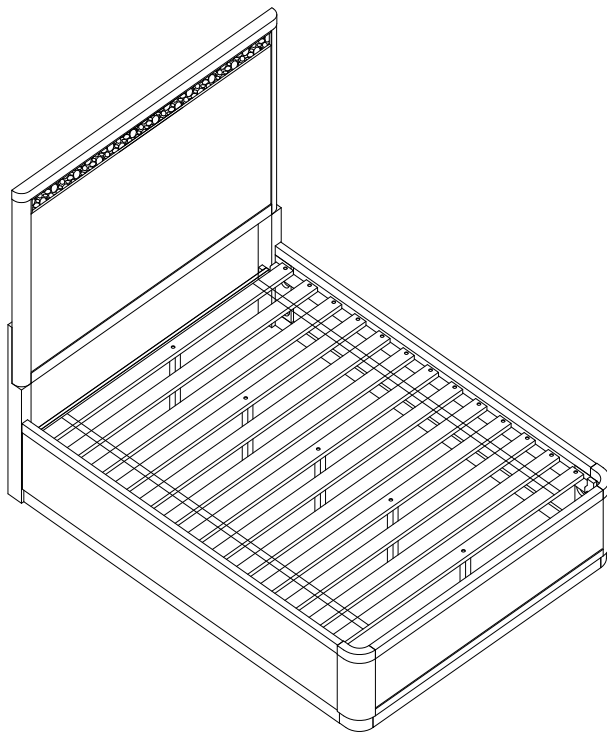
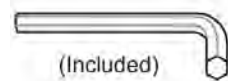

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

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damage during assembly.



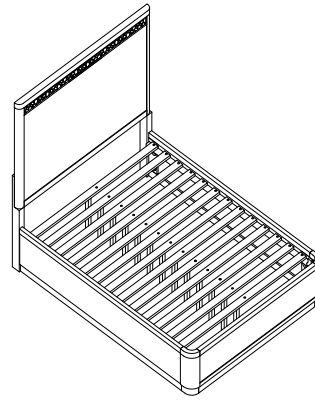
After two weeks, check and
