STEP 1.

Insert quickfit screws (A) into parts 1, 3 and 4, as shown.





STEP 2.

Insert quickfit screws (K) and long wooden dowels (L) into part 5, as shown. Insert cam locks (B) into parts 6, as shown.


Fit parts 6 to part 5.

Turn cam locks clockwise to tighten.







Insert cam locks (B) and short wooden dowels (C) into parts 3, 4 and 5, as shown.











STEP 5.

Insert parts 7 into grooves between parts 1, 3, 4 and 5, as shown.



STEP 6.


Insert short wooden dowels (C) to parts 3, 4 and 5, as shown. Fix part 2 to parts 3, 4 and 5 using screws (D) and allen key (G), as shown.


Fix legs 9 and 10 to part 2 using screws (H), as shown.






STEP 8.


Fix wall straps (M-1) to part 1 using washers (M-2) and screws (M-3), as shown. Secure backing panel 7 by fxing wedges (I) using screws (J), as shown.



STEP 9.


Fix handles (E) to doors (8) using screws (F), as shown.






STEP 10.

Insert doors 8 into grooves between top and botom from back, as shown.




STEP 11.

Insert doors 8 into grooves between top and botom from back, as shown.



STEP 12.

Turn adjustable foot nails as your need.




STEP 13.

For extra stability, it is recommended that you fix your sideboard to the wall using hardwares (N-1, N-2 and N-3), as shown.

Screws (N-1) are fixed through washers (N-2) and wall straps and into the wall plugs (N-3).

Should you choose not to afix the product to the wall, serious injury may be caused if the product tips over.
