Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

QUEEN BED



WARNING !

STRANGGULATION HAZARD

NEVER place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

NEVER suspend strings over bed.

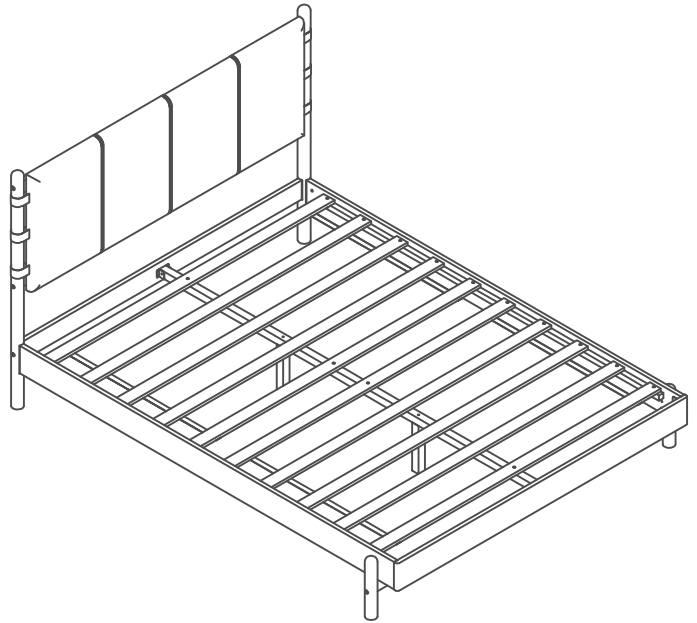
NEVER place items with a string, cord, or ribbon, such as hood strings or pacifier cords, around a child's neck. These items may catch on bed parts.

ALWAYS follow assembly instructions.

Not intended for children under the age of six. INFANTS HAVE DIED FROM BECOMING ENTRAPPED IN BEDS. Openings in and between bed parts can entrap the neck and head of a small child.

NEVER use bed for child under the age of six.

The mattress must be appropriately sized for the bed. If the mattress is undersized dangerous gaps can exist and a person can become entrapped or entangled in the frame and suffocate.




CAUTION: This Queen Bed is NOT a TOY.

Keep your child / children at bay in the process of assembly.














<p>This Queen Bed has multiple parts and may require up to 1 hour to assemble.</p> <p>To give you an overview of the Queen Bed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.</p> <p>Please read through the instructions herebelow to famiarsse the parts and steps before assembly.</p>				<p>Assembly Preparation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read instruction, cover to cover. Have 2 adults on hand for assembly. Do not assemble on flooring or carpet. Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam). Save all packaging until finished. 	

Step 2:



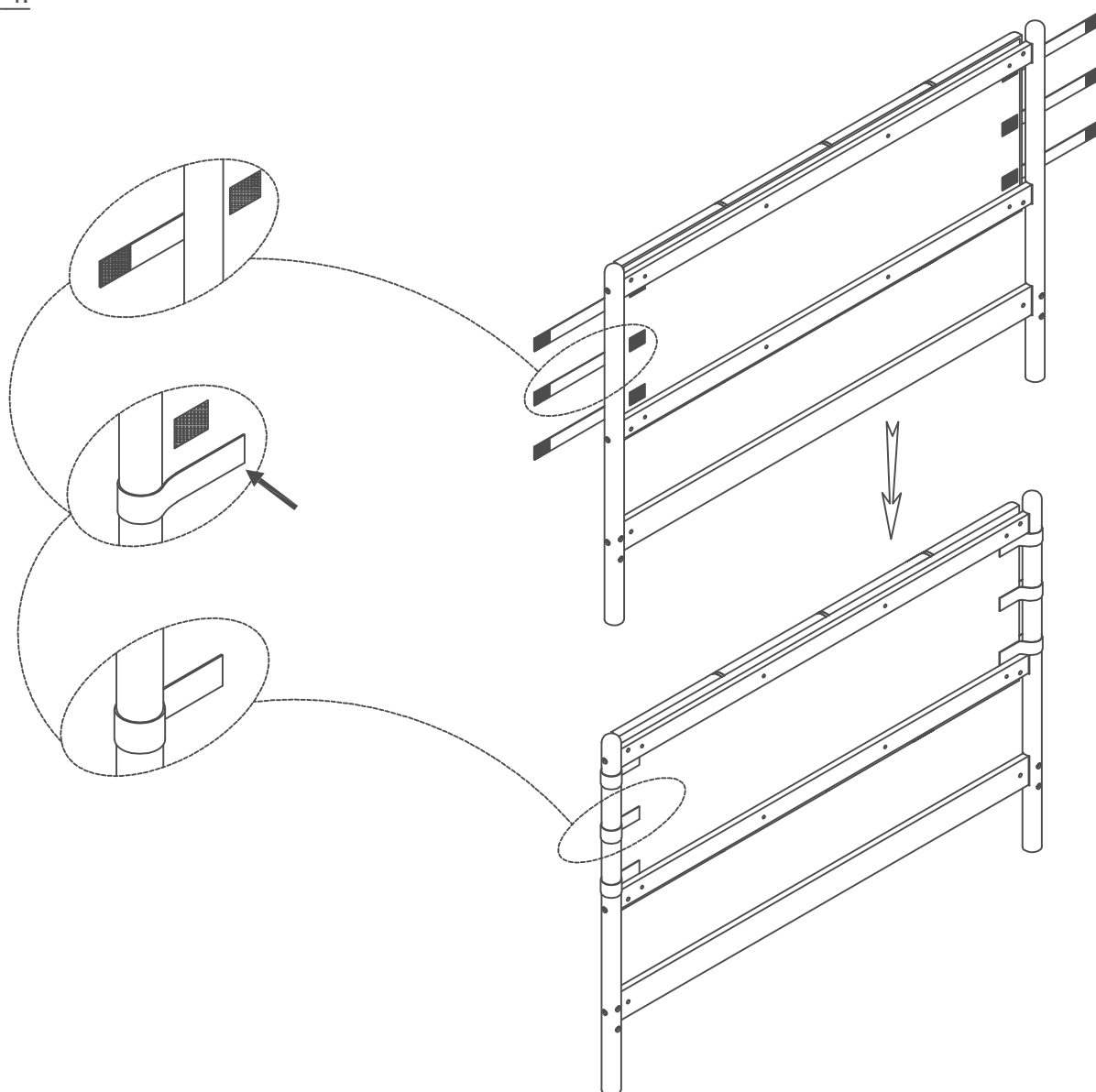
- Attach Crossbar headboard (G) and Crossbar headboard (M) to the Left leg headboard (A) and Right leg headboard (B) using Wooden dowel ⑨*8, Bolt ④*6 with Allen Wrench ⑬*1 as shown.

Step 3:



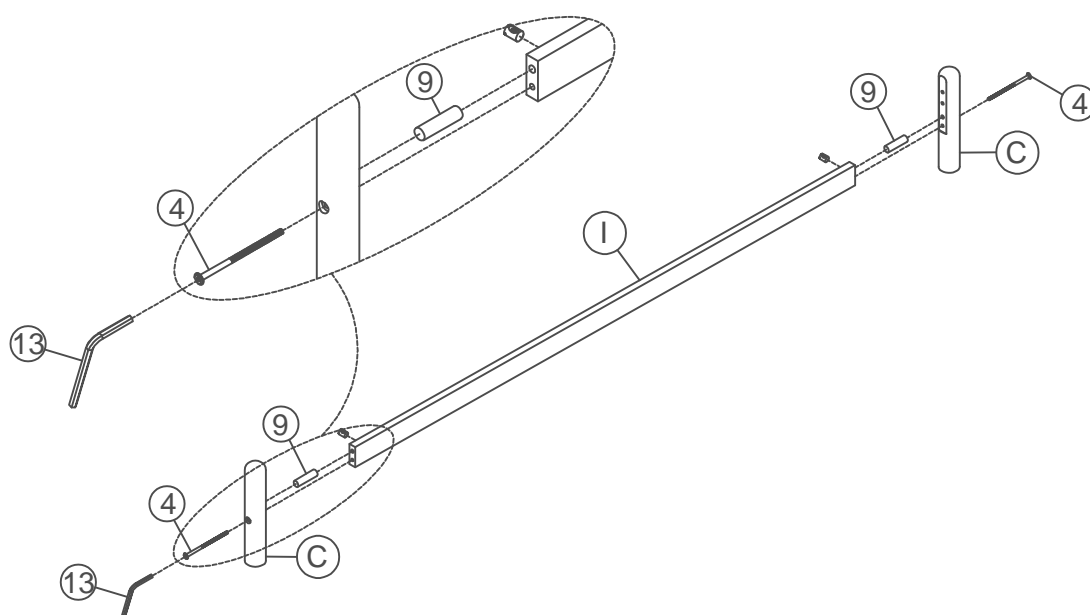
- Attach Mattress frame headboard (F) to the Crossbar headboard (M) using Bolt ⑥*8 with Allen Wrench ⑬*1 as shown.

Step 4:



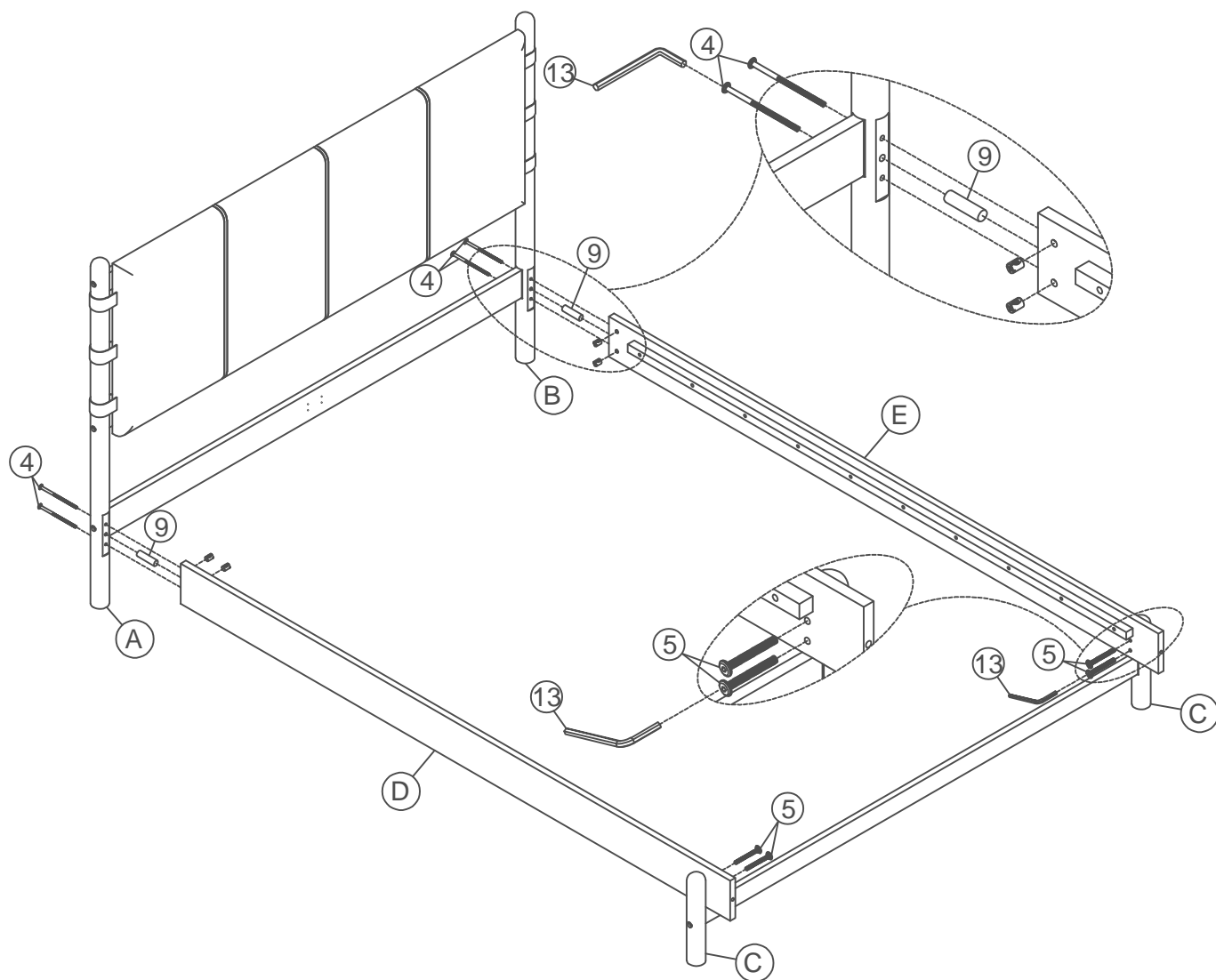
- Paste 6 positions as shown.

Step 5:



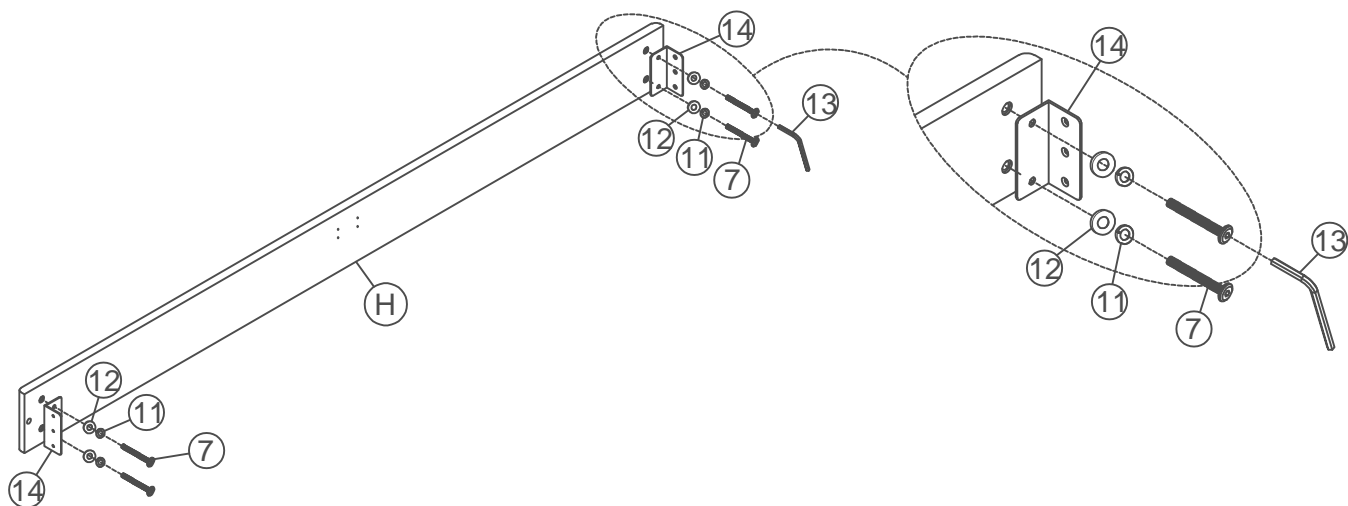
- Attach Crossbar support (I) to the Legs footboard (C) using Wooden dowel(9)*2, Bolt(4)*2 with Allen Wrench (13) *1 as shown.

Step 6:



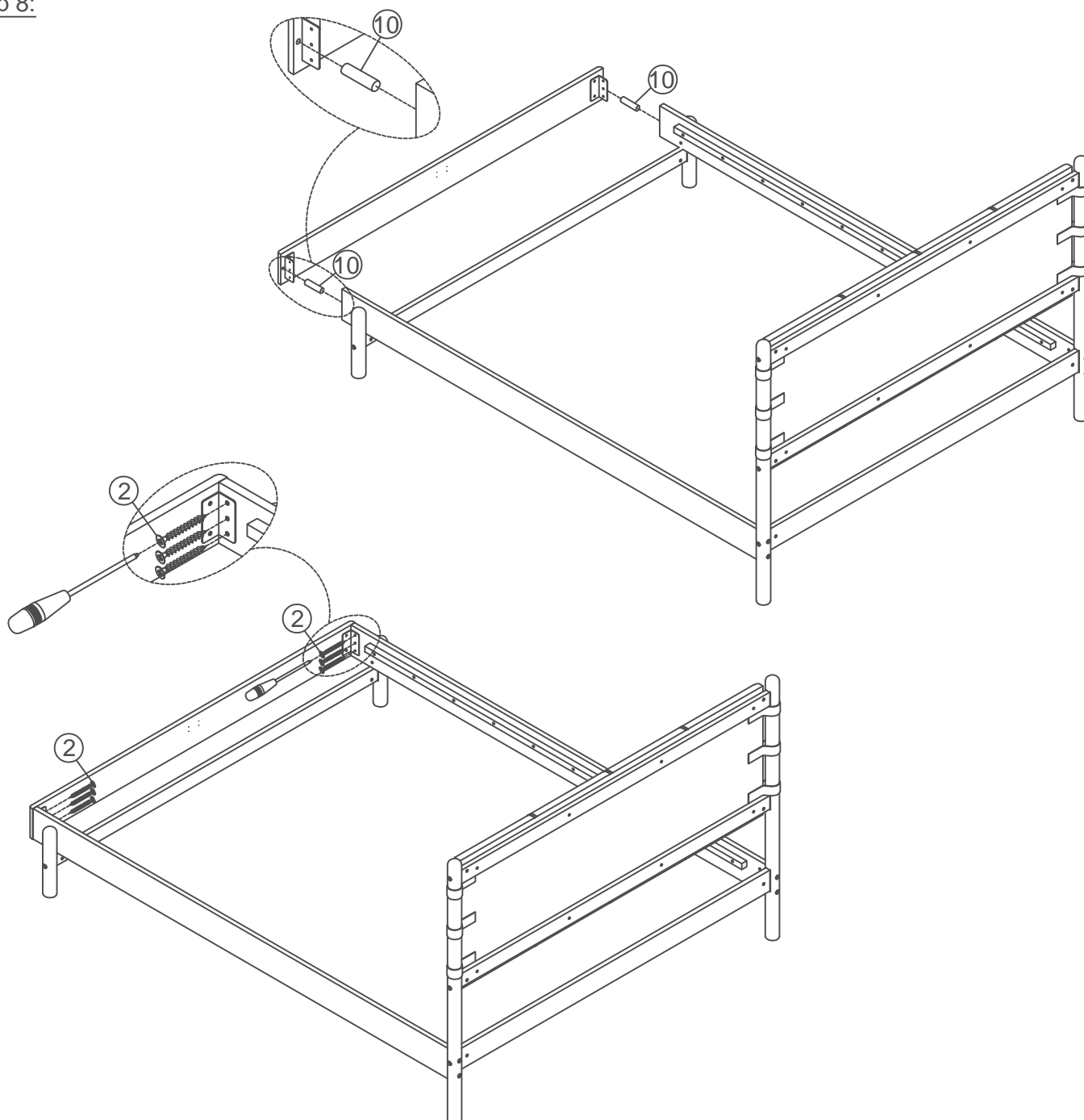
- Attach Left side rails (D) to the Left leg headboard (A), Leg footboard (C), using Wooden dowel ⑨*1, Bolt ④*2, Bolt ⑤*2 with Allen Wrench ⑬*1 as shown.
- Attach Right side rails (E) to the Right leg headboard (B), Leg footboard (C), using Wooden dowel ⑨*1, Bolt ④*2, Bolt ⑤*2 with Allen Wrench ⑬*1 as shown.

Step 7:



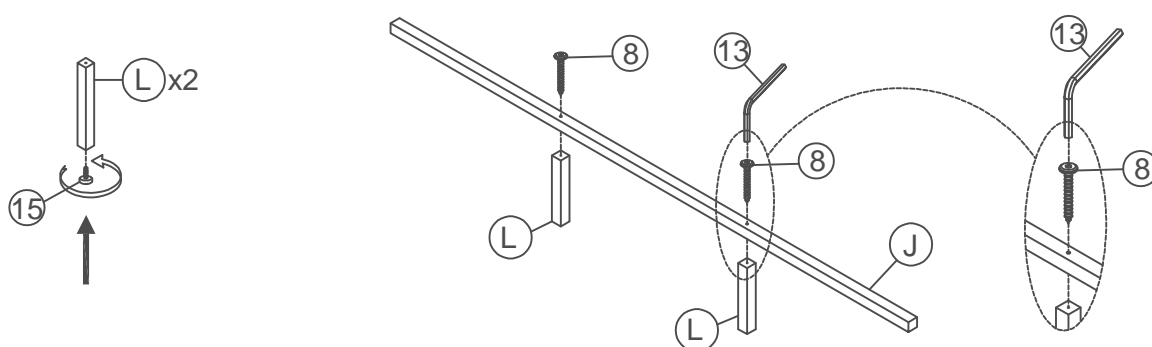
- Attach Metal link ⑭*2 to the Bed rail (H) using Spring washer ⑪*4, Flat Washer ⑫*4, Bolt ⑦*4 with Allen Wrench ⑬*1 as shown.

Step 8:



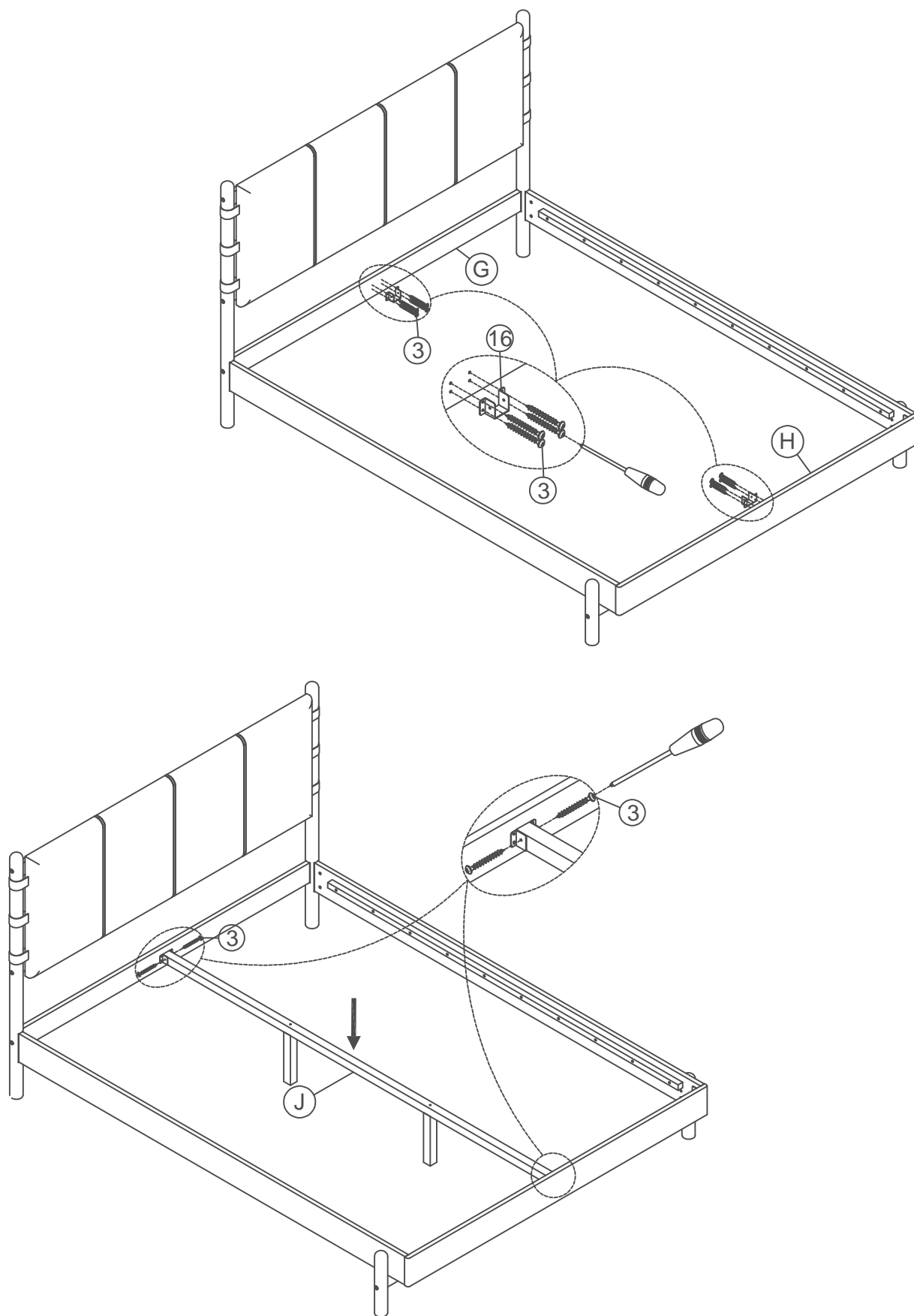
- Attach Bed rail (H) to the Left side rails (D) and Right side rails (E) using Wooden dowel ⑩ *2, Vis②*6 Screwdriver as shown.

Step 9:



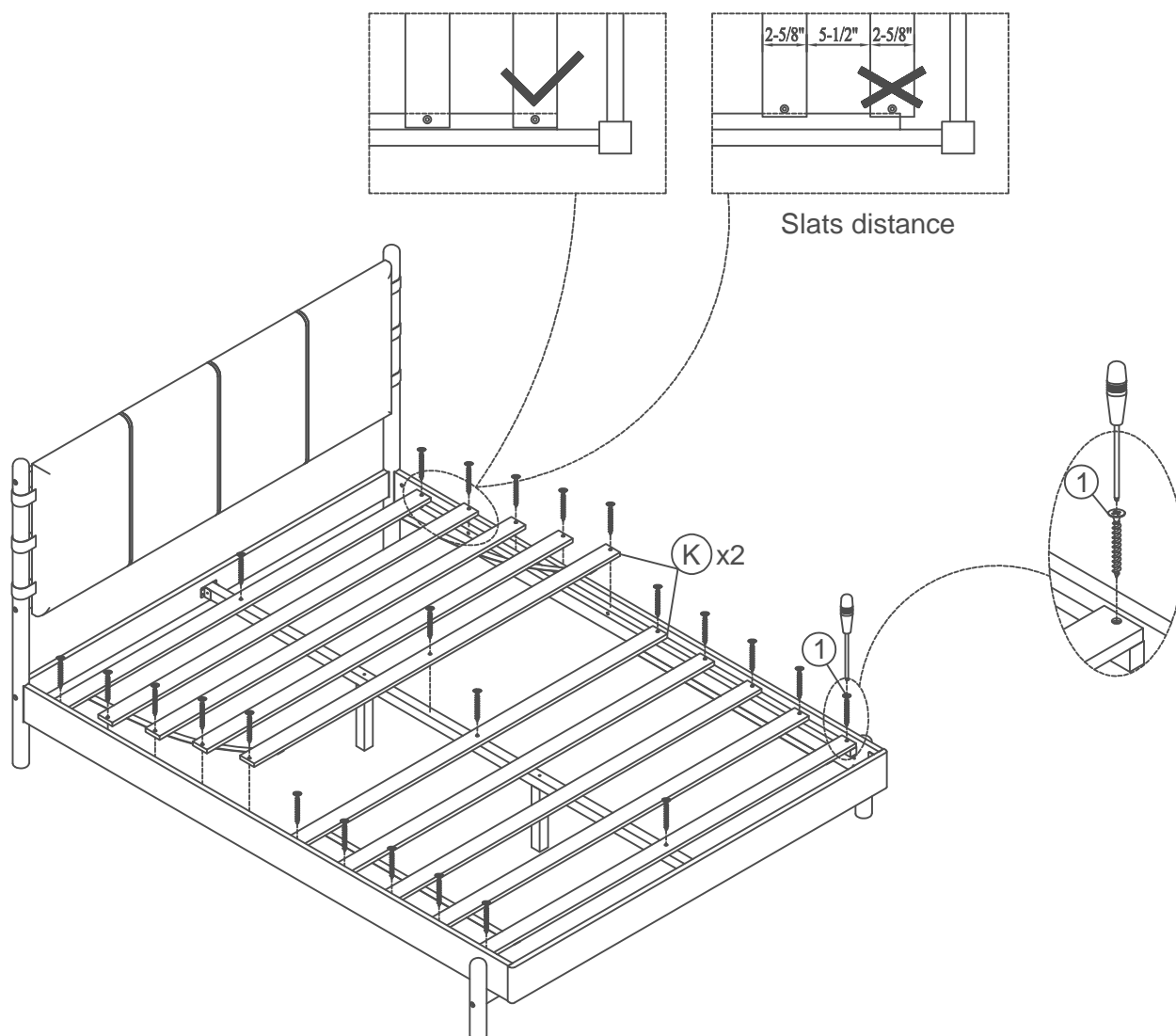
- Attach Leveler ⑮ *2 with Center rails support slats (L) as shown.
 - Attach Center rails support slats (L) to the Center rails support slats (J) using Bolt⑧*2 with Allen Wrench ⑬ *1 as shown.

Step 10:

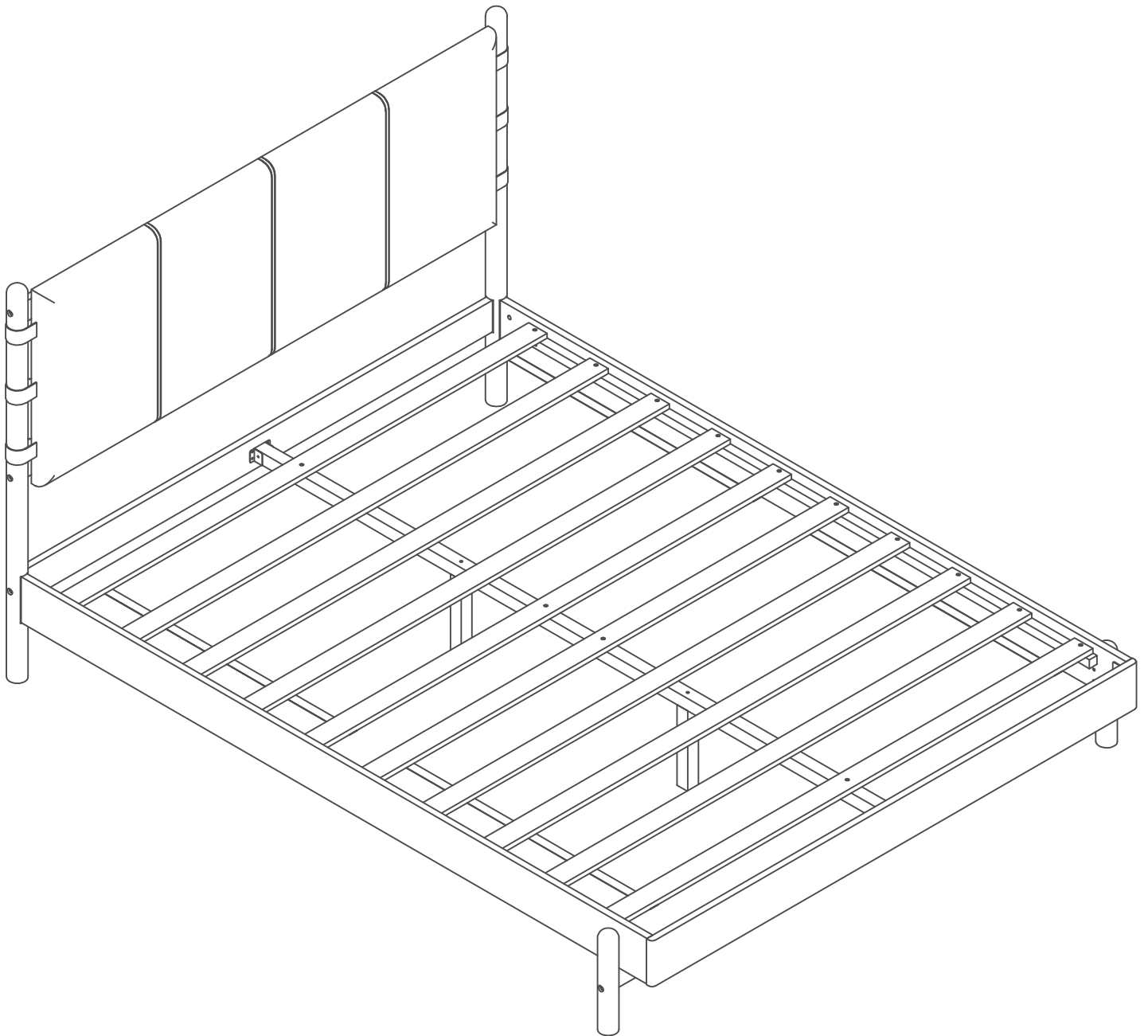


- Attach Metal link 16 *2 with Crossbar headboard (G), Bed rail (H), using Vis 3*8 Screwdriver as shown.
- Attach Center rails support slats (J) with Metal link 16 *2 using Vis 3*4 Screwdriver as shown.

Step 11:



- Attach Slats (K) to the Left side rails (D), Right side rails (E) and Center rails support slats (J) using Vis①*24 Screwdriver as shown.



Inspect the Bed and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Adjust the Levelers to desired height to avoid wobbles.

Your bed is ready for use.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Hardware may loosen overtime. Periodically check that all connections are tight.

Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. To protect finish, avoid the use of chemicals and household cleaners.
