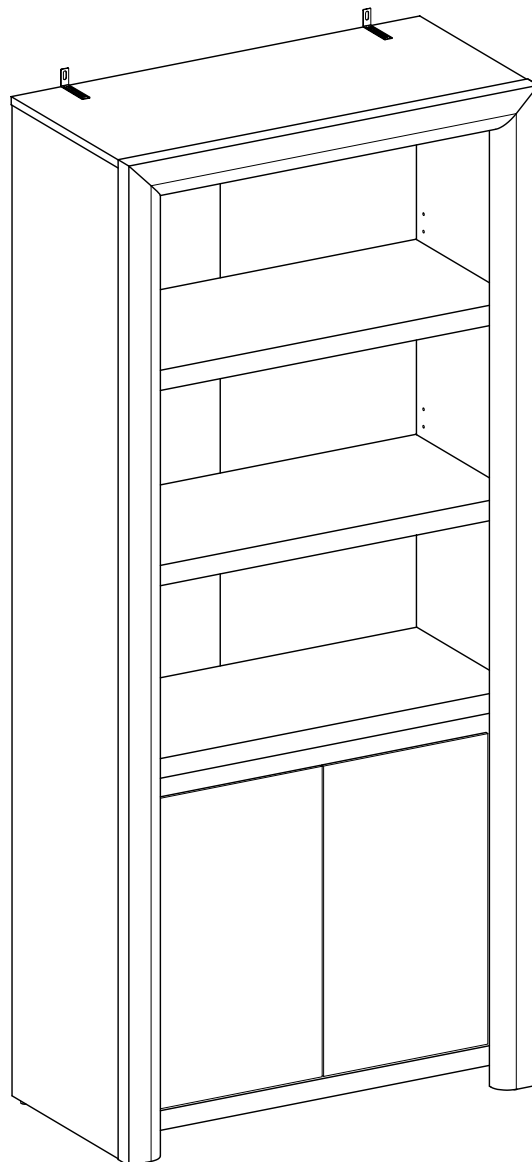

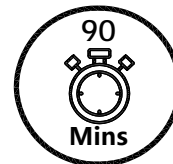

Time to get started

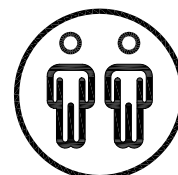
Set up a clean and soft workplace to get started and avoid damage during the assembly. It also helps to double-check that you've got all the pieces and parts before diving in to assembly.

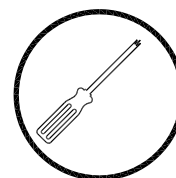

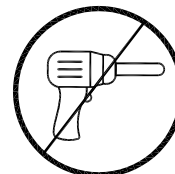
Tools Needed

Grab a Phillips head screwdriver to conquer this assembly



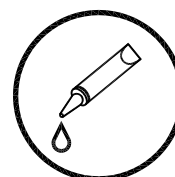
Use power tools with caution

Glue is provided to secure wood dowels in place

When inserting dowels, locate the appropriate hole, place a small amount of glue in the hole, and then insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately.

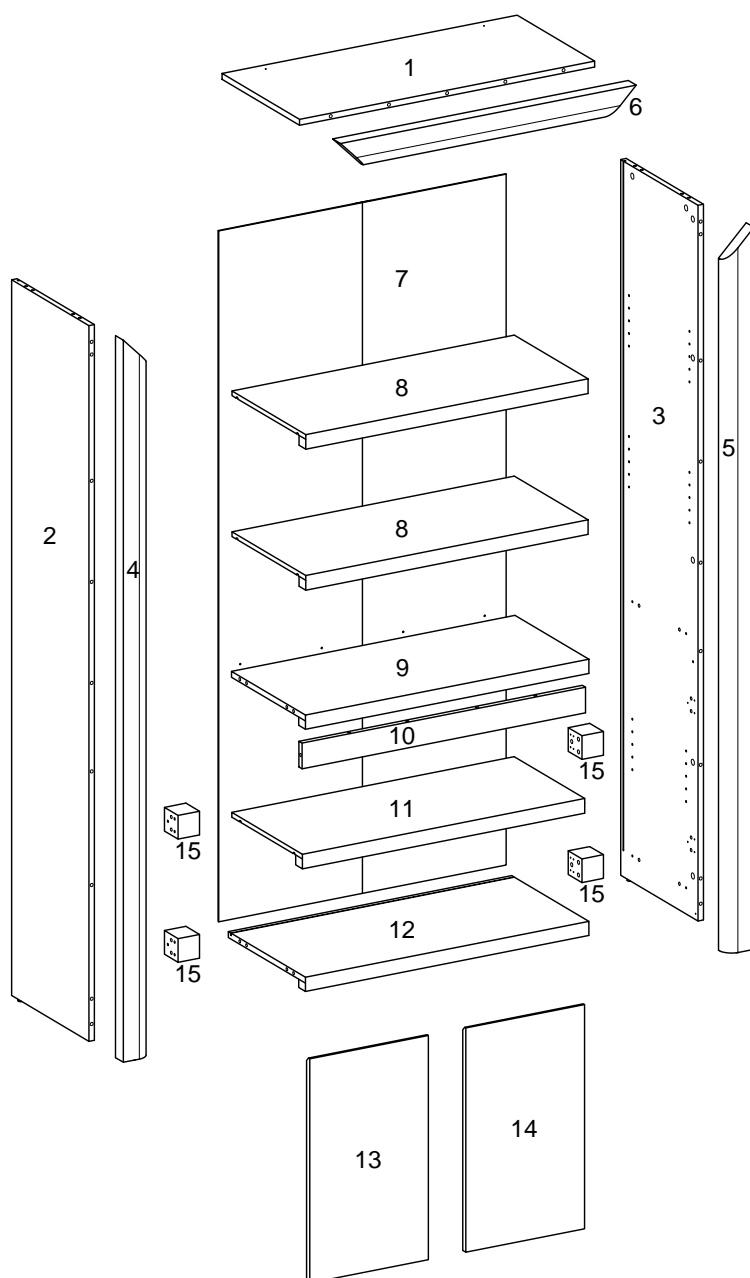

Step 1

Let's get started! Using a Phillips head screwdriver, screw cam bolts (B) into the Left Side Panel (2) and the Right Side Panel (3). Then, insert wooden dowels (A) into both pieces.

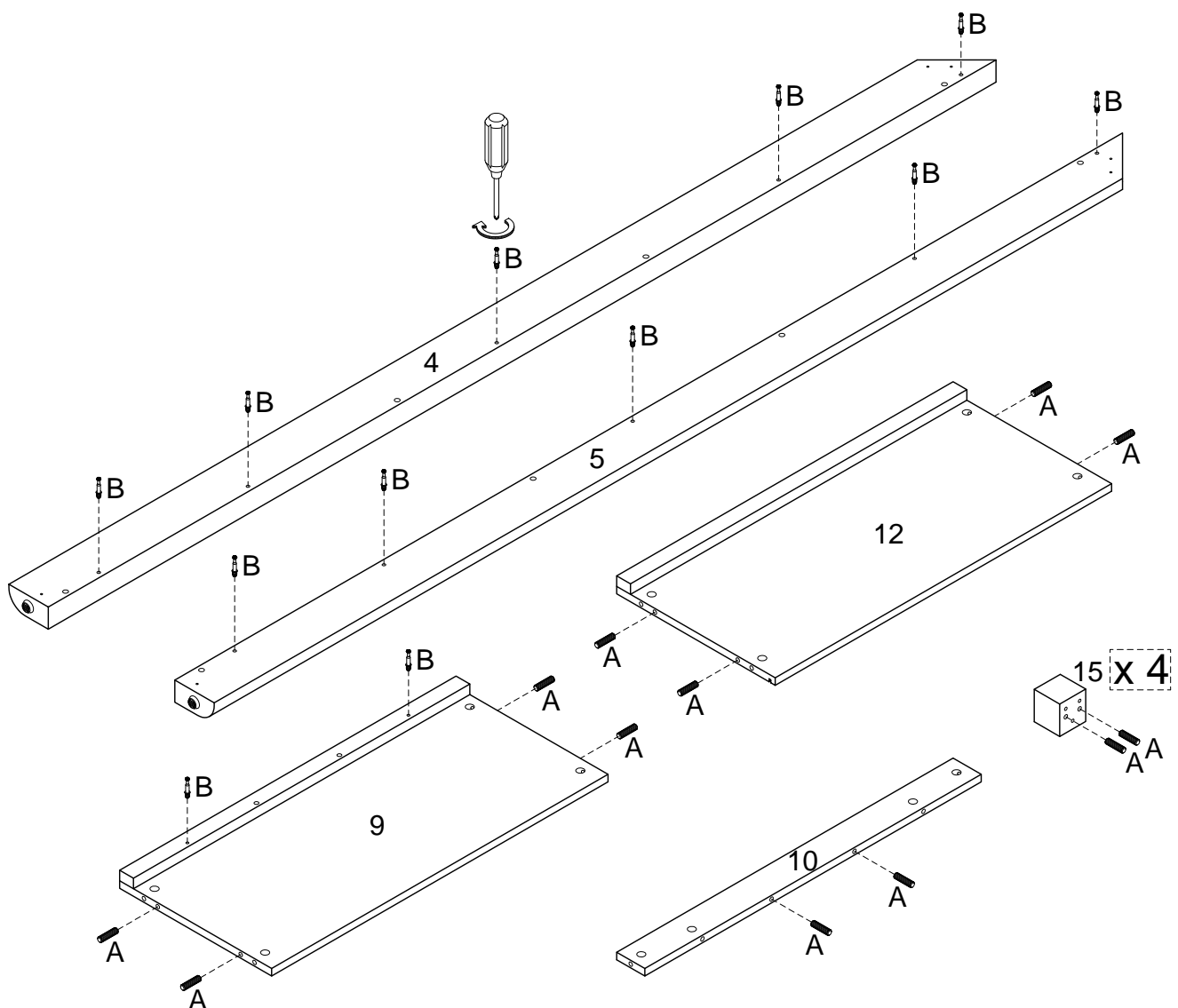


1: The provided glue is to secure wood dowels in place. When first inserting dowels, locate the appropriate hole for the dowel, place a small amount of glue in the hole and insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately.

2: In future assembly steps when dowels are necessary to attach assembly parts together, place a small amount of glue on the end of the dowel before attaching parts together. Wipe away excess glue immediately.

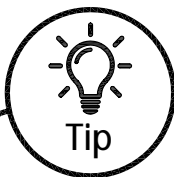
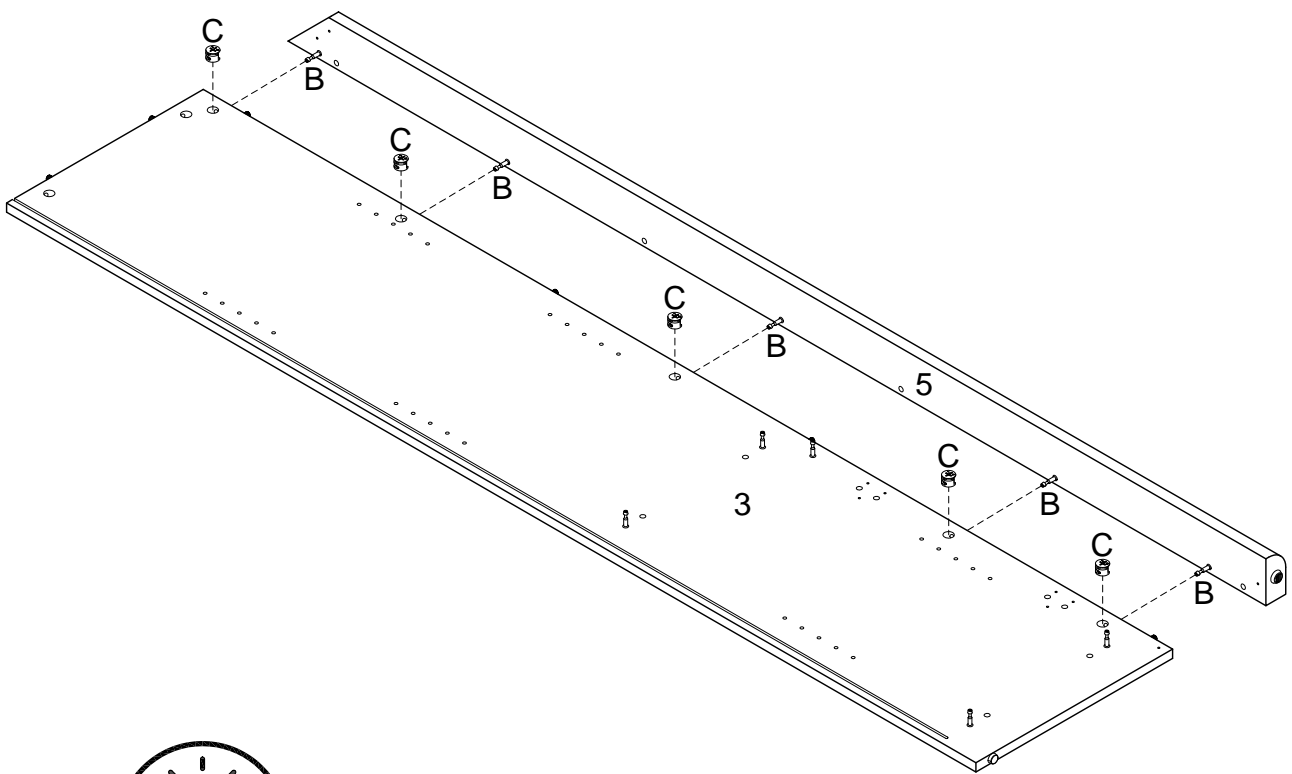
Step 2

Screw cam bolts (B) into the Left Side Molding (4), the Right Side Molding (5) and the Fixed Divider (9). Then, insert wooden dowels (A) into the Fixed Divider (9), Bottom Board (12), Front windshield (10), and all four Door Hinge Pads (15).



Step 3

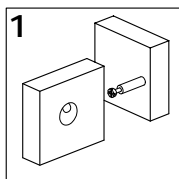
Connect the Right Side Molding (5) to the Right Side Panel (3) via the cam bolts (B). Insert cam locks (C) and tighten with a screwdriver.



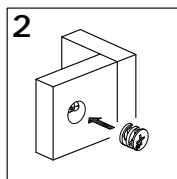
Tip

Cam Locks

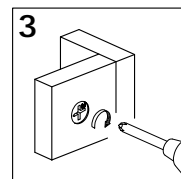
Cam Locks help securely join two pieces together.
Follow these easy steps.



1: Insert Cam Bolt into bolt holes on the flat side. Don't over tighten!



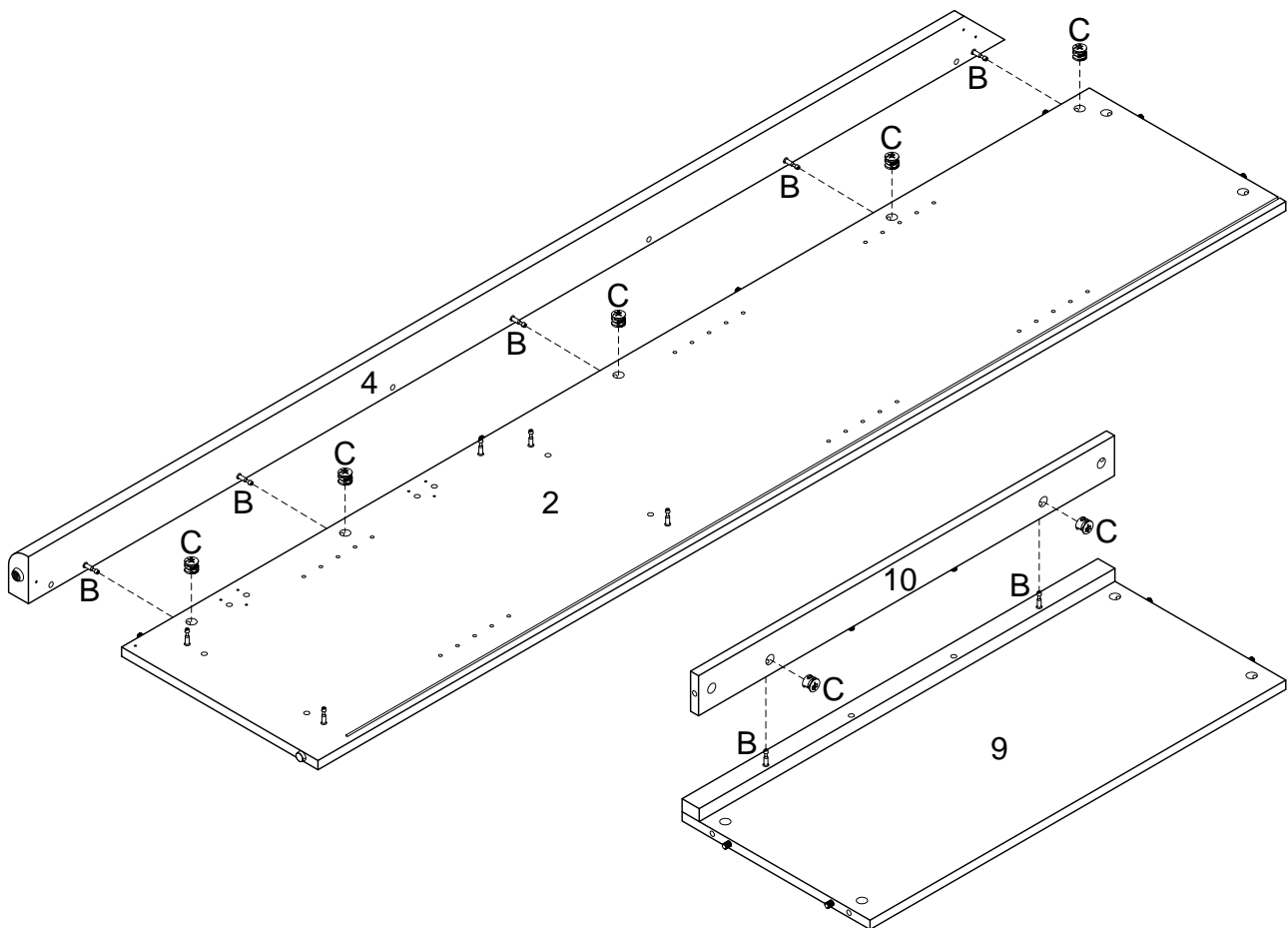
2: Fit the proper holes on the edge of the other part over the Cam Bolts. You should be able to see the cam bolts through the larger hole on the side.



3: On the back of the Cam Lock will be a "C" shape. Insert the Cam Lock so the opening of the "C" fits over the Cam Bolt. Tighten with the screwdriver.

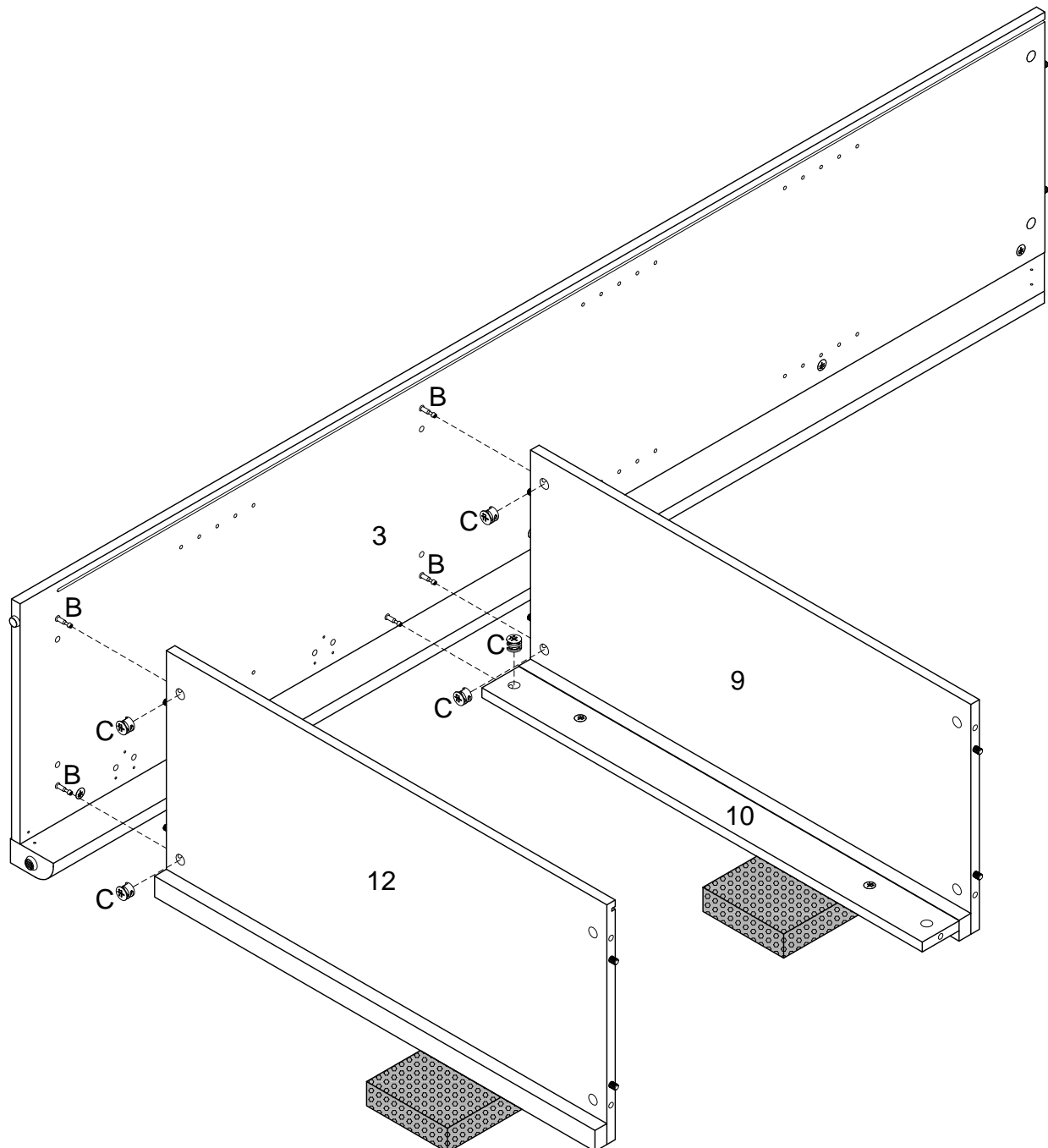
Step 4

Repeat the previous step for the other side! Connect the Left Side Molding (4) to the Left Side Panel (2) via the cam bolts (B). Insert cam locks (C) and tighten with a screwdriver. Then, secure the Front Windshield (10) to the Fixed Divider (9). Insert cam locks (C) and tighten with a screwdriver.



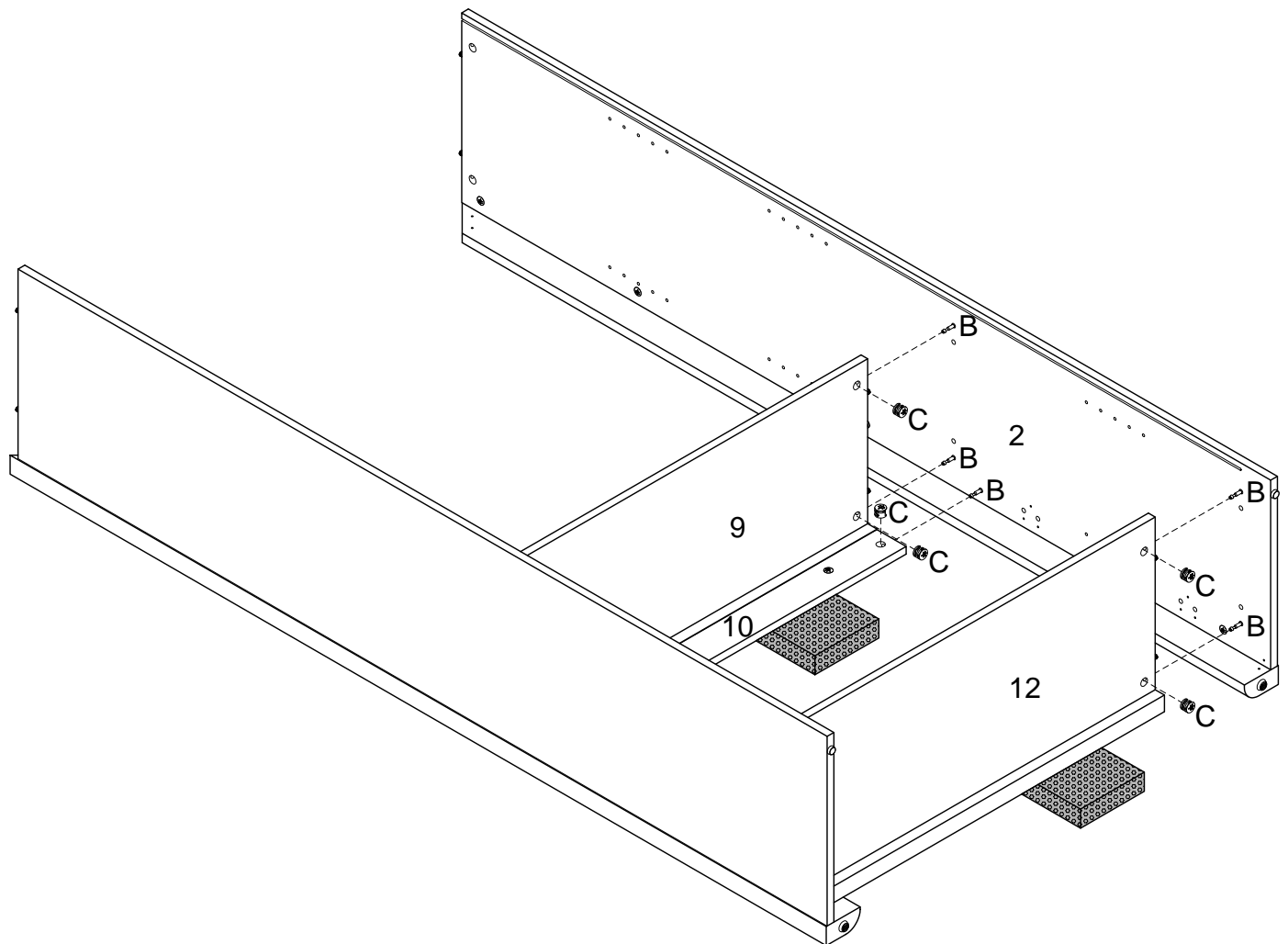
Step 5

Secure the Fixed Divider (9), Front windshield (10) and the Bottom Board (12) to the Right Side Panel (3) using the cam bolts (B). Insert cam locks (C) and tighten with a screwdriver.



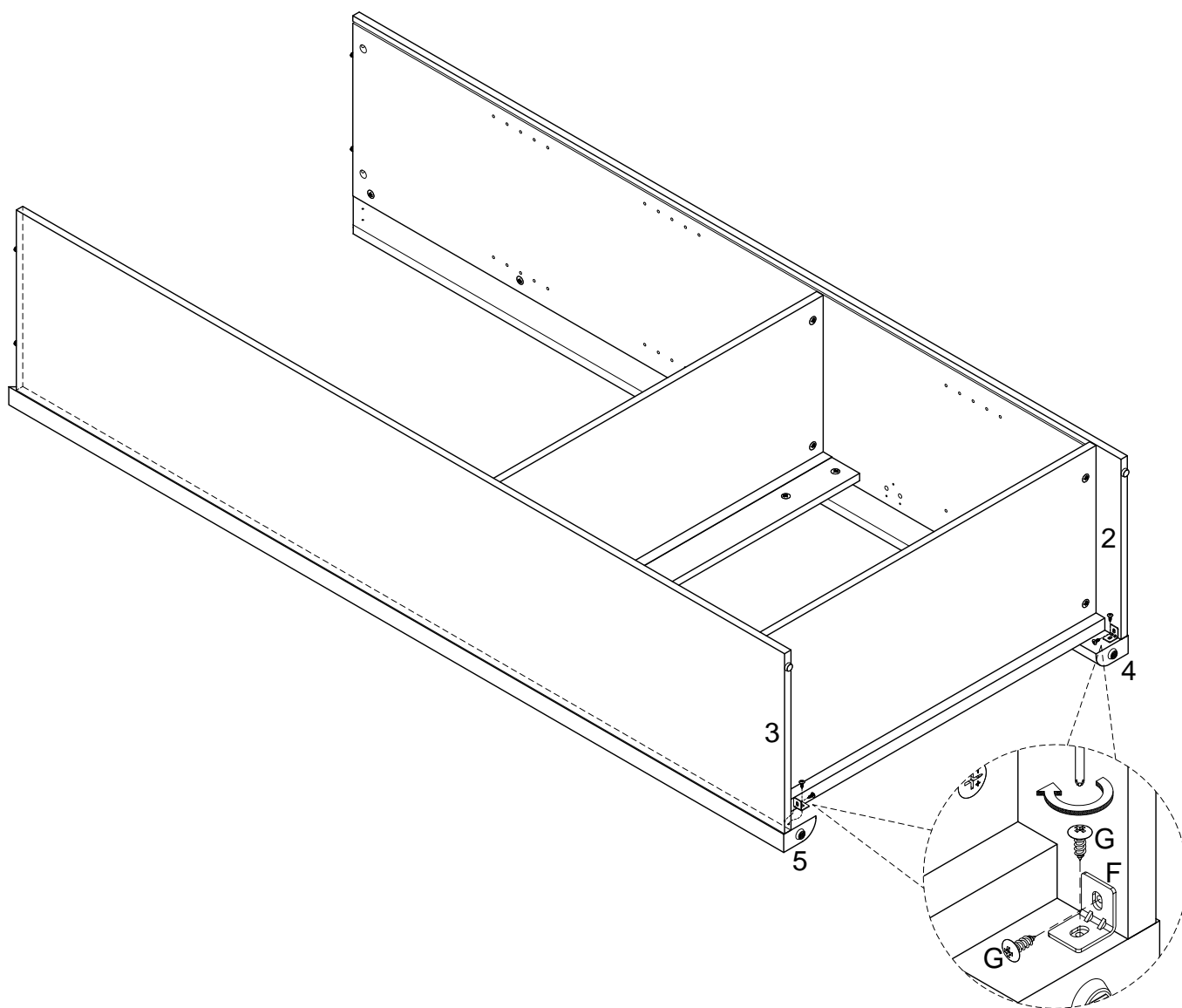
Step 6

Now, connect the Left Side Panel (2).



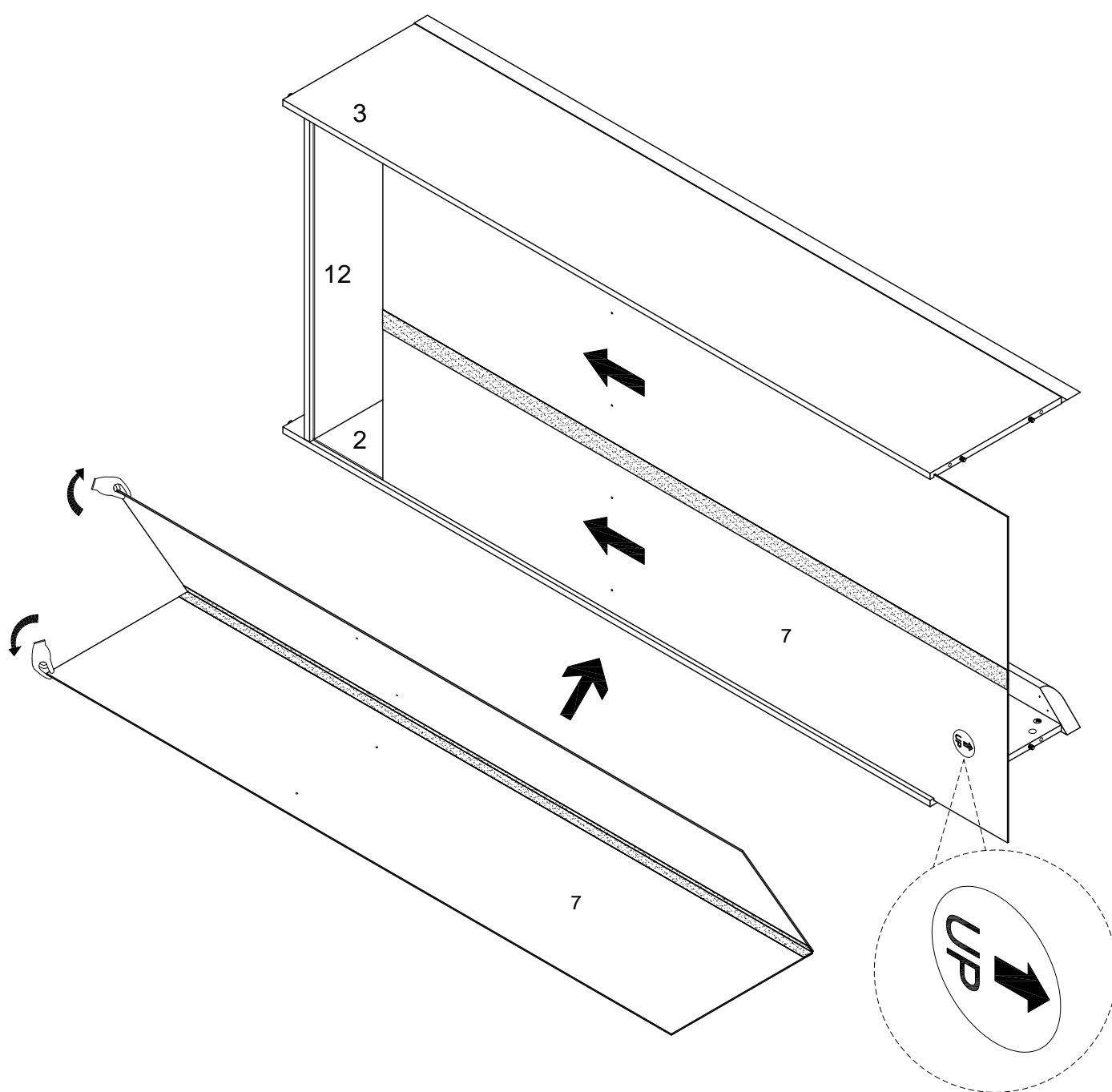
Step 7

Using the (G) screws, secure an I-shaped bracket (F) to the Right Side Panel (3) and Right Side Molding (5) as well as the Left Side Panel (2) and the Left Side Molding (4).



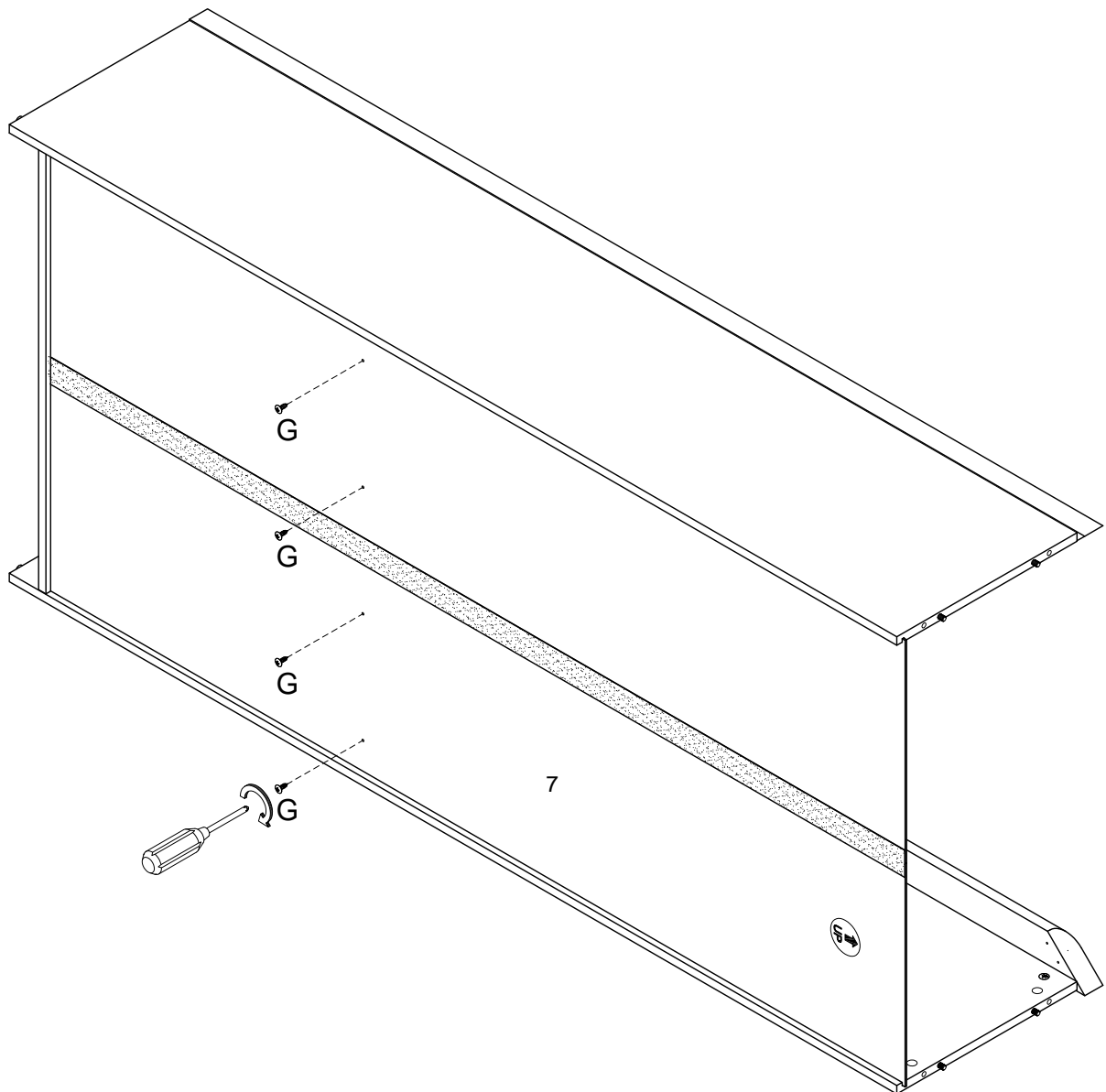
Step 8

Unfold the Back Panel (7) and slide into place using the grooves in the Bottom Board (12), Right Side Panel (3), and the Left Side Panel (2).



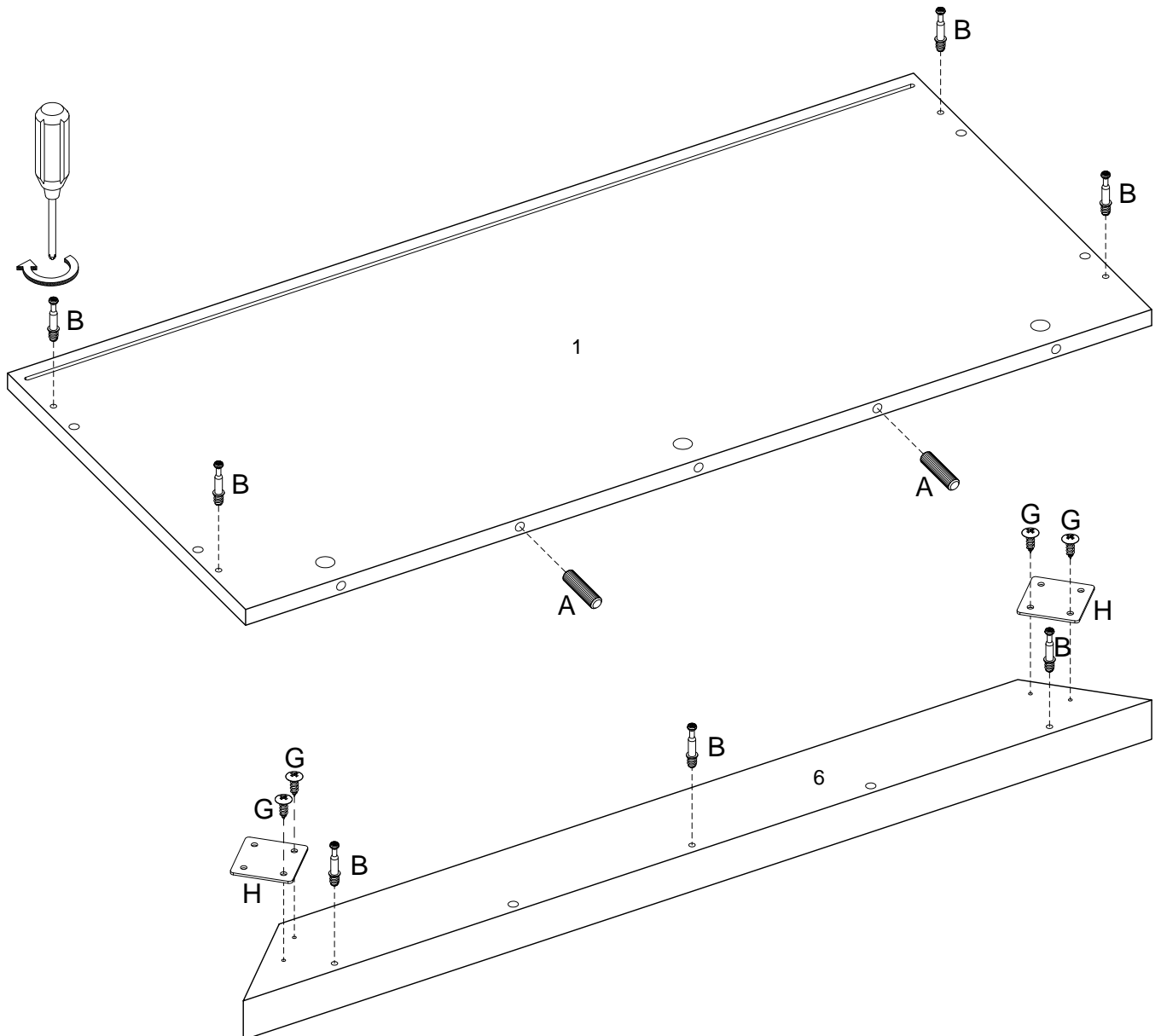
Step 9

Secure the Back Panel (7) using the (G) screws.



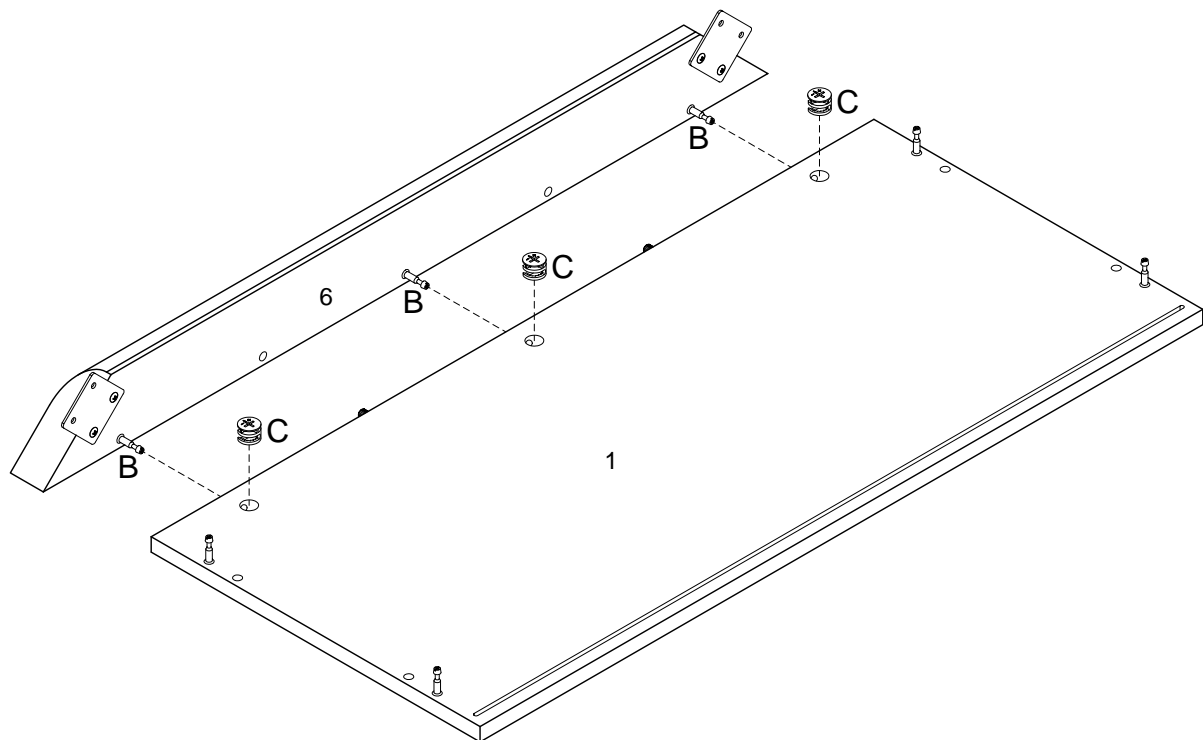
Step 10

Screw cam bolts (B) into the Top Panel (1) and the Front Molding (6). Then, insert wooden dowels (A) into the Top Panel (1) and secure a connecting iron sheet (H) to both ends of the Front Molding (6) using the (G) screws.



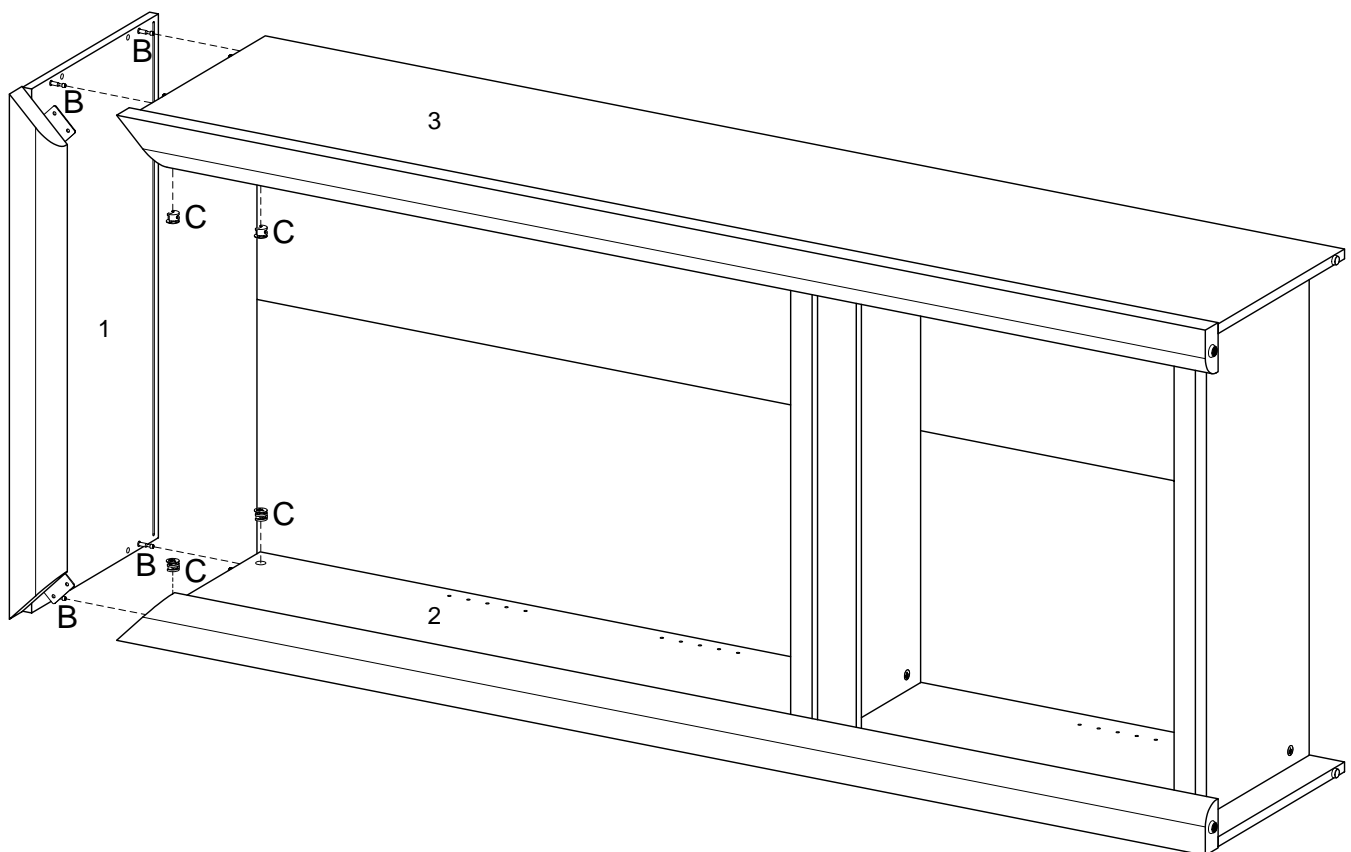
Step 11

Attach the Front Molding (6) to the Top Panel (1) using the cam bolts (B). Insert cam locks (C) and tighten with a screwdriver.



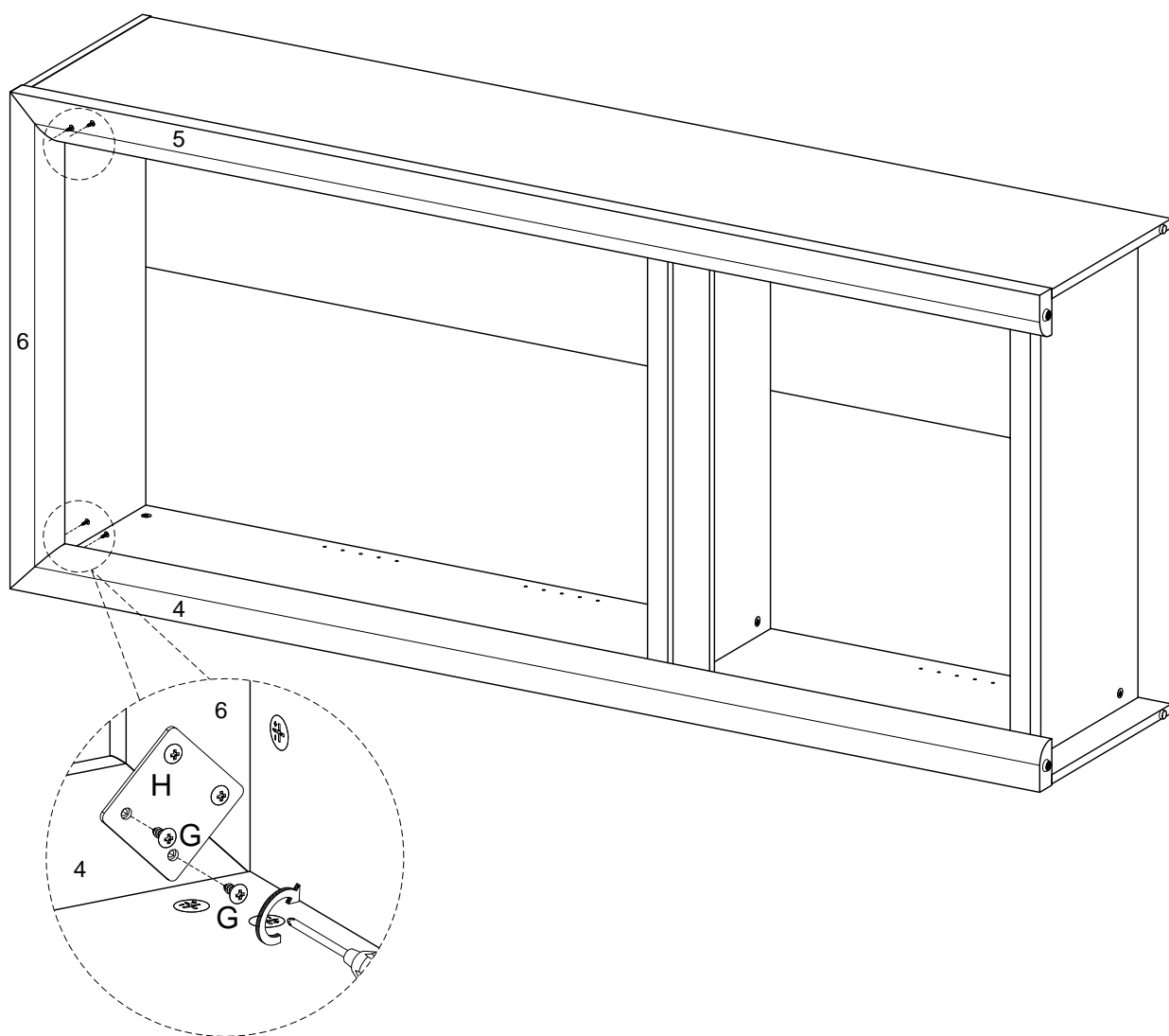
Step 12

Now, connect the Top Panel (1) and insert cam locks (C). Tighten to secure.



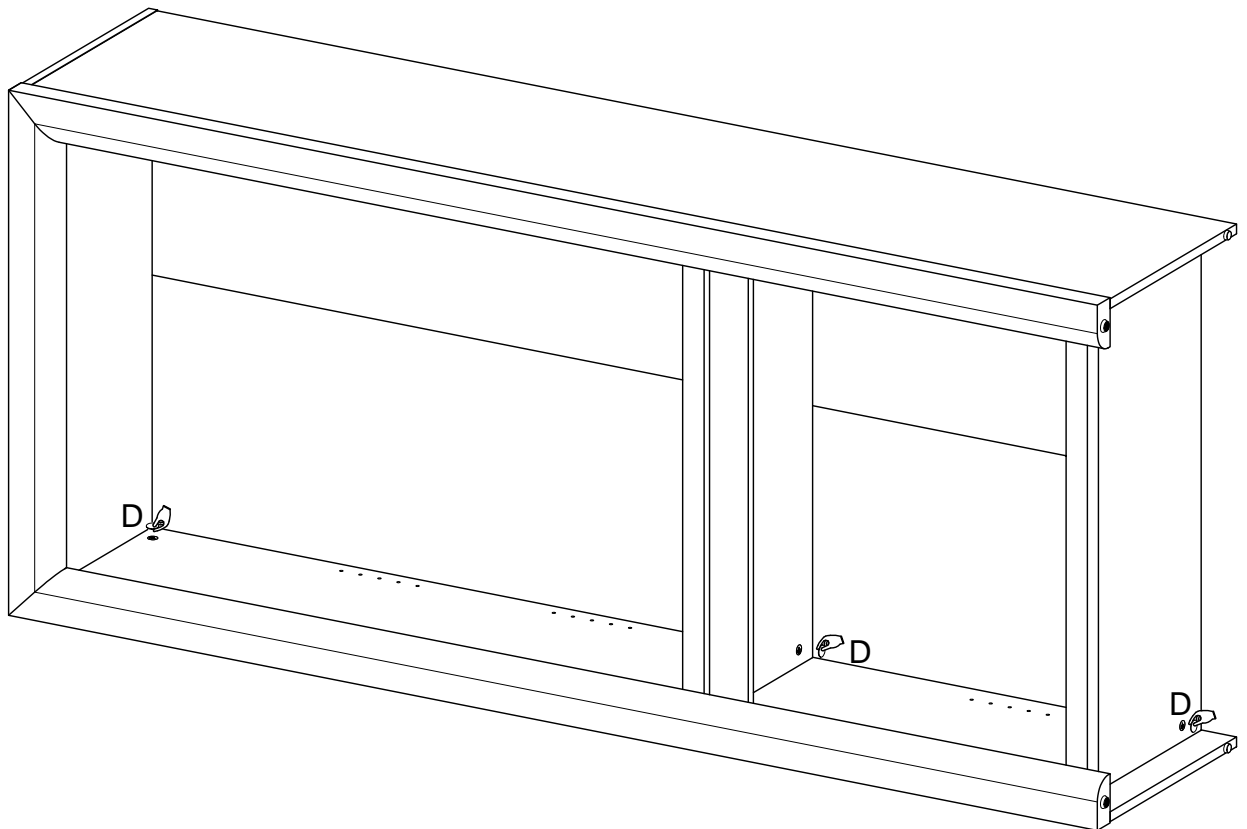
Step 13

Use (G) screws to secure the other side of the connecting iron sheet (H) to the Right Side Molding (5) and the Left Side Molding (4).



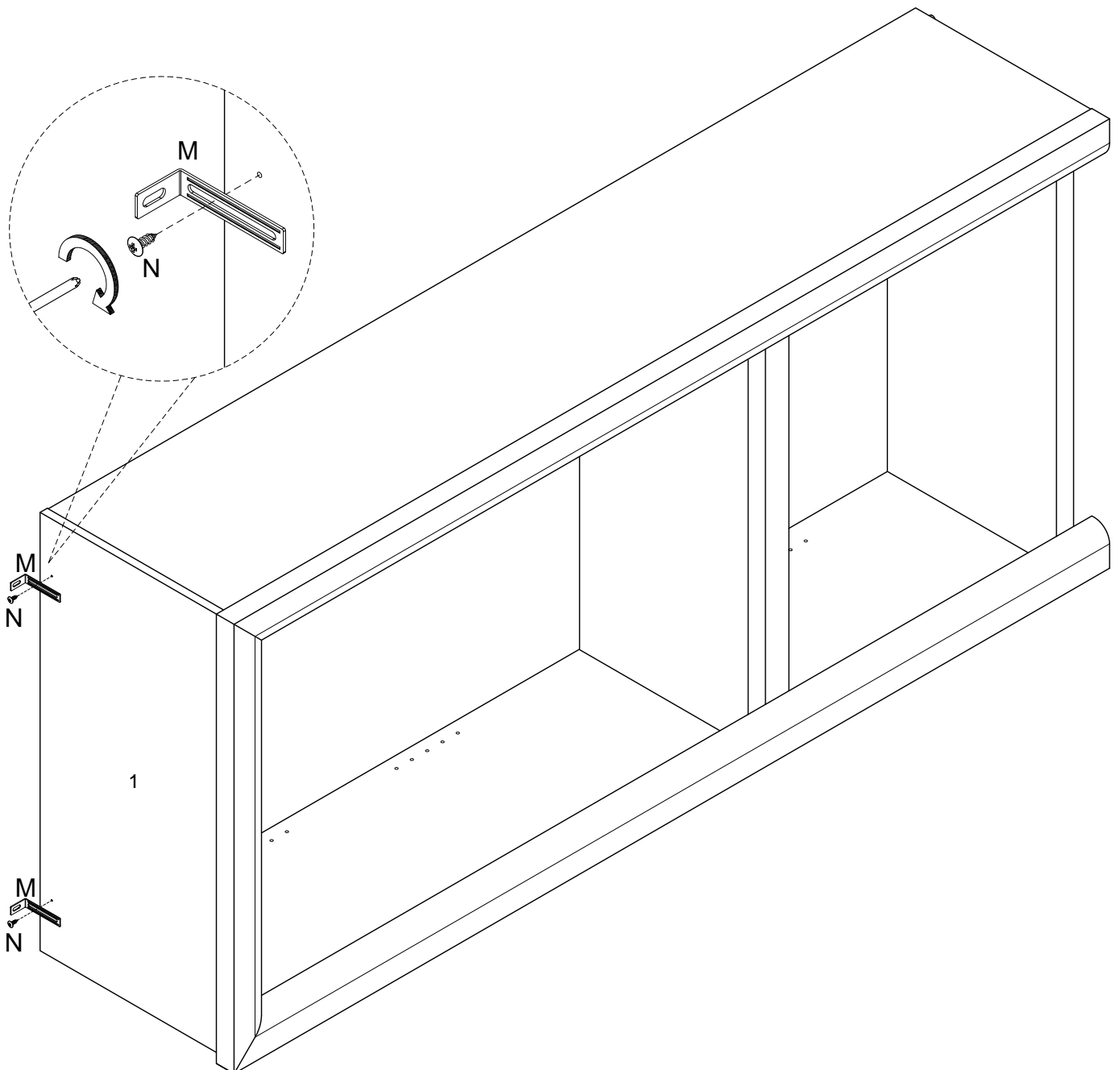
Step 14

Use the provided stickers (D) to ensure a clean finish.



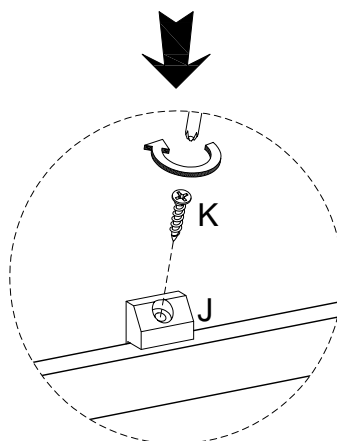
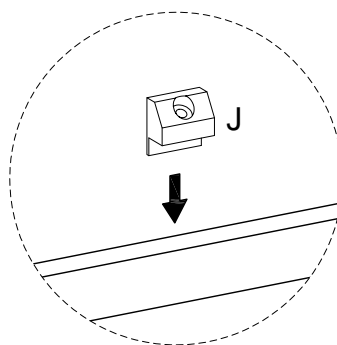
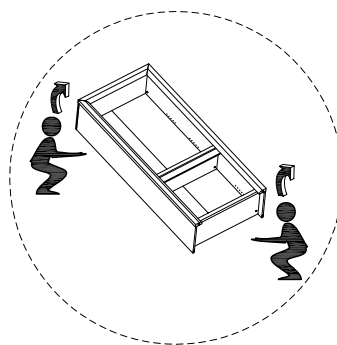
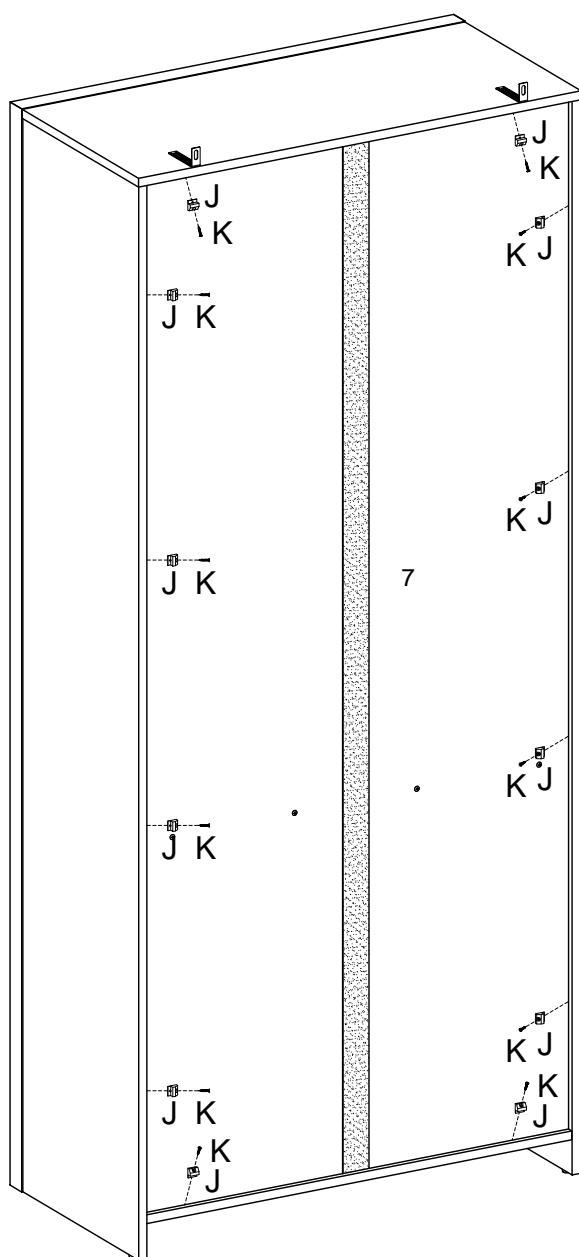
Step 15

Attach the Bracket (M) to the Top Panel (1) using the (N) screws.



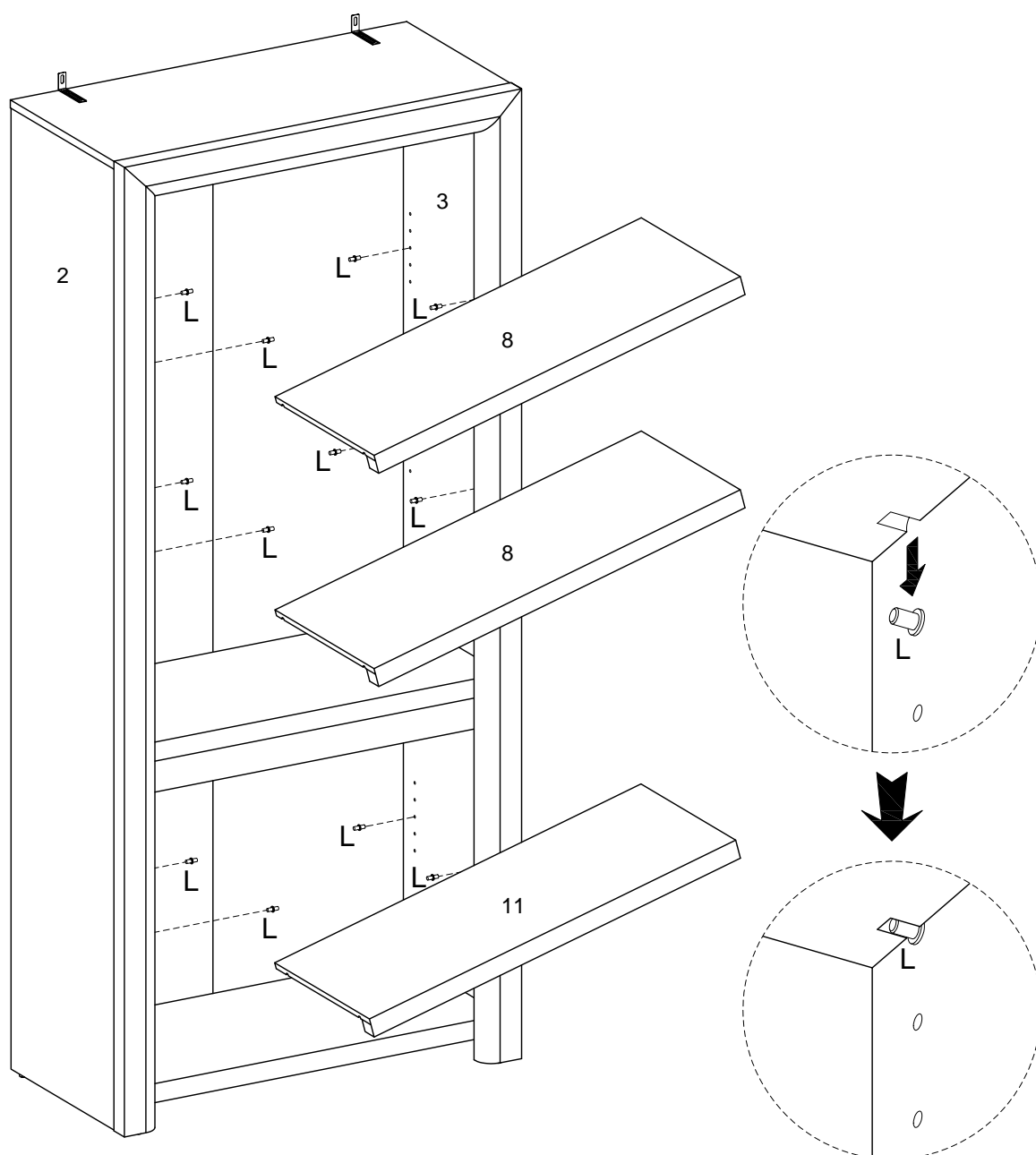
Step 16

Evenly space the plastic wedges (J) in between the Back Panel (7) and the frame. Secure with the (K) screws.



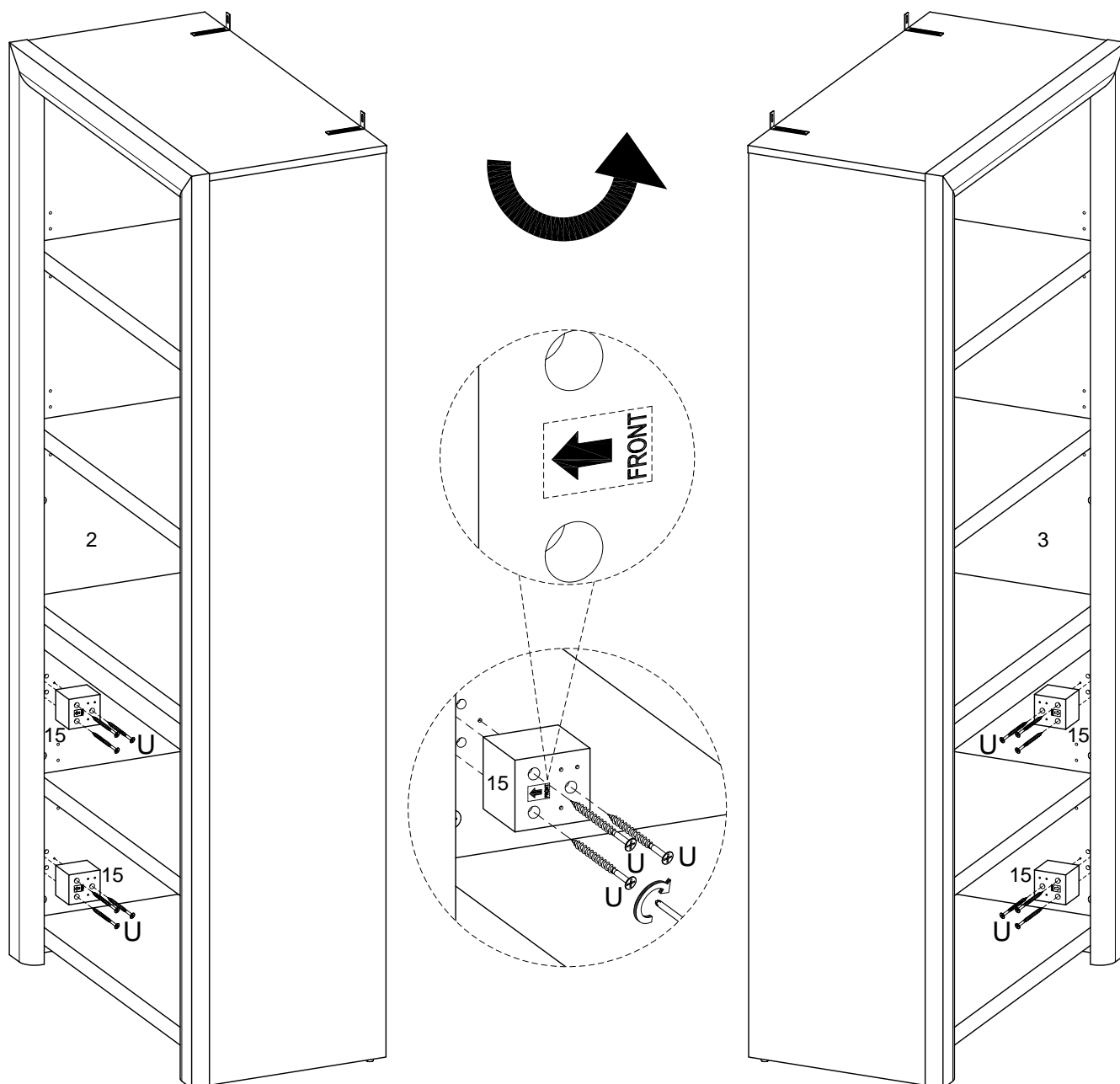
Step 17

Insert shelf support pins (L), then slide in the Adjustable Shelves (8) and the Lower active layer board (11) ensuring the notch in the shelf fits to the shelf support pin (L).



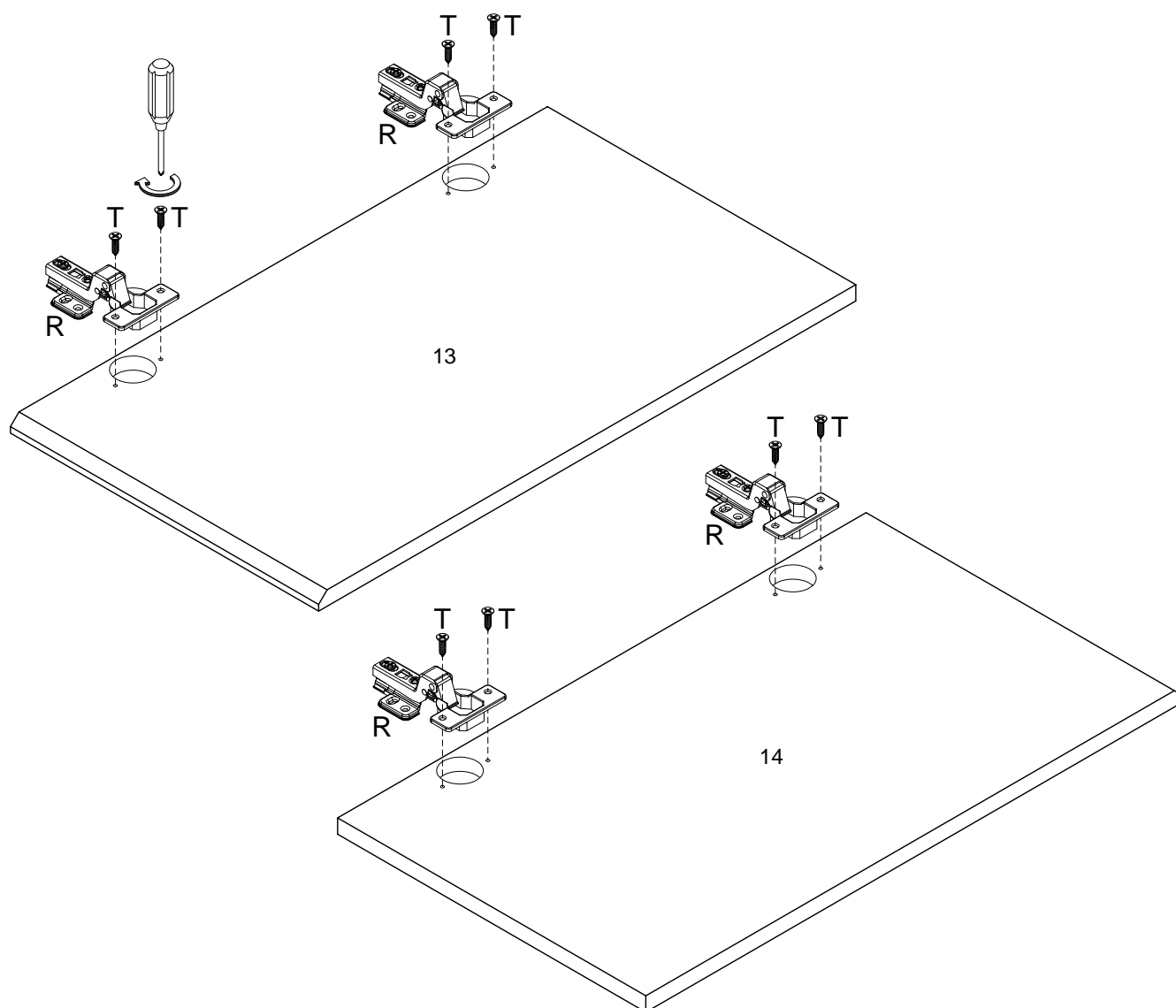
Step 18

Using the (U) screws, secure two Door Hinge Pads (15) to each side of the bookcase on the Left Side Panel (2) and the Right Side Panel (3).



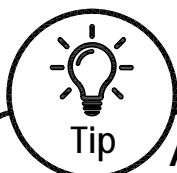
Step 19

Secure hinges (R) to the Left Door Panel (13) and the Right Door Panel (14) using the (T) screws.

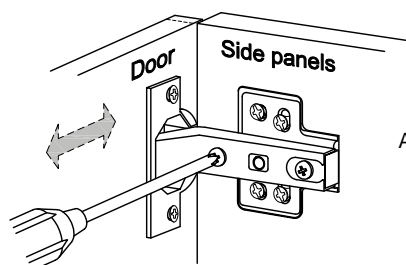


Step 20

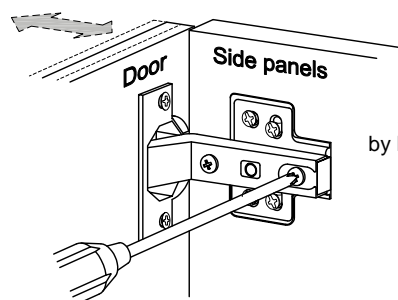
Connect hinges on the Left Door Panel (13) to the Door Hinge Pads (15) on the Left Side Panel (2) using the (T) screws.



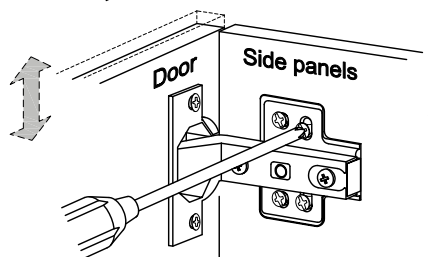
Adjusting The Cabinet Doors



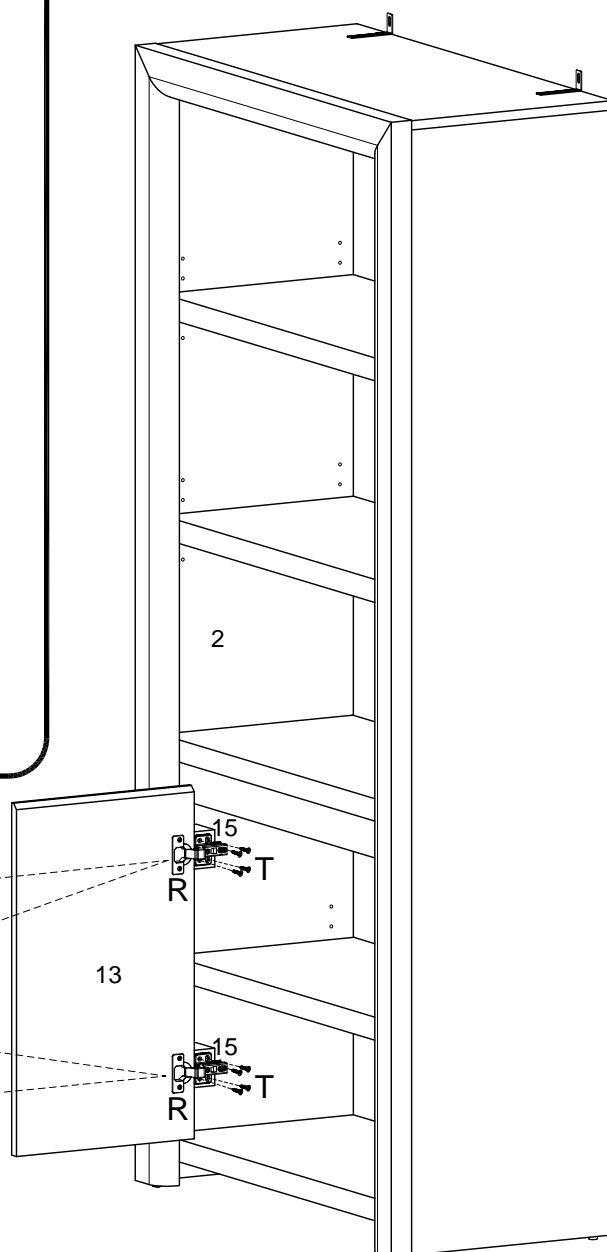
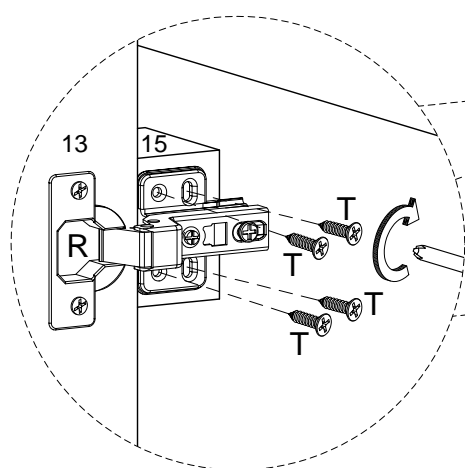
Adjust horizontal width with this screw.



Adjust depth position by loosening the hinge arm mounting screw.

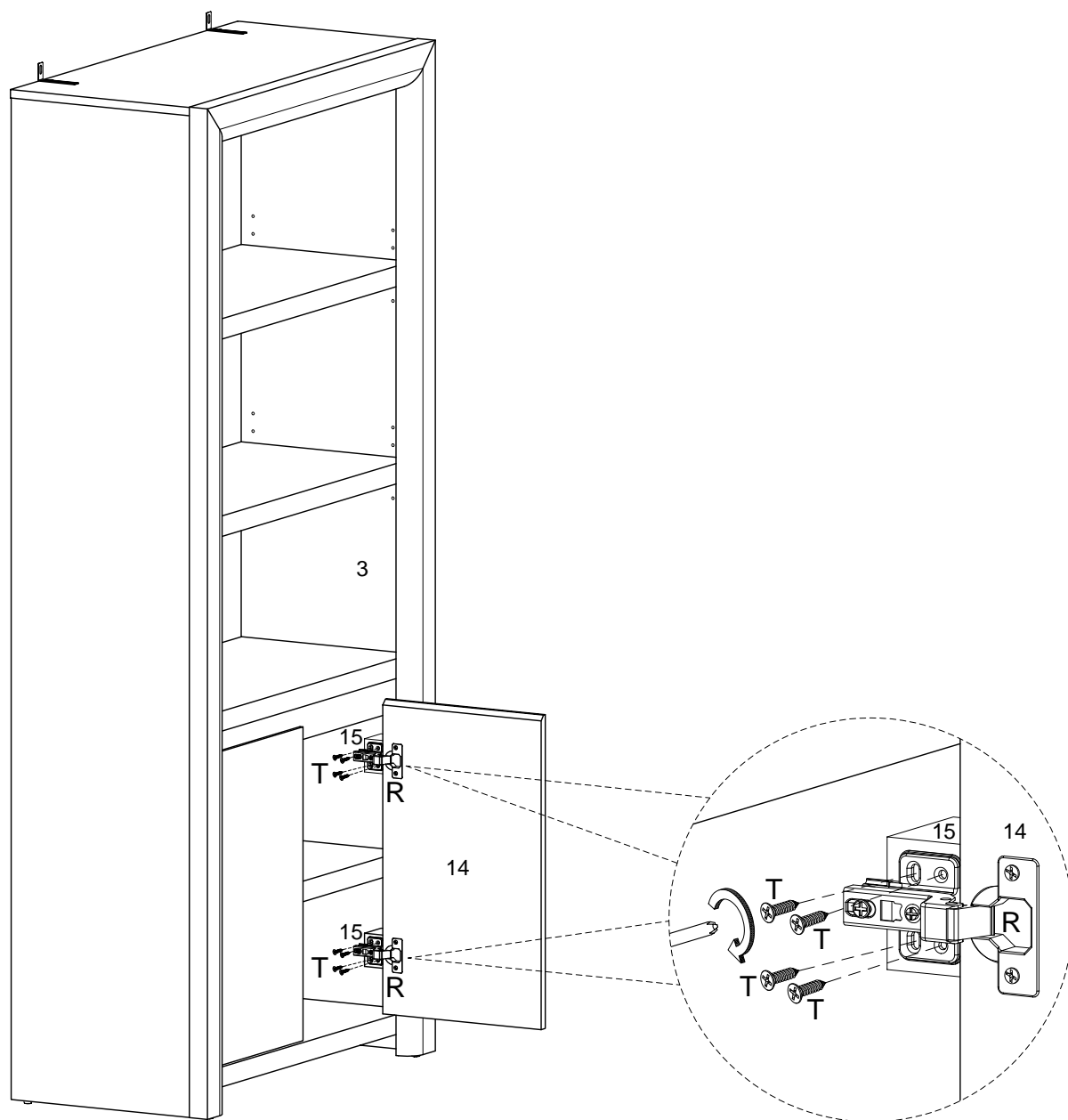


Adjust vertical height via the screws in the mounting plate.



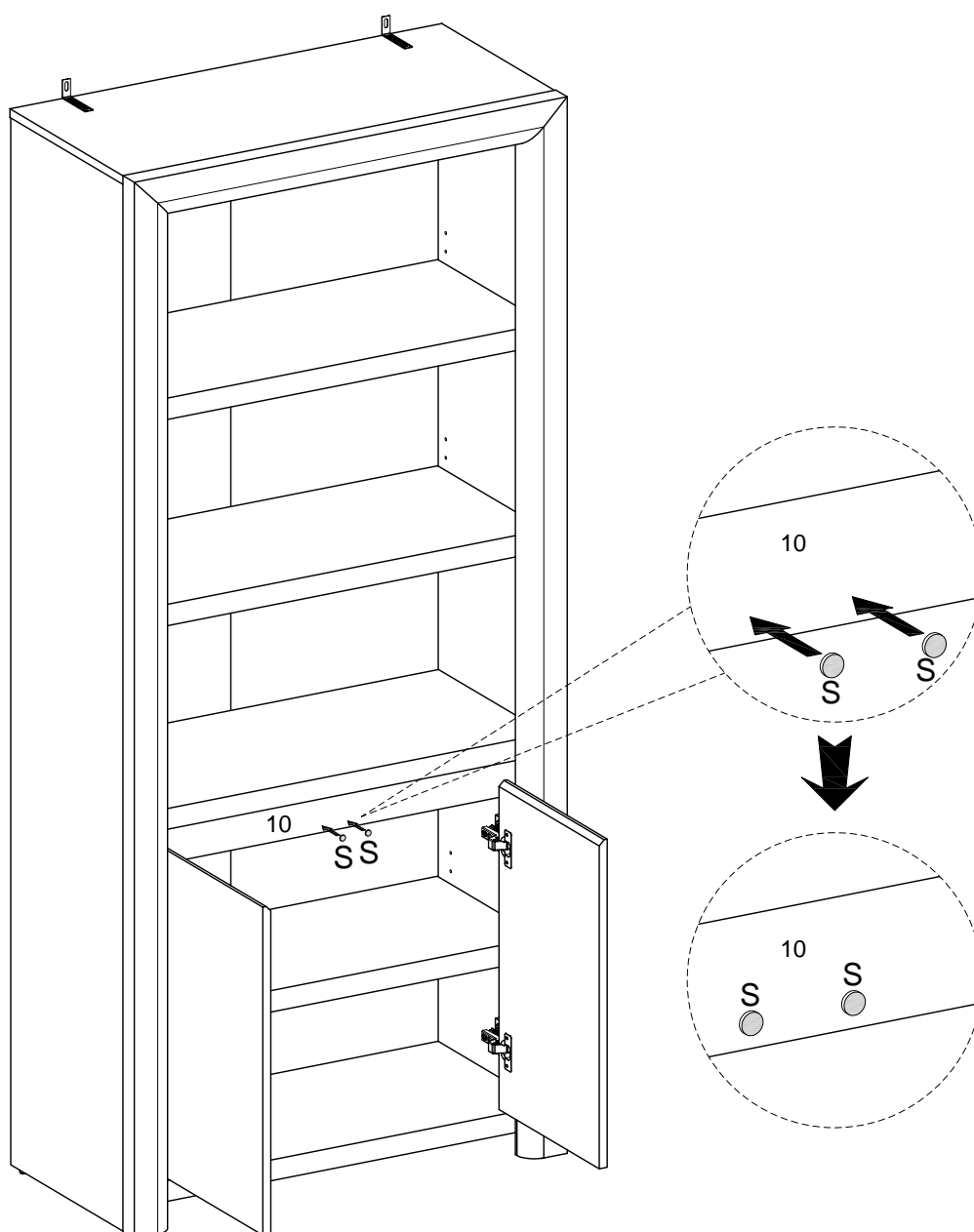
Step 21

Connect hinges on the Right Door Panel (14) to the Door Hinge Pads (15) on the Right Side Panel (3) using the (T) screws.



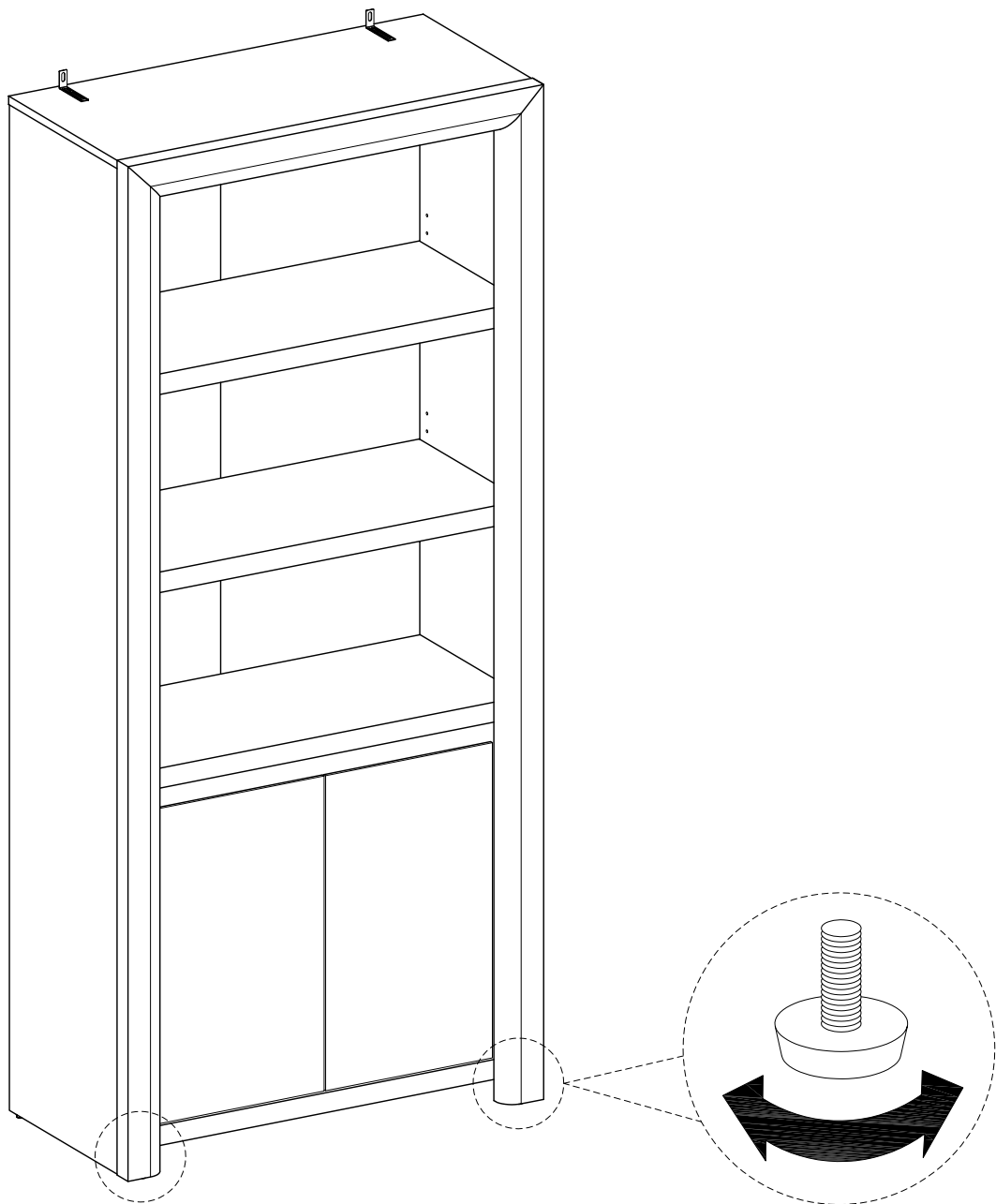
Step 22

Stick the rubber pads (S) to the Front Windshield (10).



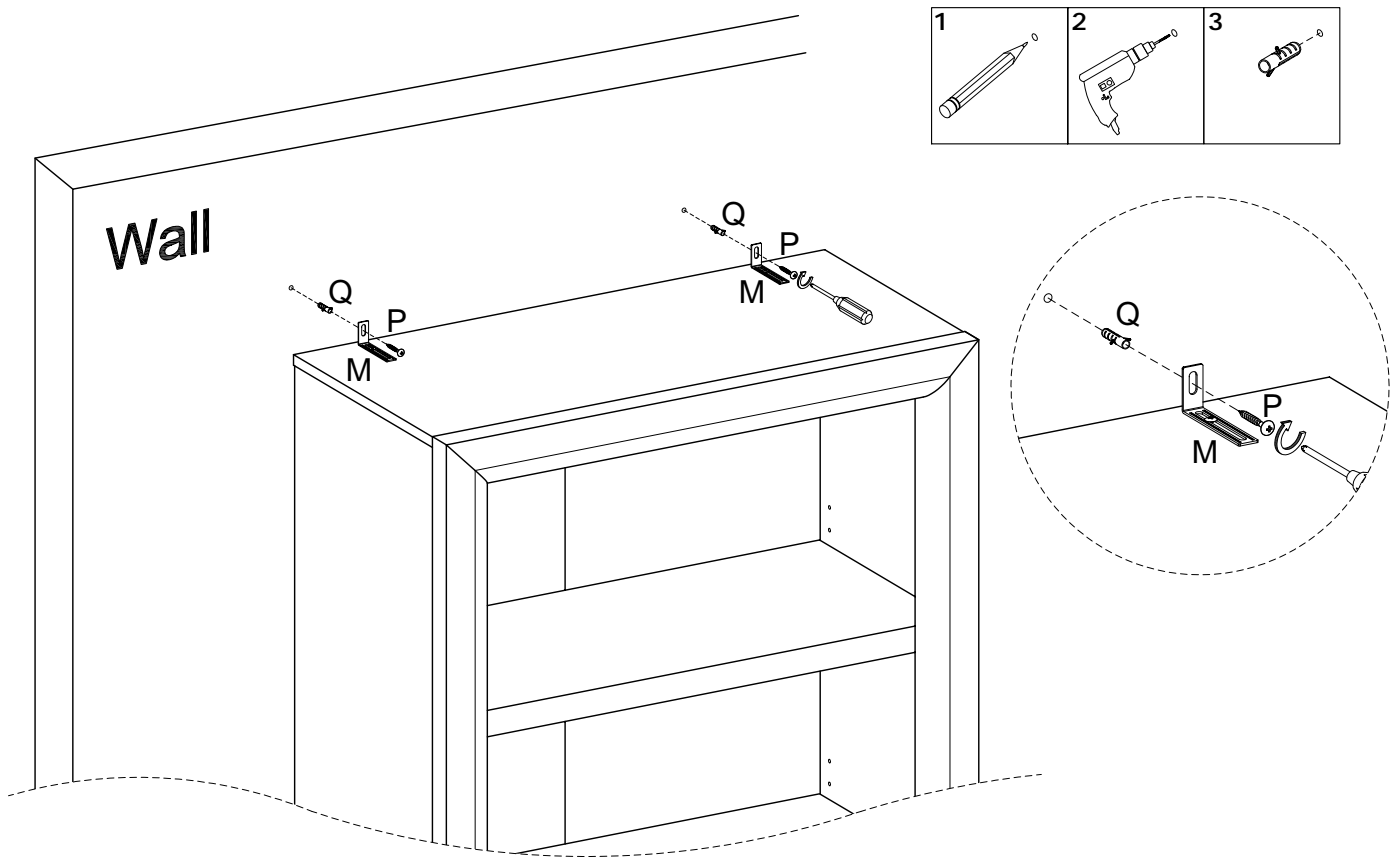
Step 23

Adjust the feet on the bottom of your unit to ensure it sits level.



Step 24

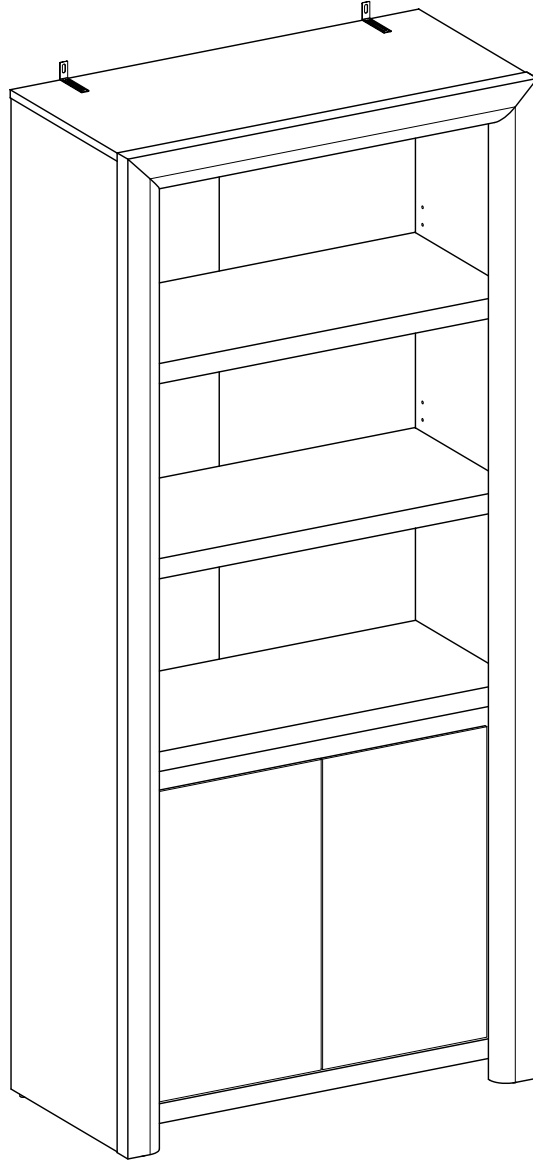
Secure your unit to the wall using the (P) screw, the Bracket (M), and the (Q) wall anchor.



Warning

Serious or fatal injuries can occur from furniture tipping over. To prevent the furniture from tipping over we recommend that it is permanently fixed to the wall. Wall anchor and hardware are included with this product. Please make sure hardware is suitable for your walls before installing, as different wall materials may require different types of anchors.
