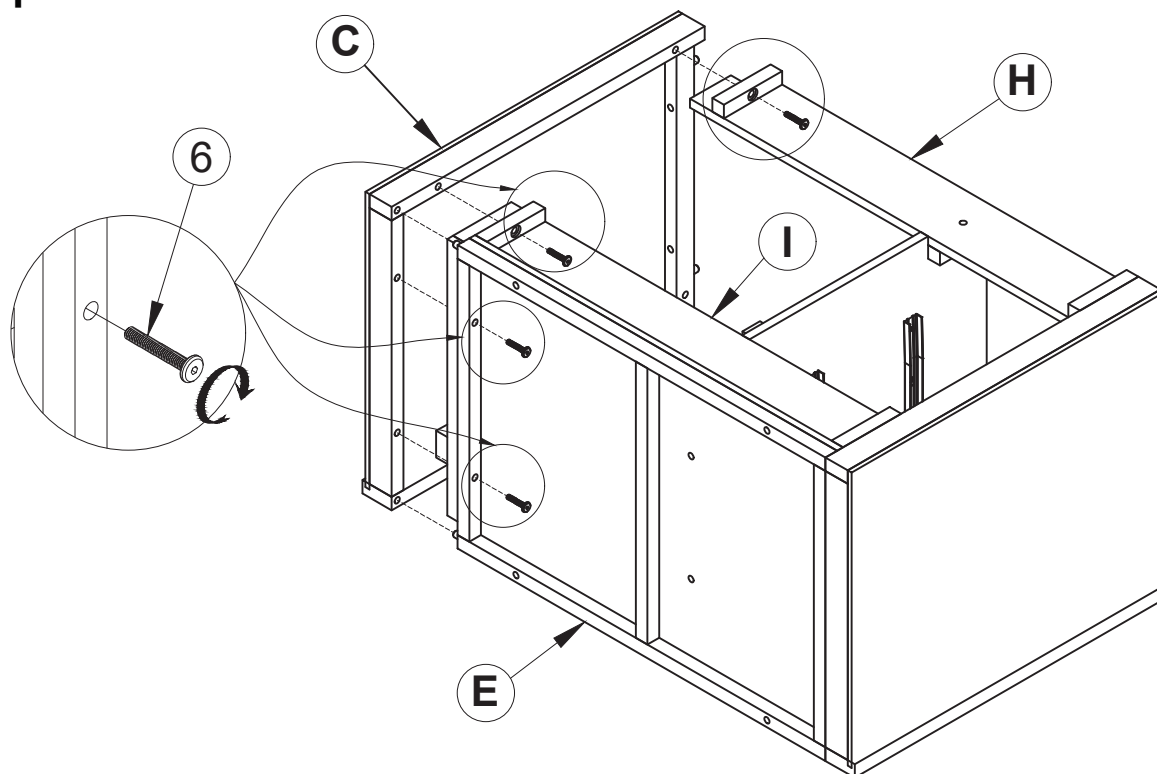
Insert Partition frame (D) and Bottom frame (E) with Bolt M6x25 (7).

Step 3



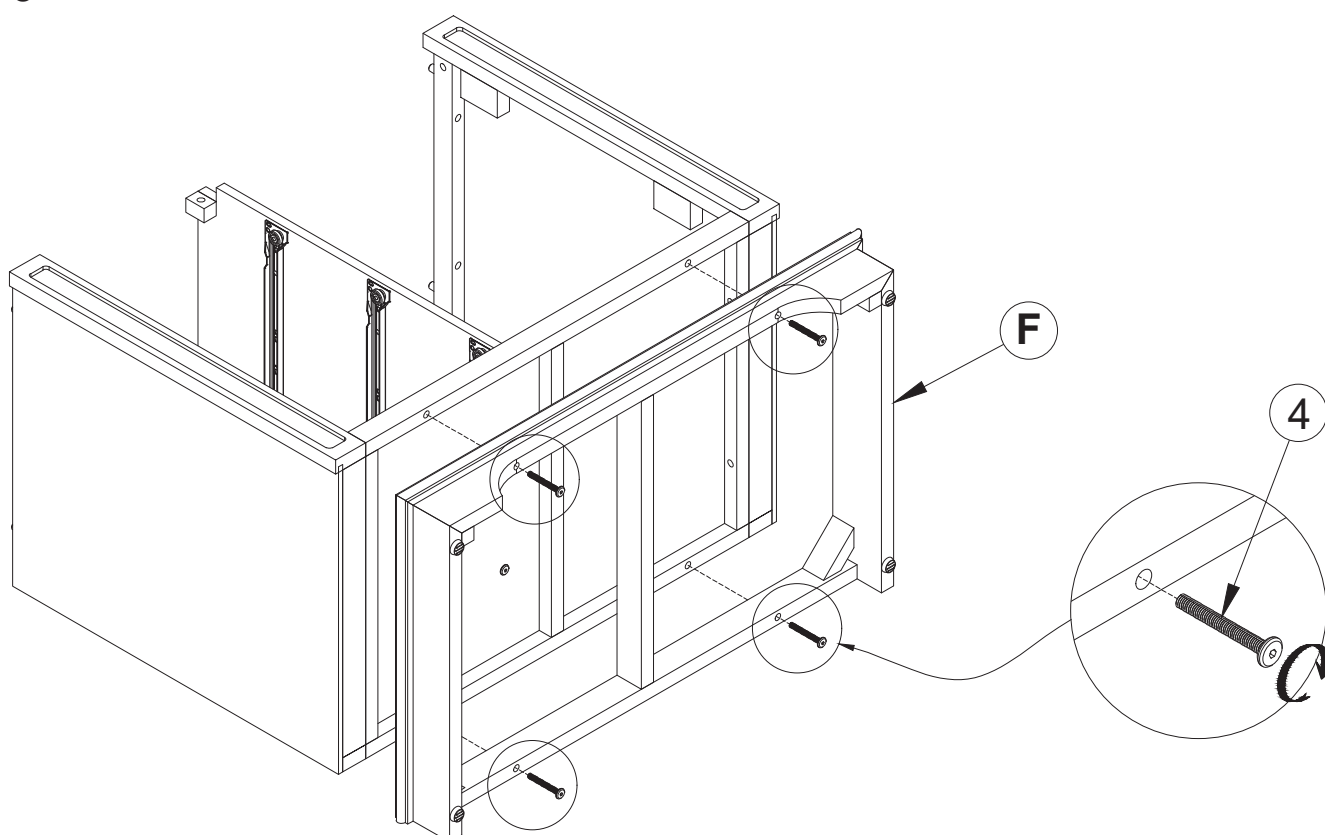
Insert Left side frame (B), Bottom frame (E), Rear top bar (H) and Rear bottom bar (I) with Bolt M6x30 (6).

Step 4



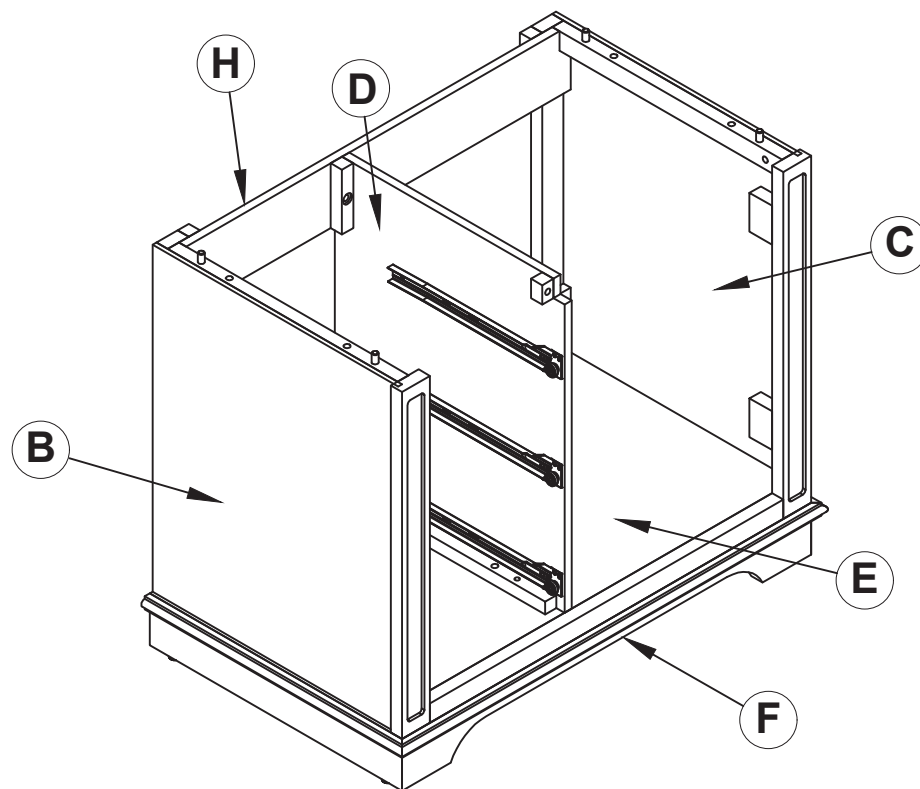
Insert Right side frame (C), Bottom frame (E), Rear top bar (H) and Rear bottom bar (I) with Bolt M6x30 (6).

Step 5



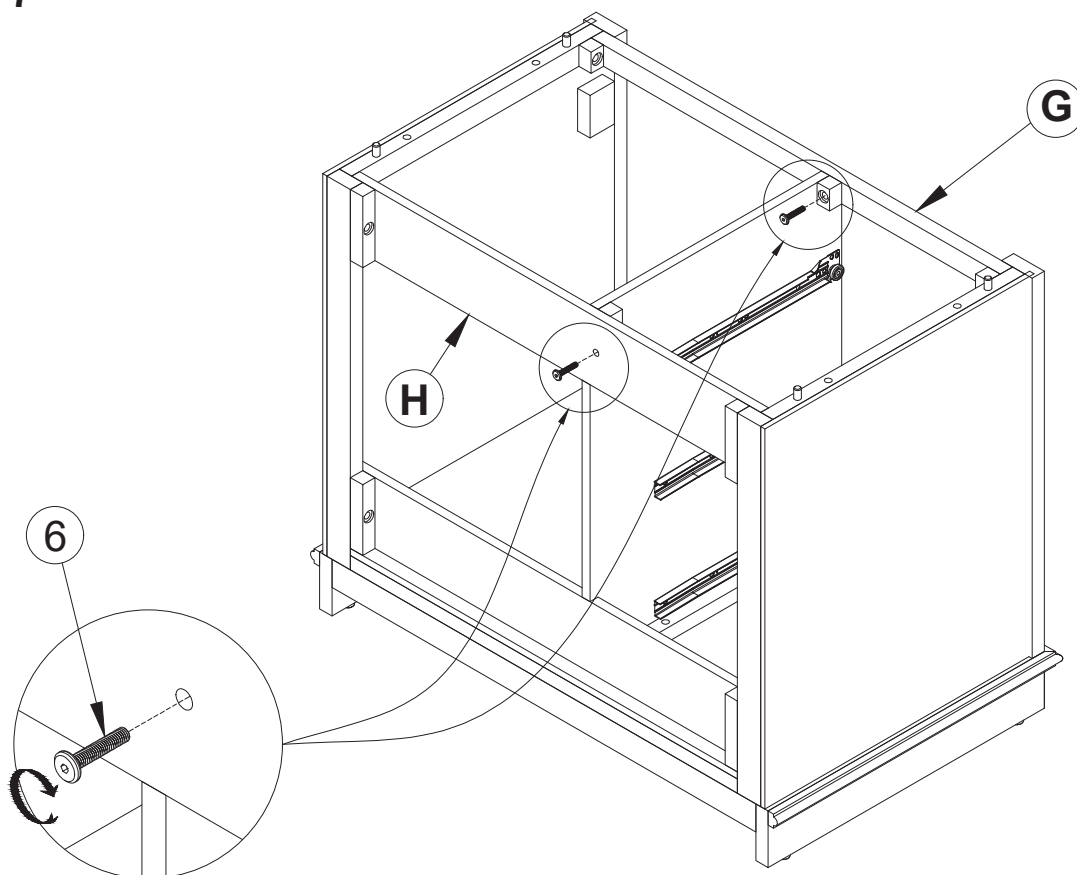
Insert Base frame (F) and Step 4 with Bolt M6x50 (4).

Step 6



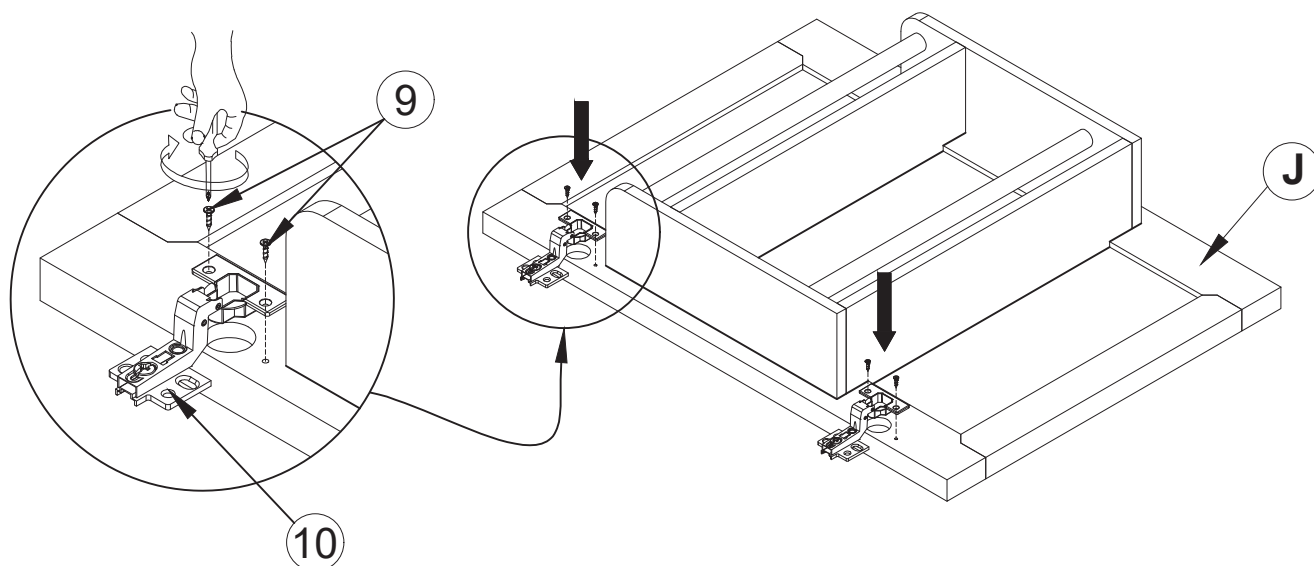
Flip to stand Step 5.

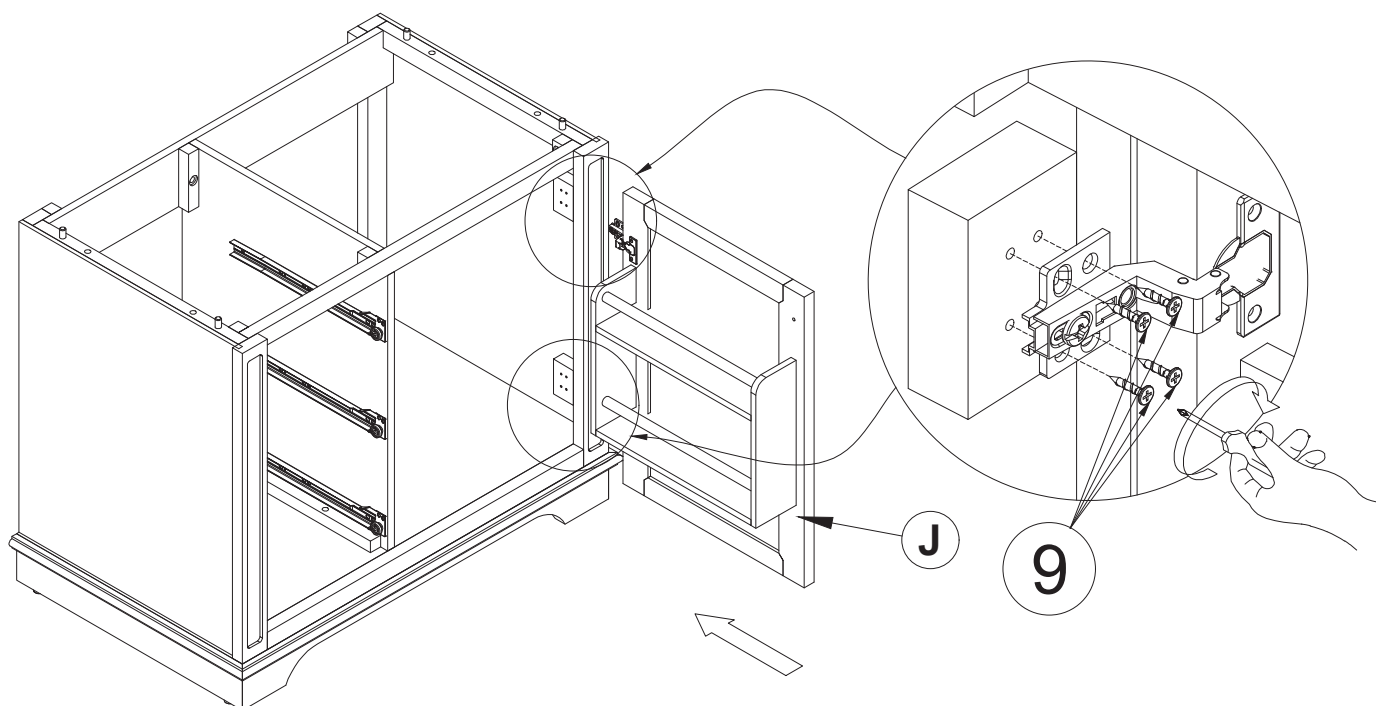
Insert Front cross bar (G), Rear top bar (H) and Step 6 with Bolt M6x30 (6).

Step 8



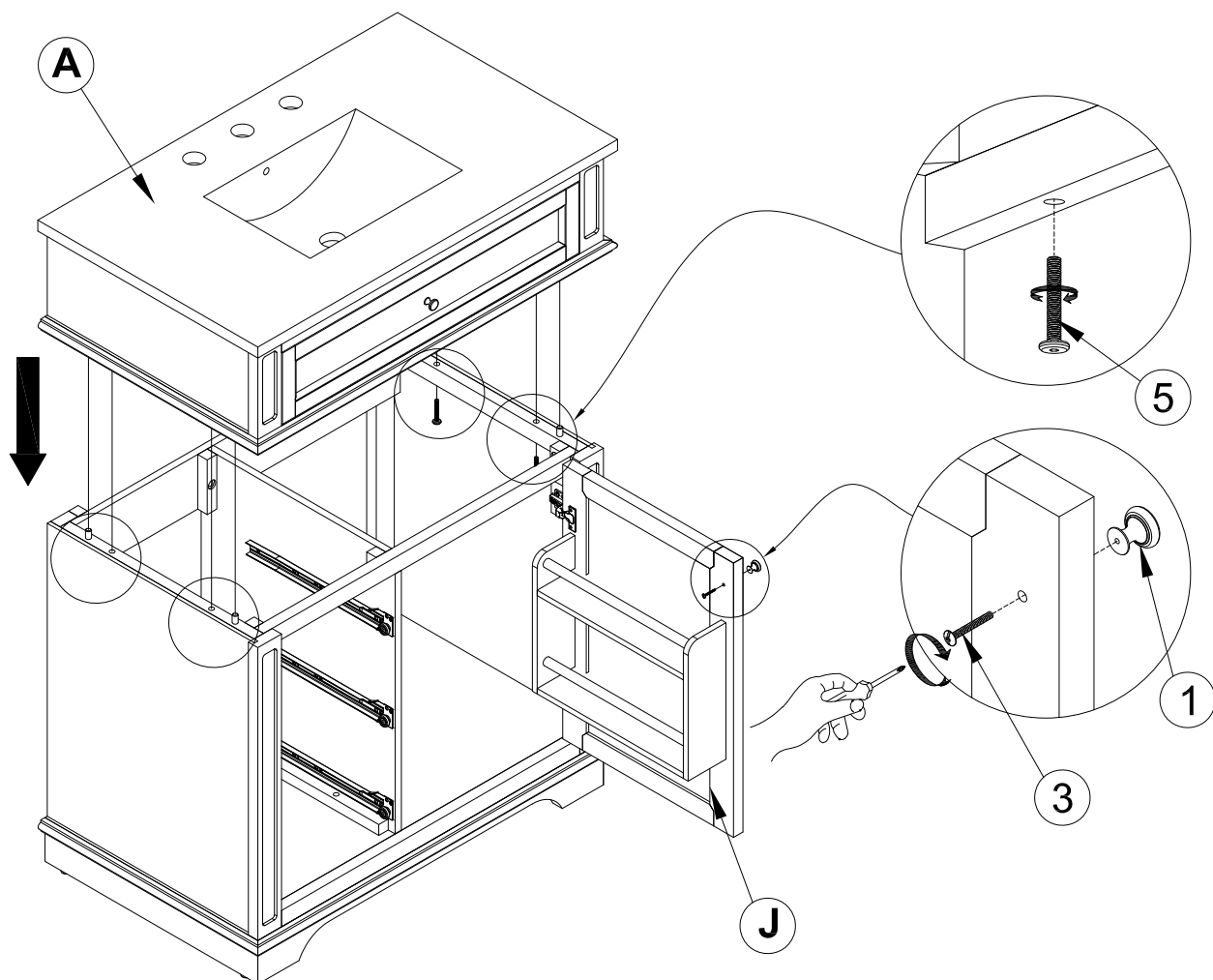
Insert Hinges (10) and Right door (J) with Screws M4x15 (9).

Step 9



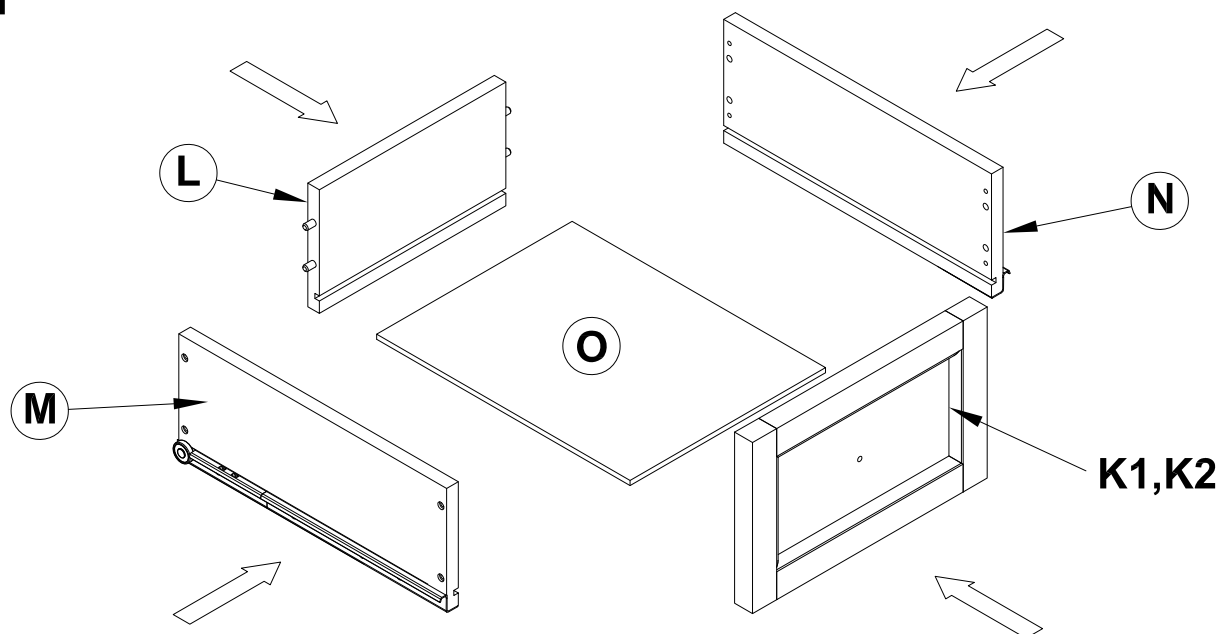
Insert Right door (J) and Step 7 with Screws M4x15 (9).

Step 10



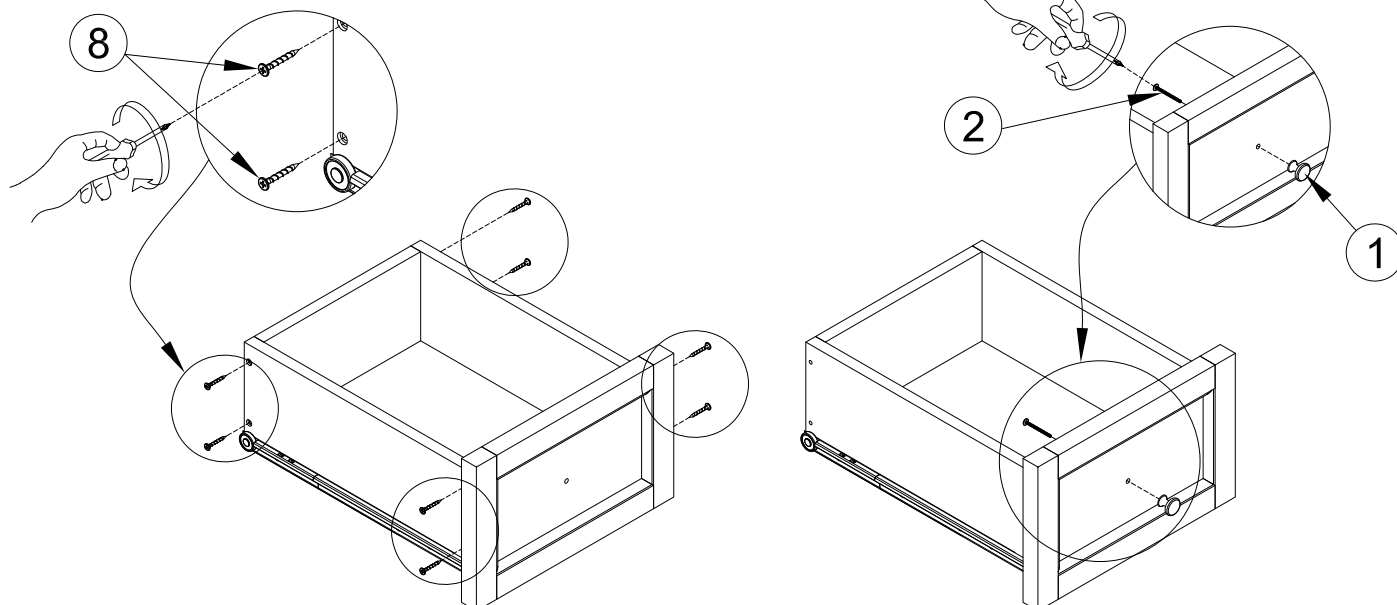
Insert Top (A) and Step 9 with Bolt M6x40 (5).
Insert Knob (1) and Right door (J) with Bolt M4x25 (3).

Insert drawer.

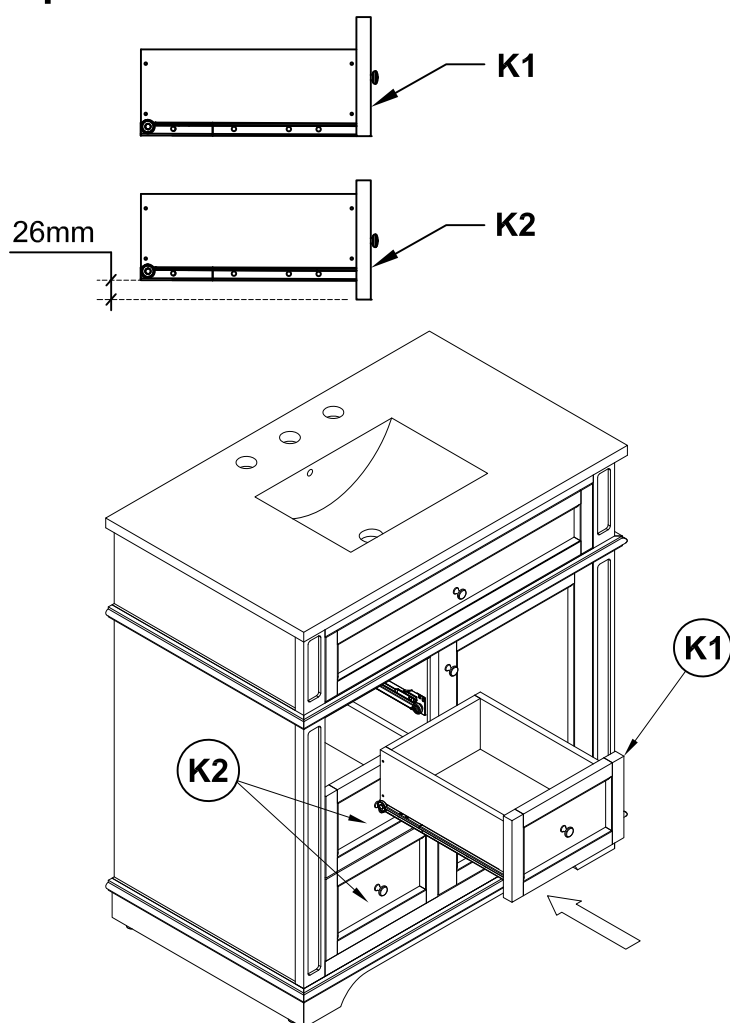

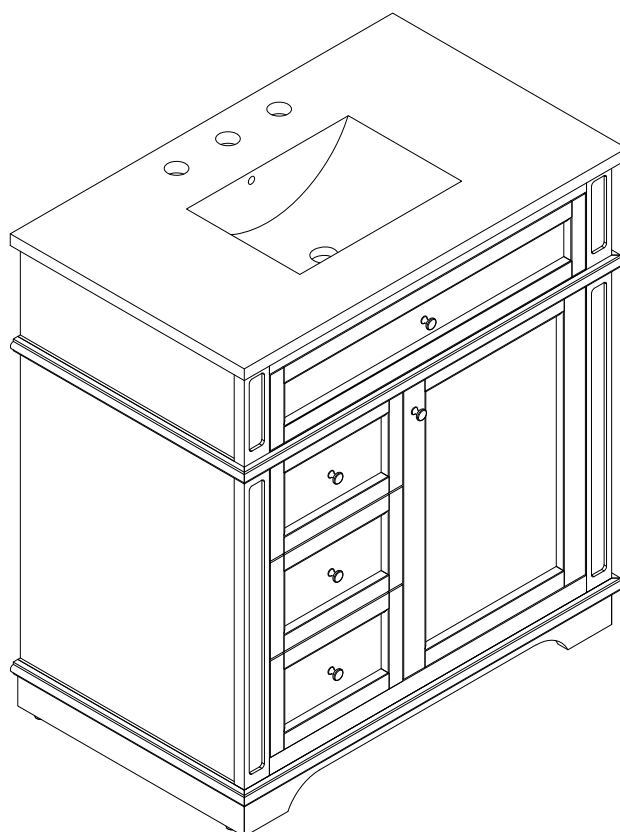
Insert all items drawer with Screws M4x30 (8)

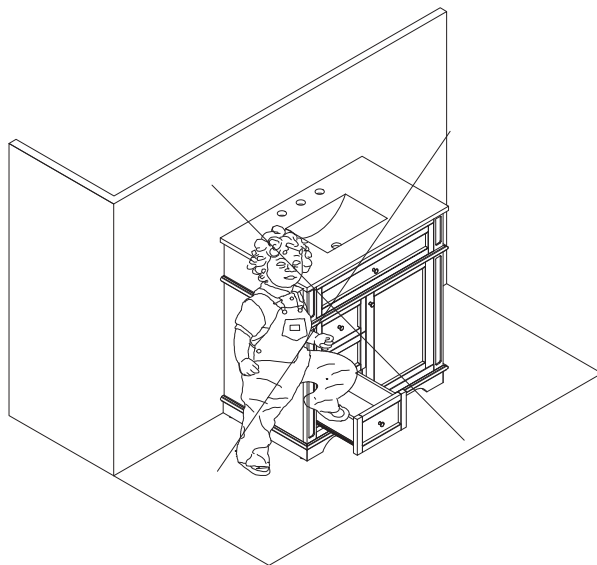

Put the drawer into the cabinet frame respectively like picture.

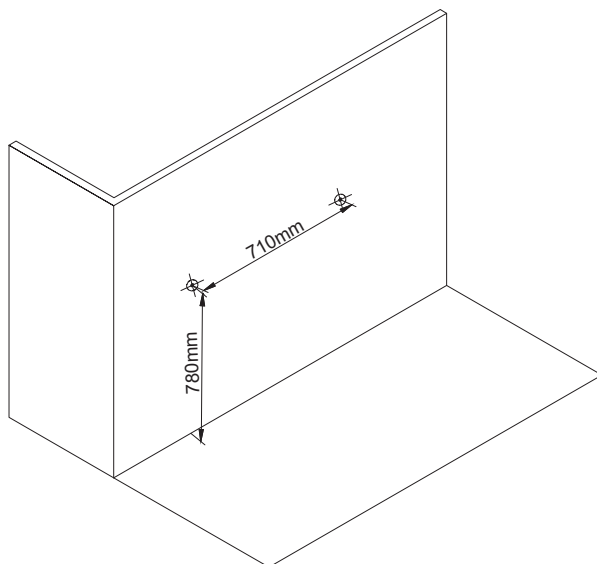
Vanity Restraint Device Installation Instruction

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tipping furniture.
To help prevent tip-over: ALWAYS secure this furniture to the wall
using Vanity Restraint Device.
See product instructions for more ways to help prevent furniture tip-overs.

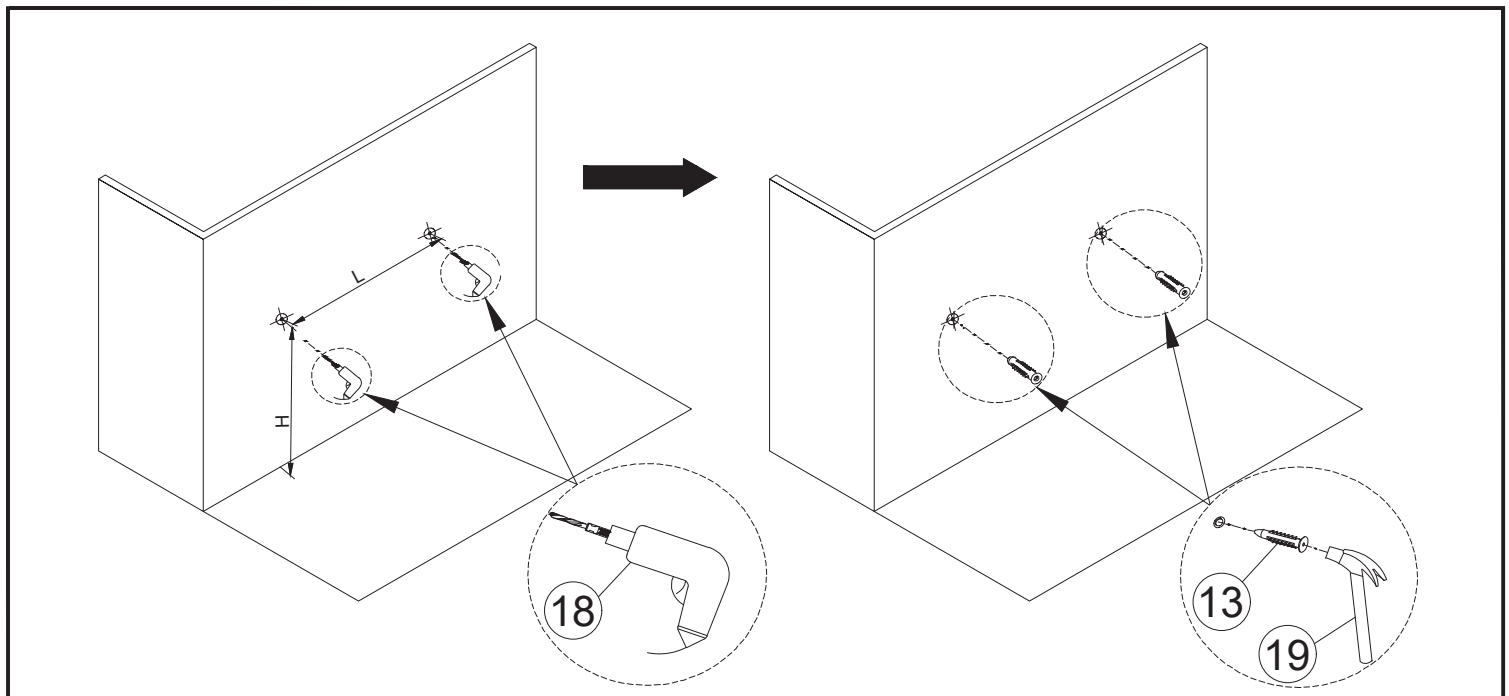


Usage For Vanity Restraint Device:

To secure the Vanity against the wall, affix 2pcs L-shape Metal Brackets (12) to the wall and to the Vanity, then use the Self tapping screws (15) to connect the L-shape Metal Brackets (12) to the wall.
Find details as below:

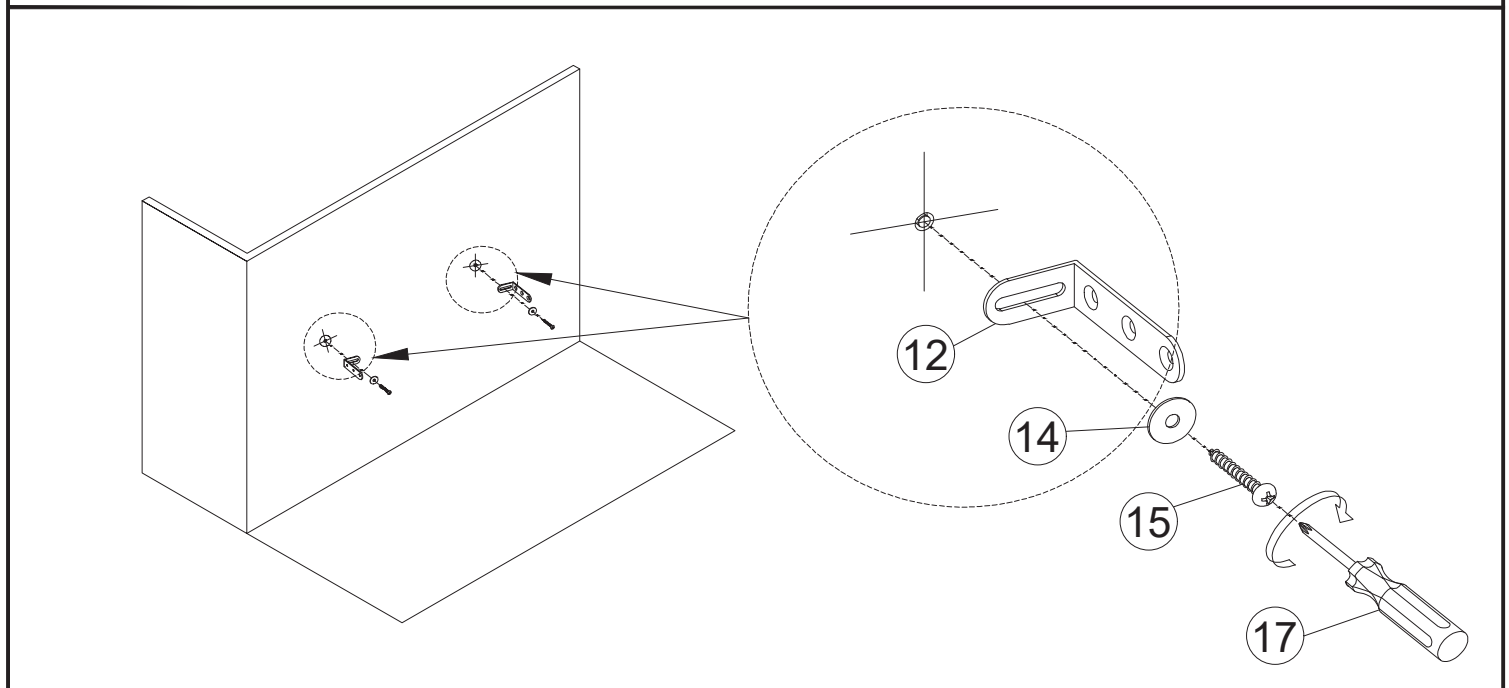


A: Determine the location where the screws should be inserted into the wall.
Mark the point at the same height and length on the wall as shown above.



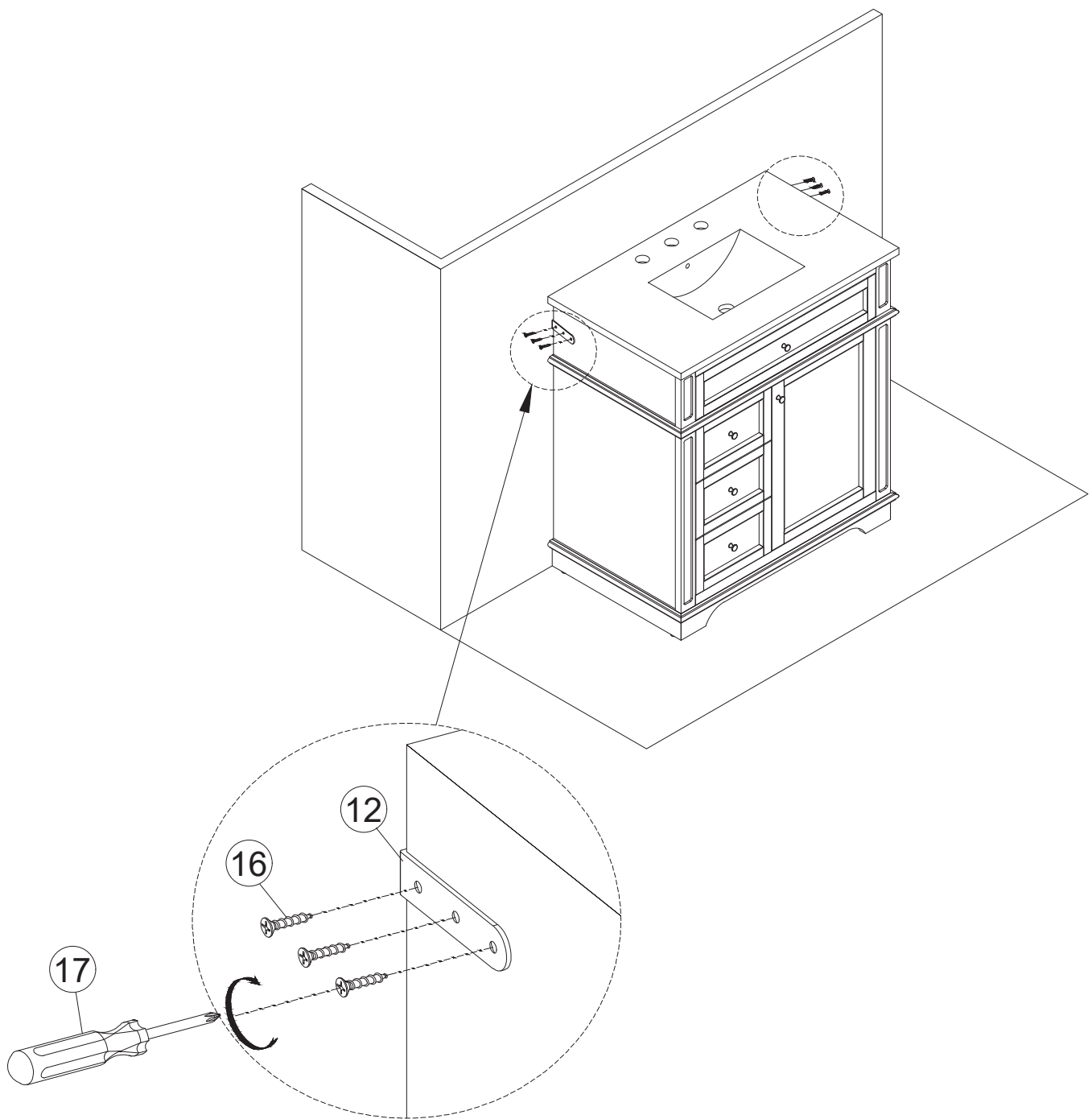
B: Affix the Plastic Anchor to the wall

Using a Power Drill(18)(not provided), drill a hole on the wall, then insert a Plastic Anchor (13) into the hole using a Hammer(19) (not provided). Repeat this step to affix the other Plastic Anchor (13) into the wall, as shown above.



C: Affix the L-shaped Metal Bracket (12) to the wall.

Then affix one L-shaped Metal Bracket (12) to the hole in the wall using the Self Tapping Screws (15), Washer (14) and Screwdriver (17)(not provided), as shown above. Repeat this step to affix the other Metal Bracket (12) to the wall as shown above.



D: Move the Vanity against the wall. Then connect the L-shaped Metal Bracket (12) to Vanity position on the wall by using the Self Tapping Screws (16) and Screwdriver (17)(not provided), as shown above. The Vanity Restraint Device is now installed and is ready for use.
