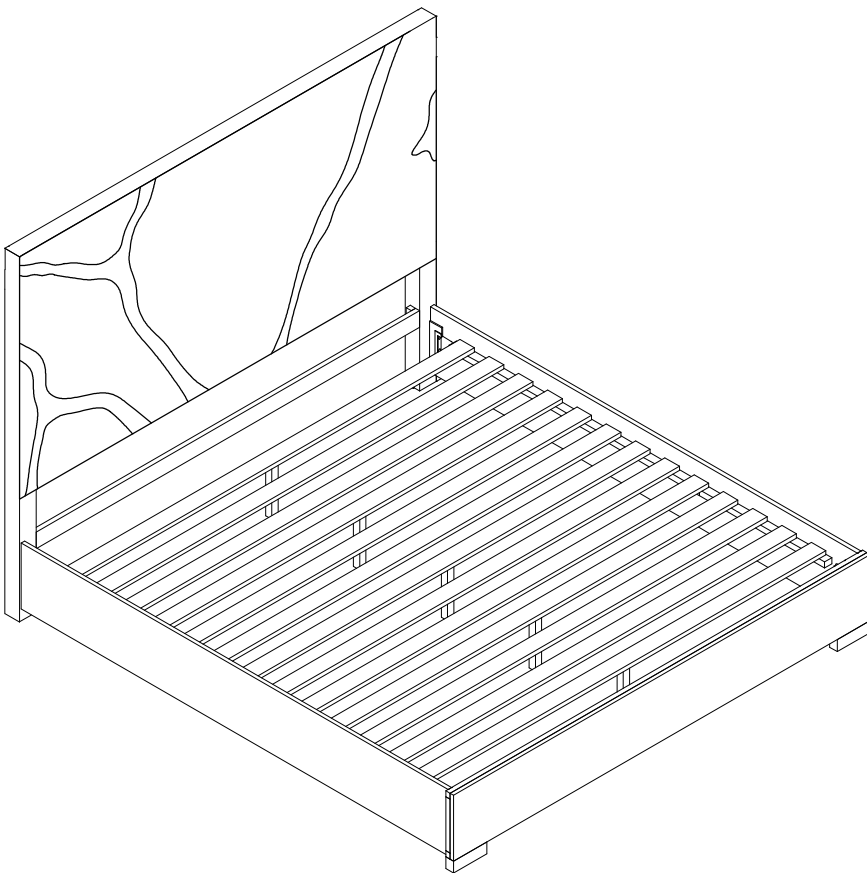


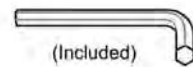

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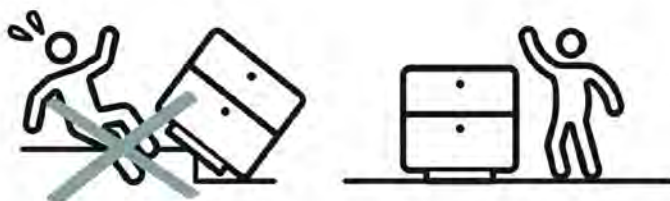

to do so.



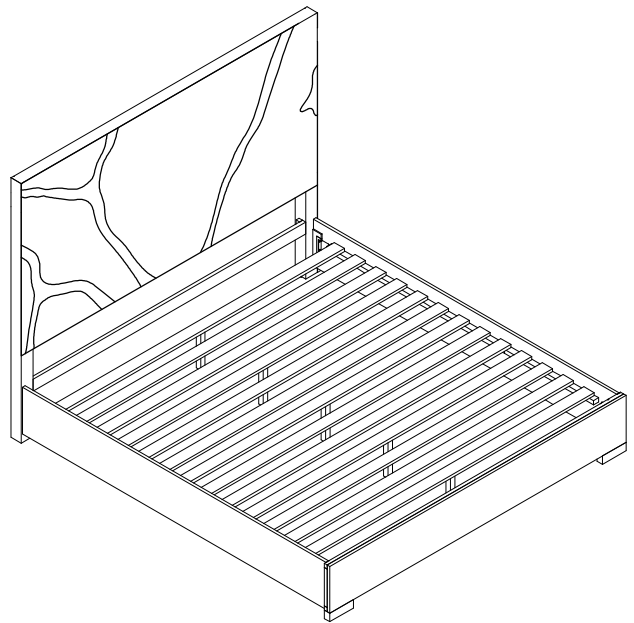
Save the instructions and store
