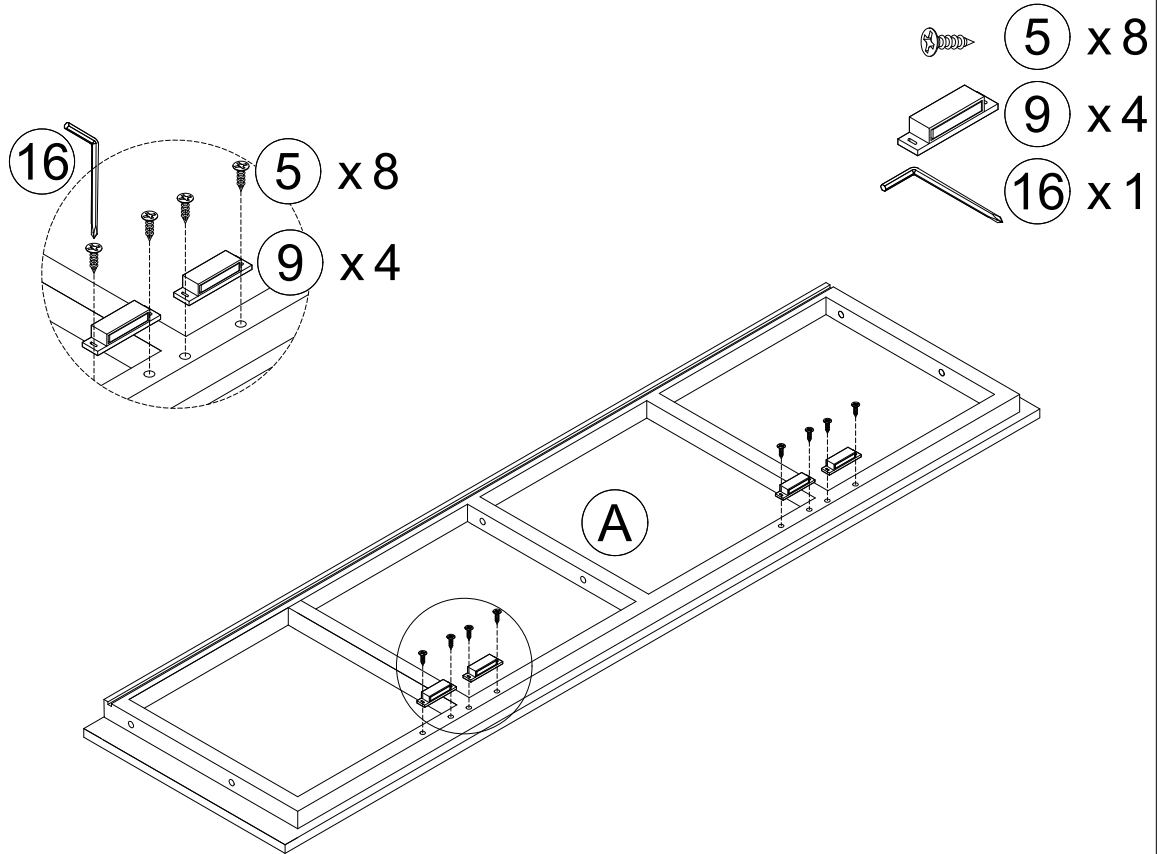
Assembly Preparation

Overview



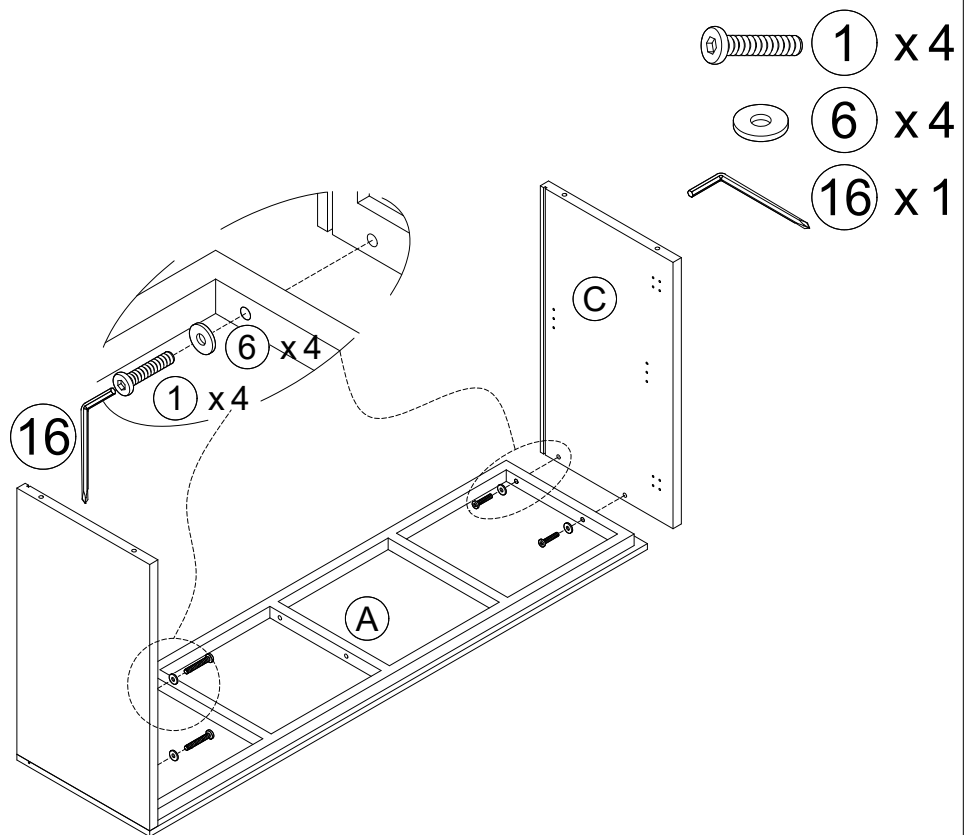
This sideboard has multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the sideboard parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



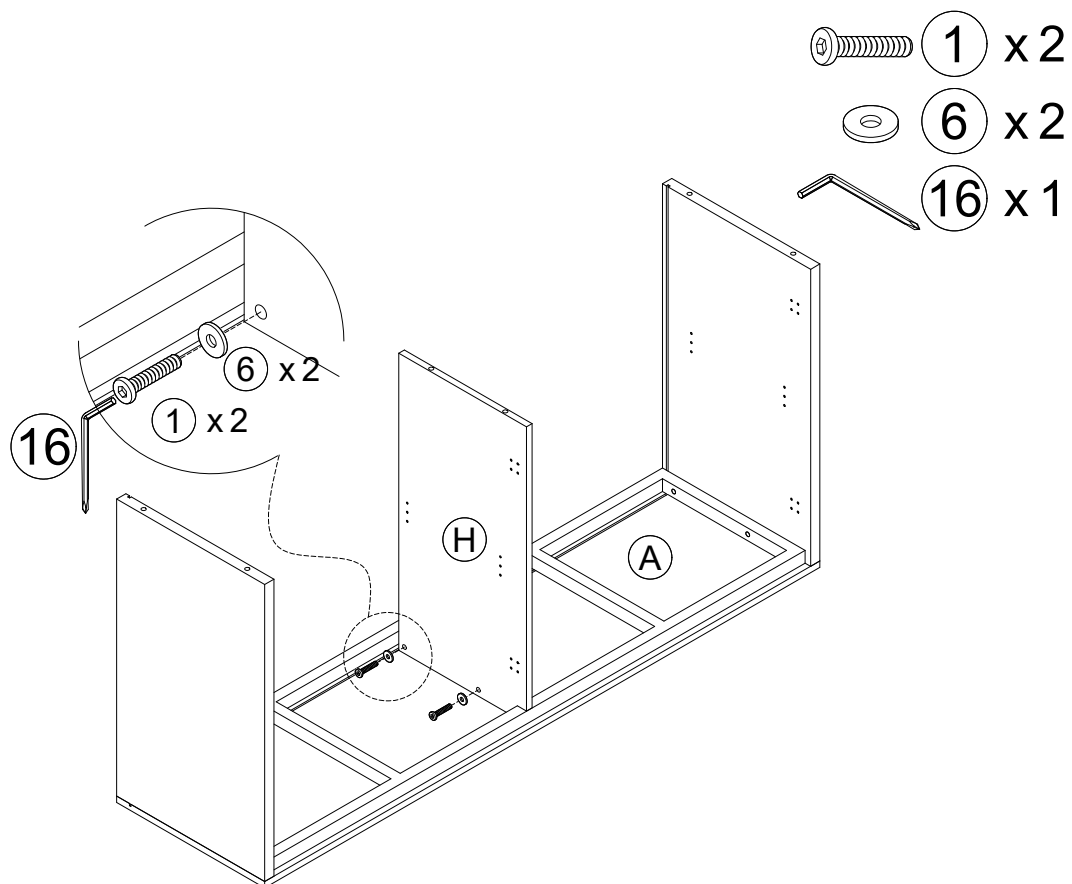
Attach magnetic door catch(9) to top board (A) with screw (5).

Step 2



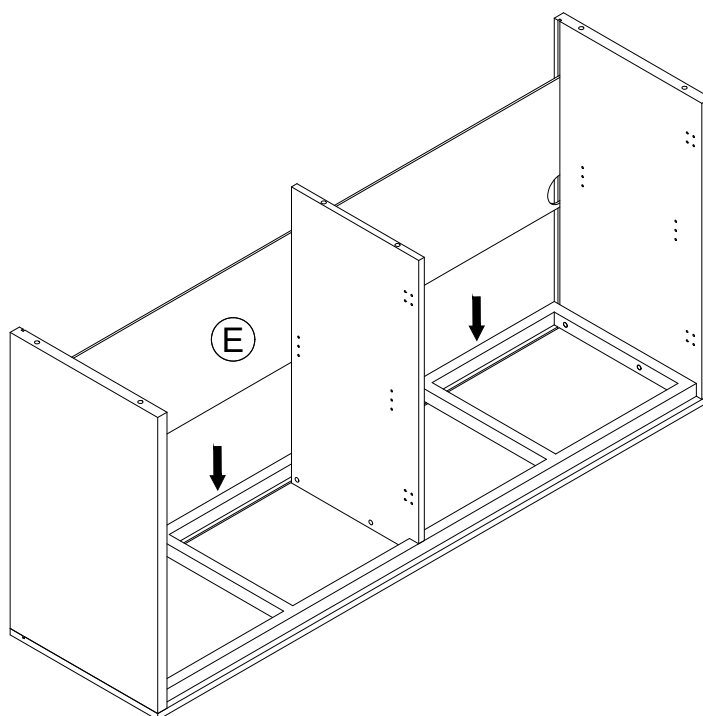
Attach left side board(B) and right side board (C) to top board(A) with short bolt (1) and washer(6).

Step 3



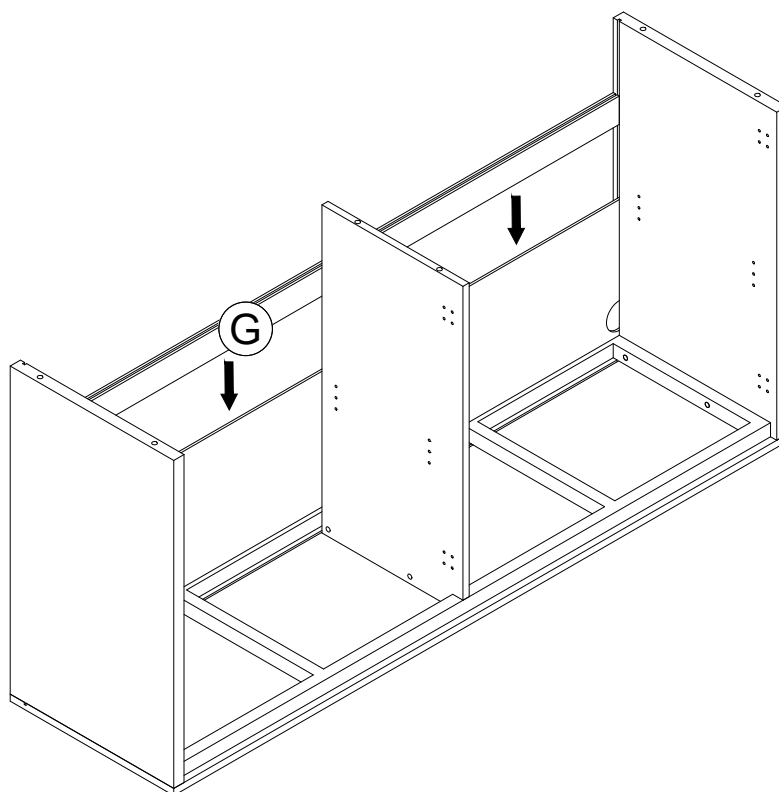
Attach middle clashboard(H) to top board (A) with short bolt (①) and washer(⑥).

Step 4



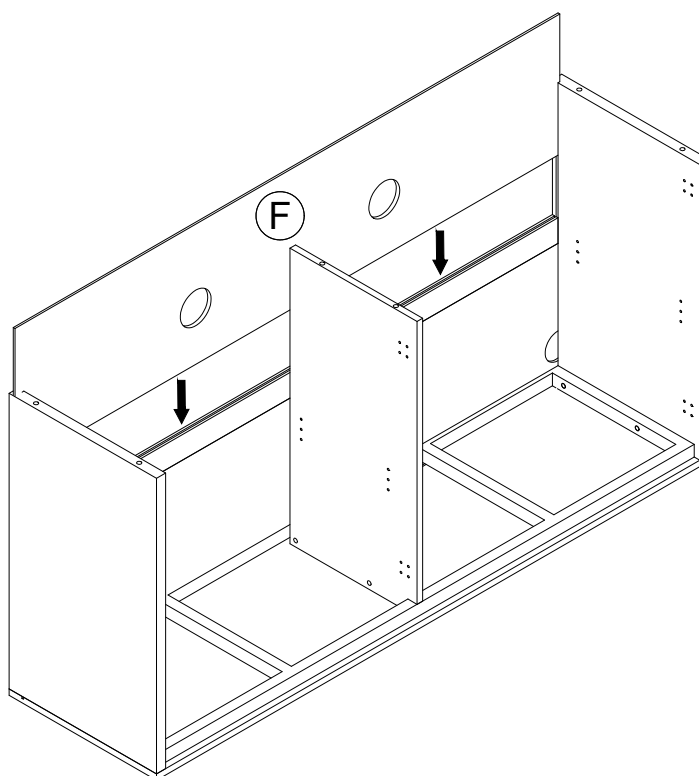
Insert upper back board(E) to left side board(B) and right side board (C).

Step 5



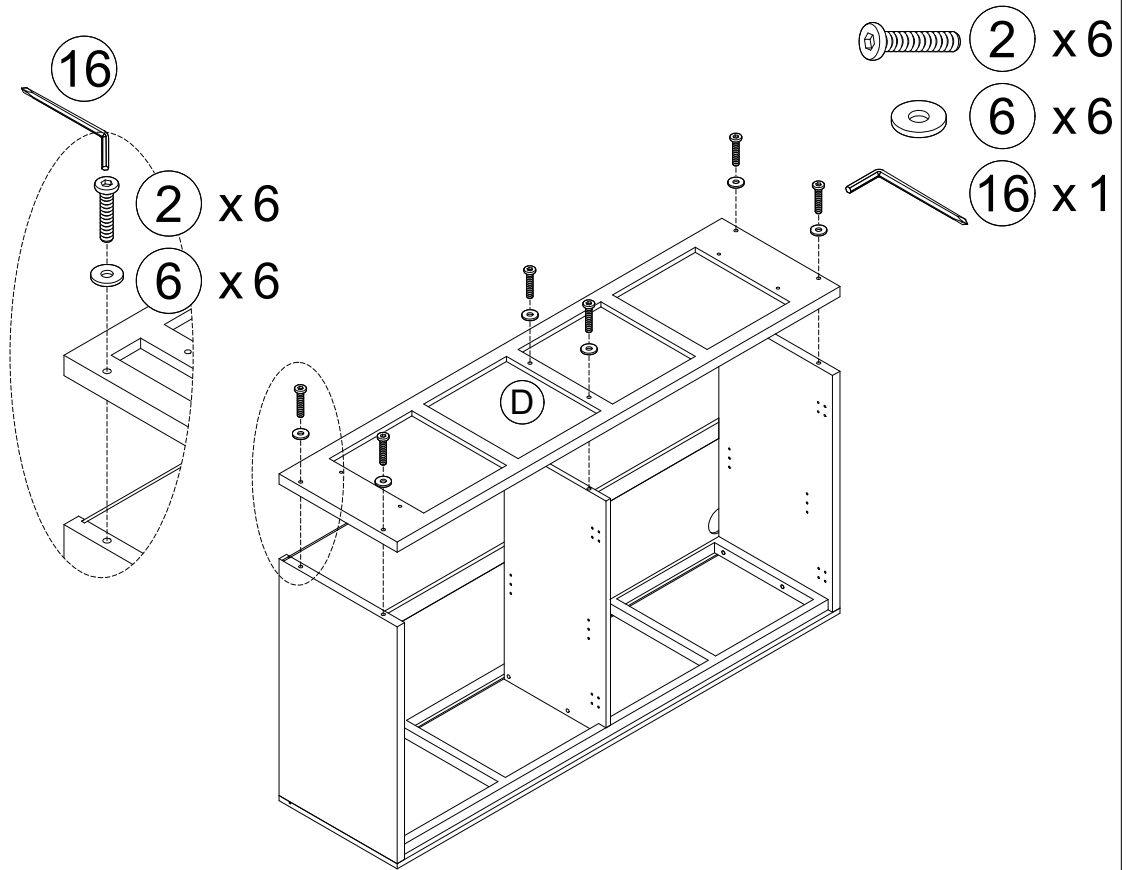
Insert slot (G) to left side board(B) and right side board (C).

Step 6



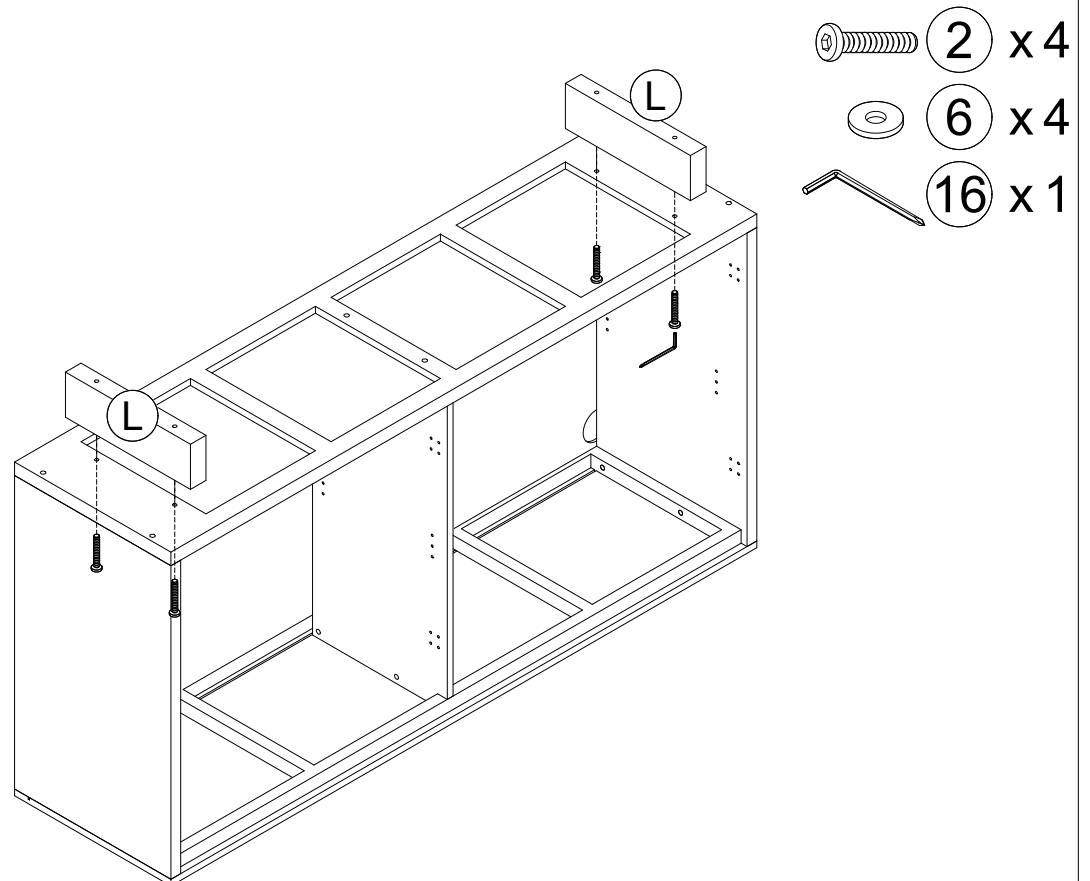
Insert lower back board (F) to left side board(B) and right side board (C).

Step 7



Attach bottom board (D) to left side board (B), right side board (C) and middle clapboard (H) with long bolt (2) and washer (6).

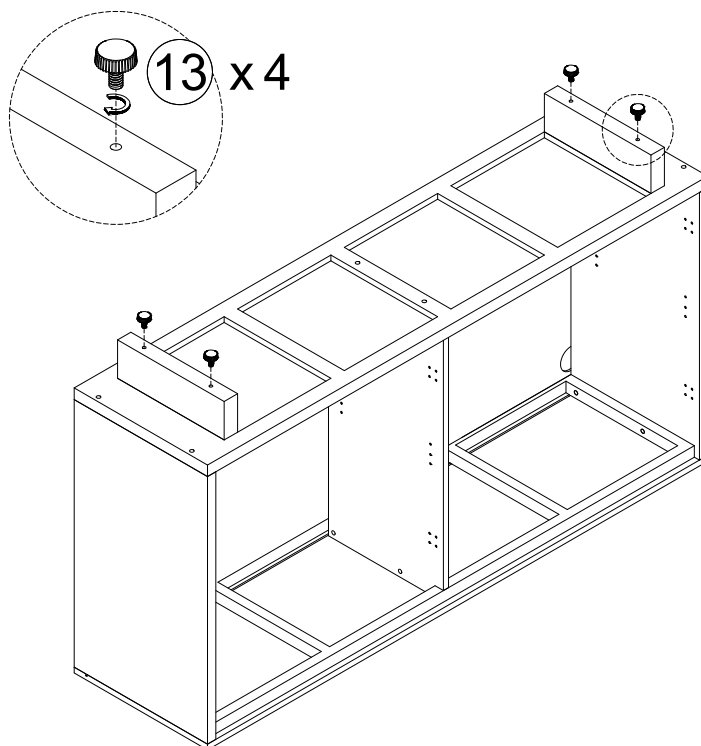

Attach leg (L) to bottom board (D) with long bolt (2) and washer (6).

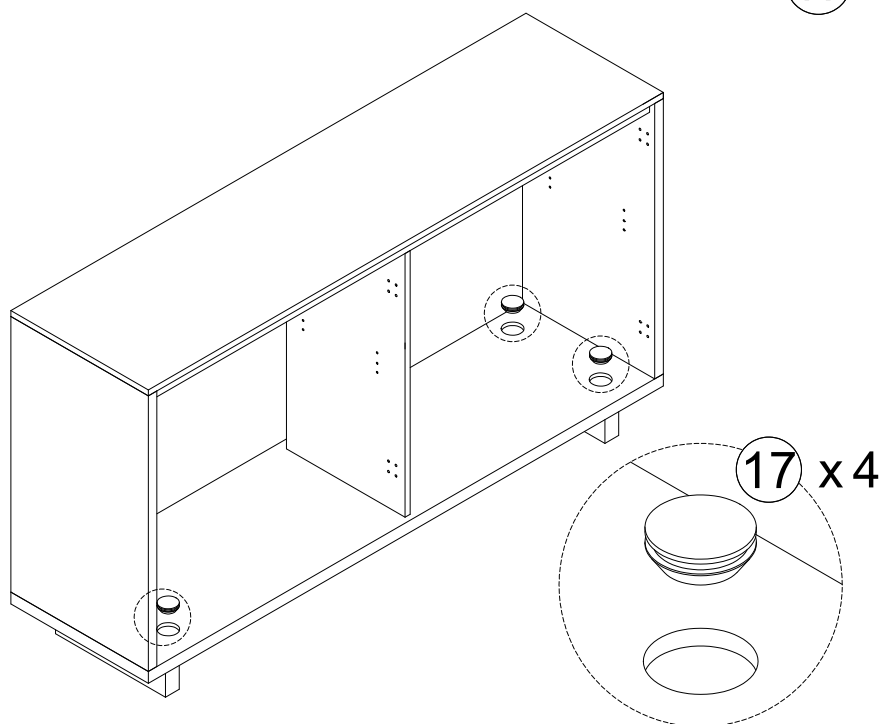

Screw adjustable leveling glide(13) to leg(L).

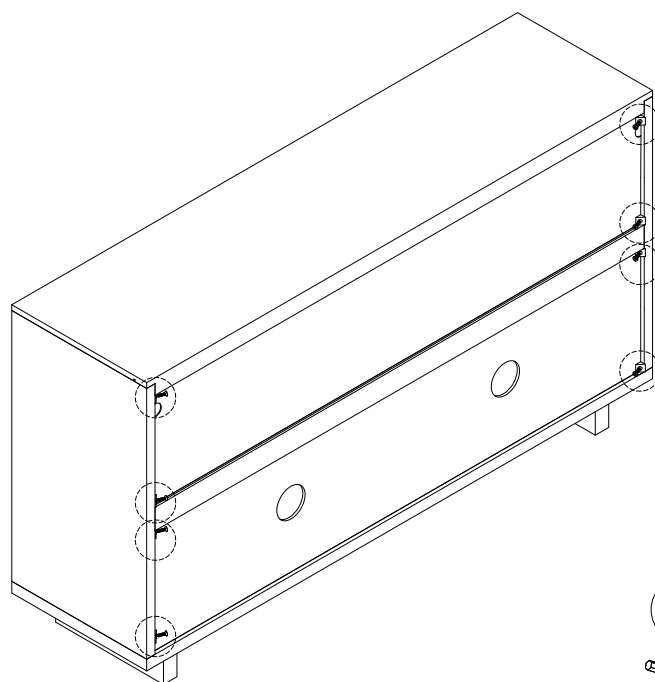

Insert rubber hole stopper (17) on bottom board(D).

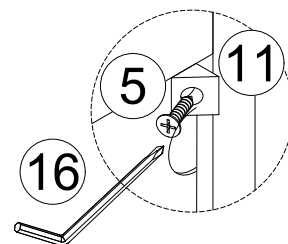
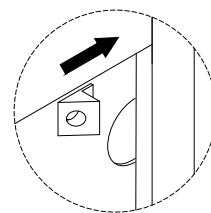

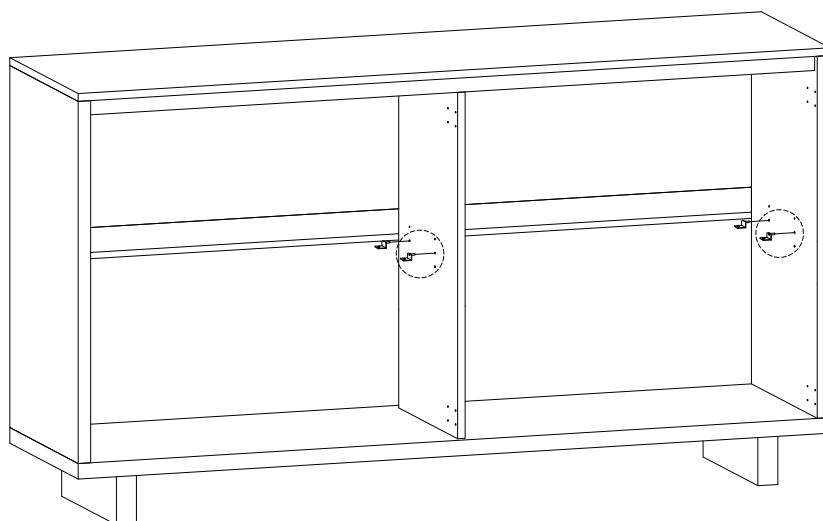

Insert backboard buckle (⑪) along the corners and fix it with screw(⑤).

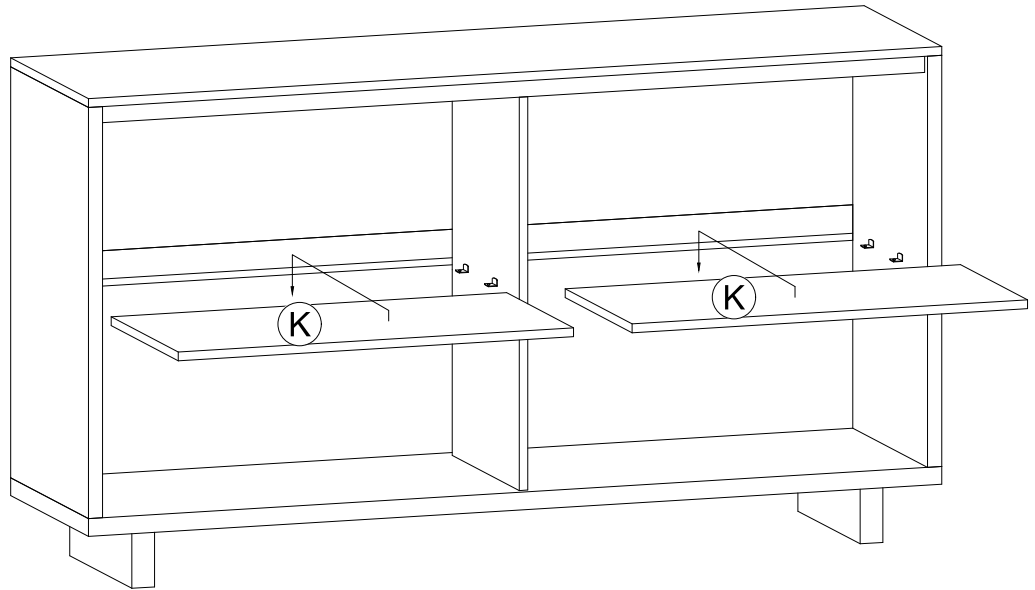

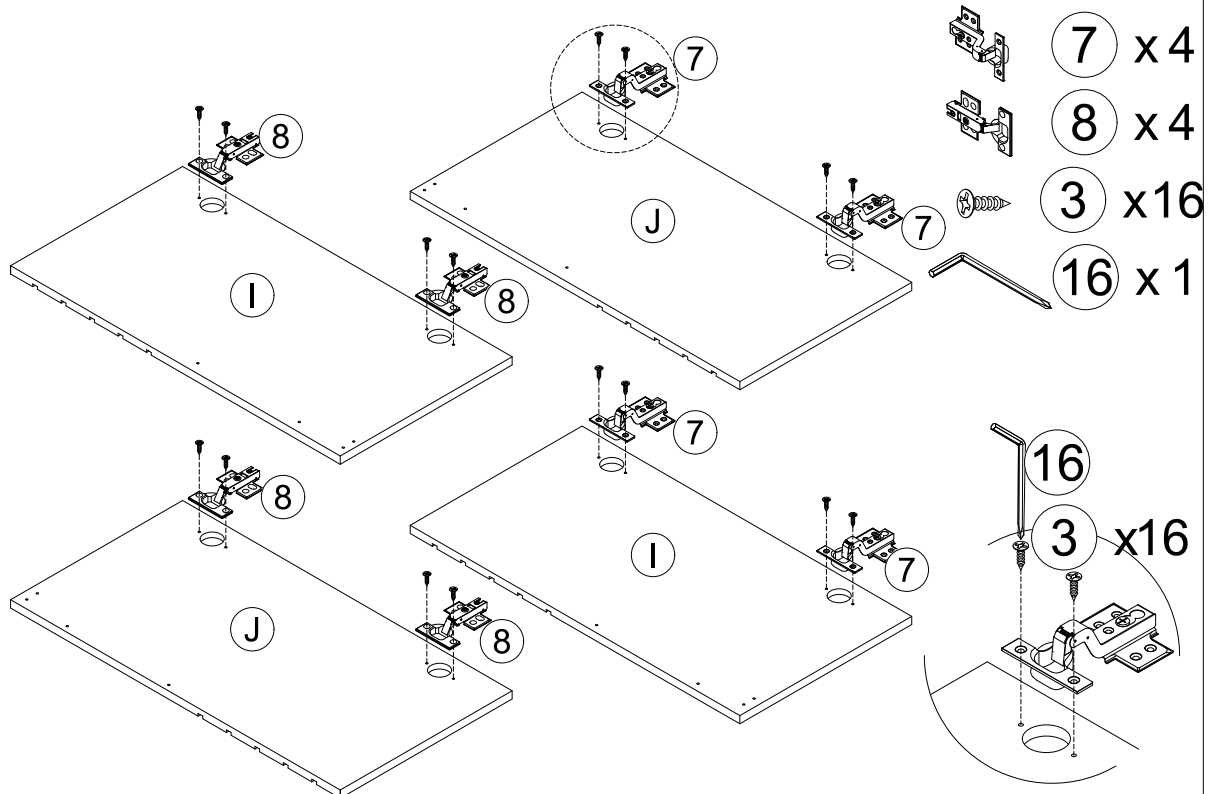
Stand the mounted sideboard up, and insert shelf support pin(⑫)into the holes of left side board(B) 、right side board (C) and middle clapboard(H).

Step 13



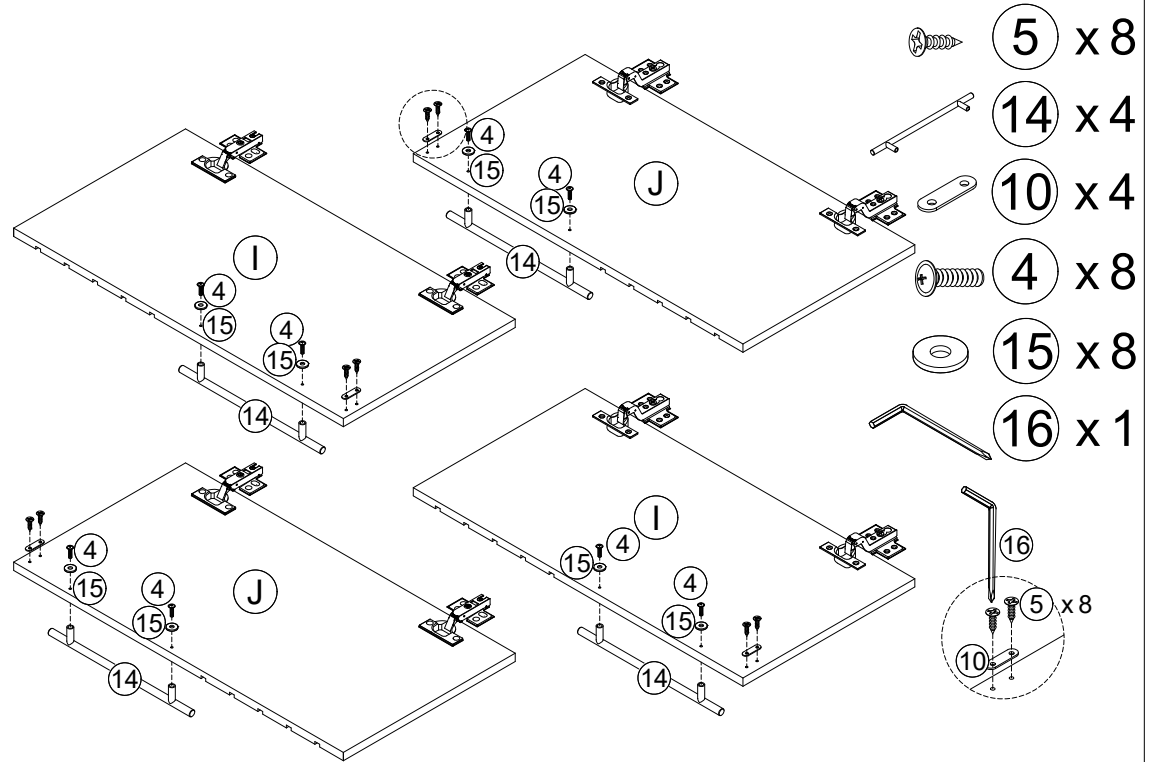
Put the shelf(K) on the shelf support pin(12).

Step 14



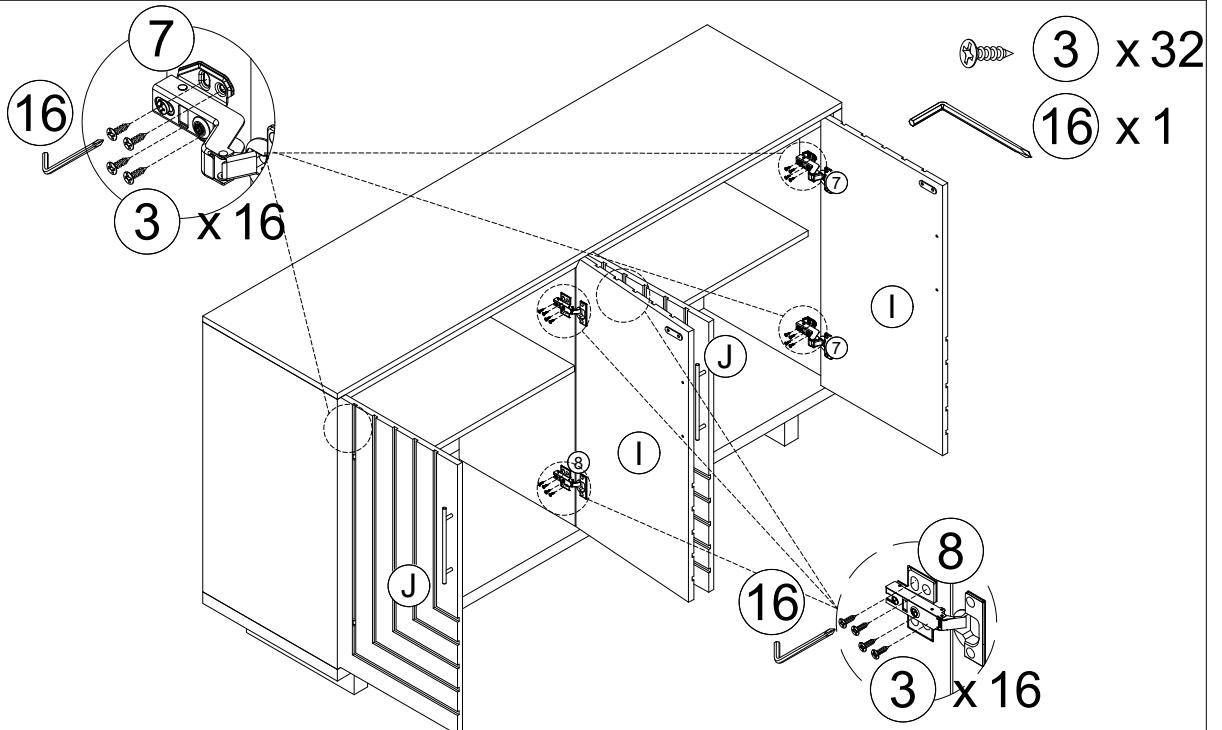
Install the big bend hydraulic door hinge(7) on one of left side door (J) and right side door(I). Install middle bend hydraulic door hinge(8) on one of left side door (J) and right side door(I).

Step 15



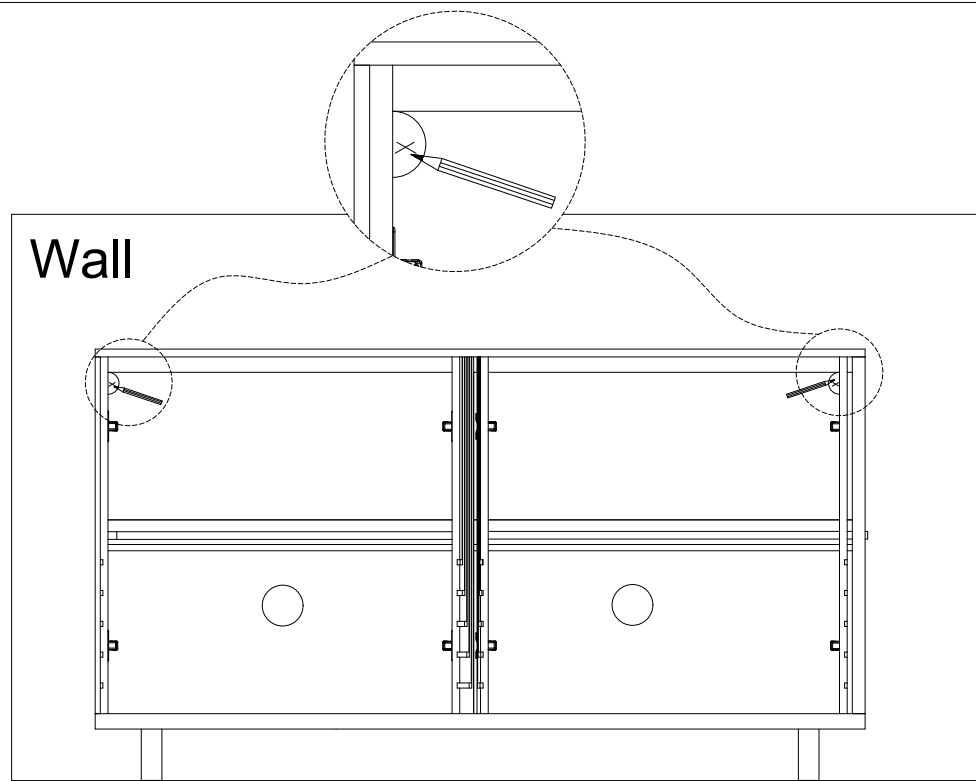
Attach handle (14) to left side door (J) and right side door (I) with screw (4) and washer (15). Attach magnetic door catch metal sheet (10) to left side door (J) and right side door (I) with screw (5) .

Step 16



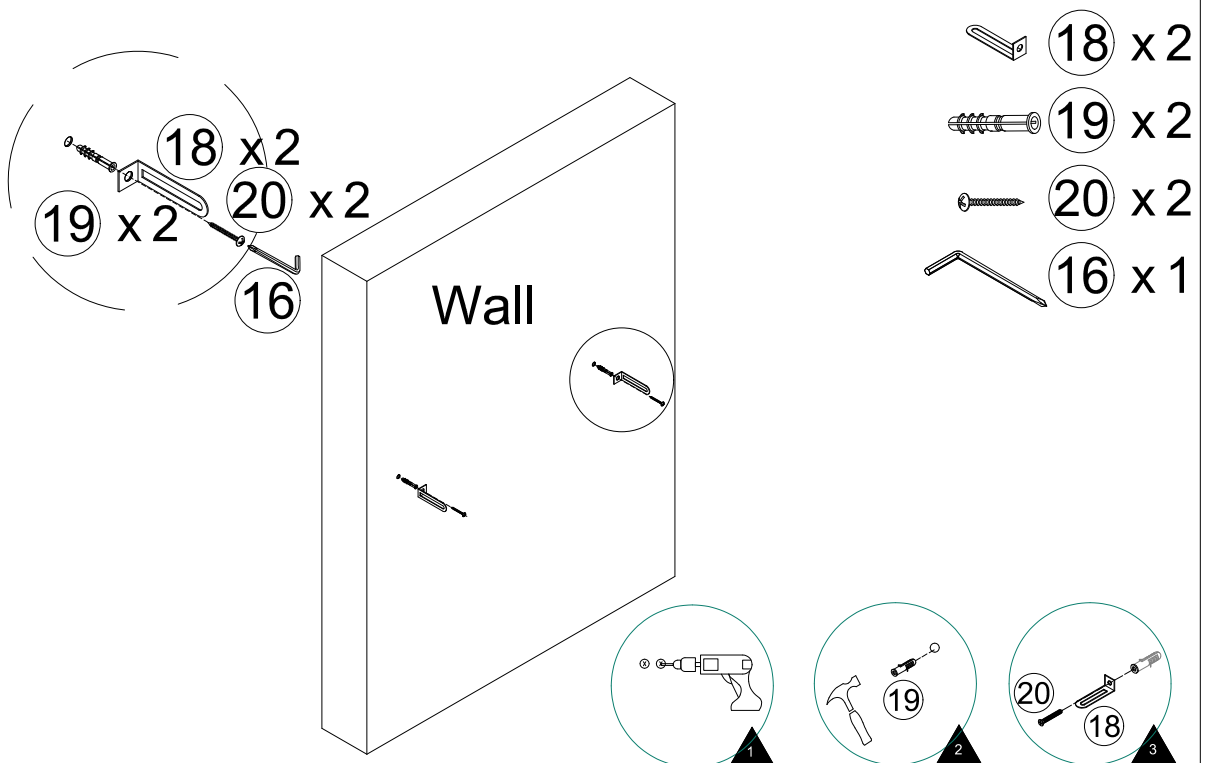
Install one of the right side door(I) 、 left side door(J), which is equipped with big bend hydraulic door hinge(7) , onto the left side board(B) and right side board(C) with screw(3).Install one of the right side door(I) 、 left side door(J), which is equipped with middle bend hydraulic door hinge(8) , onto middle clapboard(H) with screw(3). (Attention: the doors installed on the 2 side boards must be with big bend hydraulic door hinge, while the doors installed on the middle clapboard are with middle bend hydraulic door hinge.)

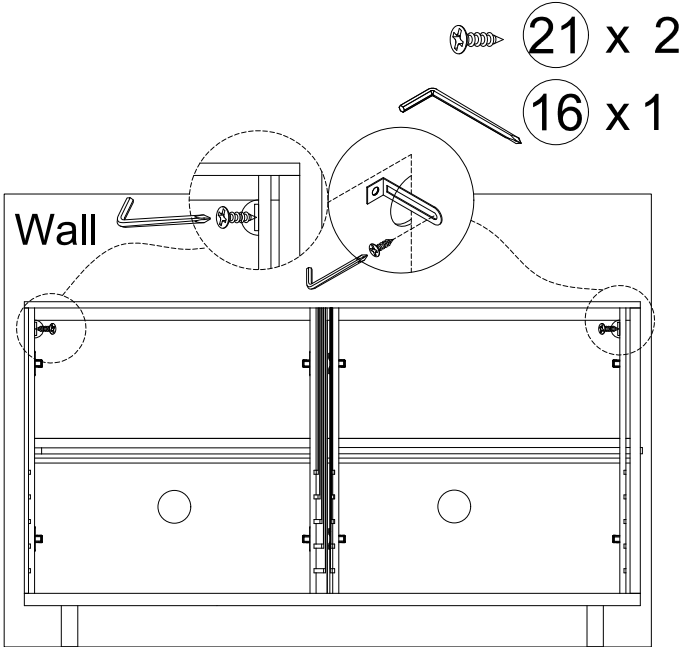
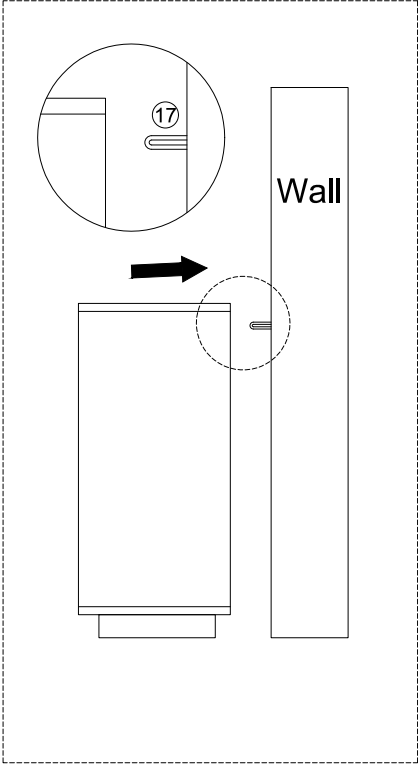
Place the sideboard against the wall. Mark the positions for the expansion plug on the wall.

Step 18



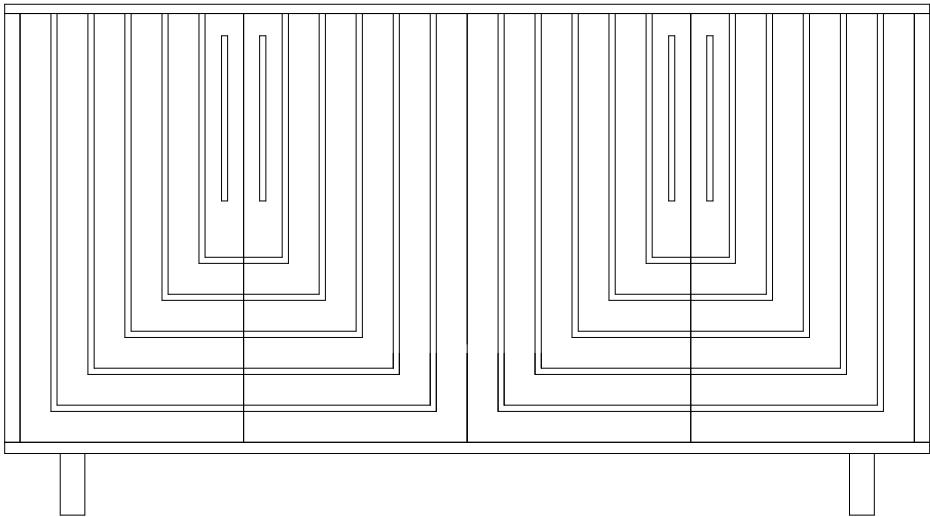
Drill holes on the wall in marking position, insert expansion plug(19) into the holes, align with the expansion plug(19),install the short side of Anti-Tip wall bracket(18) with long screw(20).

Step 19



Attach the long side of Anti-Tip wall bracket(16) to left side board (B) and right side board (C) with short screw(21).

The sideboard is ready to use.

”Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust. ”
