• Not for commercial use. For residential use only.




• Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.






Assembly Steps

Overview



This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.


Step 1



1.Attach Leg Frame 1 (B) and Leg Frame 2 (C) to the Table using Bolt (2) and Allen Wrench(4).


Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 2




2. Continue to attach the last leg of Leg Frame 1 (B) to the Table using Bolt (2) and Allen Wrench (4).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.



3.Attach Metal Supports (3) to the Leg Frame 1 (B) using Screw (1) and Screwdriver (5).


Do not fully tighten the Screw.



Place the Table Top (A) face down onto a clean , non-marring surface. **4.**Insert the dowels of Table Top (A) into the mountings in the Leg Frame 1 (B) and Leg Frame 2 (C) using Screw (1), Metal Supports (3) Allen Wrench (5).

Do not fully tighten the Screw.

Step 5



With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Table back to normal flat ground

EXERT pressure, floorwards, onto the Table.

This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach alignment at all joints. Check for wobbles.

In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts until evenly secured. Inspect the Table and make sure all parts are adequately connected. Your Table is ready for use.

Step 6
