Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




Keep away from sources of ignition.







Table Leg-H

This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Place all the parts on a clean, non-marring surface. Attach Table Top (G), Table Leg (H) together. Lock in the mounting position, using Bolt (2) Flat Washer (1) and Allen Wrench (3)

Step 2



Place the Table onto a flat, level surface.

Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Table with both hands.

This pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts at all joints until evenly secured.

Inspect the Table and make sure all parts are adequately connected. Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
