
Overview Wooden Structure (A) Leg B3 Front Facing

This Cabinet has multiple parts and may require up to some 30_minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Cabinet parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




With assistance from your adult partner, Place the Cabinet Top (A) face down as shown in picture on clean & non-marring surface.


As shown in "Step 1" picture Affix the Leg B1,B2,B3 and B4 into the Top (A).



As shown in "Step 2" picture attach the Leg (B1,B2,B3,B4) into the Top (A) by using Allen Bolt (1), Washer (2) and Allen Wrench (3).


DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE BOLTS.





With help of your adult partner, Carefully stand the Cabinet.

- 3.1) Open the Door and de-attach the Knob (C) which is attached inisde the Door in Anti-clockwise using Screwdriver (4).
- 3.2) Install the Knob (C) with the help of Screwdriver (4) closkwise as picture.



Check the product if stable and not wobbling. Once done, Tighten all the Legs to secure the Cabinet.

This Cabinet is now ready to use.





Usage For Tipover Restraint Device:

To secure Cabinet against the wall, attach two Metal Brackets (⑦) on wall.




5.1) Drill two holes on wall at 5 cm below from the height of Cabinet as Metal Brackets (⑦) on Cabinet with Power Drill (⑥).

You can mark these points in two ways as below:

1) Move the Cabinet back to the wall. Mark two points same width as Cabinet on the wall.

Note: The Metal Brackets need to e secured to solid, Load bearing surface. Please use a stud finder (not supplied) if needed to locate the wall frame.

- 2) Measure the Height of Metal Brackets (②) with ruler/measuring tape and mark on wall to keep them accurate and same height and width of the Cabinet.
- 5.2) Insert Wall Plugs (9) into drilled holes on wall with Hammer (5).



Attach Metal Brackets (⑦) to Wall Plugs (⑨) using Wall Plug Screws (⑧) and Washer (⑪) with Screwdriver (④).

Step 7

Move Cabinet to the wall, Customer can choose one of 3 hole for assembly same as other side.

Connects the Metal Brackets (⑦) to Cabinet with help of Product Screw (⑩) and Screwdriver (④) same as other side.
