



Note: It is not recommended to use power tools during assembly.




Note: Wood dowels are intended for alignment. Additional clearance between wood dowel and pre-drilled hole is intentional for ease of assembly.

Step 1. Attach knobs (part #3) to doors (part G) using round head bolts (part #4) and phillips head screwdriver.


Attach double magnets (part #8) to top panel (part A) and bottom panel (part D) using short screws (part #9) and phillips head




Step 2. Attach left panel (part B) and right panel (part C) to bottom panel (part D) using wood dowels (part #1), bolts (part #2) and allen wrench (part #10).



Step 3. Attach top panel (part A) to assembled unit (parts B & C) using wood dowels (part #1), bolts (part #2) and allen wrench (part #10).




Step 4. Attach covers (part H) to back panel (part E) using binding posts (part #6) and phillips head screwdriver.




Step 5. Carefully turn unit upright. There are two installation options for back panel (part E).

When used as a base, attach back panel (part E) to assembled unit (parts A, B, C & D) using long screws (part #5) and phillips head screwdriver.

When used as a top, turn back panel (part E) 180° and attach to assembled unit (parts A, B, C & D) using long screws (part #5) and phillips head screwdriver.



Step 6. Place shelf holders (part #7) into desired position and slide adjustable shelves (part F) into place.



Step 7. Attach doors (part G) by placing pin hinges (preinstalled in door) in the pre-drilled hole of bottom panel (part D). Then depress the top springloaded pin hinges so it can be placed in the pre-drilled hole of top panel (part A).


Note: Be sure top and bottom pin hinges are fully extended to secure

doors in place.




Note: It is important to adjust levelers once fully assembled and upright. Extend adjustable leveler until it's firmly in contact with the floor. If relocating, adjust leveler as needed until it's firmly in contact with the floor in new location.

Step 8. Flip and place pantries together by lining up top panel (part A).



Step 9. Attach connecting bars (part #11) to back panels (part E) using long screws (part #5) and phillips head screwdriver.



Important: Safety strap kit (part #12) must be installed to prevent tipping damage and / or injury.



SAFETY WALL STRAP INSTALLATION

Note: It is highly recommended to install this safety strap kit to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.

- 1. Insert short screw (C) and safety wall strap (E) through bracket (B) and attach to top panel (part A) using phillips head screwdriver.
- 2. Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure the unit. The drill hole will be at the same height as the hole in top panel (part A) where bracket (B) is attached. Tap wall anchor (A) into the hole.
- 3. Insert long screw (D) and safety wall strap (E) through bracket (B) into wall anchor (A) using phillips head screwdriver.

SAFETY WALL STRAP INSTALLATION

Note: It is highly recommended to install this safety strap kit to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.

- 1. Insert short screw (C) and safety wall strap (E) through bracket (B) and attach to bottom panel (part D) using phillips head screwdriver.
- 2. Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure the unit. The drill hole will be at the same height as the hole in bottom panel (part D) where bracket (B) is attached. Tap wall anchor (A) into the hole.
- 3. Insert long screw (D) and safety wall strap (E) through bracket (B) into wall anchor (A) using phillips head screwdriver.
