Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

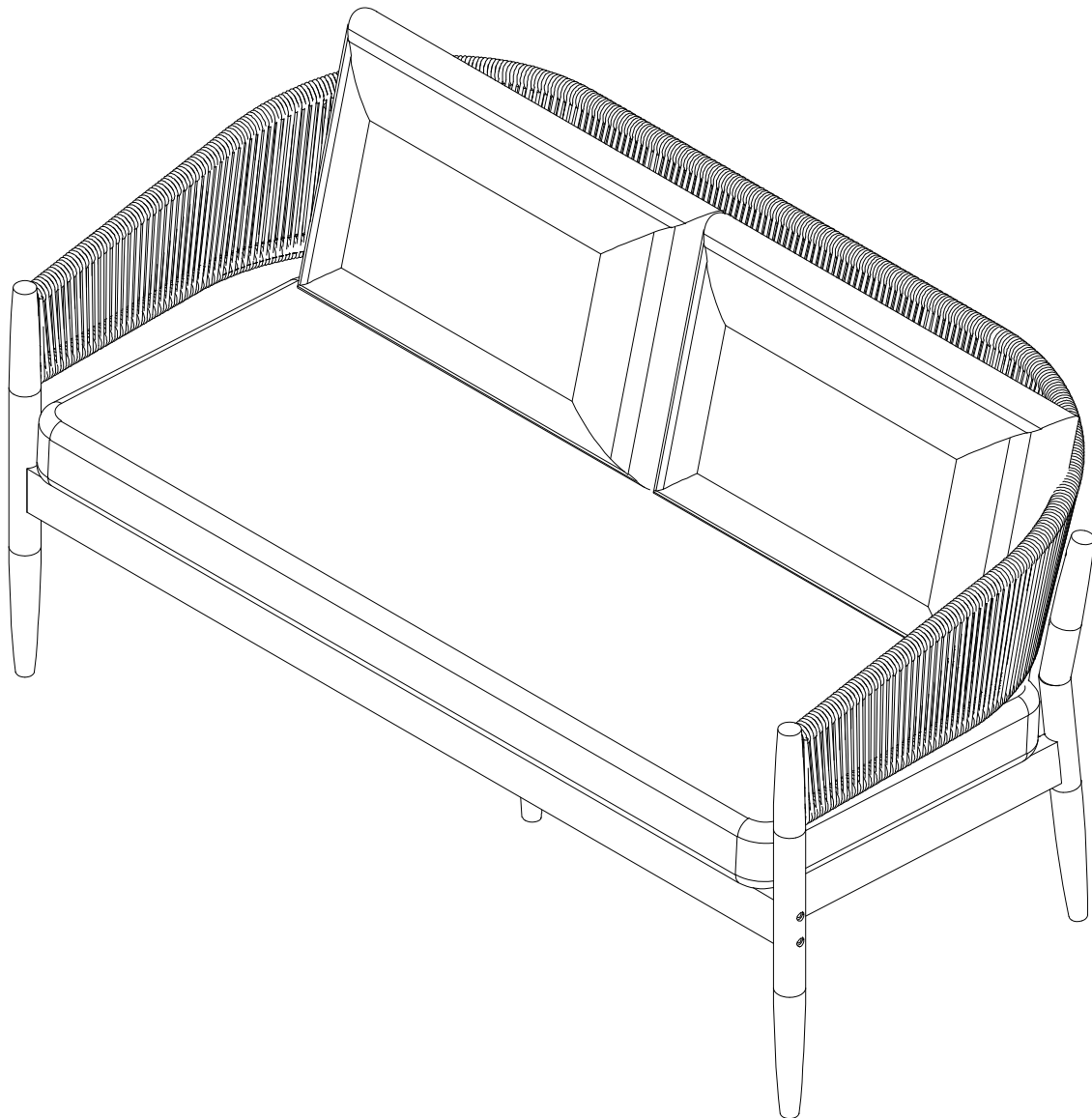


- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.






Caution: This Loveseat is NOT a TOY.

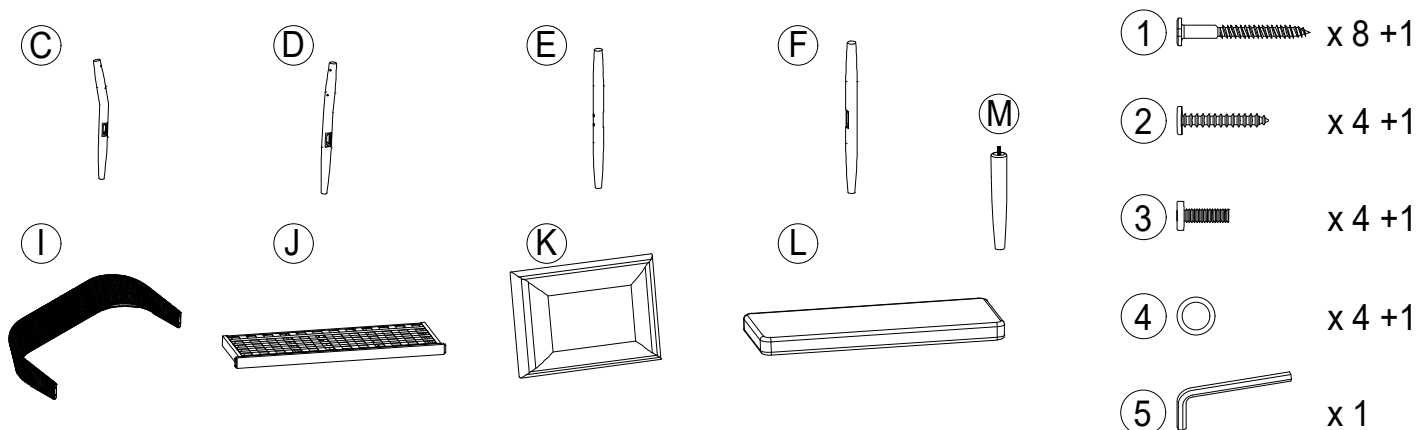

Before Beginning Assembly



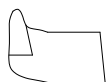
- Read instructions, cover to cover.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.



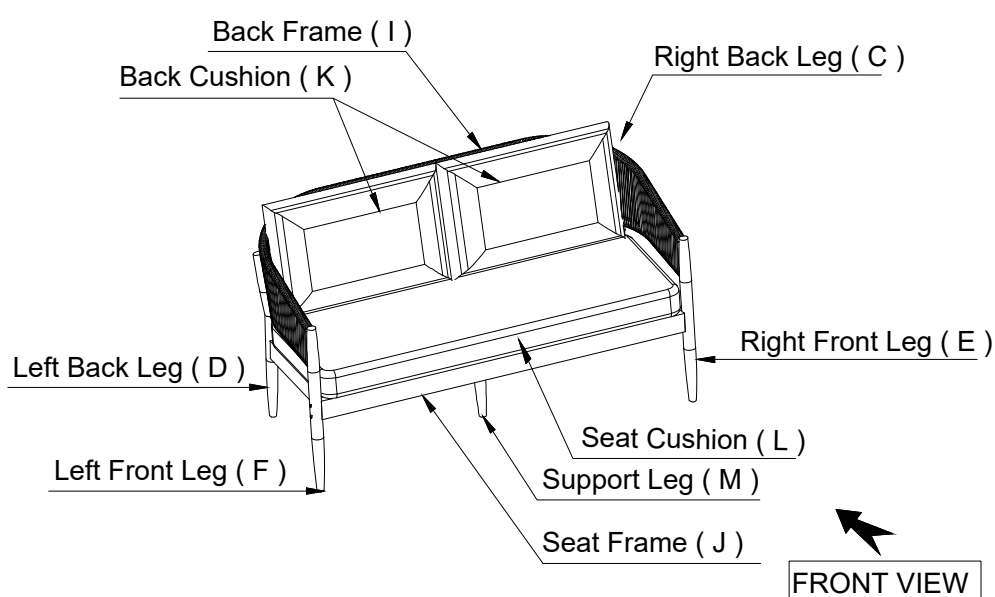
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).



- Save all packaging until finished.

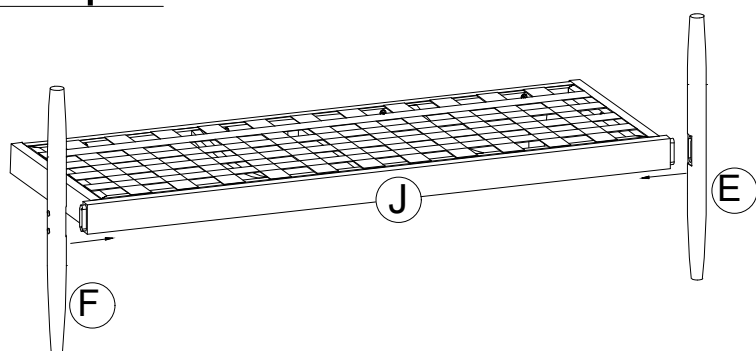

Overview

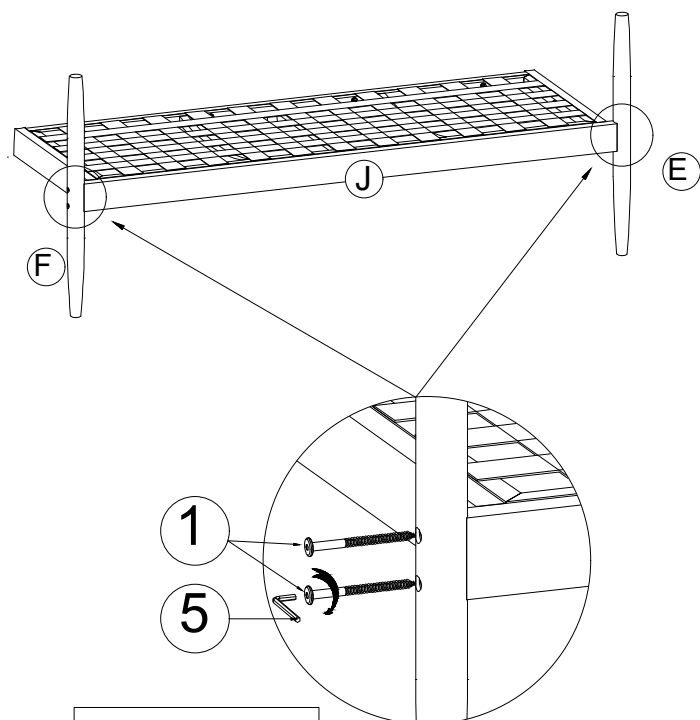


This Loveseat has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Loveseat, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

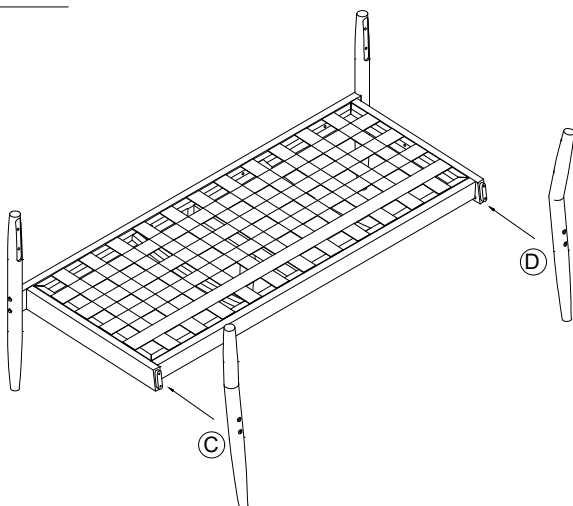
Open the box and place all parts on a clean surface to avoid damage.

1.1) Align the Seat Frame (J) with the two Front Legs (F) and (E), ensuring the holes match as shown in the illustration.

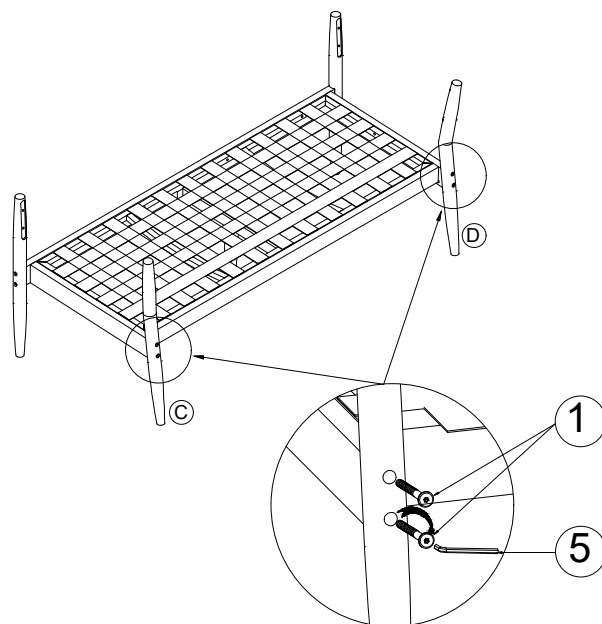
1.2) Attach the two Front Legs (F) and (E) to the Seat Base (J) using Screws (1) and Allen Wrench (5) as shown in the illustration.

Do Not Fully Tighten the Screws.

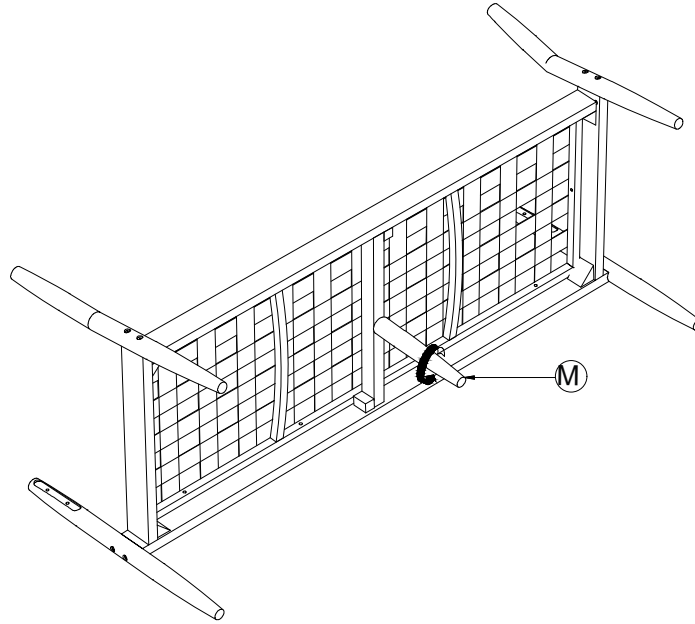

2.1) Align the Seat Frame (J) with the two Rear Legs (C) and (D), ensuring the holes match as shown in the illustration.

2.2) Attach the two Rear Legs (C) and (D) to the Seat Base (J) using Screws (1) and Allen Wrench (5) as shown in the illustration.

Do Not Fully Tighten the Screws.

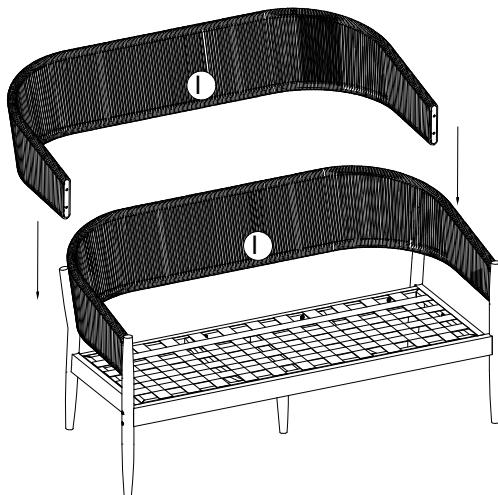

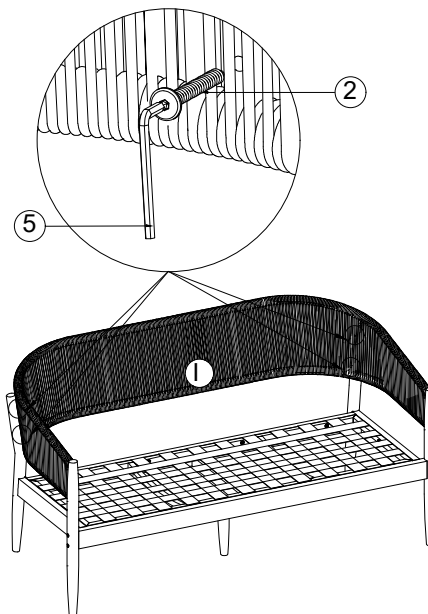

3.1) Twist the Support Leg (M) into the Seat Frame (J) as shown in the illustration.

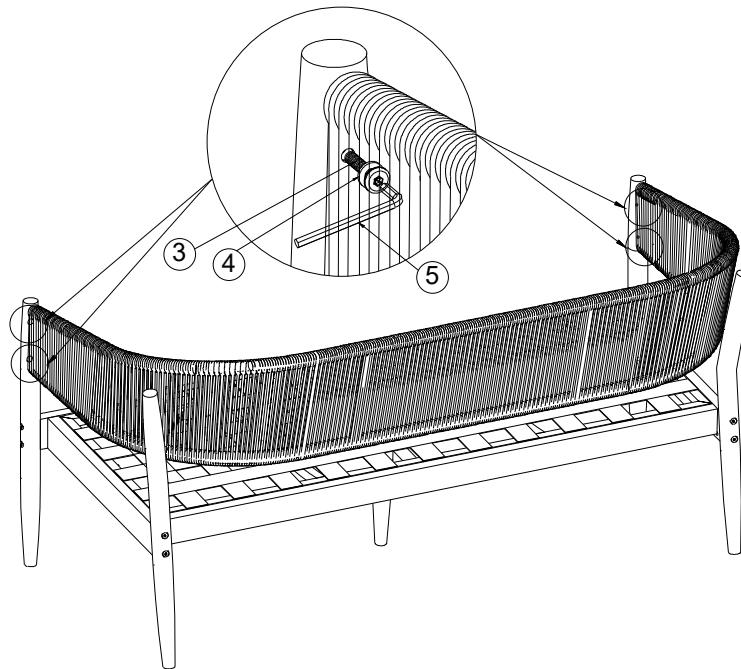

4.1) Align the Backrest (I) with the four Legs (C), (D), (E), and (F), ensuring the holes match as shown in the illustration.

4.2) Attach the Backrest (I) to the two Rear Legs (C) and (D) using Screws (2) and Allen Wrench (5) as shown in the illustration.

Do Not Fully Tighten the Screws.

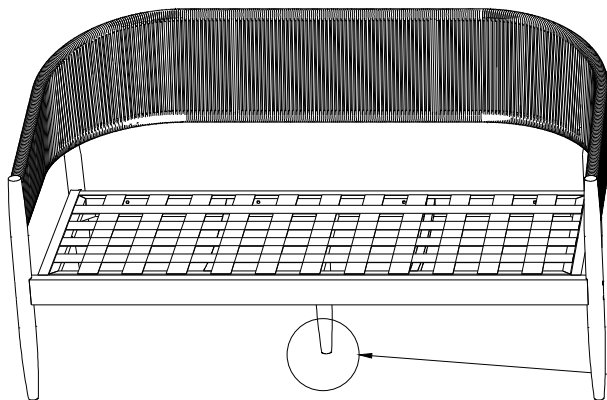

5.1) Align the Backrest (I) with the four Legs (C), (D), (E), and (F), ensuring the holes are properly matched as shown in the illustration.

Attach the Backrest (1) to the two Front Legs (F) and (E) using Screws (3), Washers (4), and Allen Wrench (5) as illustrated.

Do Not Fully Tighten the Bolt.

Adjust Pre-installed
Levellers height for balance

Adjust height for balance Adjust low for balance

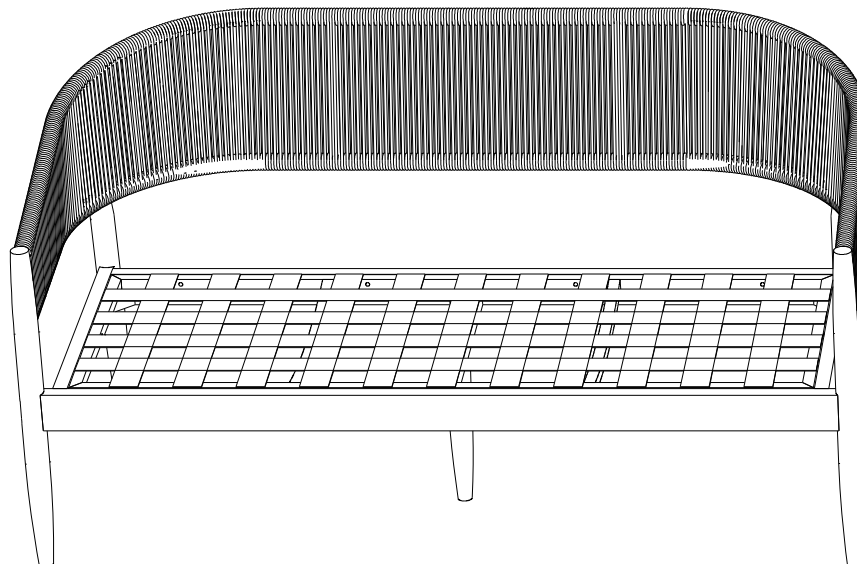
6.1) Then, with the assistance from an adult partner, stand the Loveseat upright.

Adjust the Pre-installed Levellers until the Loveseat is level with the ground.

To adjust the Levellers, with assistance from an adult partner, tilt the Loveseat to rest on two feet.

Adjust the levellers to the desired height until the Loveseat is level.

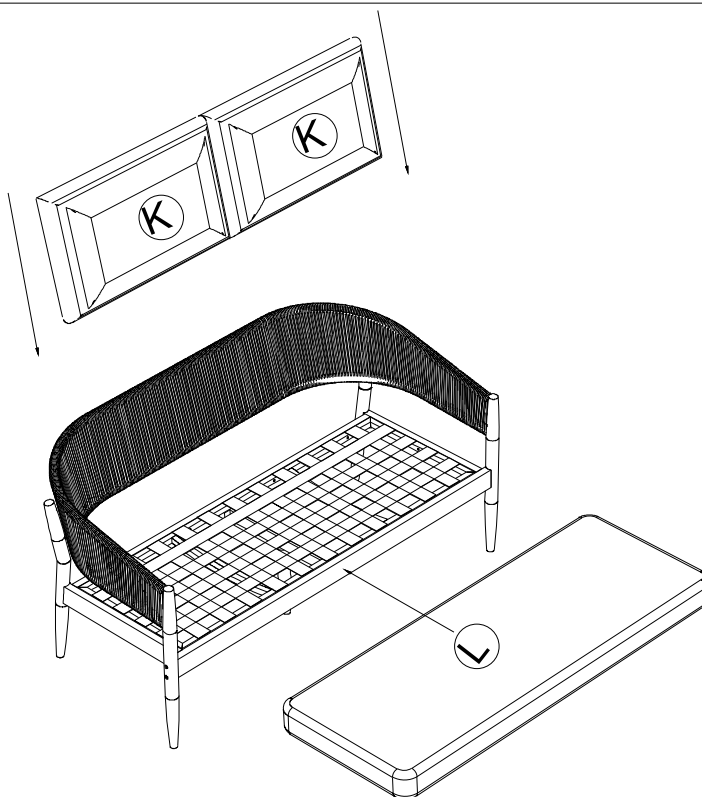

7.1) Fully tighten all screws and bolts to 100%.

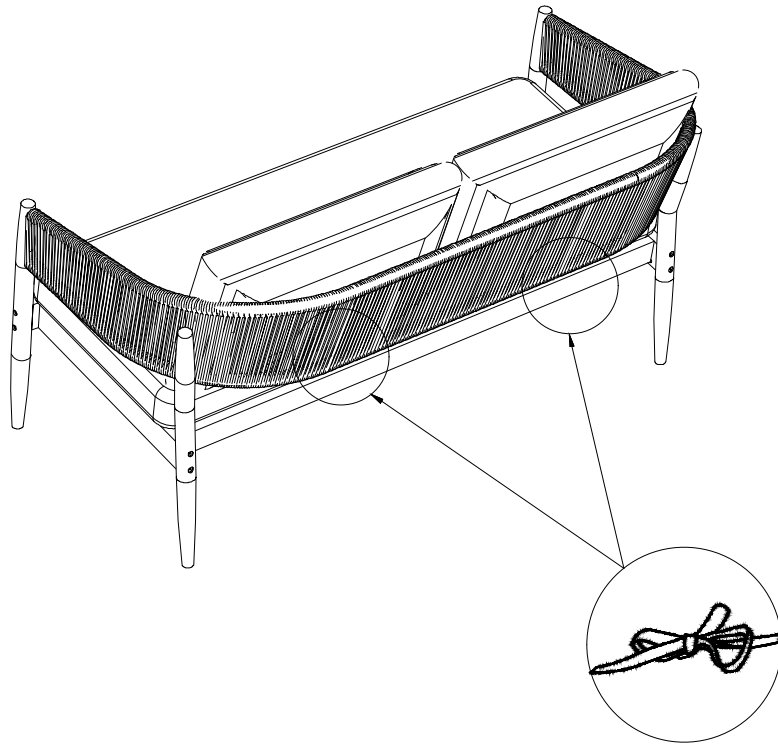

8.1) Place the Seat Cushion (L) onto the Seat Frame (J). Place the two Back Cushions (K) onto the Seat Frame (J).

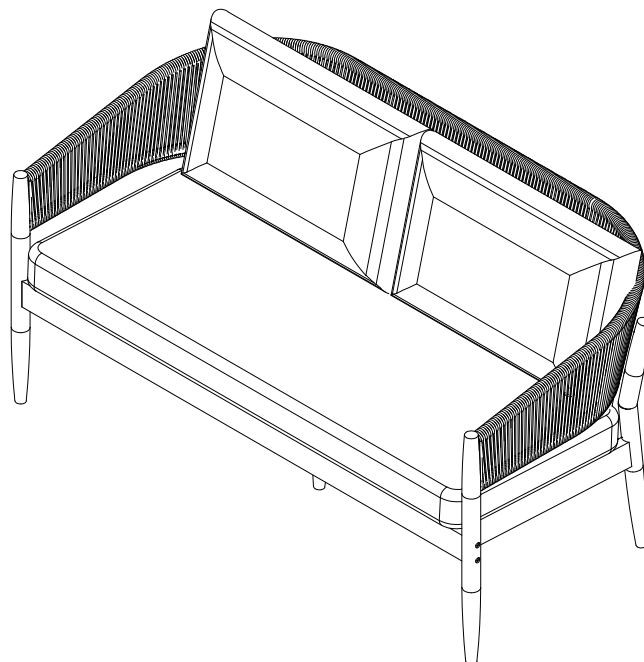

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
