
Care & Maintenance




Assembly Steps

OVERVIEW




This Bed have multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.


Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.




Attach side lever 8 to the headboard 1 by using bolts (B) with allen wrench (E), make sure the bolts are tighten.




Attach side lever \otimes to Base Headboard \oplus by using bolts B with allen wrench E.




Open the unwoven fabric, attach two Headboards by using 3 bolts B with allen wrench E.




Attach Legs D to Base Headboard 4.




Attach Legs D to Base Headboard 4 by using bolts A with allen wrench E. Do not fully tighten the bolts.




Attach Legs D to Footboard 2.




Attach Legs D to Footboard 2 by using bolts A with allen wrench E. Do not fully tighten the bolts.




Attach the hinge on the side rails support bar 3 to Base Headboard 4 and Footboard, by using bolts with allen wrench E. Make sure bolts A are fully tighten and secure.




Attach middle crossbar 7 to Base Headboard 4 and Foot board 2 by using bolts A with allen wrench E. Make sure bolts are tighten.




Attach the middle support leg 6 to crossbar 7 by using bolts B with allen wrench E.



Lay slats (5) on the bedframe



Secure all Flat noodles (5) to the rails on the side panel (3) using screws (C) and a screwdriver F.



Place the Bed on a LEVEL SURFACE.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Don't push too hard, shake on the bed.

This would help to align all the parts at all the joint areas.

CAUTION 1: When tightenIng these screws, tighten sequentIally.

DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

This would cause the frame to warp.

If there is still wobbles, loosen the screws and execute this same process.DO NOT

tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

WARNING!! IF BED IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Ensure all screws are fully locked into position.
