

SAFETY WARNINGS AND GENERAL NOTES

- ✓ Follow the information on the warning labels on the low loft bed structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from the bed.
- ✓ Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- ✓ The top surfaces of the mattress must be at least 5"below the upper edge of the guardrails.
- ✓ **<u>Do not</u>** allow children under 6 years of age to use the low loft bed.
- ✓ **Prohibit** more than one person on the low loft bed.
- ✓ Periodically check and ensure that the guardrails, ladder and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- ✓ <u>**Do not**</u> allow horseplay on or under the bed. Always prohibit jumping on the bed.
- ✓ Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the low loft bed.
- ✓ <u>**Do not**</u> use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- ✓ Use of a night-light may provide added safety for a child using the low loft bed.
- ✓ If the low loft bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
- ✓ Always use guardrails on both long sides of the low loft bed.
- ✓ The use of a water or sleep floatation mattress is prohibited.
- ✓ Keep these instructions for future reference.
- ✓ We recommend assembling your low loft bed on the shipping carton to protect your floor or carpet. Be certain all staples are out of the box before beginning assembly on the shipping carton.
- ✓ <u>Strangulation Hazard</u> Never attach or hang items to any part of the low loft bed that are not designed for use with the bed for example, but not limited to hooks, belts, and jump ropes.



















BEDDING SPECIFICATION

- Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- All Bedz King low loft beds are supplied with a complete slat kit, so there is no need for a foundation or bunkie board.

BED MATTRESS SPECIFICATIONS

Only use a mattress that is 74" - 75" long and 37 1/2" - 38 1/2" wide on the low loft bed.

- Ensure thickness of mattress and foundation combined does not exceed 9".



ASSEMBLYTIPS

- Power tools are not recommended for assembling your furniture.
- Give yourself plenty of room to work.
- Due to the size of this low loft bed, it must be assembled within the space it will occupy.
- The assembly will require at least two people to complete.
- Make sure all the fasteners are tight.
- Take your time and read the instructions carefully.


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS Loft Bed Tent
