- Ensure thickness of mattress and foundation combined does not exceed 9".

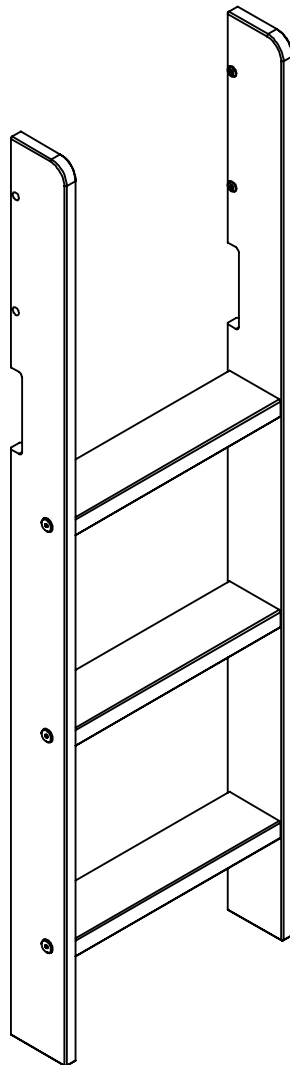

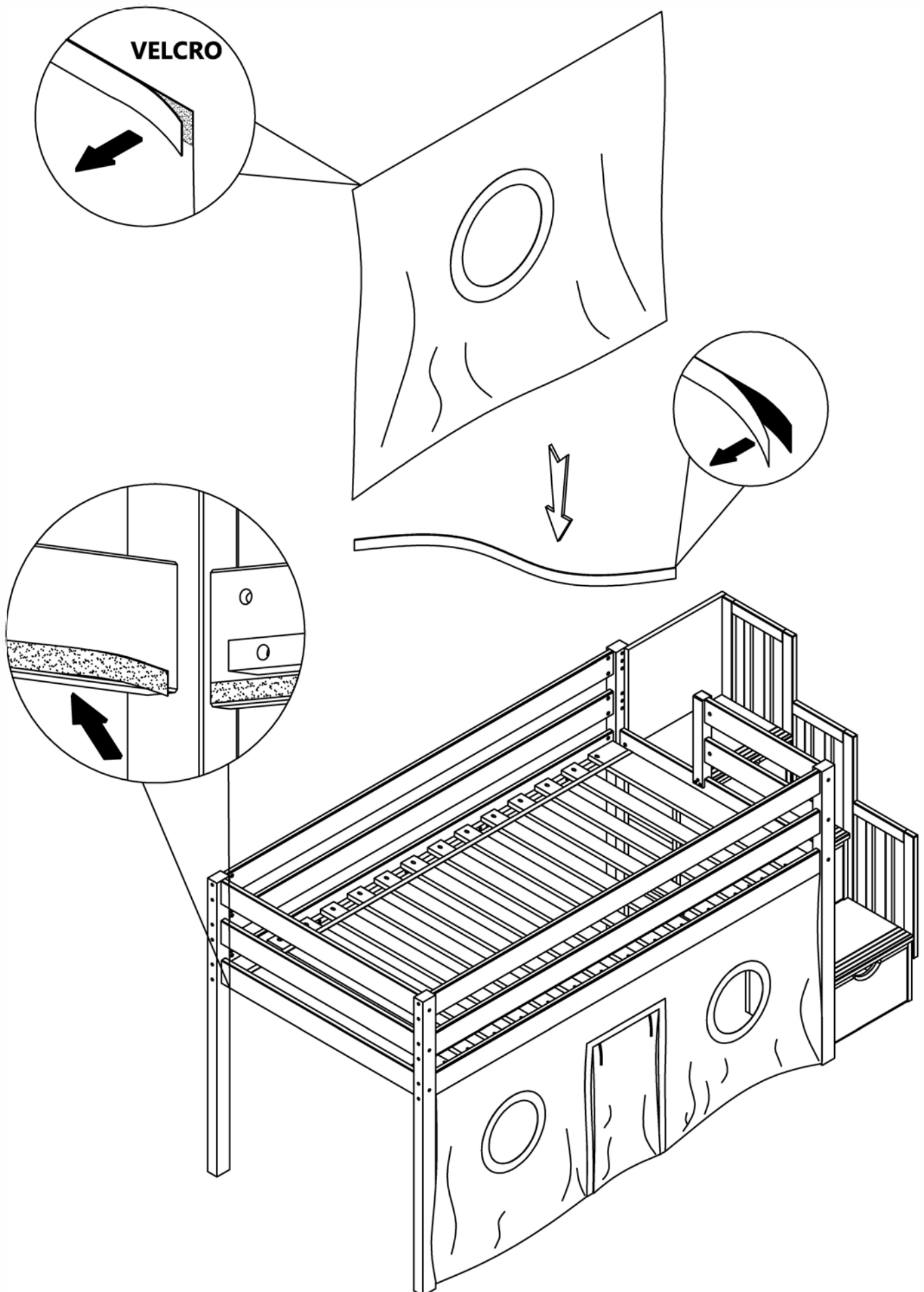




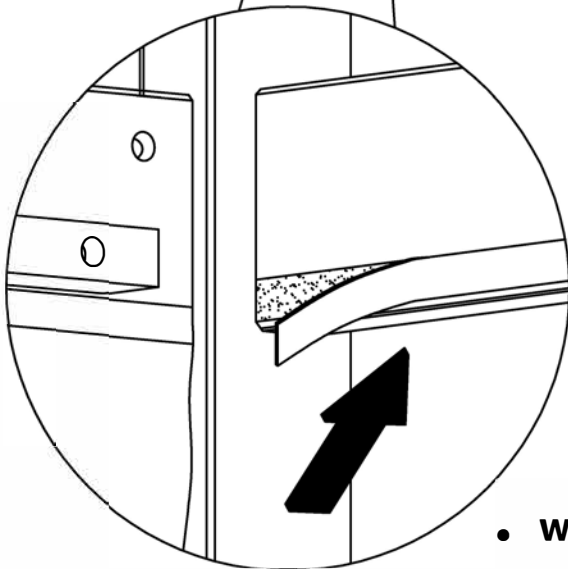
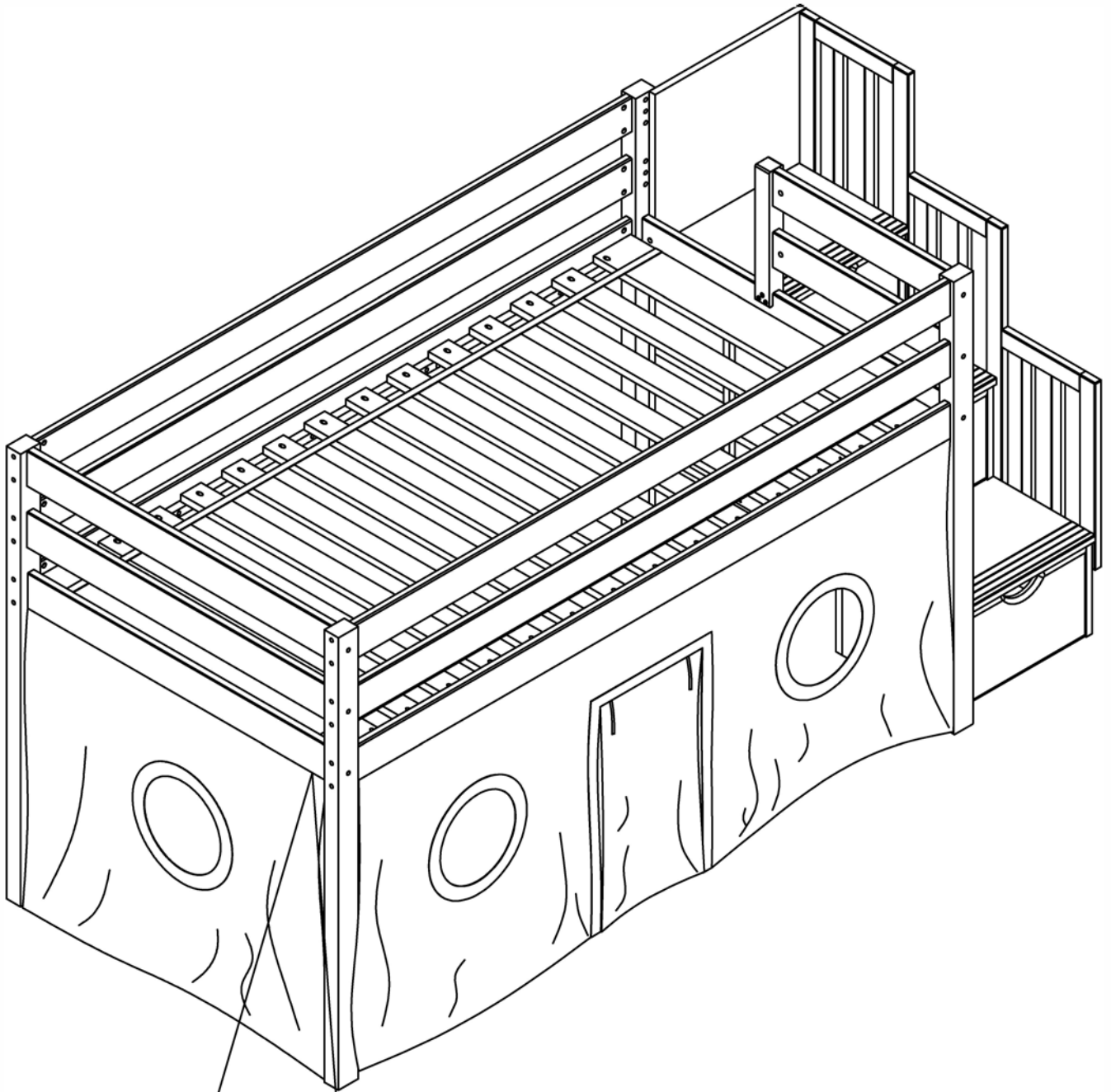
- **Attach Velcro to the bottom of the bedside rail.**
