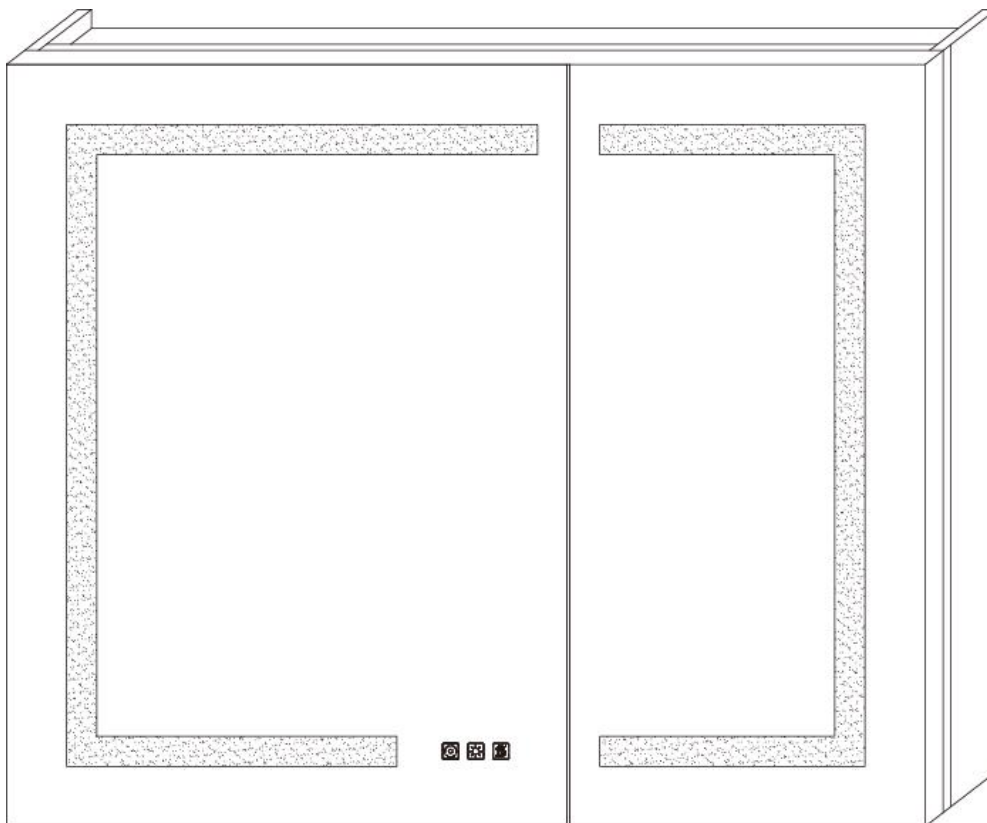


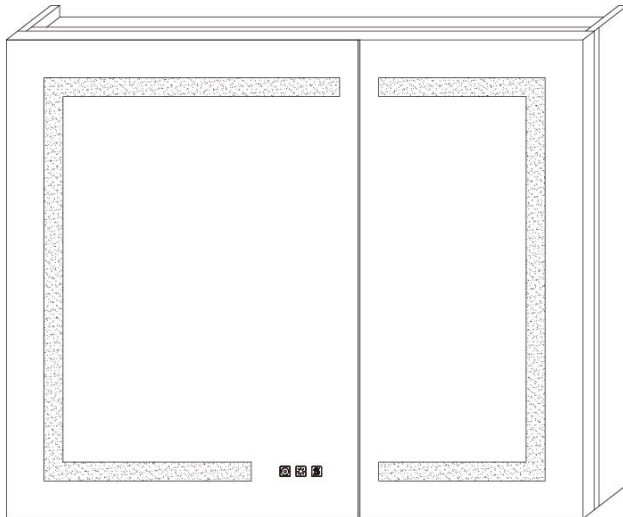

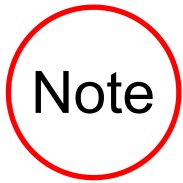

### **WARNING** Risk of Fire and Electric Shock

- All fittings must be installed in accordance with current IEE wiring regulations. If in doubt, please consult a qualified electrician.
- Turn breaker off the electrical supply at the main circuit board before installation and maintenance.
- Suitable for indoor use only. This product should be positioned well away from curtains and fabrics. Never cover the mirror.
- Regularly check any parts for damage, if any part is damaged the product should not be used.

### **INSTALLATION SAFETY**

- Inspect the product immediately upon receipt for any possible damage during transportation or missing parts. Handle the product with care and protect against knocks to all sides and edges of the glass.
- Ensure there are no hidden pipes or cables in the wall before drilling and sawing.
- Wear suitable safety glasses when drilling. Take care if drilling on tiled surfaces in case the drill slips.

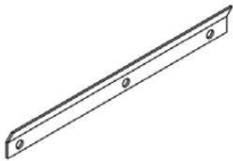

# Installation Instruction



The medicine cabinet supports two installation methods:  
**1.Surface Installation** and **2.Embedded Installation**.

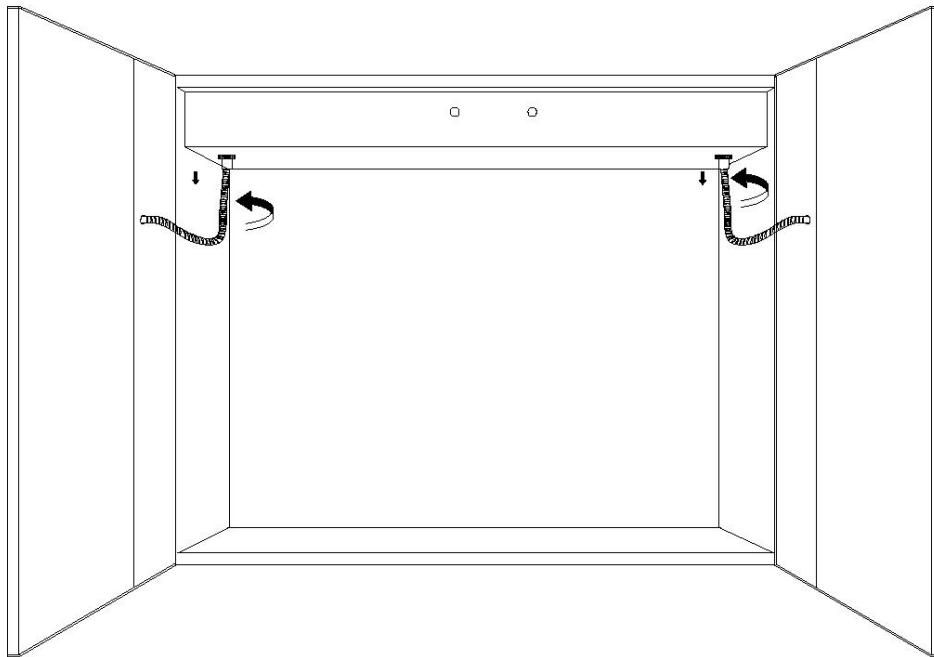
Please choose the installation way that best suits you.



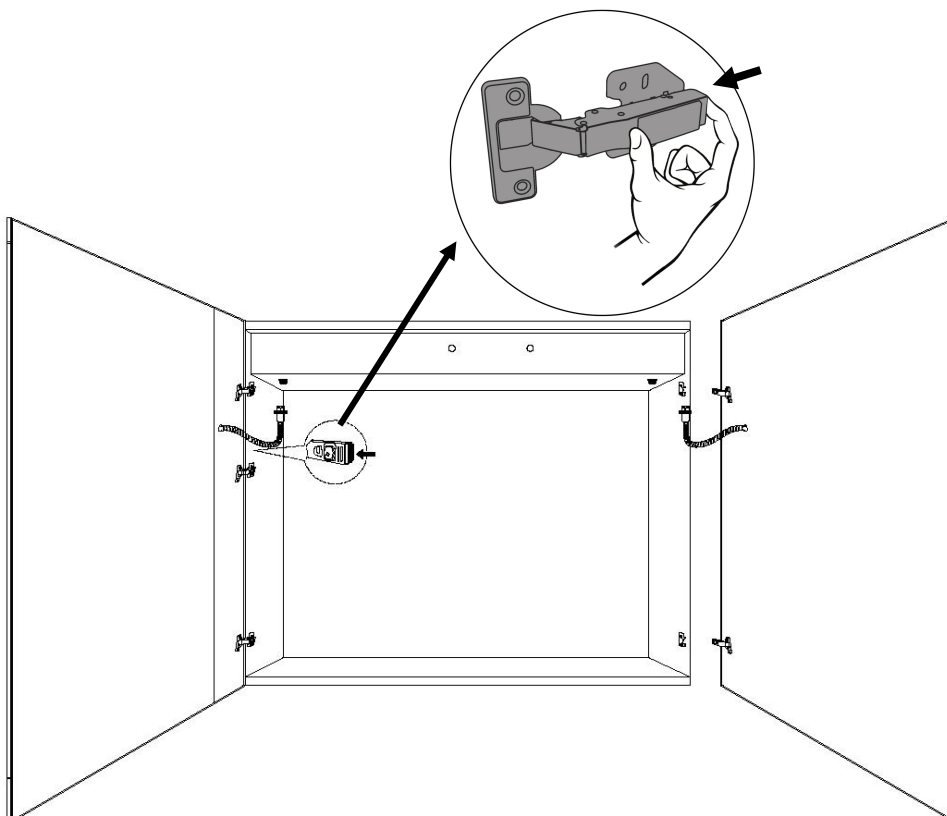
Some cabinet doors will be packed uninstalled but inside the cabinet to reduce packaging volume. Please install the cabinet door after completing the cabinet installation according to the instructions.

**Before installing the medicine cabinet, please remove the cabinet doors first. This will make the installation easier, more convenient and safer.**

1. First, disconnect the cords from the cabinet .



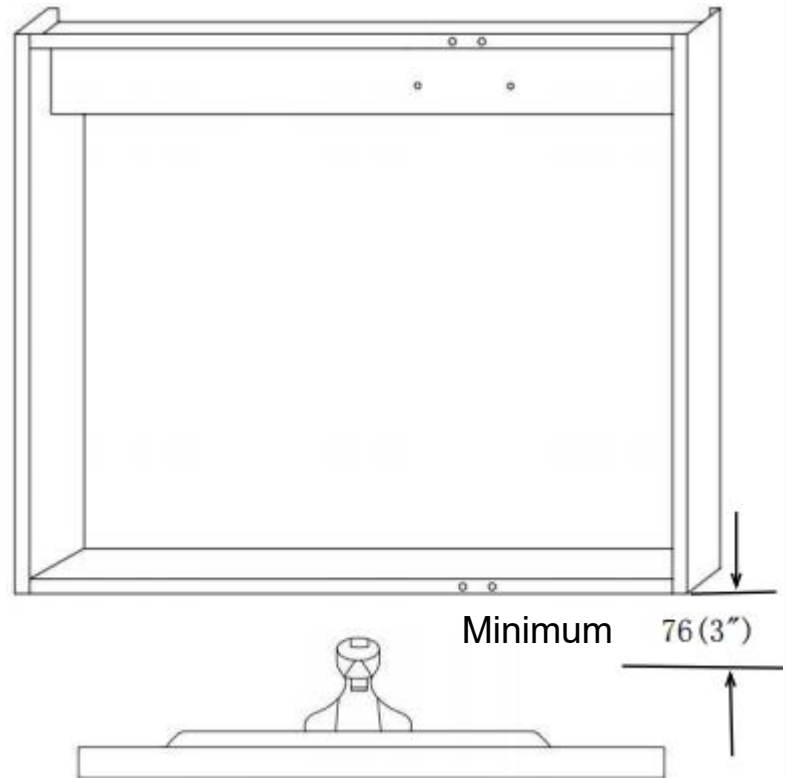
2. Then, press the end of the hinges and detach the cabinet door.





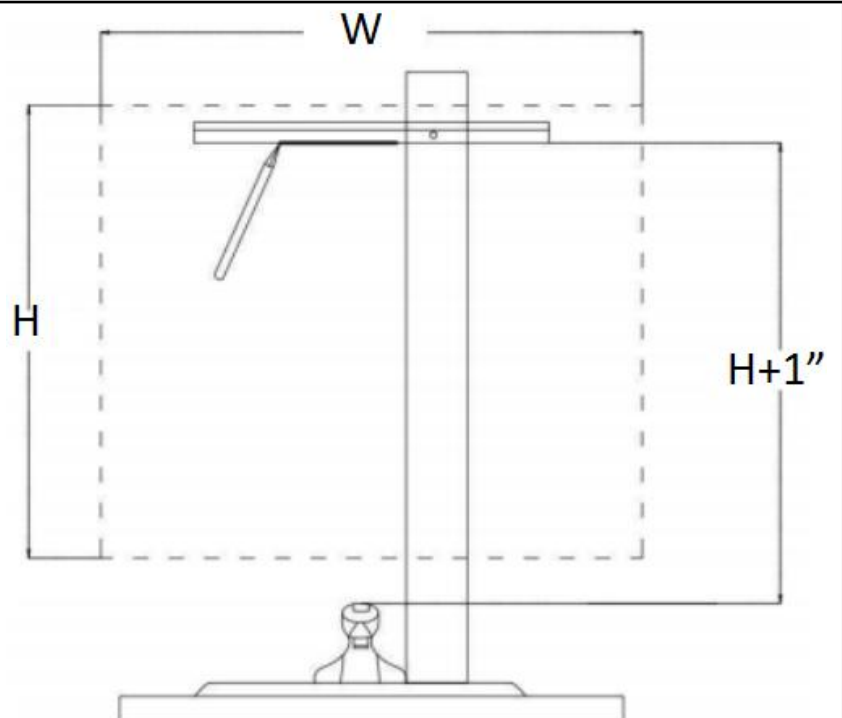
## Surface Installation Instruction

STEP 1

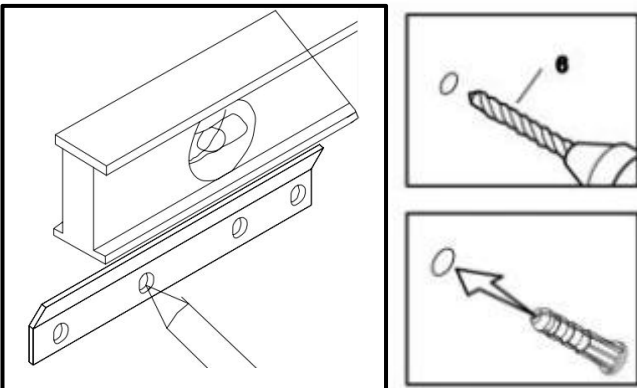
H is the total height of the medicine cabinet, and W is the total width of the medicine cabinet

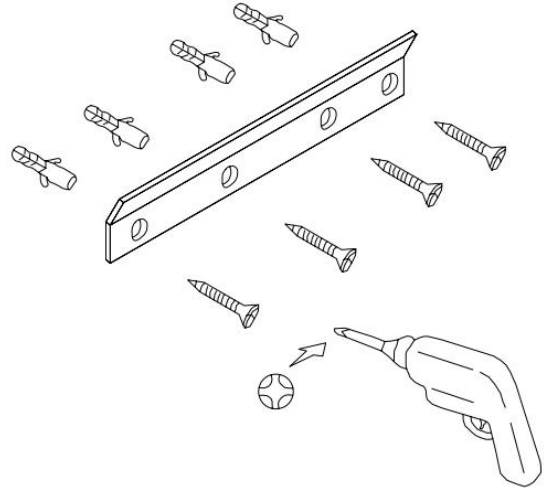
## Surface Installation Instruction

- A) Mark holes locations on the wall. All markings must be properly leveled.  
 B) Drill holes and insert anchor where needed.

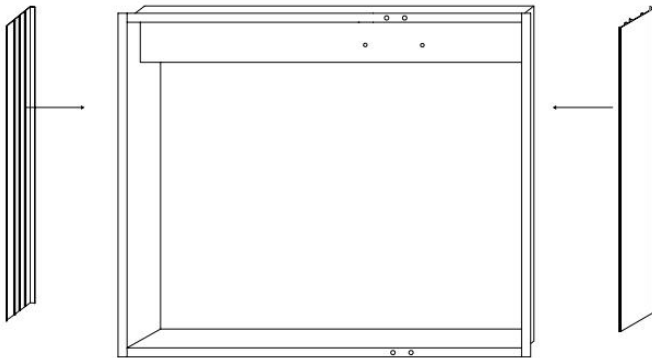


STEP 3

Secure the bar with Flat head screws provided.

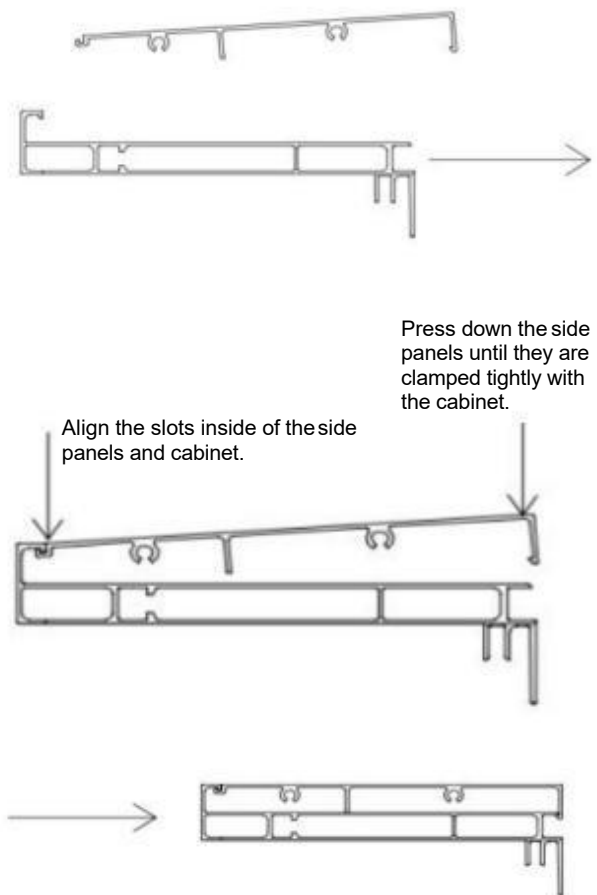

The side panels and cabinets are individually packaged , you need follow the STEP 5 to STEP 6 to install the side panels for surface mounting, for embedded installation no need to install the side boards.

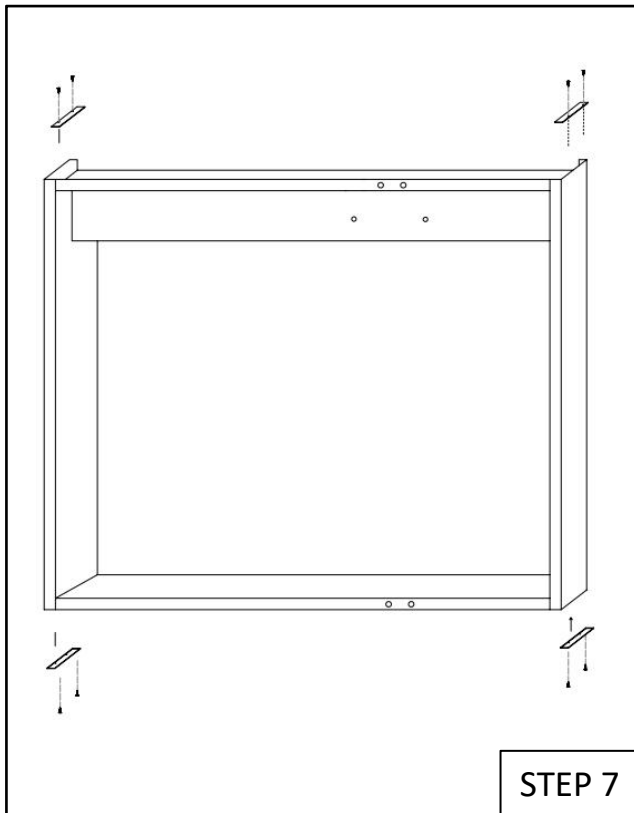


Press down the side panels until they are clamped tightly with the cabinet.

Align the slots inside of the side panels and cabinet.

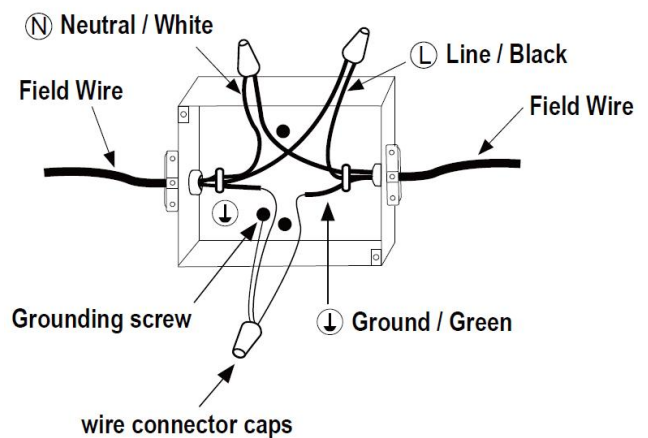

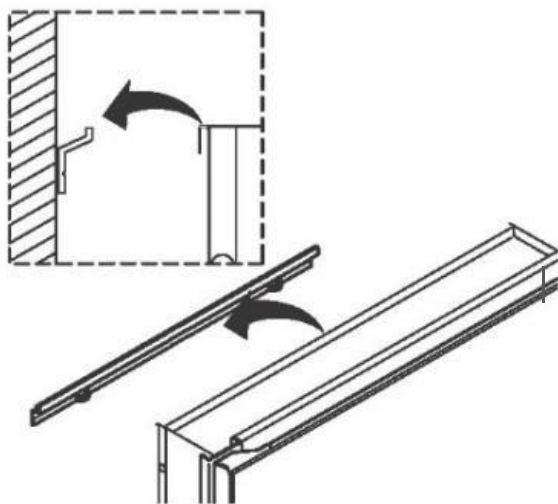


### Connect the wires

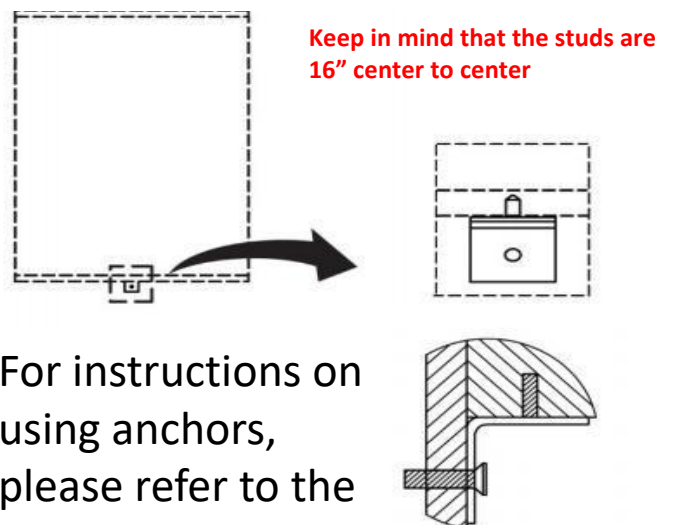
BLACK WIRE --- POWER SUPPLY L (LINE)  
 WHITE WIRE --- POWER SUPPLY N (NEUTRAL)  
 GREEN WIRE --- POWER SUPPLY G (GROUND)



Lift the cabinet and slide it down over the mounting bar.  
 Make sure the hooks engage the bar.



Place the support angle on the bottom of the cabinet and mark hole location on the wall. Drill hole and insert anchor where needed. Fix the support angle by screw. Always look for wood studs behind the drywall for stronger installation.

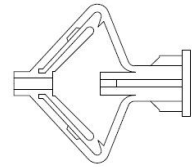
## Surface Installation Instruction

### Rules for Selecting Anchors

#### Installing on Drywall:

- Use Anchors A to ensure a secure installation on drywall.
- Anchors A are designed to provide adequate support on drywall.

#### Installing on concrete wall:

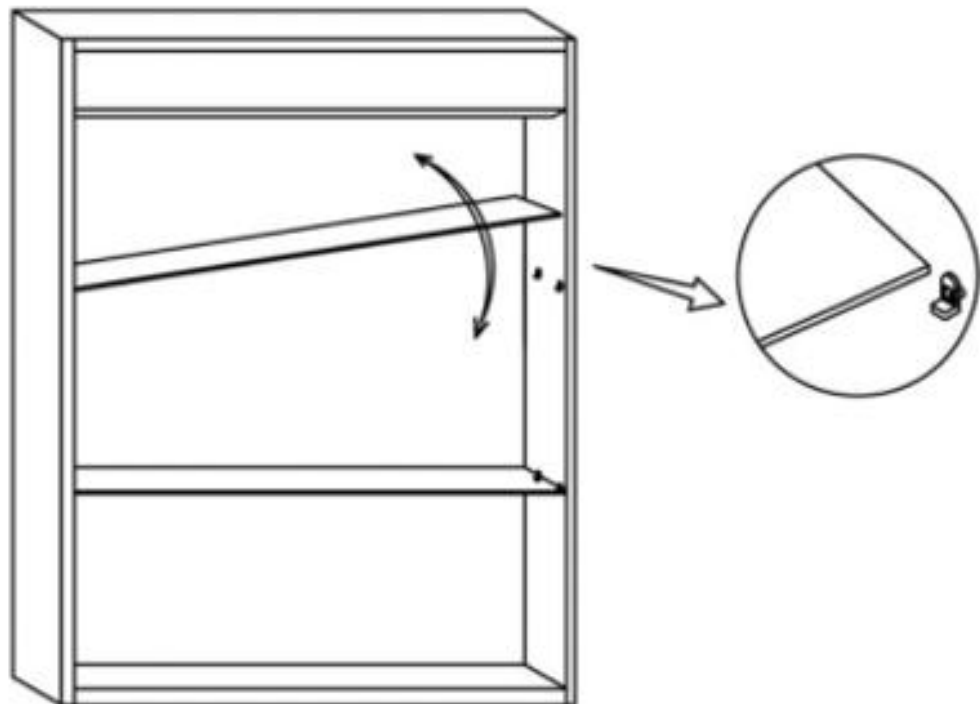
- Use Anchors B for a stronger installation.
- Anchors B are specifically designed for concrete wall, offering higher fastening strength.

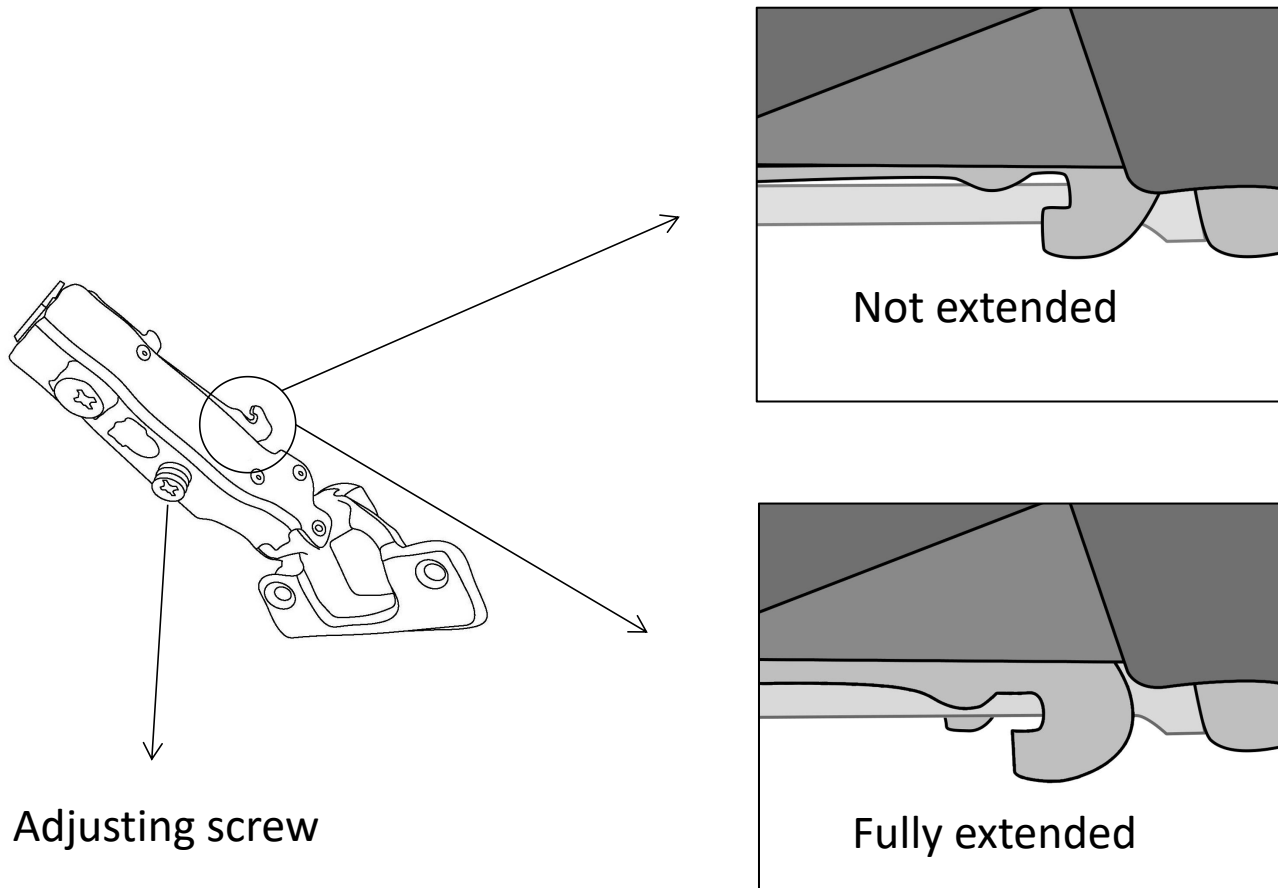

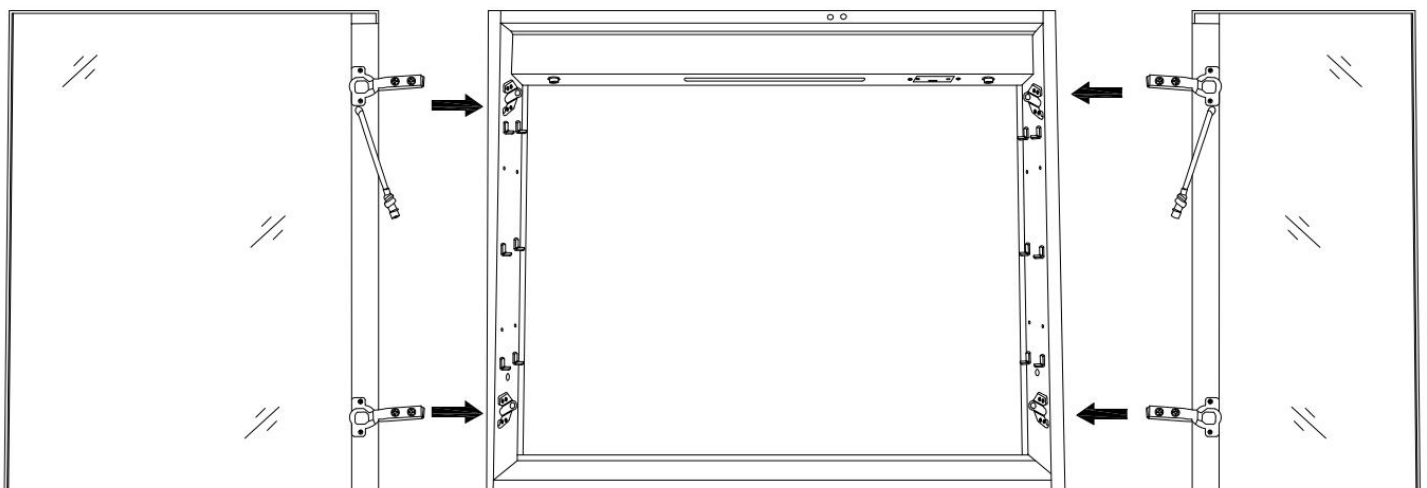

## Step12: Cabinet Door Installation

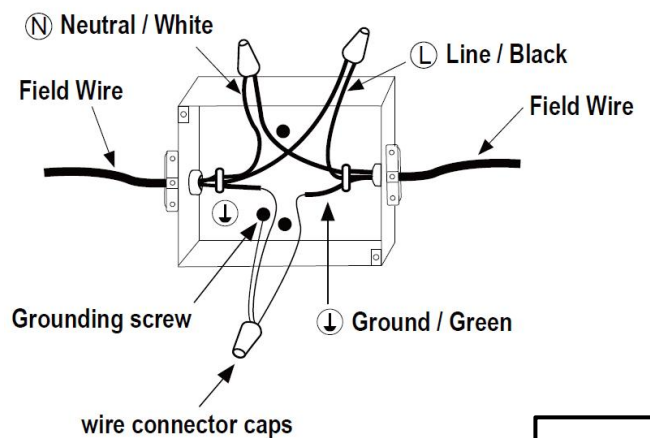
### Determine the size of the opening



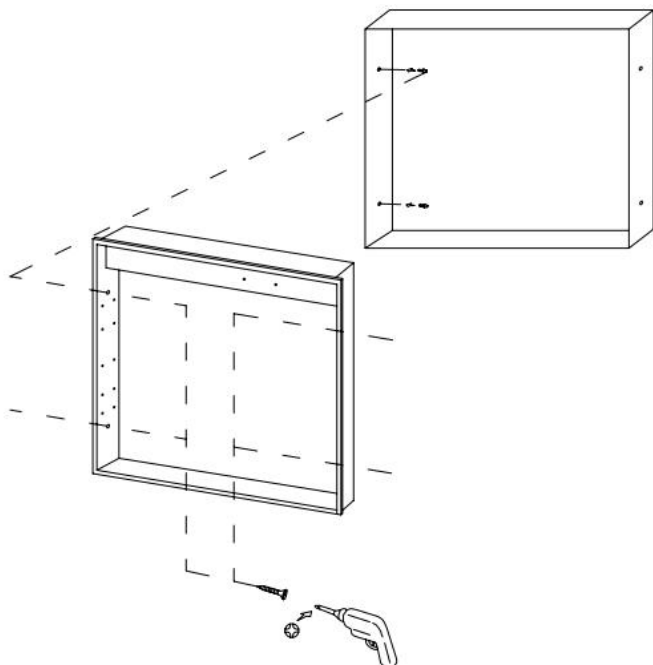

 GREEN WIRE --- POWER SUPPLY G (GROUND)

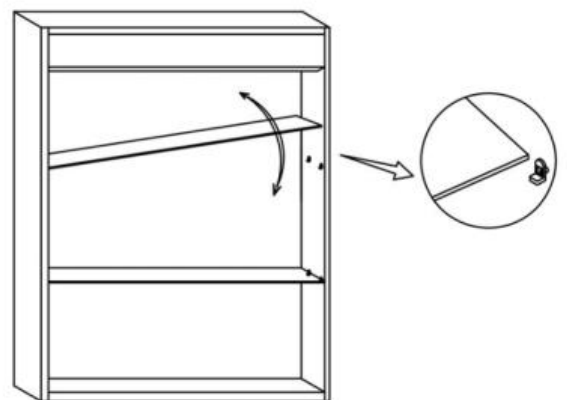

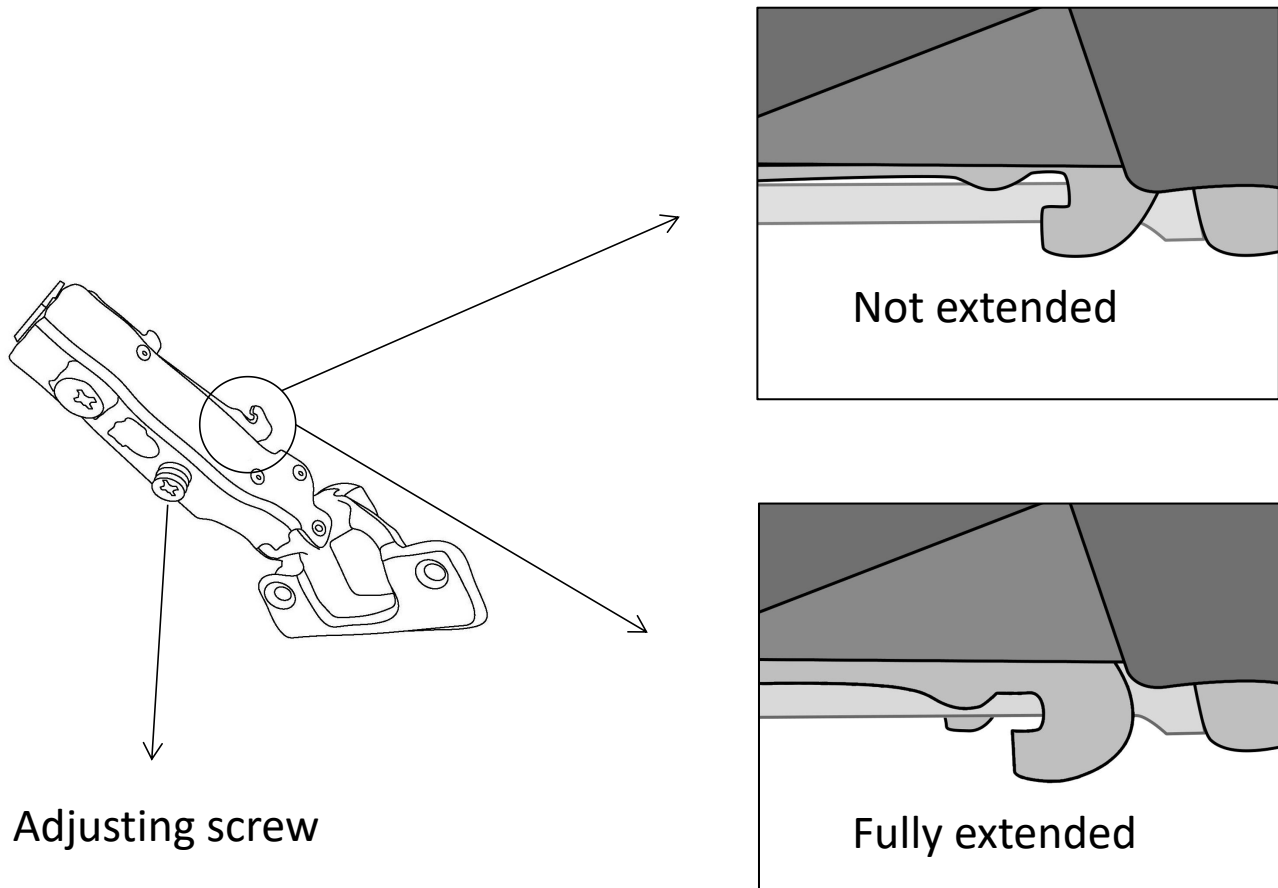

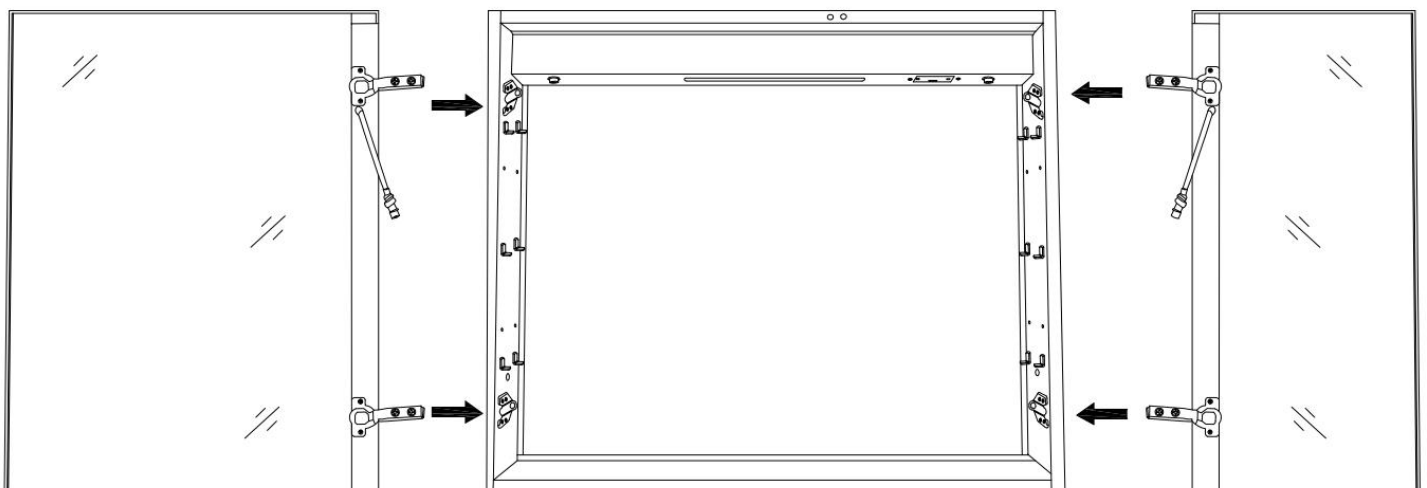


## Step5: Cabinet Door Installation

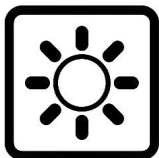
# Operating Manual



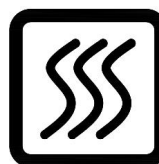
The buttons turn blue when connected to the main power supply and turn white after a brief touch.



- Briefly touch the button to turn the mirror on or off.
- Press and hold the button to change the color temperature when the mirror is on.
- Optional to be wired to wall switch by ON/OFF memory function.



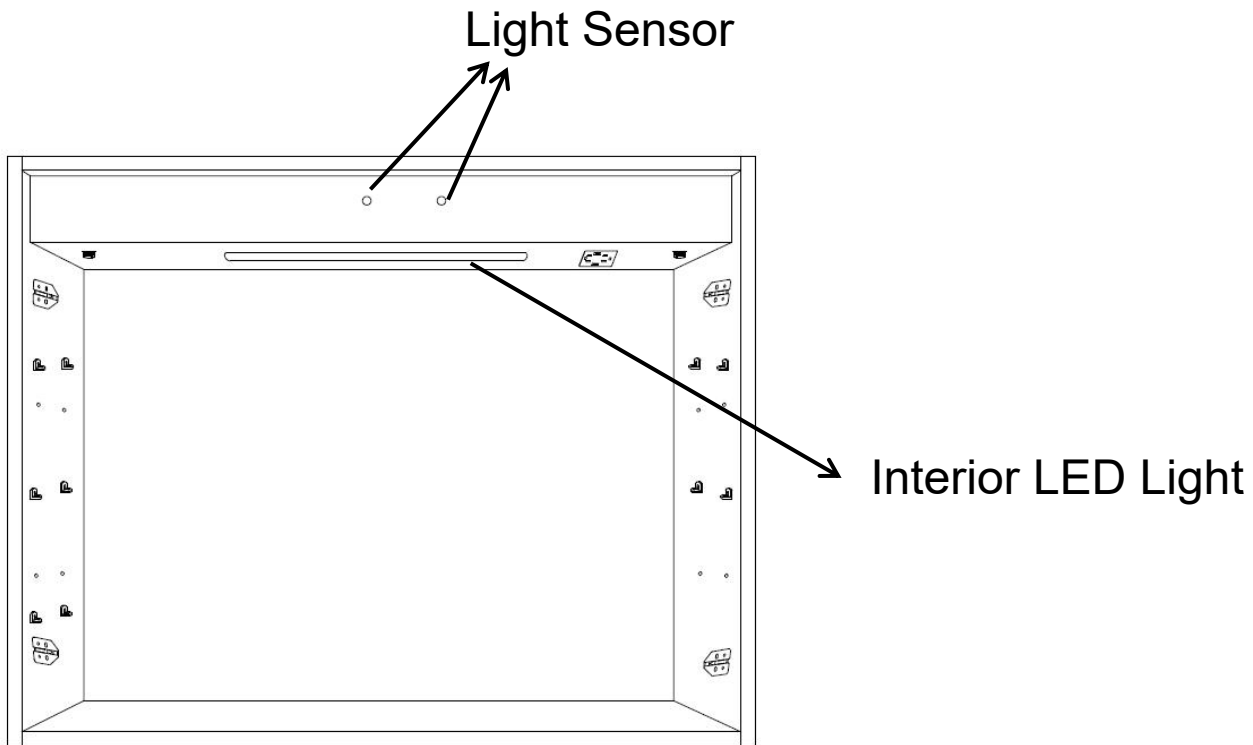
- Briefly touch the button to turn the mirror on or off.
- Press and hold the button to adjust the brightness.
- Release the button when the brightness reaches your desired level



- The mirror begins to warm up and defog after you press the defogger button.
- Press the button again to turn off the anti-fog function.
- **Press and hold the button to turn the blue backlight on or off.**
- Note: To prevent damage from prolonged high temperatures, the defogger will automatically stop after 60 minutes of continuous operation.

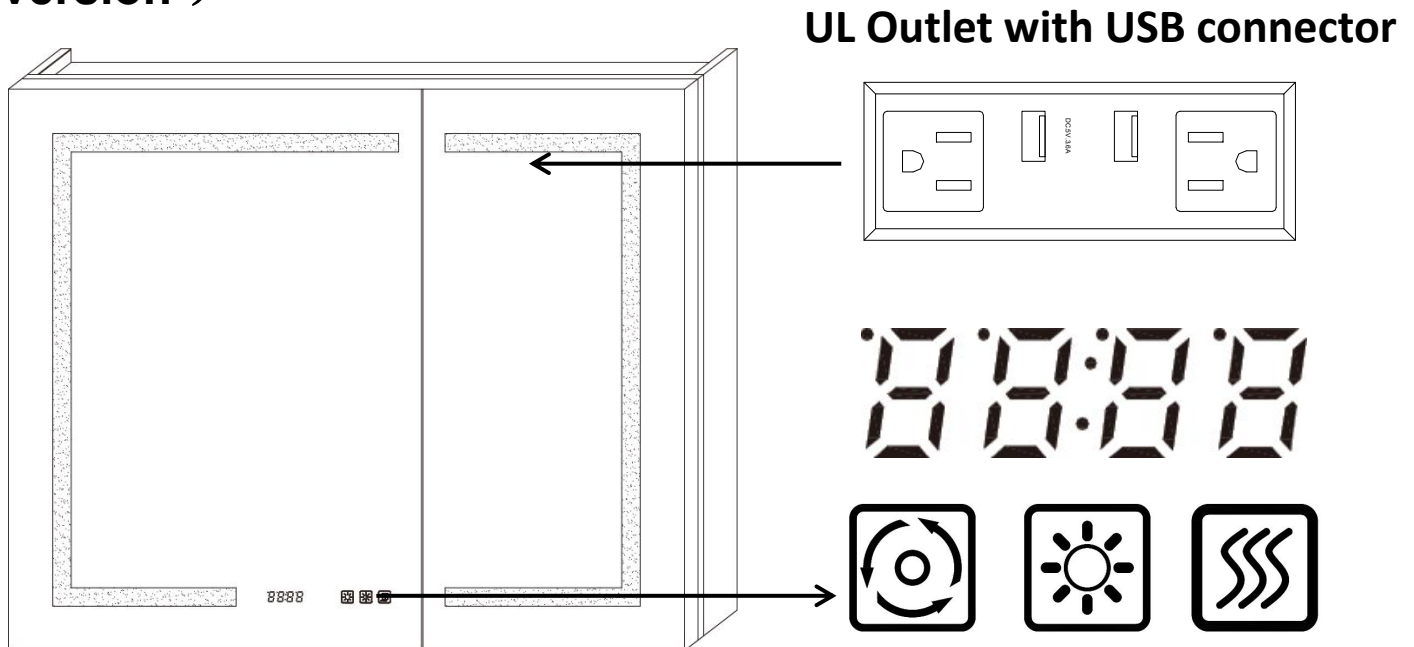
## Manual to Interior LED Light



- The Interior LED Light will be automatically on when the cabinet door be opened.
- Don't cover the light sensor.

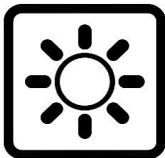
## Manual to setting clock (The 36\*30inch cabinet with clock version )



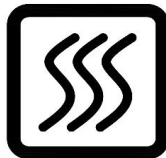

### ● Setting the clock

- Please turn off the light before setting the clock.
- Press and hold the Button 1 for seconds , the “Hour” will flash , then briefly touch button1 or 2 to set Hour.
- Wait for seconds after setting up the Hour then it will automatically switch to the Minute adjustment mode.
- Briefly touch Button 1 or 2 to set up the Minute.
- Wait seconds after you finish the time setting , the time will be saved automatically.

#### To turn on/off the clock:

- First, turn off the mirror light.
- Then, press and hold the button 2 for a few seconds until the clock turns on/off.
