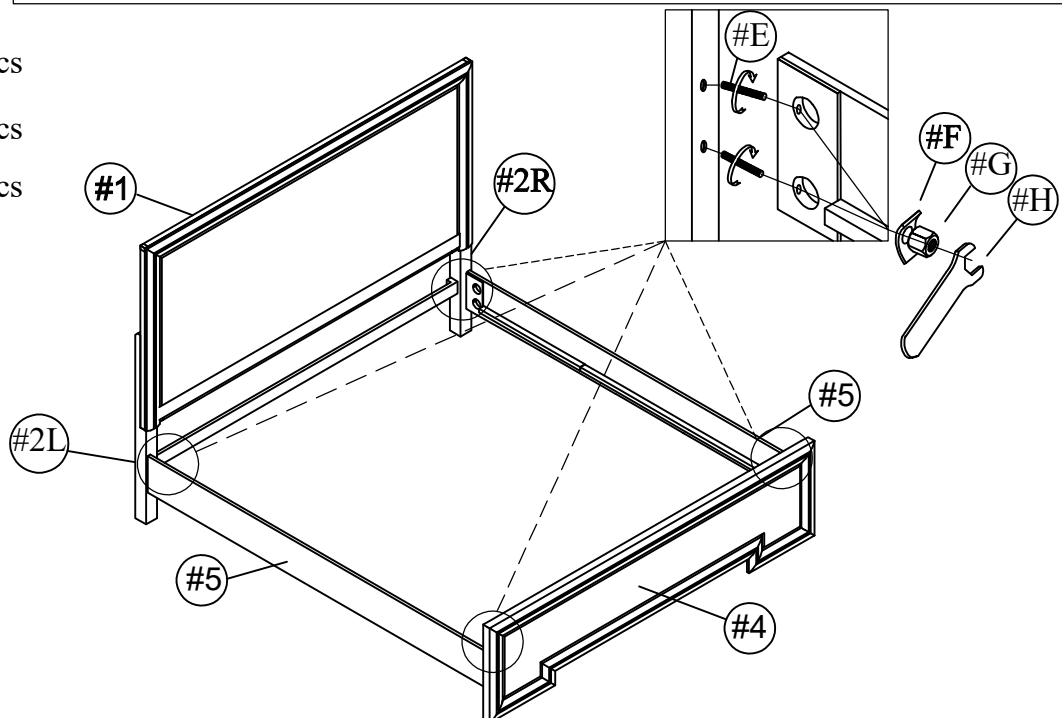
1) Align leg (#2L) and cross bar (#3) to the holes of the headboard panel (#1). Prepare 4 bolts assemblies by inserting lock washer (#B), then flat washer (#C) to bolts (#A). Secure with bolts (#A) by using an Allen wrench (#D)

Attach thread bolts (#E) to headboard (#1) and footboard (#4). Align bed rails (#5) to headboard (#1) and footboard (#4). Secure with hex nuts (#G) by using a wrench (#H).



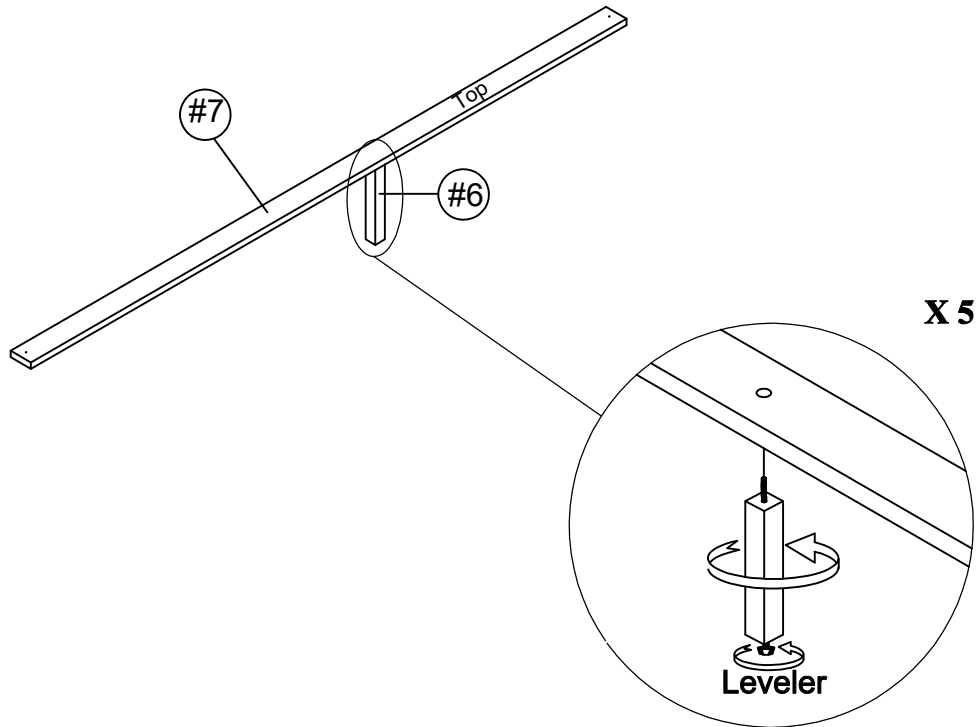

Attach 2 support legs (#6) to each bed slat (#7). Adjust support legs (#6) height according to ground level.

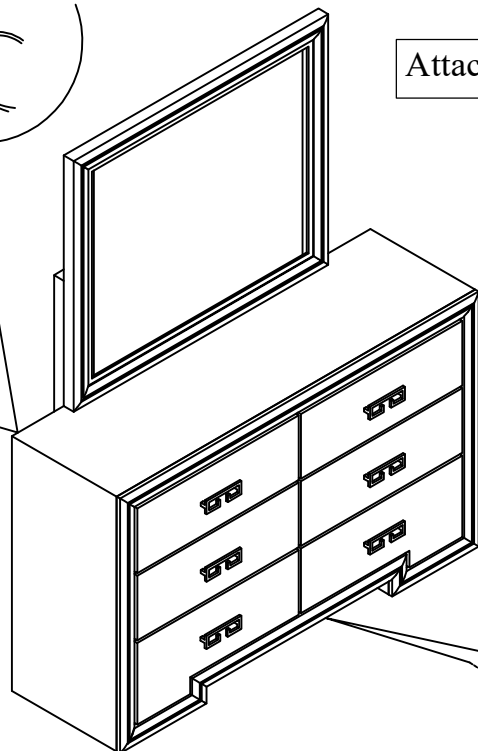

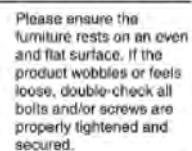
