Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



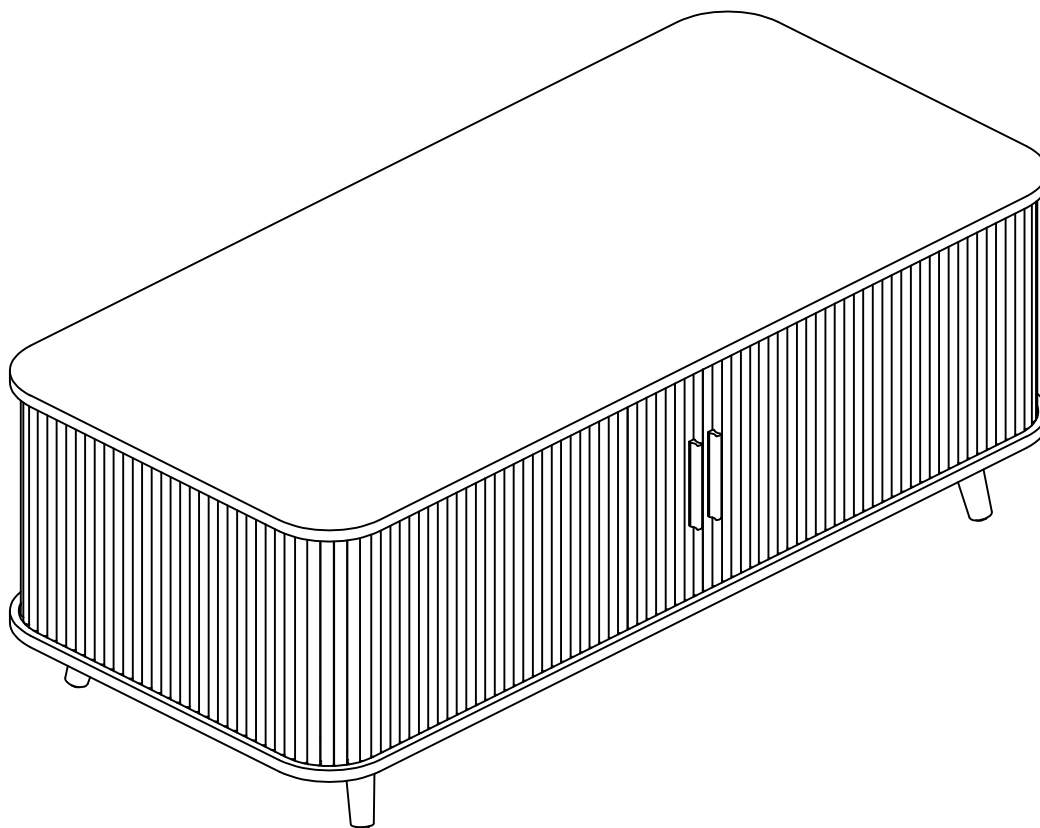
- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.



Please look in carton for hardware packs and legs.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



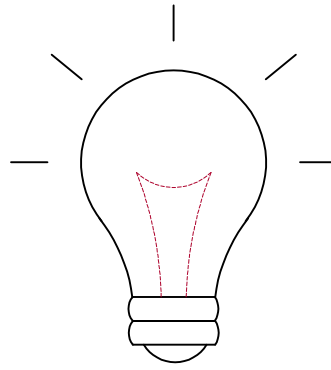

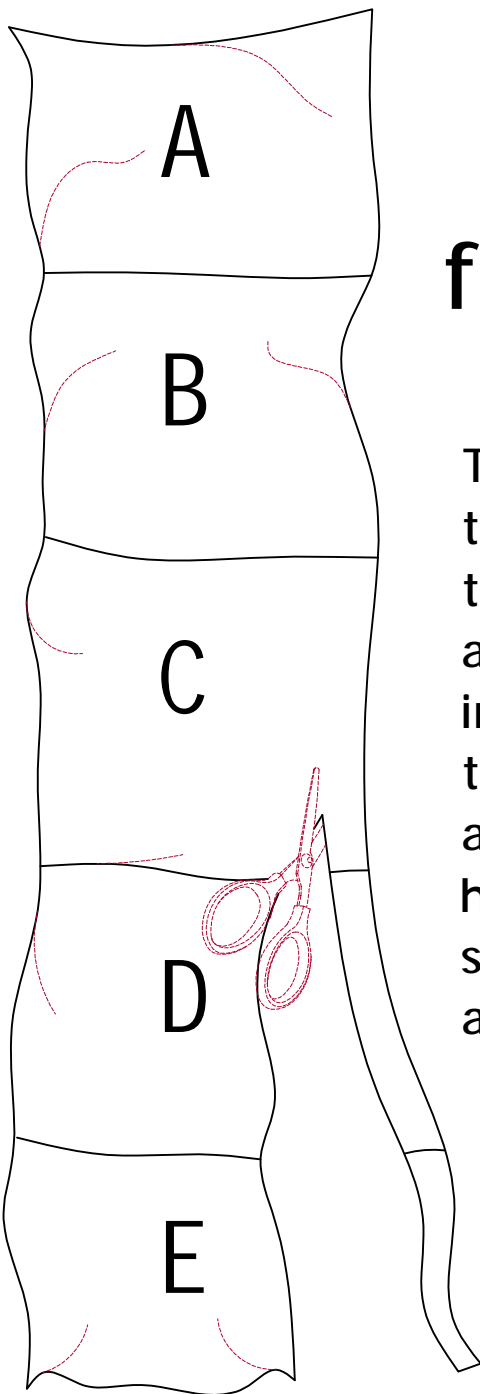
Assembly Steps

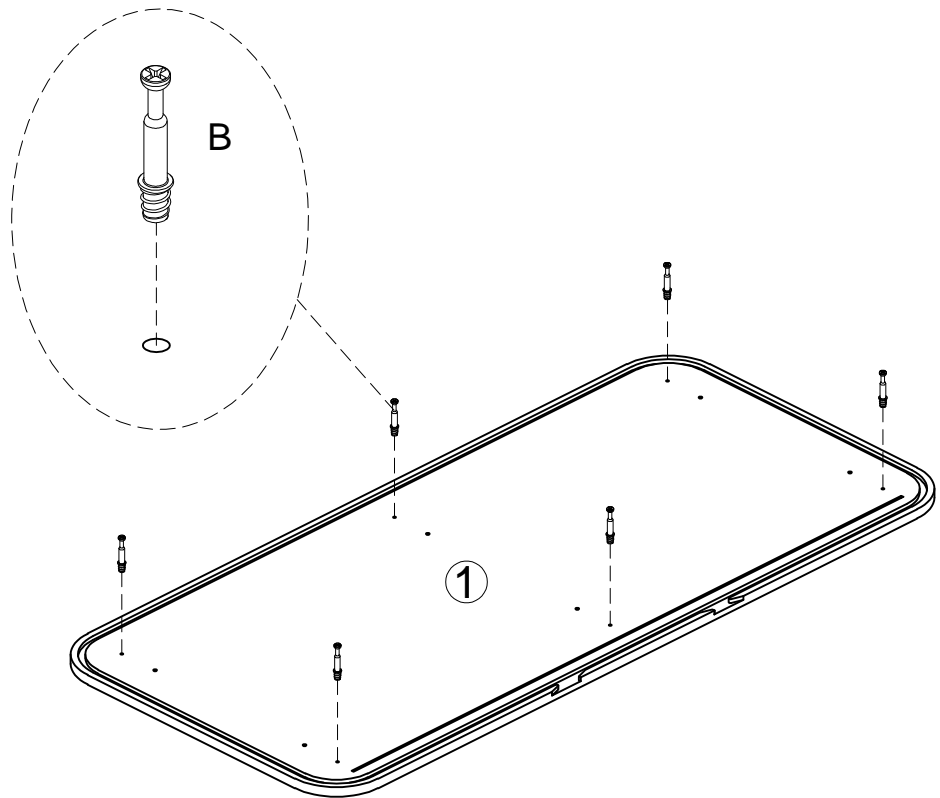

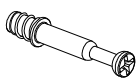
To avoid errors and confusion during the installation of accessories, use the type and quantity of hardware accessories according to the installation procedure described in the instructions. First, unroll the accessories bag and lay out the hardware accessories, cut holes in the side, and take out the hardware accessories

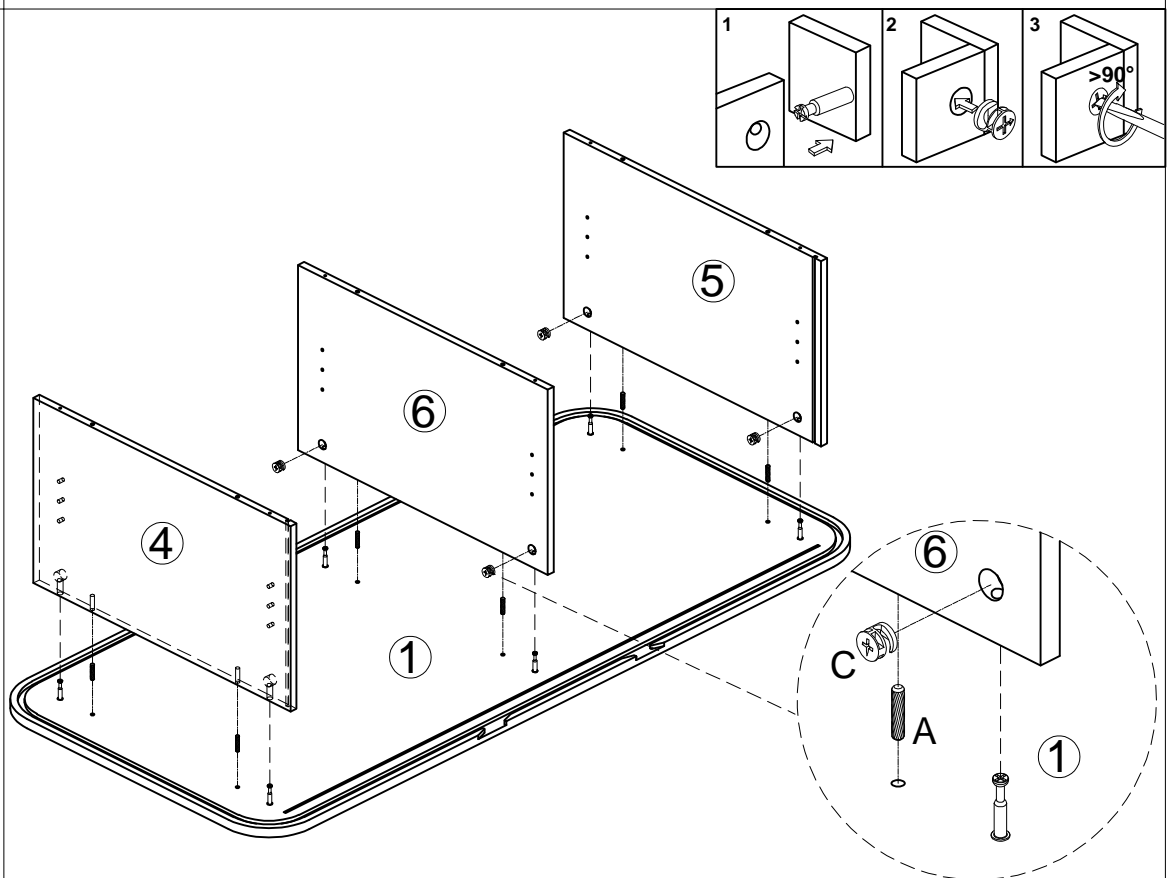

Attach the Cam Bolt (B) to Panel(1).

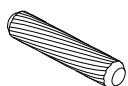

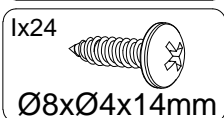
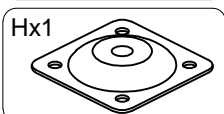
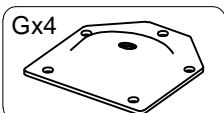
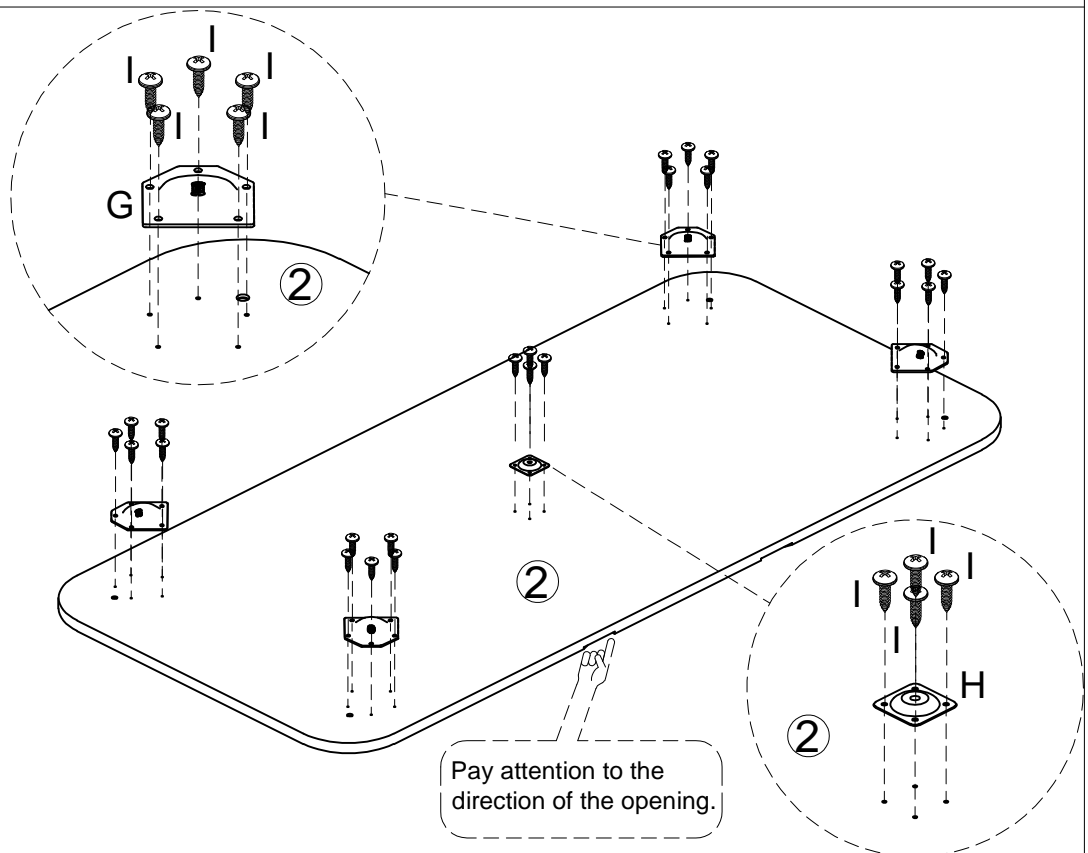
Attach Left Side Panel(4)and Right Side Panel(5)and Middle Partition Board(6) to Panel(1)with Dowel (A) as shown. Install and turn Cam Nut (C) to secure position as shown.

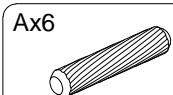
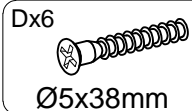
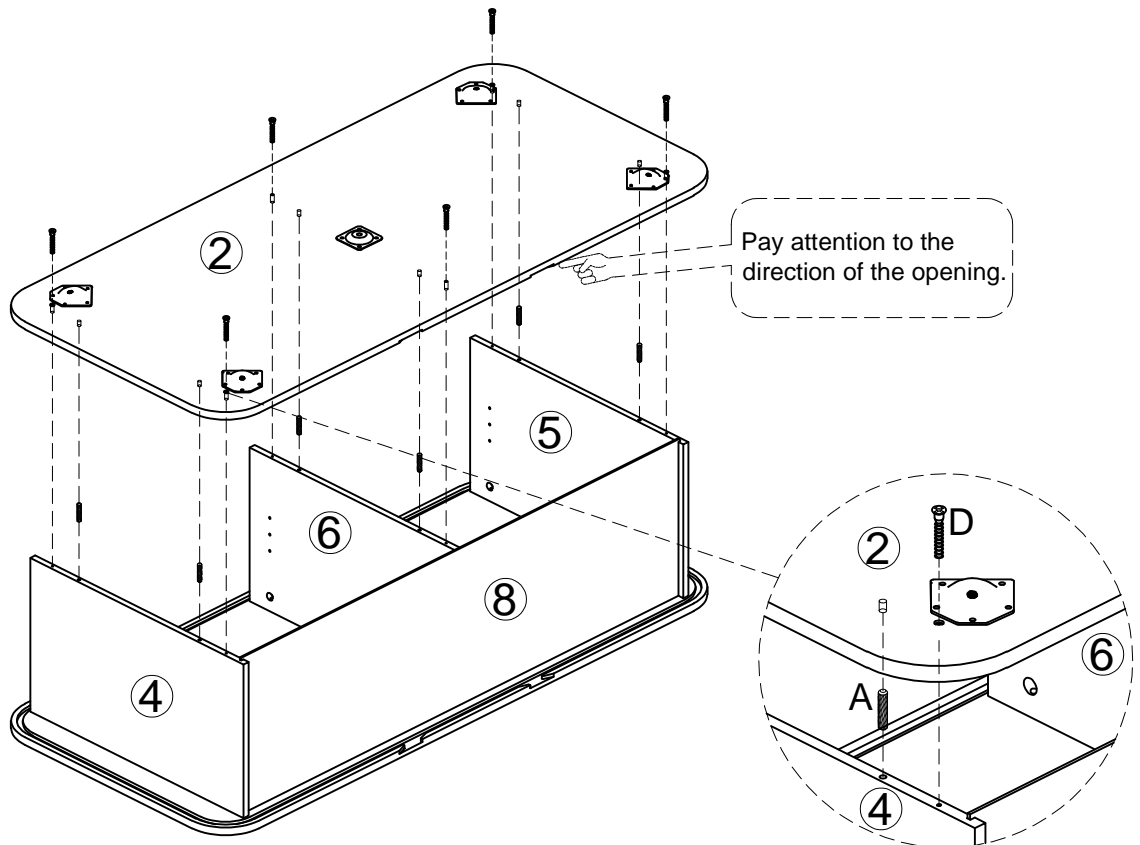
Attach Back Panel(⑧) to the grooves of Panel(①), Left Side Panel(④) and Right Side Panel(⑤)

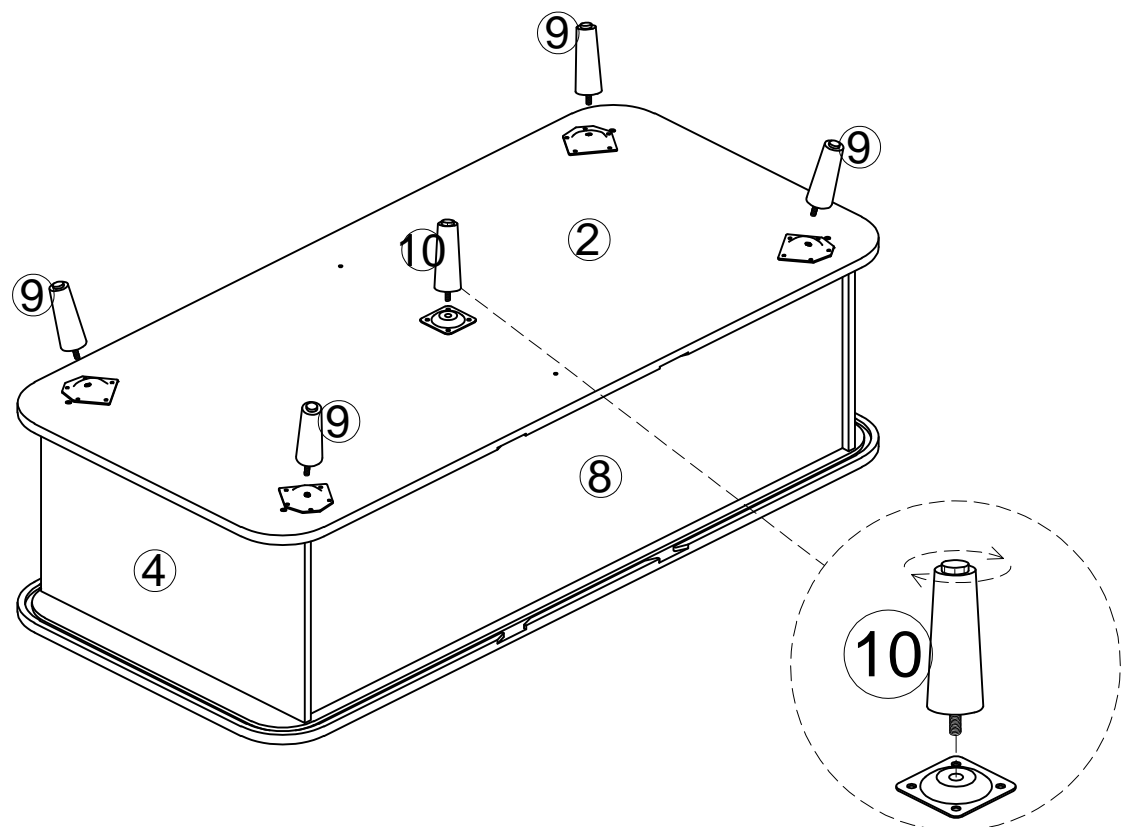
Secure Connecting Iron Sheet-Slanted (G) and Connecting Iron Sheet-Flat (H) by locking the Screws (I) into the small holes on the Base Plate (②).

STEP 5



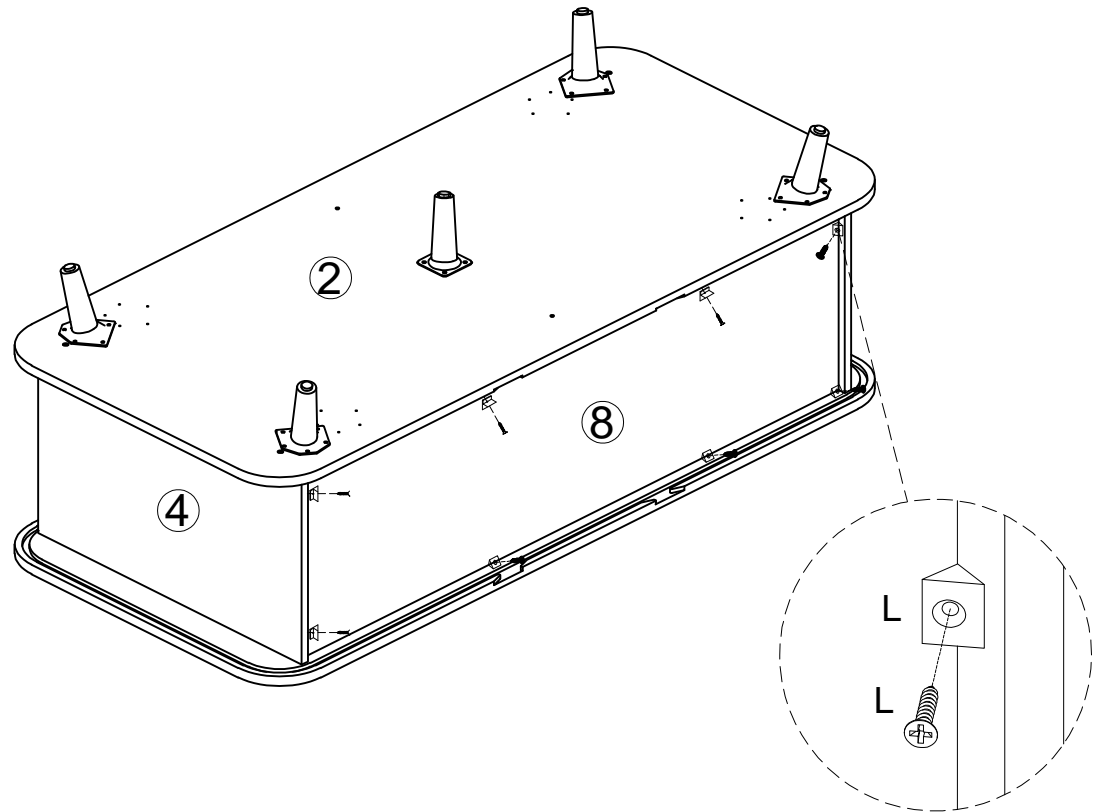
Fix the components installed in step 4 to Left Side Panel (4) and Right Side Panel (5) and Middle Partition Board (6) with Screw (D) and Dowel (A).

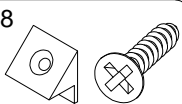


Connect Side foot (9) and Middle Foot (10) to the connecting iron plate.

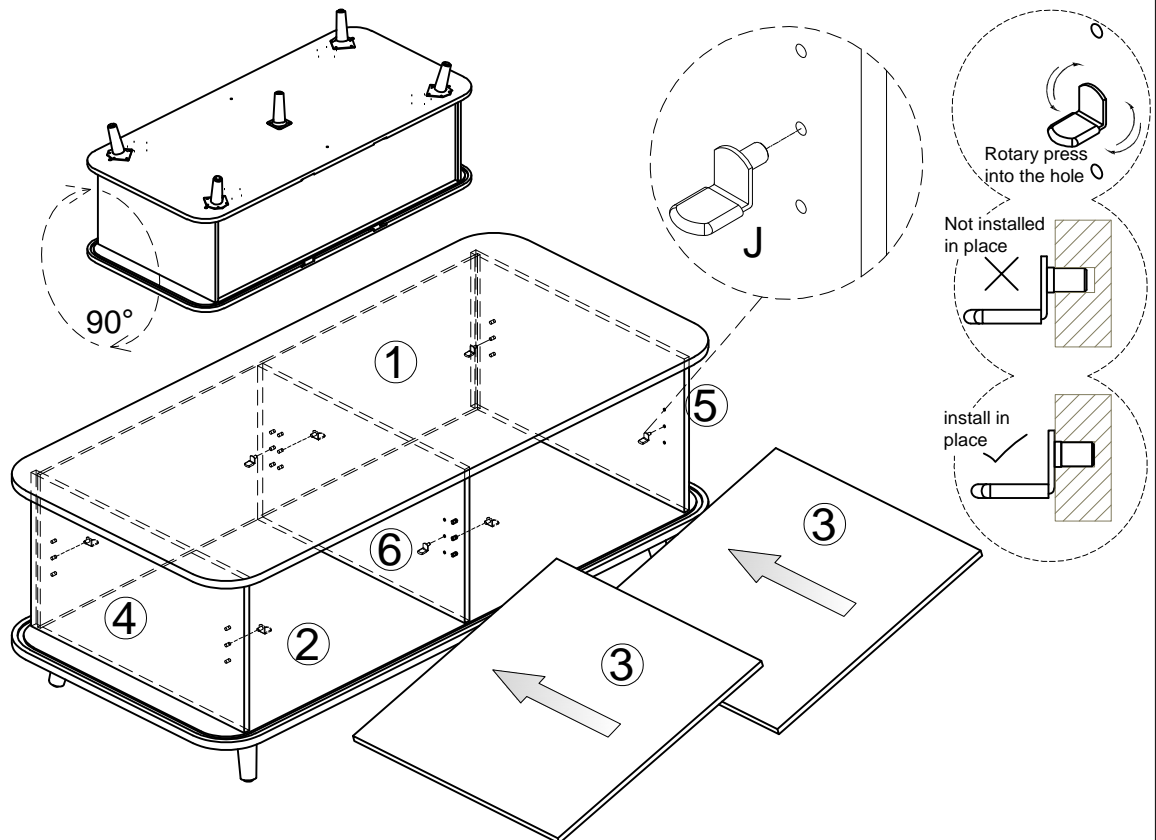

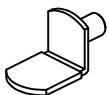


Install Backplate Buckle (L) onto the Back Panel (8), and fix it using Screws (L) to make the product more stable.

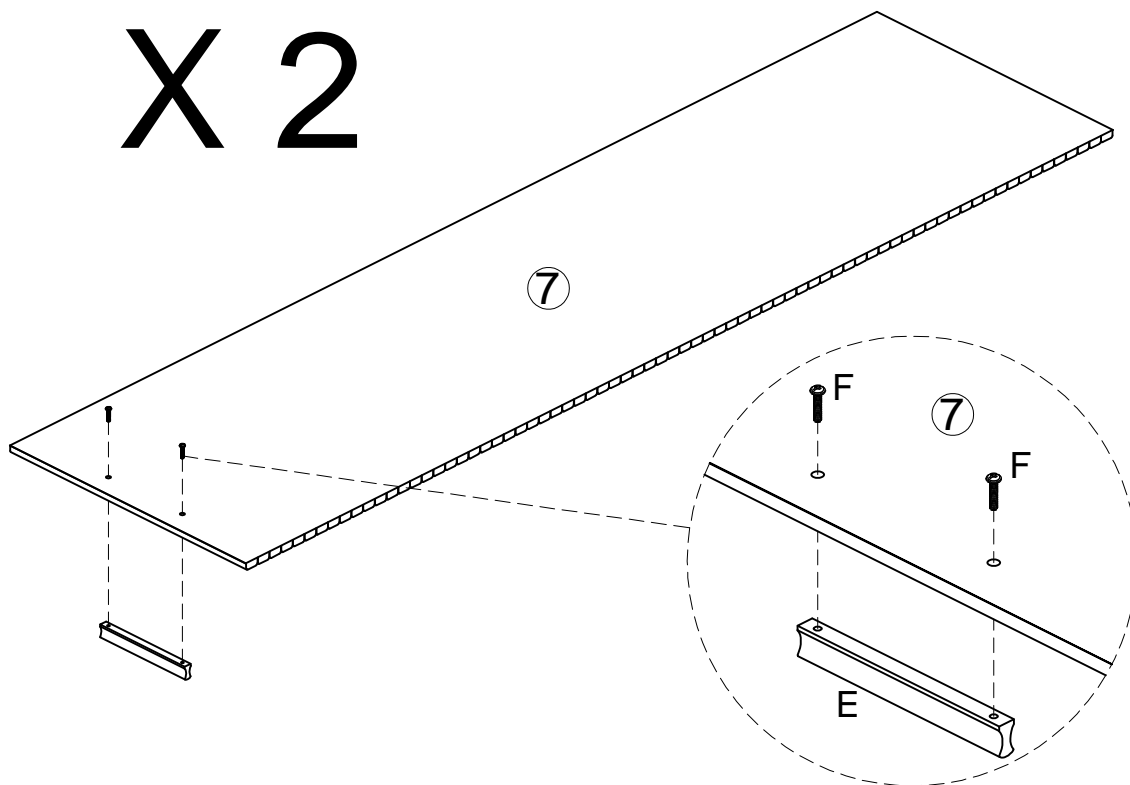

Insert Shelf Support(J) completely into the hole of Left Side Panel (4)& Right Side Panel (5)&Middle Partition Board (6), and place Moveable Panel (3) diagonally inside.

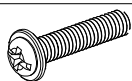

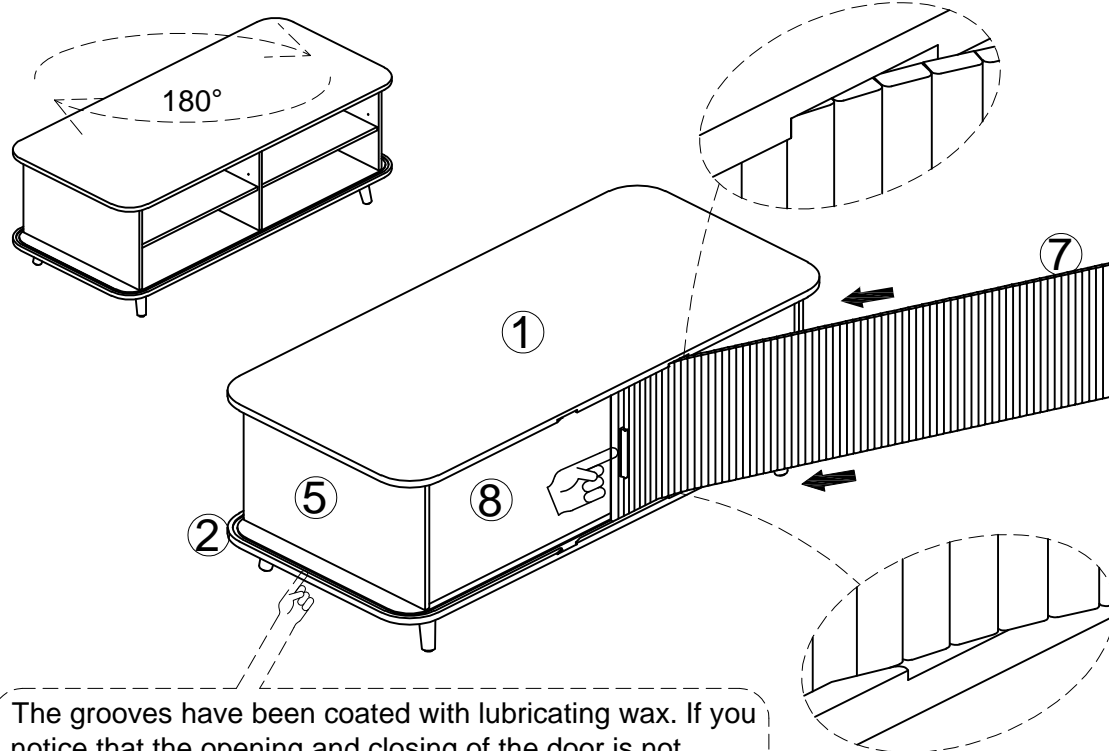

Install Pull Handle (E) to each door with Screws (F) as shown. Repeat the above actions twice

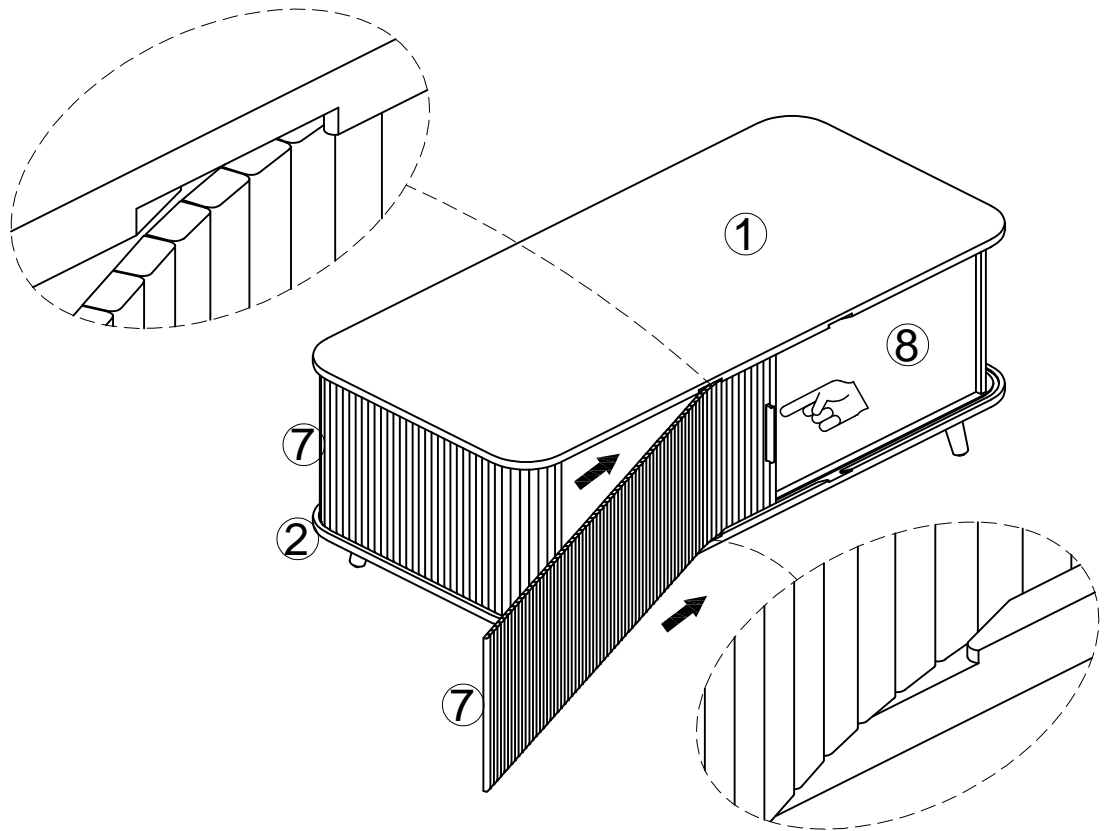
STEP 10



The grooves have been coated with lubricating wax. If you notice that the opening and closing of the door is not smooth enough, it is recommended that you apply a small amount of soap to improve its performance.

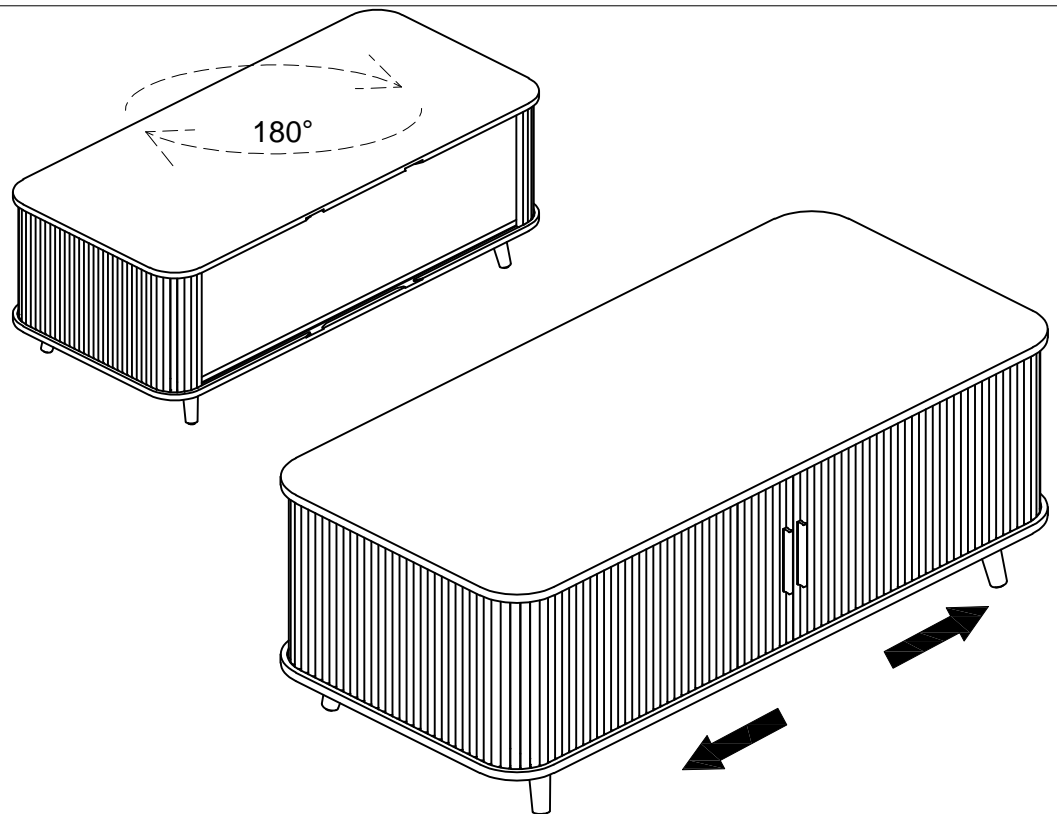
Push Door Panel(7) into the slot between Panel(1) and Base Plate (2). Be sure to pull the front end of the Door Panel to enter and support the other end with your hands. Pay attention to the direction of the door handle.

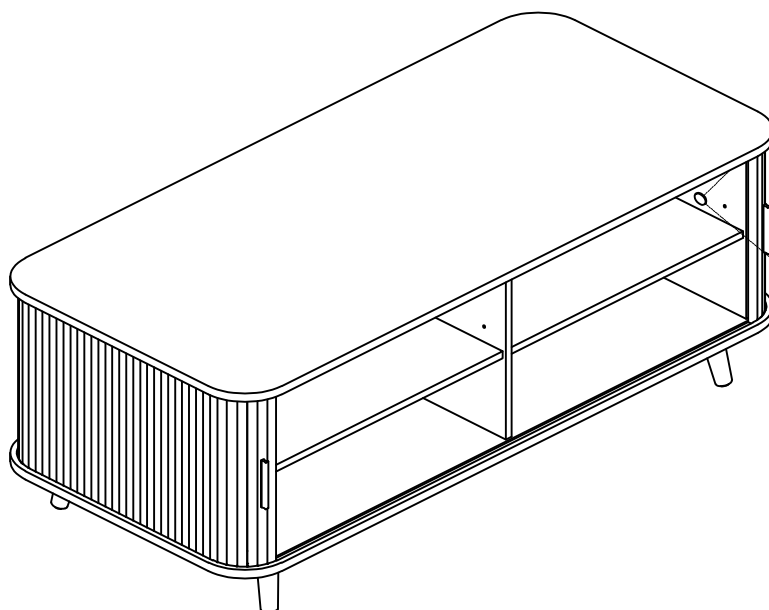

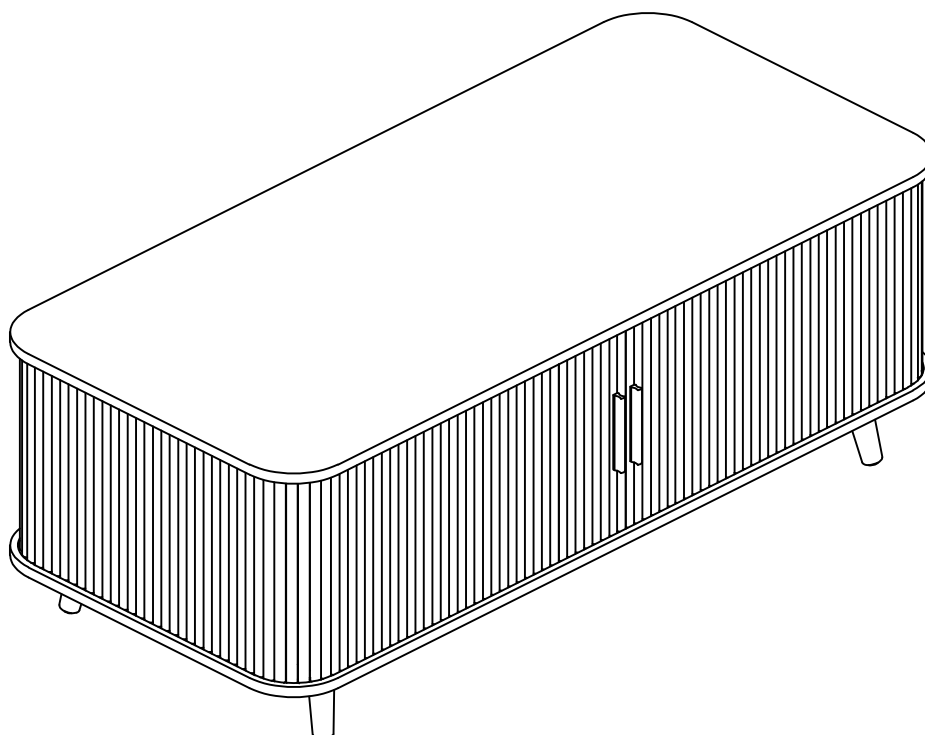

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
