## Care & Maintenance

- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.

- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.

- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.





## Assembly Steps




## friendly reminder


To avoid errors and confusion during the installation of accessories, use the type and quantity of hardware accessories according to the installation procedure described in the instructions. First, unroll the accessories bag and lay out the hardware accessories, cut holes in the side, and take out the hardware accessories






Attach the Cam Bolt (B) to Left Partition Board (7) and Right Partition Board (8)





Install Slide Rail (L-"CL") onto the hole of Right Partition Board (8), install Slide Rail (L-"CR") onto the hole of Left Partition Board (7), and fix them with Screw (M). The installation method is as shown in the figure. Please pay attention to the installation direction of the guide rails.



Fix the components installed in step 3 to Panel(①) with Dowel (A ) as shown. Install and turn Cam Nut (C ) to secure position.






Fix Side foot ( ⑩⑥ ) and Middle Foot ( ⑩⑦ ) to the connecting iron plate.







Install Pull Handle (E) to each Door Panel( 9 ) with screws (G) as shown. Repeat the above actions twice.


## STEP 13



The grooves have been coated with lubricating wax. If you notice that the opening and closing of the door is not smooth enough, it is recommended that you apply a small amount of soap to improve its performance.



Push Door Panel (9) into the slot between Panel (1) and Base Plate (2). Be sure to pull the front end of the Door Panel to enter and support the other end with your hands. Pay attention to the direction of the door handle.








Attach Drawer Bottom Plate( 14 ) to the assembled unit from Step 15.




Cover the visible hole with a Pad (N).



## Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
