1. Remove the nuts and spacers from the rear axle and place them for later use, and install them on the body as shown in the figure.






Required parts: rear wheel*2, gasket*2, nut*2, wheel cover*2.

2. Install the gasket, nut and wheel cover to the rear axle in the order shown in the figure.




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

1. Install the steering shaft to the body as shown in the diagram.




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

Required components: Front wheel axle assembly, nut*2,gasket*2.

1. Remove the two nuts and spacers from the front axle assembly.
2. The front axle assembly is mounted to the body as shown in the figure.
3. Secure the front axle assembly to the body with 2 nuts.





Required parts: Front wheel x2, gasket*2, nut*2, wheel cover*2.



1. Remove the nuts and washers from the front axle.
2. Install the front wheel, gasket, nut and buckle cover in the order shown in the figure.

Required components: steering wheel, spacers, nuts, dashboard cover.


1. Align the steering wheel with the steering shaft and install it onto the vehicle body.
2. Install the gasket, nut, and dashboard cover in the order shown in the diagram.

Required parts: bumper, screws*6.


1. Remove the 6 screws from the bumper mounting position.
2. Fix the bumper to the body with the 6 screws removed, as shown in the figure.





2. Install the flag onto the car body.




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

1. Remove the positive safety cap from the battery.




2. Connect the positive terminal.




Required components: Backrest.

Charging precautions




- Before the first use, it is necessary to ensure that the battery is charged for 18 hours; otherwise, it will cause permanent damage to the battery and it cannot be repaired.
- Toy cars must not be operated while the vehicle is charged.
- After 1 hour of use, it must be charged in a timely manner. The normal charging time is 6-10 hours, and each charging period should be not more than 20 hours.
- Do not charge near flammable materials.
- It is normal for the charger or battery to heat up (below 60 degrees) during charging.
- If there is standing water in the connector, it should not be charged; otherwise, it may cause a short circuit.
- The electric vehicle must utilise the charger and battery equipped with the vehicle to avoid damage to the charger and battery or electrical wiring.
- When the vehicle slows down, please ensure it is charged timely; otherwise, the battery life will be reduced.
- When an electric vehicle is not used for a long time, it must be charged at least once a month.



Remote control operating instructions



Usage Instructions:

The first use requires pairing, and this remote control has a built-in memory, so there is no need to pair again after replacing the battery.

- ①:Code pairing: press the pairing button for a long time,3seconds until the indicator light flashes, then turn on the stroller power, and the indicator light will remain on, indicating successful pairing.
- ②:Speed control: Press the S speed control key to adjust the gear, with a total of 3 indicator lights showing 3 gears.
- ③:Control: Use the forward, backward, left turn, and right turn buttons to operate the stroller.
- ④:The brake: When the P brake button indicator light flashes, the self-driving function is disabled. Press the P brake button again to exit brake mode.
- ⑤:Standby: The remote control will automatically enter standby mode after 10 seconds of inactivity, the indicator light will turn off, and pressing any key will wake it up.

Safety Precautions

1. During charging, it must be operated by an adult; do not allow children to charge by themselves.
2. The vehicle must be operated under the supervision and guidance of an adult.
3. This product must be assembled by adults or checked for correct assembly by adults before use.
4. It is strictly prohibited to drive or play in dangerous areas such as public streets, roads, slopes, and swimming pools.
5. The vehicle cannot exceed the maximum load capacity of 30 kilograms.
6. This product is only suitable for children over 37 months of age, not for children under 3 years of age.
7. Please be aware that some parts may be damaged due to improper use.
8. It is strictly forbidden to suddenly change the forward, backward, and switch functions while driving, and the switch function should be changed at standstill.
9. When the car is dirty, it can only be scrubbed with a clean cloth, not washed with water, so as not to damage the components.
10. The charger is not a toy; please place properly it after charging.
11. The product is a plastic item, kept away from the fire.
12. The motor will generate sparks when starting during the use of the product, so it is strictly forbidden to use it in areas such as flammable and explosive areas such as petrol stations.
13. Please pay special attention to ensuring that children do not touch the wheels or come near the wheels to avoid pinching or crushing injuries. When using the vehicle, please do not allow other children to approach.
14. The car is suitable for driving on flat ground, so please endeavour to avoid driving on mud, sand, or uneven surfaces.

Safety Precautions

15. Please do not allow children to play with the dismantled packaging to avoid any accidental danger to them.
16. Before the product is used by children, their parents are responsible for understanding the content of this instruction and guiding the child to operate and use it correctly.
17. The safety belt attached to the car are merely toys for children to enhance their safety awareness, and do not serve the same safety function as those in adults' vehicles.
18. Please instruct children on how to relax the accelerator pedal and brake, how to deal with obstacles, and how to stop the car.
19. Insert the battery correctly, paying attention to the positive and negative terminals.
20. The battery should not be heated and thrown into the fire to avoid a short circuit.
21. Non-accumulators cannot be recharged, and accumulators can only be charged under adult supervision.
22. When the battery is insufficient, the remote control distance will decrease; please replace the battery with a new one.
23. If it is not used for a long time, please remove the battery to avoid leakage and corrosion, and the battery should be removed from the device when it is out of power.
24. The power terminals must not be short-circuited.
25. This toy car may have small parts that can come off during use, therefore it is not suitable for children aged 36 months and below.
