## IMPORTANT NOTICE(SAFETY PRECAUTIONS)

In order to prevent users or others from suffering harm and economic losses, this manual records the important contents to ensure safe and correct use.

Please read this manual carefully based on the understanding of the following content (indicated by sign/ circular symbols), and strictly abide by the matters mentioned herein.

### **MARNING** Please keep all packaging materials out of reach of infants and young children, as they may pose a risk of suffocation if they cover the head or obstruct breathing Do not adjust the swing intensity too loosely. Excessive looseness may cause the adjustment bolt to fall off or the backrest to shift, potentially leading to injury. Do not place the product near heating equipment or open flames. Also, avoid using or storing it in high-temperature environments. Failure to do so may cause the gas cylinder to rupture, leading to injury, burns, or fire hazards. Do not use the product with more than one person at a time. Doing so may result in falls, product damage, or injury. Do not stand on the seat, sit in reverse on the chair, or sit on parts other than the seat, such as the armrests (sold separately) or backrest. Doing so may result in falls, product damage, or injury. Do not sit on the edge of the seat or tilt the chair. Doing so may result in falls, product damage, or injury. Do not use the product on sloped or uneven surfaces. Doing so may result in falls and injuries. **Prohibited** Do not let cigarette ashes or other burning materials fall onto the product, as this may cause a fire. Be careful not to let the product's casters or other parts press on electrical appliance power cords. Doing so may damage the cord, leading to electric shock or fire. If any part of the product becomes loose or abnormal, stop using it immediately. Continuing to use it may cause Do not allow children to use the product unsupervised. ## **MARNING**

## **ATTENTION**

- Do not use outdoors. Otherwise, it may cause deformation or severe deterioration, and personal injury.
- Do not place in a humid environment for a long time (with reference to humidity above 70% and room temperature at C degrees or above), otherwise it may cause mold or mite breeding, which could harm health.



Do not operate the lifting rod when no one is seated. Otherwise, the seat may suddenly rise and cause injury.

- Do not insert fingers or other objects into the rotating parts or their gaps. Otherwise, you may be caught and injured when they are moving.
- When moving, do not let it drop. Otherwise, it may cause damage to the product or the floor.
- Do not use for purposes other than its intended use, such as transportation.
   Otherwise, it may cause accidental accidents or injuries.
- Do not disassemble or modify on your own. Otherwise, it may cause a decrease in product strength and personal injury.
- Do not use lubricants or other sprays or oils. Oil droplets may stain the floor or clothing.

- When first using, please ensure that the room is well ventilated. Adhesives may contain formaldehyde residues, which can easily lead to allergic reactions in those with chemical sensitivities.
- If the floor is made of soft materials such as wood, Please ensure lay down carpets or similar to protect the floor. Otherwise, the casters may cause dents or damage to the floor.
- Please make sure to check the chair's position before sitting down. When used on slippery surfaces, the casters can make the chair slide easily, which may lead to falls and accidental injuries.
- Please frequently check for any loosening or shaking of the casters, screws, and other metal parts, and sustained use them securely when loose. Continuous use without checking can cause damage or injury.

## **REQUEST (OTHER NOTES)**

- Do not press down on the lift lever. Otherwise, it may cause damage and malfunction.
- During maintenance, please do not use organic solvents or bleaching agents. Otherwise, it may cause discoloration or deformation.



## **ASSEMBLY STEPS**




During assembly, make sure that at least two people work together. Assembling alone may result in product damage or accidental injury due to falling parts. Do not use power tools during assembly, as excessive force may damage the product and cause injury.


Press swivel casters (B) firmly into base (A) until they click. Align gas lift (C) vertically with center hub.




Install mechanism (D) onto the seat (F) using screws (K).




5 Assemble the installed base and seat.




Mount the armrests (G) onto the seat (F) using screws (L).



4 Secure the backrest (E) to the seat using screws (M).



Mount the headrest (H) on the backrest with the coat hanger (I) using screws (N) afterthat insert the plug (J) to cover it.



#### **USAGE INSTRUCTIONS**

#### ■ Adjusting the Seat Height


You can adjust the seat height by operating the lifting handle beside the seat.

- · When raising the seat:
  - Pull the lifting handle upward, gently rise from the seat to raise the chair. Release the lifting handle at the desired position to lock it in place.
- Lower the seat when sitting on the seat vertically and applying weight, pull up the lifting handle to lower the seat. Release it at the appropriate position to secure it in place.

#### ■ Adjusting the Reclining Function

- To recline: Sit down, pull the backrest adjustment lever and lean back. Choose from 3 positions, then push the backrest adjustment lever to lock.
- · To return upright: Pull backrest adjustment lever and lean back firmly.

· When scrapped, please deal with it in the manner

### MAINTENANCE METHOD

#### **Maintenance inspection**

- Please frequently check the metal parts such as pulleys and screws for any loosening. If any loosening is found, please retighten them to prevent injury, damage to the product, or scratching the floor.
- Please regularly check if all parts are not loose or shaking, and immediately stop using if any abnormalities are found, otherwise it may lead to product damage or injury.

#### **Canvas maintenance**

- During daily maintenance, please use a brush or vacuum cleaner (low wind) to remove dust and other debris
  from between the fabric textures.
- If stained with coffee, alcohol, or other severe dirt, please dilute a neutral detergent with warm water at a concentration of 3-5%, soak a soft cloth, wring it out, and then gently tap the surface. After that, wring out the cloth with clear water, wipe it clean again, and allow it to air dry naturally.

#### Maintenance of Plastic/Metal Parts

- During daily maintenance, please use a soft dry cloth to wipe.
- When dirt is severe, please use a neutral detergent diluted to 3-5% to moisten a soft cloth, then wipe off the dirt. Next, use a cloth moistened with clear water to wipe away the detergent, and finally, gently wipe with a soft dry cloth and allow it to air dry naturally.
