Care & Maintenance



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.


Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.

 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.

- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Keep your child/children at bay during the assembly process.


Whenever moving/lifting the Loveseat and to prevent damage to the Loveseat, two adults are needed to execute these actions.

Before Beginning Assembly:





Read instructions, cover to cover.



Have 2 adults on hand for assembly.



Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).




Save all packaging until finished.

Assembly Steps




This Loveseat has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Loveseat parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2



Place the Left Arm Panel (A) on a clean, non-marring surface.

With assistance from your adult partners, attach the Backrest Panel (C) to the Left Arm Panel (A) using Bolts (2) and the Allen Wrench (9) as shown above.


Do not fully tighthen Bolts.



With the help of your adult partner, attach the Right Arm Panel (B) to Step 2 using Bolts 2 and the Allen Wrench 9 as shown above.

Do not fully tighthen Bolts.


Step 4



Attach the Left Side Stretcher (Left Loveseat) (F) to the Front Stretcher (Left Loveseat) (E) using Screw (4) and the Screwdriver (11) as shown above.


Screwdriver is not provided, guests need to bring their own.

Do not fully tighthen Screws.




Attach Step 4 to Step 3 using Bolts ①, Washer ⑧, Screws ⑤ and the Allen Wrench ⑨ as shown above.

Do not fully tighthen Bolts, Screws.




Step 6.1. Attach the Seat Panel (D) to Step 5.

Step 6.2. Using Bolts 2, Washer 8 and the Allen Wrench 9 to secure step above as shown above.

Step 6.3. Using Screws (6) and the Allen Wrench (9) to secure step above as shown above.

Do not fully tighthen Bolts, Screws.



Place the Loveseat onto a flat, level surface.

Then EXERT pressure floorward onto the Loveseat with both hands.


This pressure will help the Loveseat reach full alignment at all joints.

In a sequential manner, gradually **tighten all Bolts and screws at all joints** until evenly secured.

Inspect the Loveseat and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Adjust the Levelers until the Loveseat is level with the ground.

To adjust the Levelers, get assistance from an adult partner to lean and hold the Loveseat while you are working.



Place Seat Cushion (H), Back Cushion (G) to Seat Panel (D)


Turn the Loveseat right side up.


Tie the magic tape straps on the Seat Cushion (H) to the Seat Panel (D) as show above. Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Ensure all screws, bolts are fully locked into position and secured.

Your Loveseat is ready for use.

Caution: This Loveseat can only be used on a flat, level surface.





Note: This is on optional step in case you want to connect the two Loveseat of the set together and should be done before placing the cushions.

Step 9.1.With assistance from your adult partners, connect the Loveseats together by using Bolts (2), Bolts (3), Sleeve Nut (7) and the Allen Wrench (9) as shown above.

Step 9.2. Then, tie the Magic tape straps (10) to secure the Loveseats together as shown above.

Step 9.3. Place Back Cushion (G) to Seat Panel (D)

Your Loveseat is ready for use.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the

environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly

discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?
- The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?
- If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.
- By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
