


Step 1: Open the pull rod and carefully remove it from the fastening and place the pull rod horizontally.



Step 2: Carefully push the cart together by lifting the loop as shown in the picture. Be careful, there may be a risk of your fingers getting trapped if you pull them together too quickly!



Foldable transport trolley - instructions for use



Warnings:

DANGER! Please read the operating instructions and the safety instructions carefully before assembling and using the handcart.
A guarantee cannot be made if damage occurs due to failure to correctly assemble or improper use of the handcart. Assembly may only be carried out by an adult! The handcart does not have a brake, so it may only be set up on level surfaces and fix the tires with obstacles.
The hand truck should not be parked near stairs, slopes, sloping terrain or swimming pools.
DANGER! The handcart may not be used as a trailer for vehicles of any kind. Pull the handcart slowly through curves. Place items in the center of the cart.
The height of the payload must not exceed a maximum of 2/3 of the total height of the body.
The pushing and pulling speed must not exceed 5 km/h
If items are transported with the handcart, they should always be secured against falling out with lashing straps or similar fasteners.

DANGER! Loads attached to the drawbar affect the stability of the handcart.
DANGER! The handcart is not suitable for jogging or skating.
DANGER! Do not sit on the side wall as there is a risk of tipping over.
DANGER! Children may only use the handcart under the guidance and supervision of adults.
DANGER! Dangerous situations can occur during initial use or when handled by people who have no experience with the handcart. In such cases, get help.
DANGER! Only use the handcart on level ground without slopes and do not park it on slopes.
Dangerous situations can arise in the event of violation or disregard.
DANGER! The maximum static weight of 80 kg and the maximum dynamic weight of 40 kg must not be exceeded: overloading can result in dangerous situations.
DANGER! No people may be transported with the handcart. Dangerous situations can arise in the event of violation or disregard.

The ambient temperature for using the handcart should be between -25°C and +50°C. Dangerous situations can occur at other ambient temperatures.

The operating life of this handcart is 3 years. Dangerous situations can occur if the handcart is used beyond its operating period.

Only operate the handcart using these instructions for use. Dangerous situations can arise in the event of violation or disregard.

Service this hand truck only using these instructions for use. Dangerous situations can arise in the event of violation or disregard.

Please always keep these instructions for use close at hand and in a safe place for documentation purposes. Always include it when passing on the handcart.

Continue reading these instructions for use and assembly instructions after you have internalized the points mentioned above!

Disposal:

Please observe local official regulations when disposing of waste. Also dispose of the packaging in the designated collection containers. You can obtain further information from your local disposal point. For environmental protection: Dispose of the used handcart in accordance with your local waste disposal regulations.

Structure of the handcart:

Step 1: Carefully pull the trolley apart, there is a risk of your fingers getting trapped!



Step 2: Place the pull rod vertically and attach it to the frame in the device.



Top picture - slide to the right - open // slide to the left - close

Step 3:

Pull out the vertical roof bars on all 4 sides. Then pull up the fabric top and attach it to the front and rear frame of the handcart using the loops. Close the loop with the Velcro fastener.



Folding the handcart:

Step 1: Remove the roof and push the poles back into the frame of the handcart.
