## (!) CARE & MAINTENANCE

### Please keep these instructions for your future reference.


- Be careful when assembling, avoid damaging the painted surface.
- Clean the table with lukewarm water, mild detergent & soft cloth.
- Firmly secure all bolts before use, do not use any part of this item as a step ladder.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and nuts are secure every 90 days.
- Do not use or store this item in the proximity of open flame or flammable/combustible chemicals.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- Do not overtighten screws. (Insert all screws before tightening screws.)
- Please do not exceed the weight limitations of this item.







Look at following overall view of this table and learn the exact position of each part to be assembled.




### **PRODUCT ASSEMBLY**



Pick out **Part B Storage Layer** and **Part C Leg** from the package.

Attach 4 pcs of Part C Leg to Part B Storage Layer with 4 pcs of Hardware #1 Screw and 4 pcs of Hardware #2 Screw as below.


Pay attention not to tighten the bolts too much. Only tighten by about 70%.

Place **Part A Table Top** onto the top of **Part C Leg**, make sure to align the holes in the legs with the holes in the rails of **Part A Table Top**.

Attach Part A Table Top to the legs with 4 pcs of Hardware #2 Screw.

Check and tighten all the screws again to ensure the table is steady enough.

Enjoy the table now.







### PRODUCT ASSEMBLY - OVERALL VIEW


Look at following overall view of this lounge and learn the exact position of each part to be assembled.






Place Part B Lounge Base on a flat surface as below. Attach Part C Left Rear Leg to Part B Lounge Base with 2 sets of Hardware #2 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut.

Pay attention not to tighten the bolts too much. Only tighten by about 70%.





Attach Part H Front Leg to Part B Lounge Base with 3 sets of Hardware #1 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut.





Attach 4 pcs of Part I Rail to Part C Left Rear Leg and Part H Front Leg with 4 pcs of Hardware #5 Screw.





Do the same to attach Part D Right Rear Leg and another Part H Front Leg to Part B Lounge Base with 2 sets of Hardware #2 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut, 3 sets of Hardware #1 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut, and 4 pcs of Hardware #5 Screw.






Attach Part G Cup Holder to Part E Right Lounge Arm with 1 pc of Hardware #4 Bolt.

Attach Part F Left Lounge Arm to Part C Left Rear Leg with 2 sets of Hardware #3 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut.

Attach Part E Right Lounge Arm to Part D Right Rear Leg with 2 sets of Hardware #3 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut.






Place Part A Lounge Backrest as below.

Attach Part A Lounge Backrest to Part C Left Rear Leg and Part D Right Rear Leg with 2 sets of Hardware #2 Bolt, #10 Washer and #9 Nut.


Attach Part J Wheel to Part D Right Rear Leg and Part C Left Rear Leg with 2 sets of Hardware #6 Bolt, #8 Washer and #7 Nut as below.





Check and tighten all the bolts and nuts again to ensure the lounge is steady enough.

Enjoy the lounge now.

**REGULAR CLEAN:** Use a mixture of warm water and mild soap. Gently scrub the surface with a soft bristle brush to remove any dirt or stains.
