- 4. Please unbox the item from the side with an open-label and put a carpet on the foor to avoid scratching it.



















Pop-up Waste Installation

STEP 2 Connect the drain pipe.








# Installation of drain assembly

Turn the screw at the bottom of the guide rail counterclockwise!





### Always fully close the faucet after use!

Failure may cause:

#### Water Overflow

Continuous flow with blocked drain floods cabinetry, floors, and ceilings below, causing property damage and liability for compensation.

#### Personal Injury

Water accumulation significantly increases slip/fall risks (especially for children/elderly).

#### **Cabinetry Damage**

Water infiltration leads to swelling, warping, hardware corrosion, and countertop cracks.


#### **Hidden Hazards**

#### We strongly recommend that you:


- Confirm faucet is fully closed after each use;


### **PIVOT-PRO** side adjustment

Side adjustment of the door is made by using the indicated screw.



### **PIVOT-PRO Depth Adjustment**

Depth adjustment is made without loosening any screw. The door can be moved in or outby rotating the cam adjuster on the hinge arm.



## **PIVOT-PRO Height Adjustment**

By loosening the two fixing screws to allow the mounting plate to slide up or down ,the door can be adjusted vertically by ±2mm. After retightening the screws, the Depth adjustment is done.
