• Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.


• Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.






Assembly Steps




This 3 Seater Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the 3 Seater Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions herebelow to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.




Take out the Left Armrest (A), Right Armrest (B), Sofa Base (C) and Hardware Box from the Carton"2-1" and place them on a clean, non-marring surface.




Take out the Backrest (D) from the Carton"2-2", place it on a clean, non-marring surface




Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.



Flip the Sofa Base (C) so that its Bottom faces forward, then align the Left Armrest (A) flush against the side of the Sofa Base. Match the holes of both components as shown in the diagram above. Secure them together using a Long Screw (1), Spring Washer (2), and Flat Washer (3) as illustrated. Finally, install the right armrest (B) to the right side of the Sofa Base following the same method. After completing the above installation, return the Sofa to its upright position.




Flip the Sofa Base (C) so its Bottom faces forward. Then place the Sofa Backrest (D) with its rear side down on the ground and slide it forward toward the Sofa Base (C). Align the holes, then secure them from underneath the Sofa Base (C) using Long Screws (\bigcirc 1), Spring Washers (\bigcirc 2), and Flat Washers (\bigcirc 3) as shown in the diagram above. Do not return the Sofa to upright position yet—proceed directly to the next step.




Install the Sofa Legs (E) onto the underside of the Sofa Base (C) in accordance with the illustrated configuration.

Step 7



Install the Center Leg (F) onto the middle frame of the Sofa Base (C) following the diagrammatic illustration, then return the Sofa to its upright position.

Step 8



Your 3 Seater Sofa is ready to use.

This 3 Seater Sofa can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of

drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987. What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
