

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 UNPACK THE CONTENTS:** Take all items out of the package and place them on a carpeted or protected floor to avoid damage
- 2 PREPARE THE CHAIR TOP:**
  - Place the chair top upside down on a table (or counter), ensuring the foam wrapping is **NOT** removed yet. This will prevent your table and the chair from getting scratched during assembly
  - Ensure someone holds the chair top to prevent it from falling
- 3 ATTACH THE CHAIR LEGS:**
  - Locate the chair legs, 4 (four) Phillips screws (**C**), 4 (four) metal washers (**B**) and 4 (four) curved plastic caps (**A**)
  - Align the 4 (four) holes of the chair legs with the 4 (four) holes on the bottom of the chair top
  - Insert the screws (**C**) through the metal washers (**B**), then through the plastic caps (**A**) and then into the screw holes in the chair legs. Tighten the screws with a power screwdriver set to the **lowest torque** setting
- 4 FINISH ASSEMBLY:** Flip the chair upright, remove the foam packaging, and enjoy your newly assembled **FLEUR-ML**!



## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

To be cleaned with detergent and a soft damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive chemicals.
