 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.






Assembly Steps

Overview




This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Dining Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly

Step 1



Place Table Top (A) on a clean, non-marring surface, facedown and open.

Step 2




Align the mounting positions on the Shim(D) to the mountings on the Table Leg (C).

Attach Bolt(1)+Spring Washer(3) and Flat Washer(2)and Spring with Allen Wrench(4).

Repeat the same process with the Other Table Legs(C).

Note: DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 3




Align the mounting positions on the Table Leg with Support Block (B) to the mountings on the Table Top (A).

Attach Bolt(1)+Spring Washer(3) and Flat Washer(2) and Spring with Allen Wrench(4).

Repeat the same process with the Other Table Leg with Support Block(B).

Note: DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 4




Align the mounting positions on the Table Leg(C)&Shim(D) to the mountings on the Table Top (A).

Attach Bolt(1)+Spring Washer(3) and Flat Washer(2)and Spring with Allen Wrench(4).

Repeat the same process with the Other Table Leg (C)&Shim(D). Note: DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 5




Align the mounting positions on the Bipod(E) to the mountings on the Table Legs(B&C).

Then insert the Bolt(6)+Spring Washer(8) and Flat Washer(7) and with Allen Wrench(9) as shown.


Note: DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts at this time.

Step 6



Attach Legs Pad(⑤) to the Table legs (B&C) by hand.





Turn the Table right side up.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Then tighten all blots.

Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
