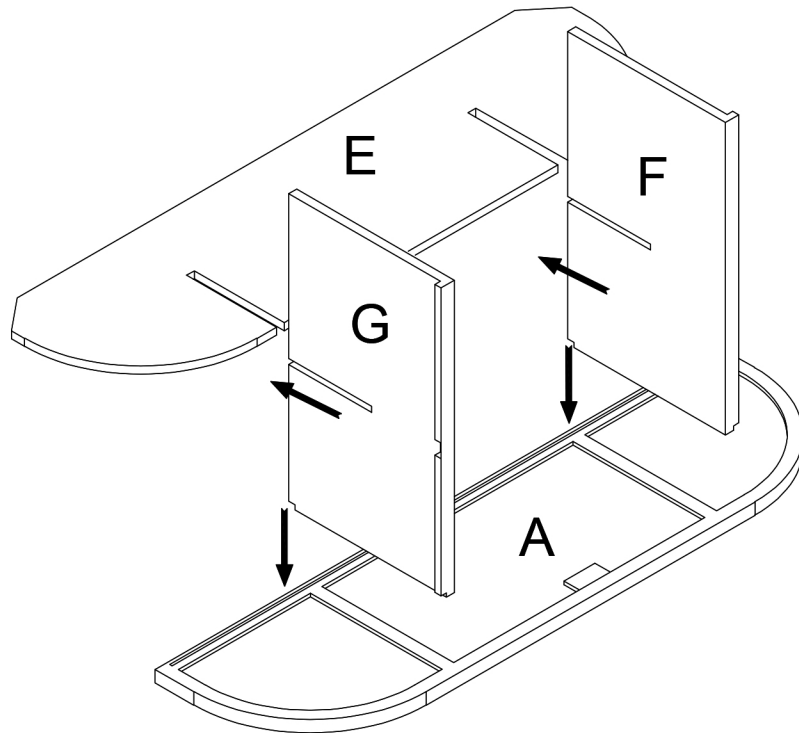
## Assembly Steps

### Overview



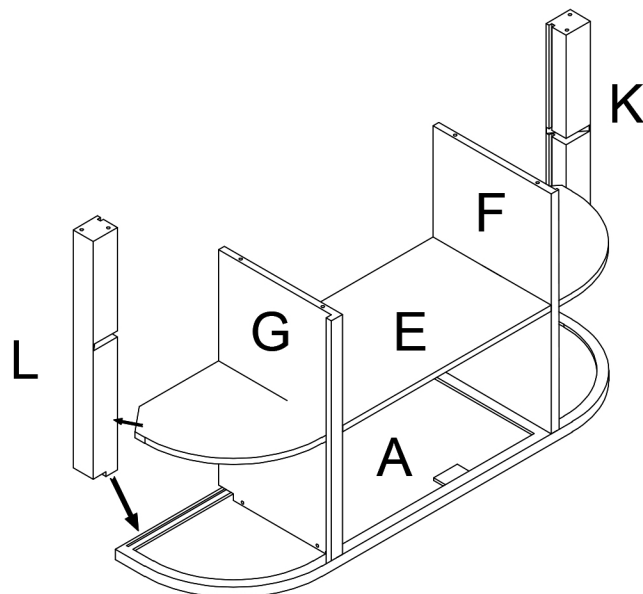
This sideboard has multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the sideboard parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

## Step1



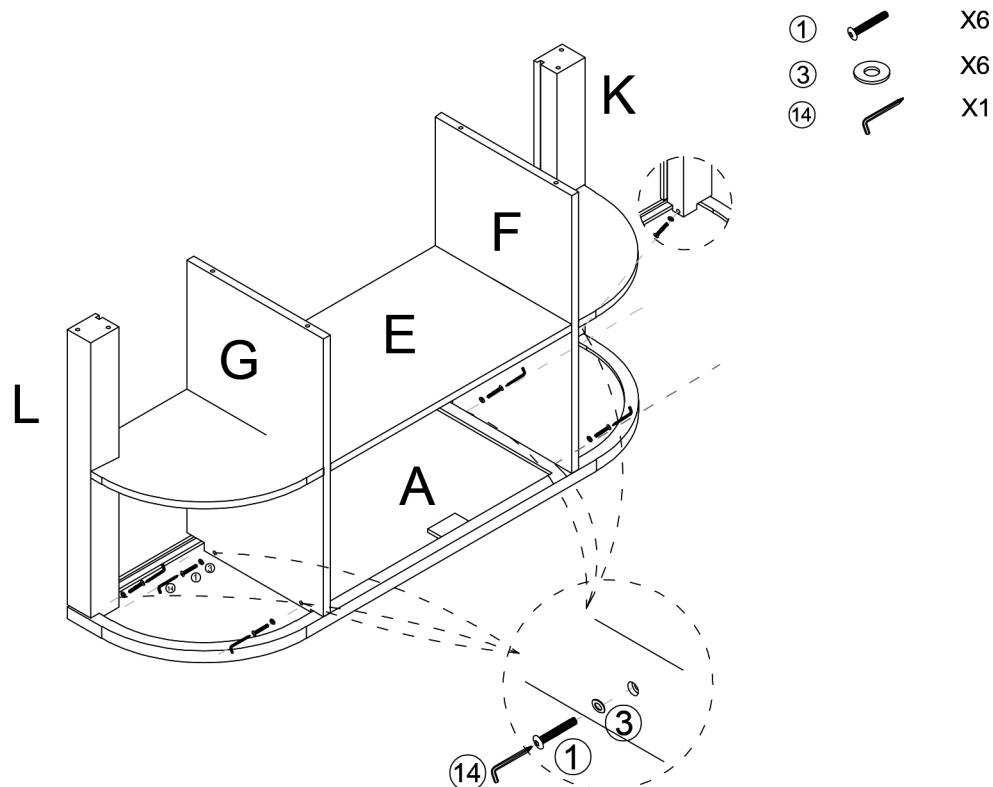
Insert left middle clapboard (F) and right middle clapboard (G) to shelf (E), and then put left middle clapboard (F) and right middle clapboard (G) with shelf (E) on top board(A).

## Step2



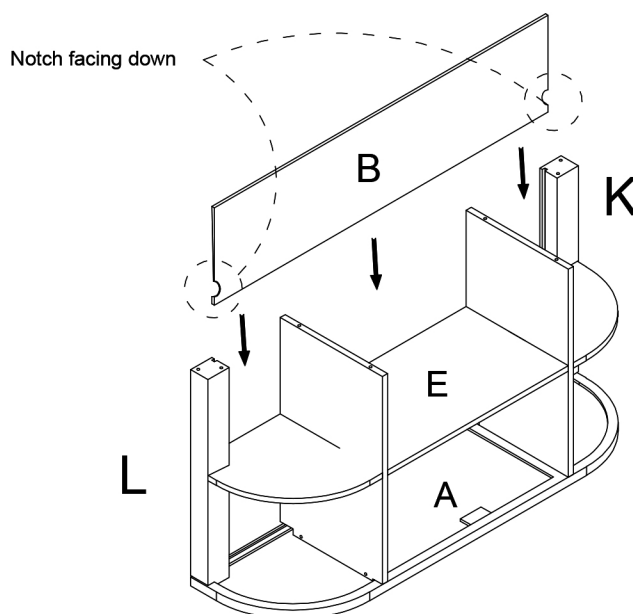
Put left side column(K) and right side column(L) on top board(A),and insert to shelf (E).

## Step3



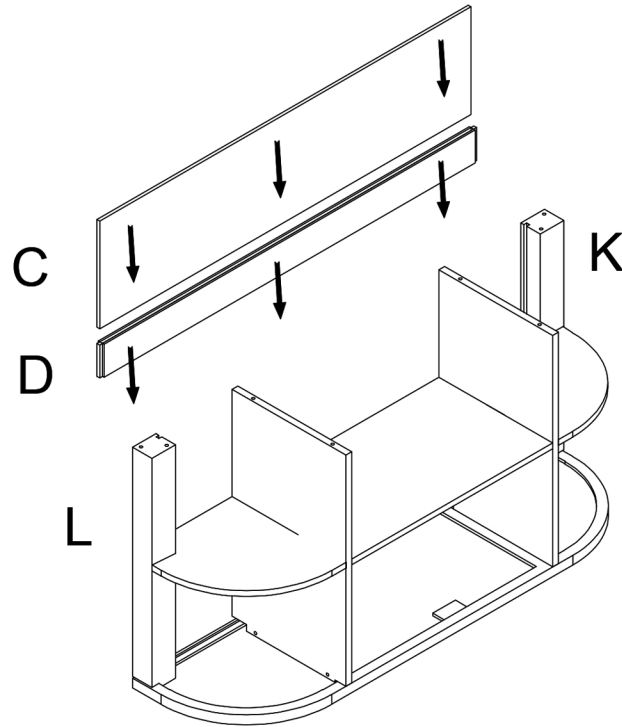
Attach left side column(K)、right side column(L) and left middle clapboard (F)、right middle clapboard (G) to top board(A) with bolt (①) and washer(③).

## Step4



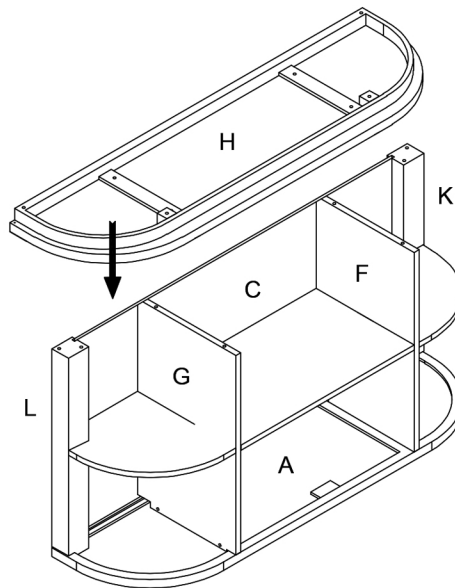
Insert upper back board(B) to left side column(K)、right side column(L) and top board(A).

## Step5



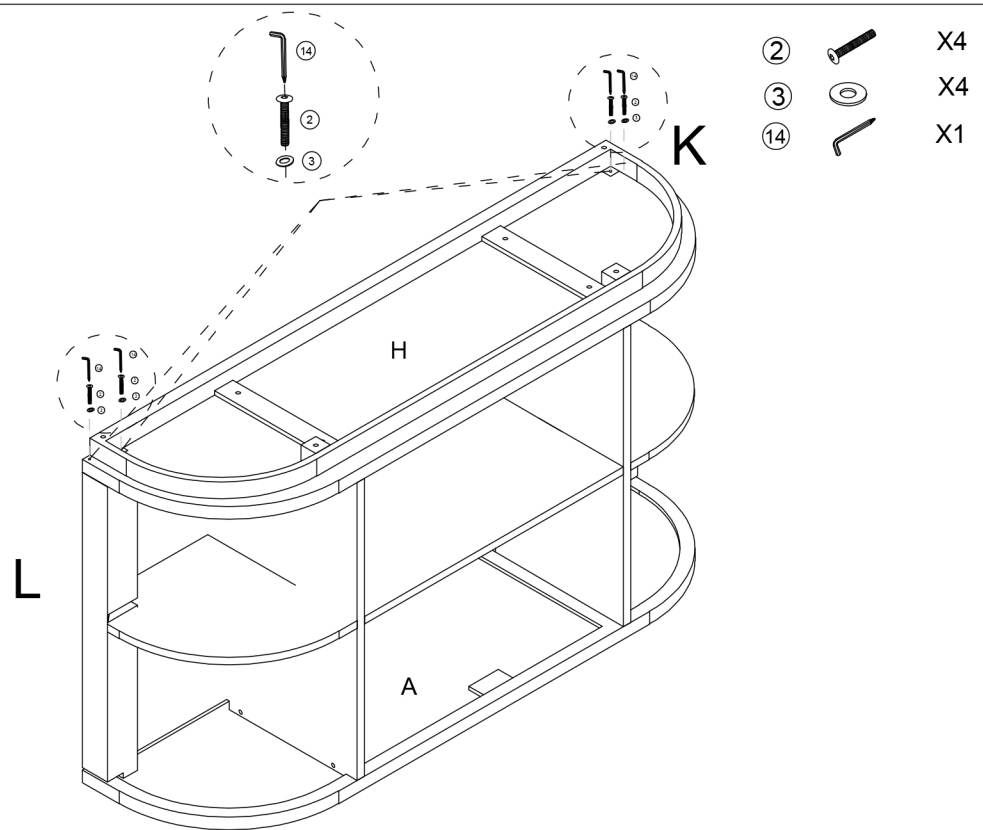
Insert slot (D) and lower back board(C) to left side column(K)、right side column(L)

## Step6



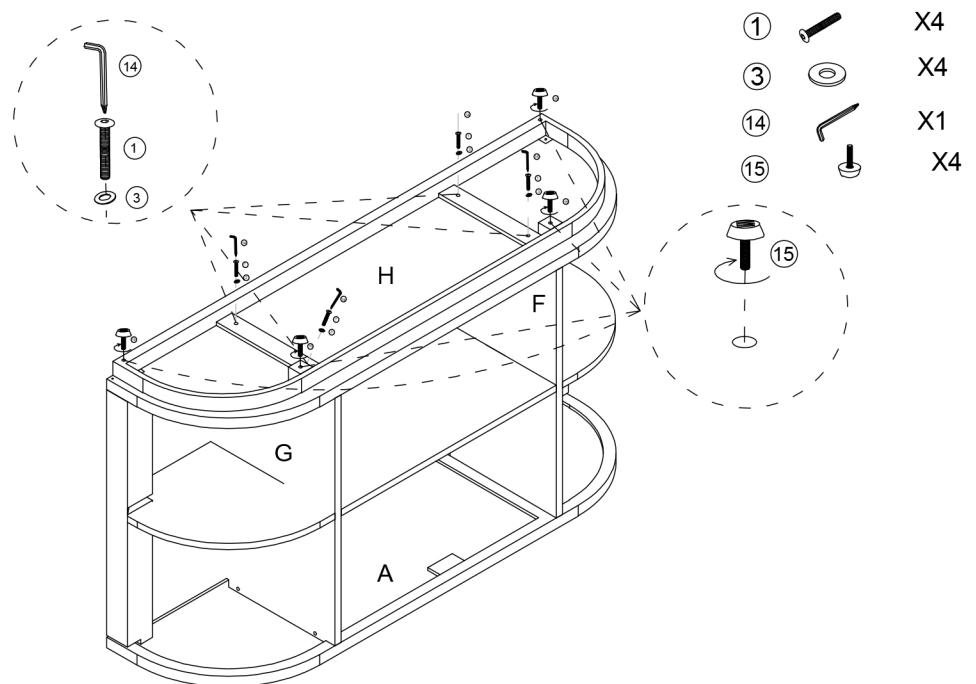
Align the bottom board(H) with lower back board (C)、left side column(K)、right side column(L) and left middle clapboard (F)、right middle clapboard (G).

## Step7



Attach the bottom board(H) to left side column(K)、right side column(L) with bolt (②) and washer(③).

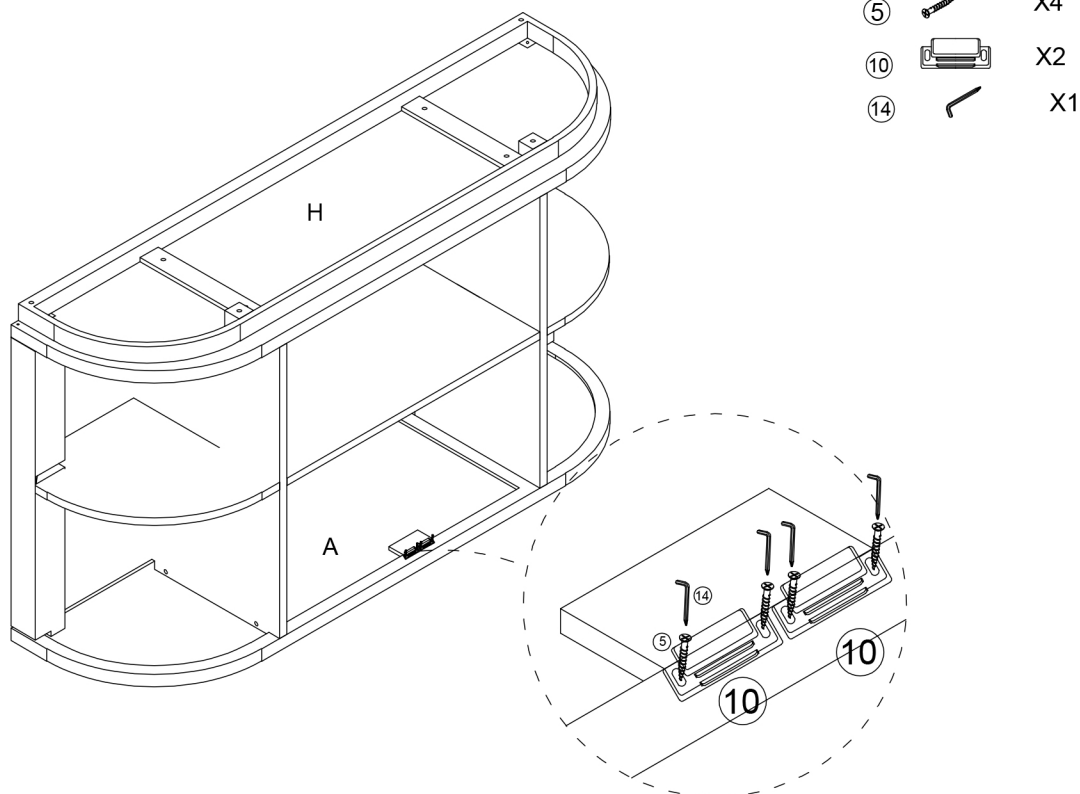
## Step8



Attach the bottom board(H) to left middle clapboard (F)、right middle clapboard (G) with bolt (①) and washer(③).Screw adjustable leveling glide (⑮) to bottom board (H).

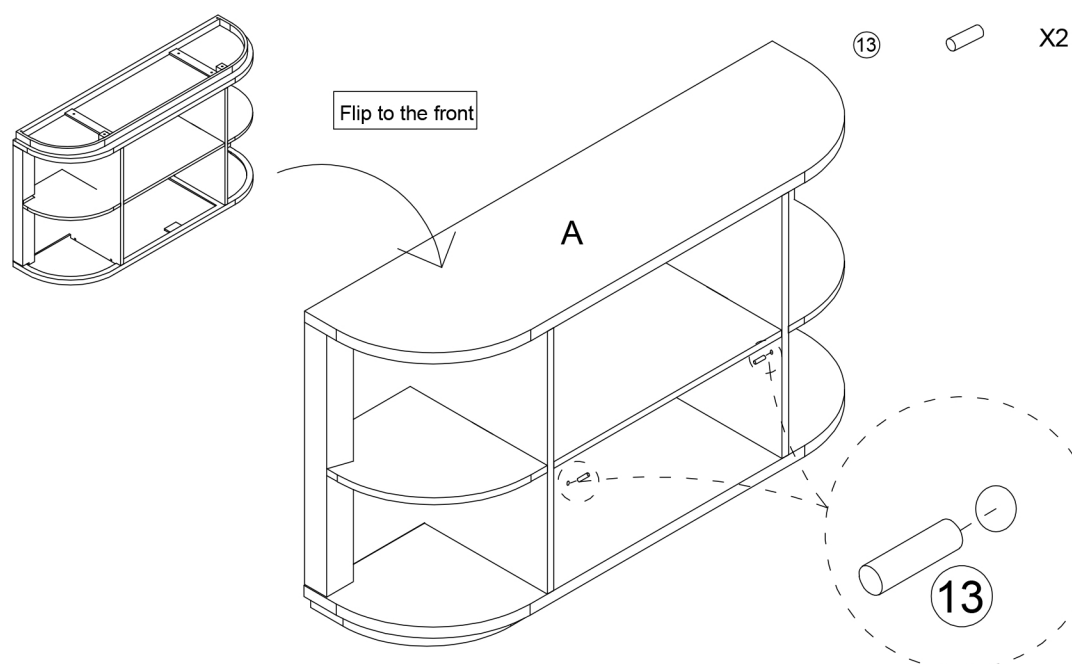


## Step9



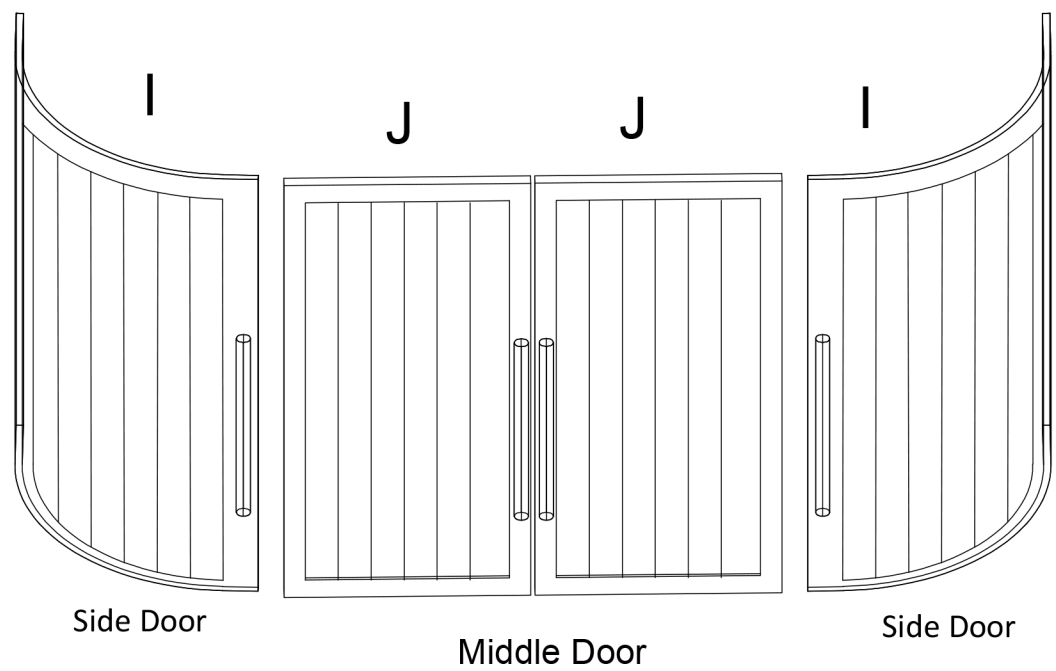
Attach magnetic door catch(⑩) to top board(A) with screw (⑤).

## Step10



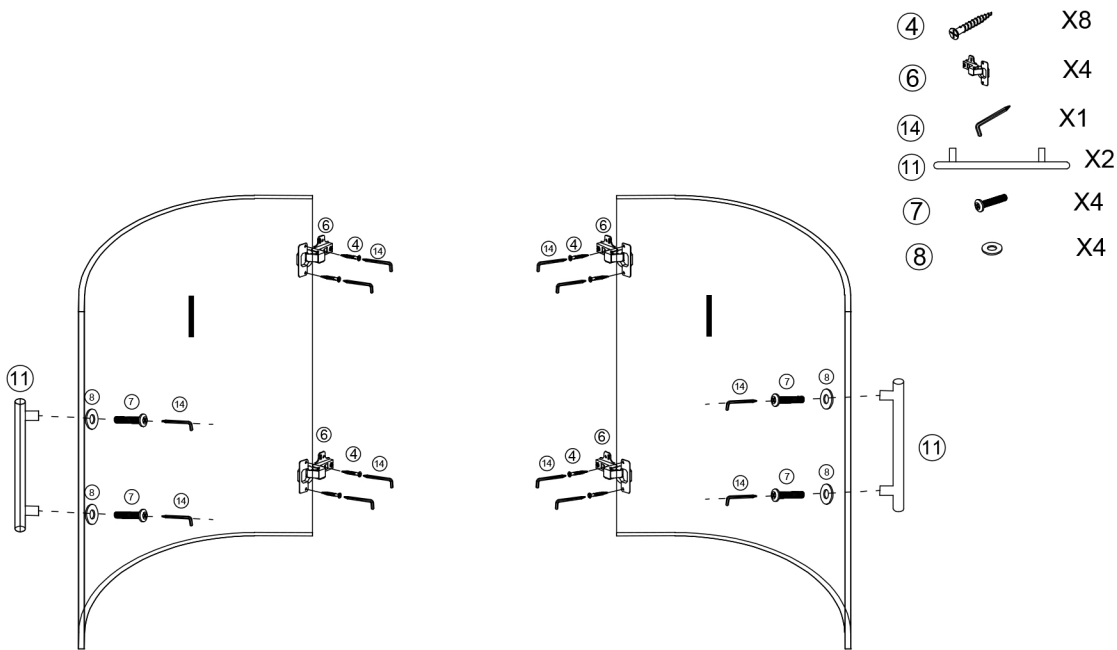
Stand the mounted sideboard up, and insert shelf support pin(⑬) into the reserved holes of left middle clapboard (F) and right middle clapboard (G).

Install the doors in sequence.

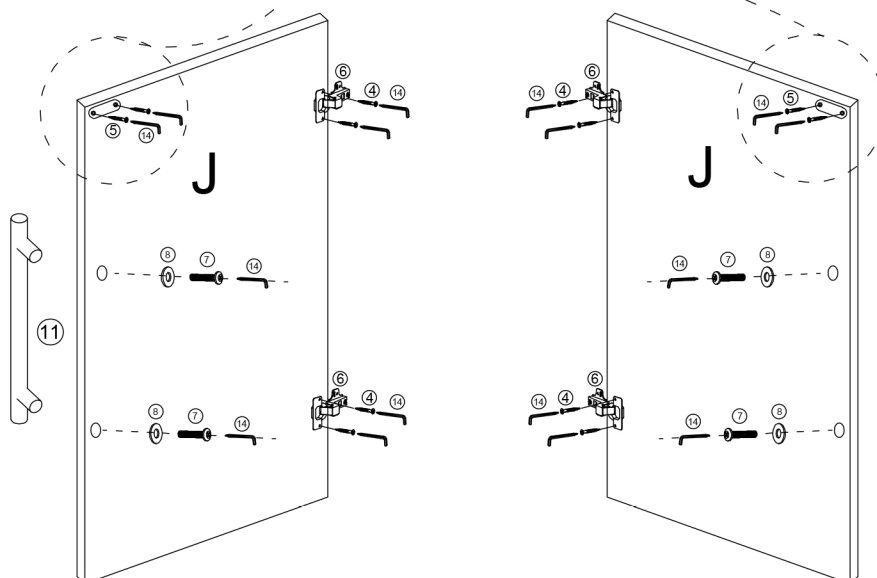
Step12



Attach hydraulic door hinge(⑥) to side door(I) with screw (④). Attach handle(⑪) to side door(I) with screw (⑦) and washer (⑧).

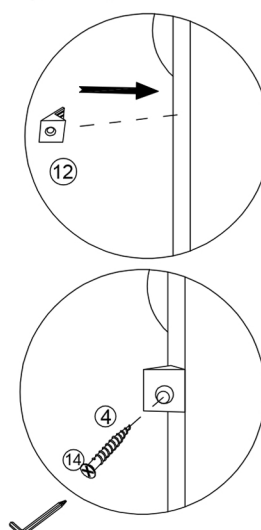


Attach hydraulic door hinge (⑥) of middle door(J) to left middle clapboard (F)、right middle clapboard (G) with screw(④).

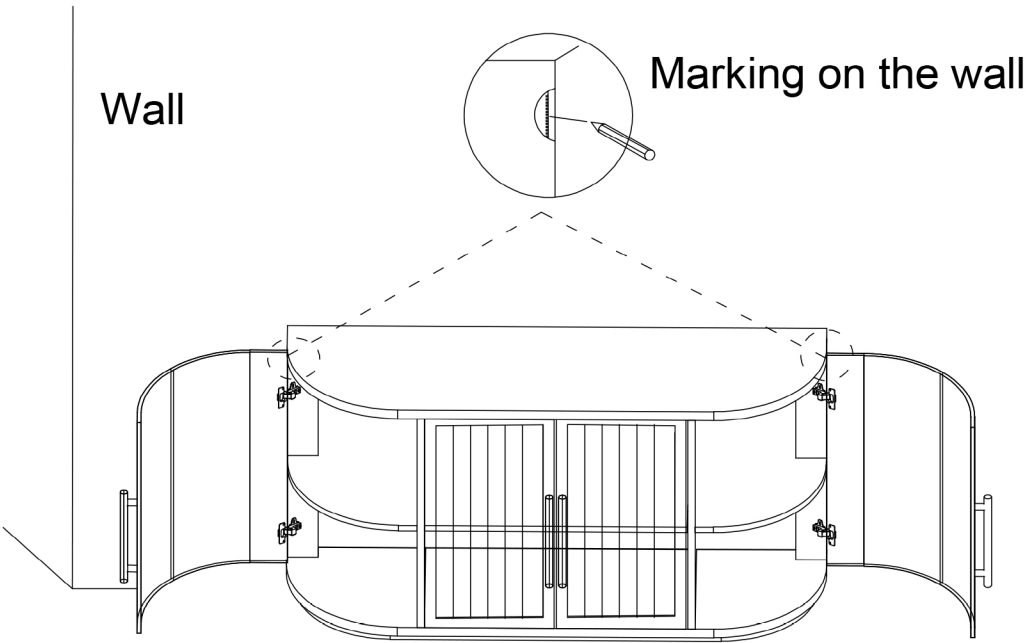

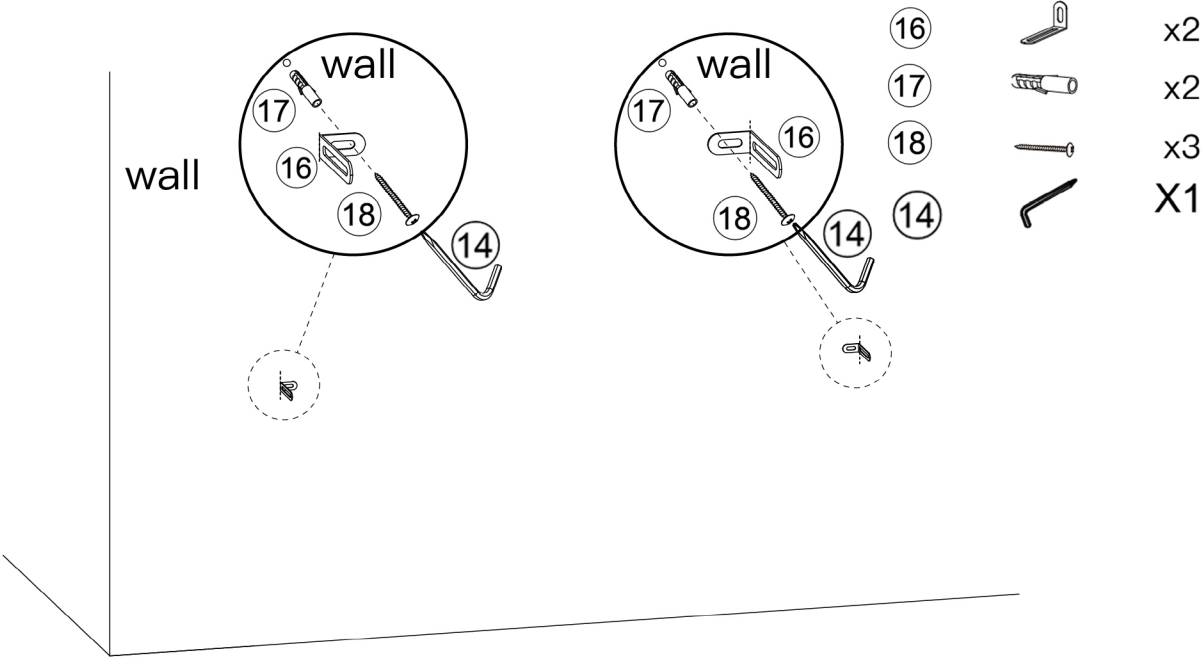
Insert backboard buckle (⑫) along the corners and fix it with screw(④).

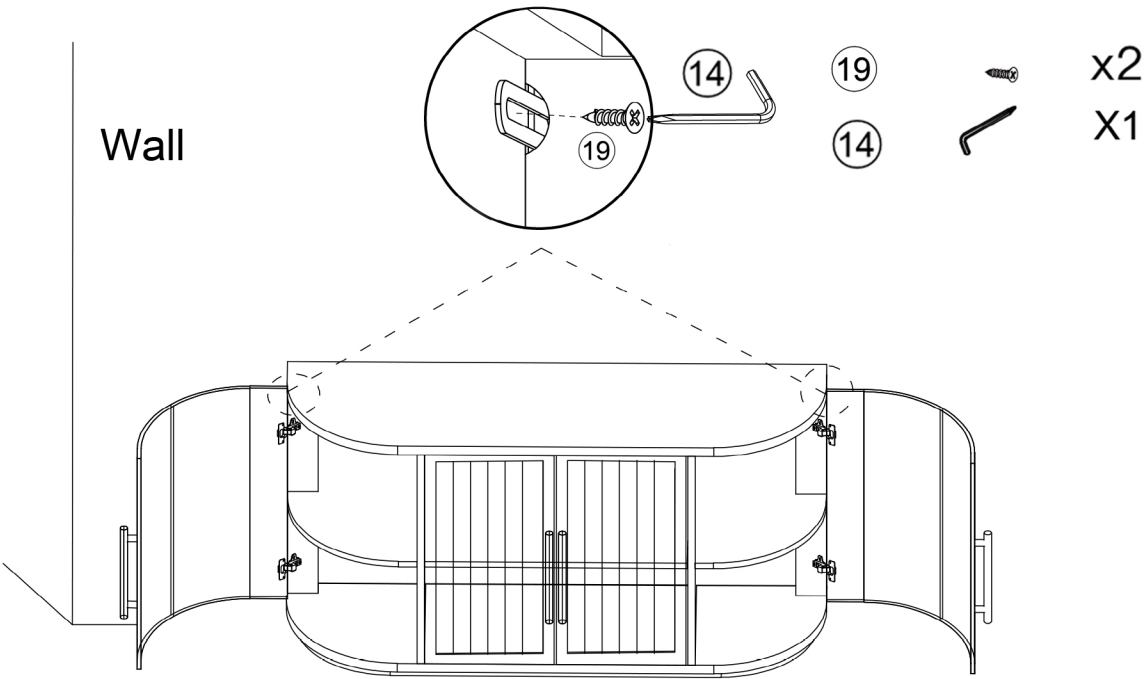
Place the sideboard against the wall. Mark the positions for the expansion plug on the wall.

Step18



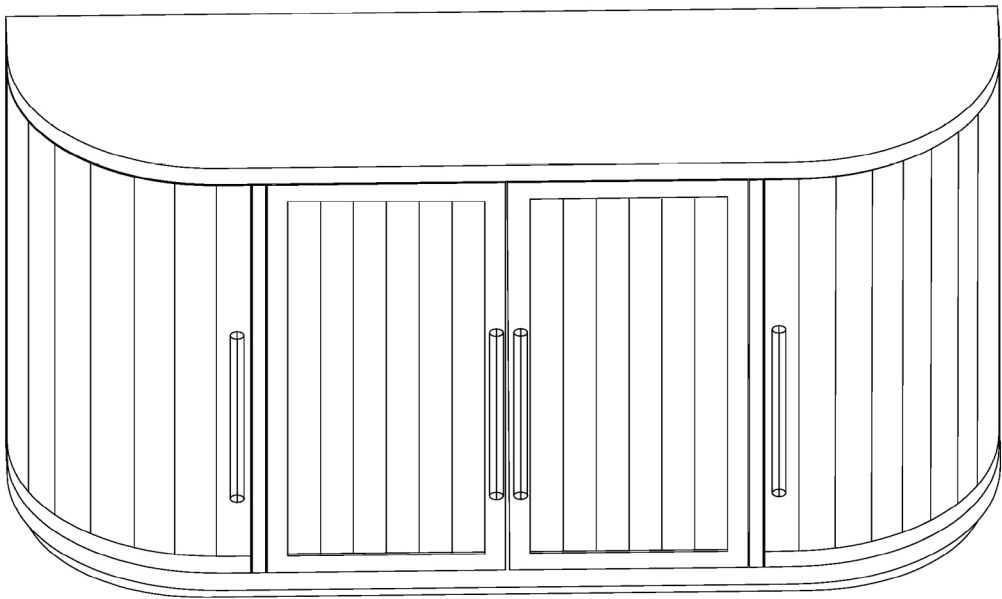
Drill holes on the wall in marking position, insert expansion plug(17) into the holes, align with the expansion plug(17),install the short side of Anti-Tip wall bracket(16) with long screw(18).

Attach the long side of Anti-Tip wall bracket(16) to slot(D) with short screw(19).

## "Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust. "
