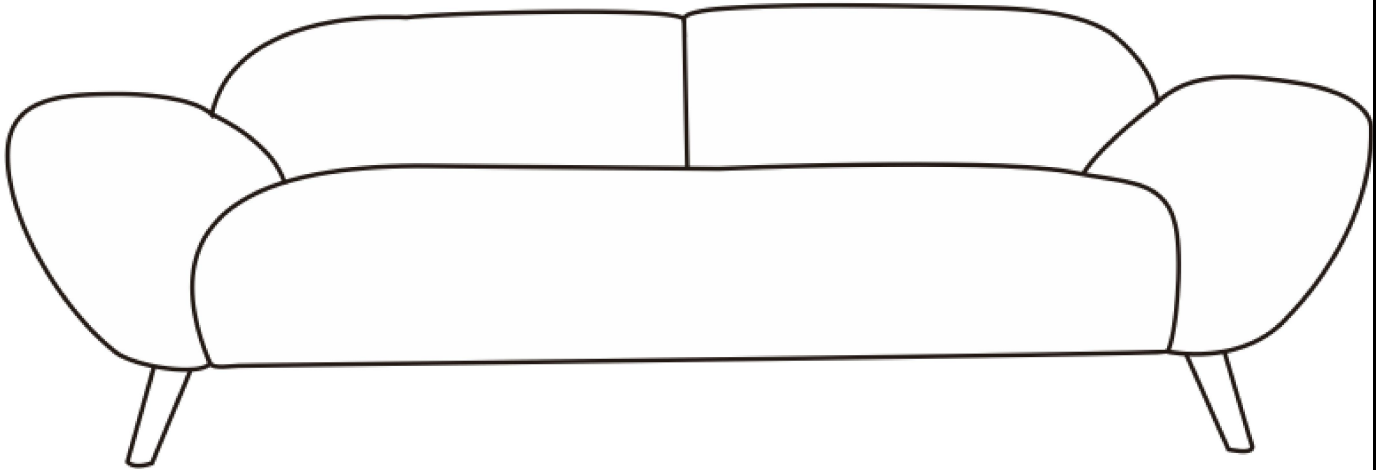

Care & Maintenance



-  Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
-  Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
-  Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-  Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
-  Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
-  Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
-  Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
-  Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
-  Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
-  Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
-  Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.






Please look in 3-seater sofa for hardware packs and legs.
Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.









Assembly Steps

Overview



Note: Middle Leg (G) is not visible here because it is located under Seat Board (A).

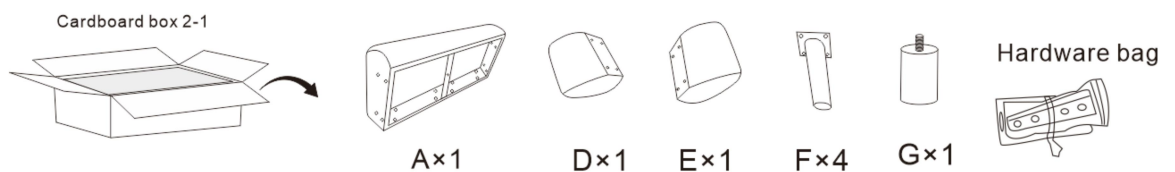
This 3-Seater Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the 3-Seater Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

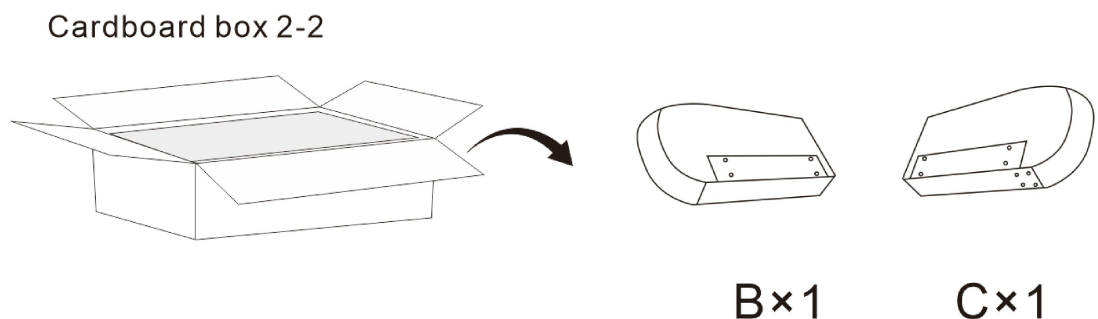
Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.

Step 1



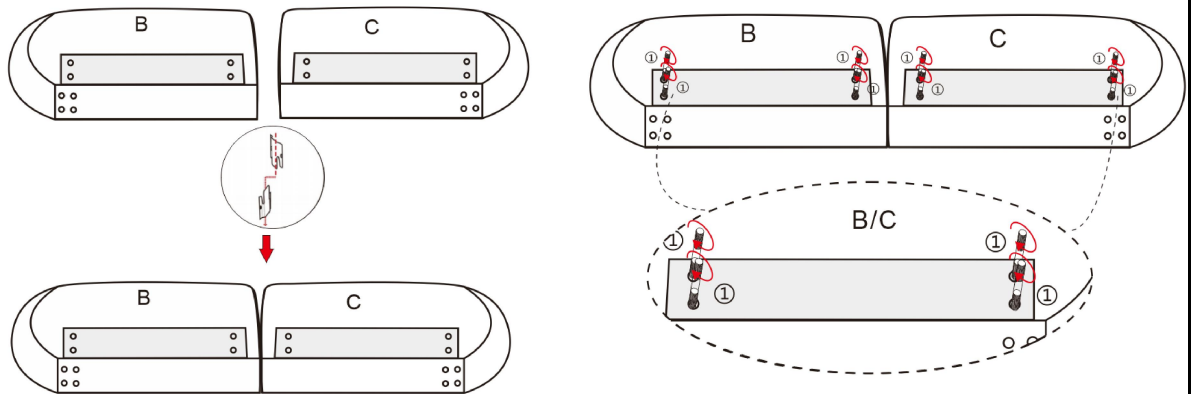
Remove items Seat Board (A), Left Armrest (D), Right Armrest (E), Leg (F), Middle Leg (G) and the hardware kit from carton 2-1. Place them on a flat, clean surface, ensuring they are not dented.

Step 2



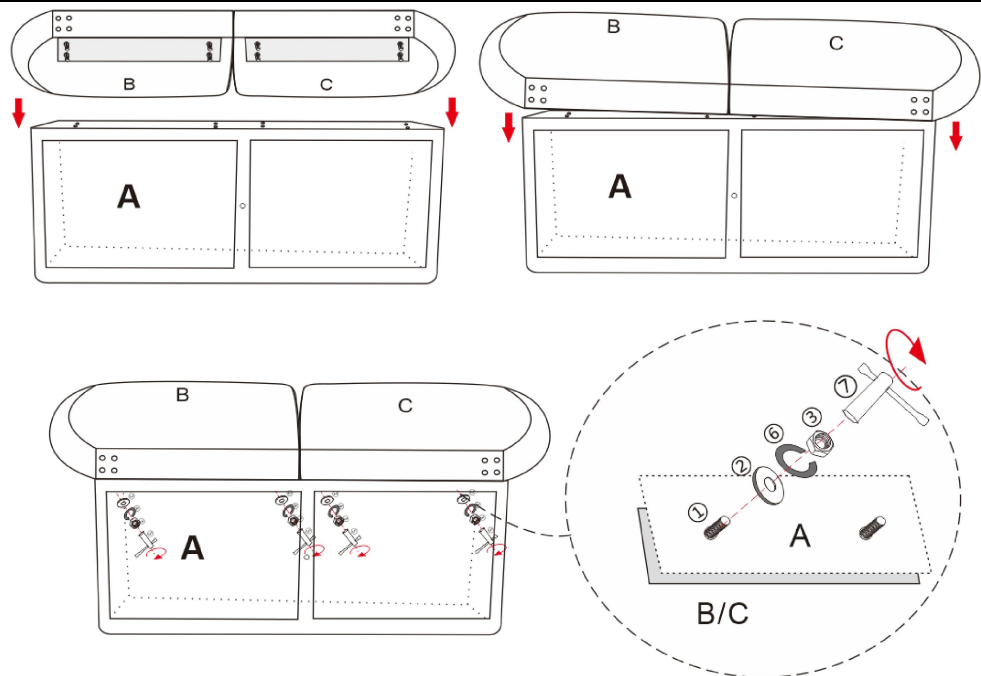
Remove Left Backrest (B) and Right Backrest (C) from cardboard box 2-2 and place them on a flat, clean surface, avoiding any indentations.

Step 3



Place the backrest on a flat surface, Left Backrest (B) fasten the mountain buckle from top to bottom Right Backrest (C).
Place Left Backrest (B) and Right Backrest (C) flat on a level surface, and screw Double Headed Screw (①) into the four holes on the surfaces of Left Backrest (B) and Right Backrest (C).

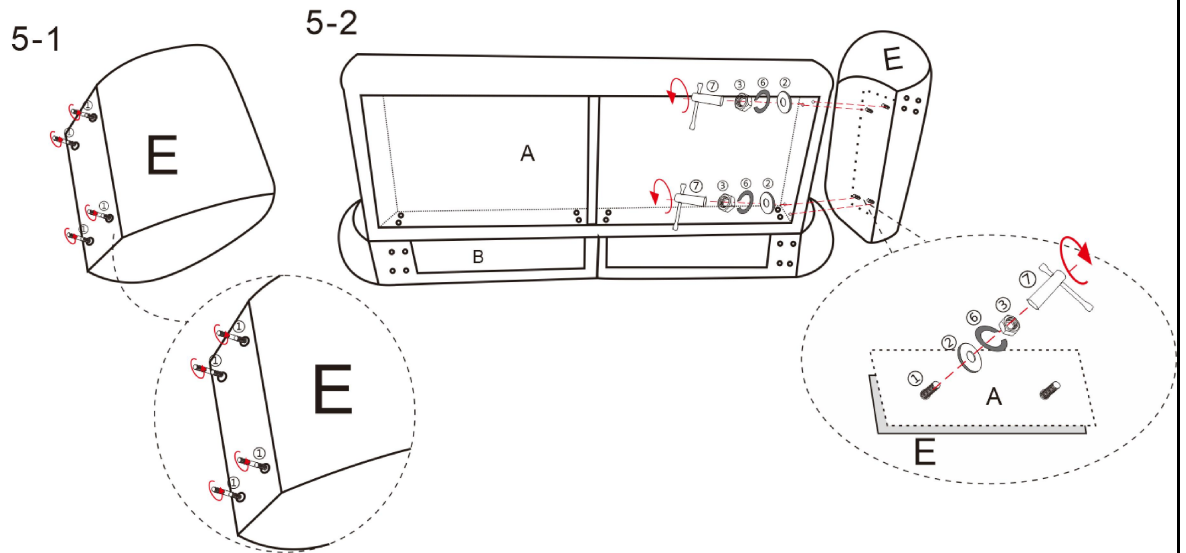
Step 4



Align Left Backrest (B) and Right Backrest (C) with Seat Board (A). From left to right, thread Double Headed Screw (①) through Seat Board (A). Using Wrenches (⑦), thread Gaskets (②), Spring Shims (⑥) and Nut (③) in sequence, then tighten Nut (③).

Note: This step requires two or three people to complete.

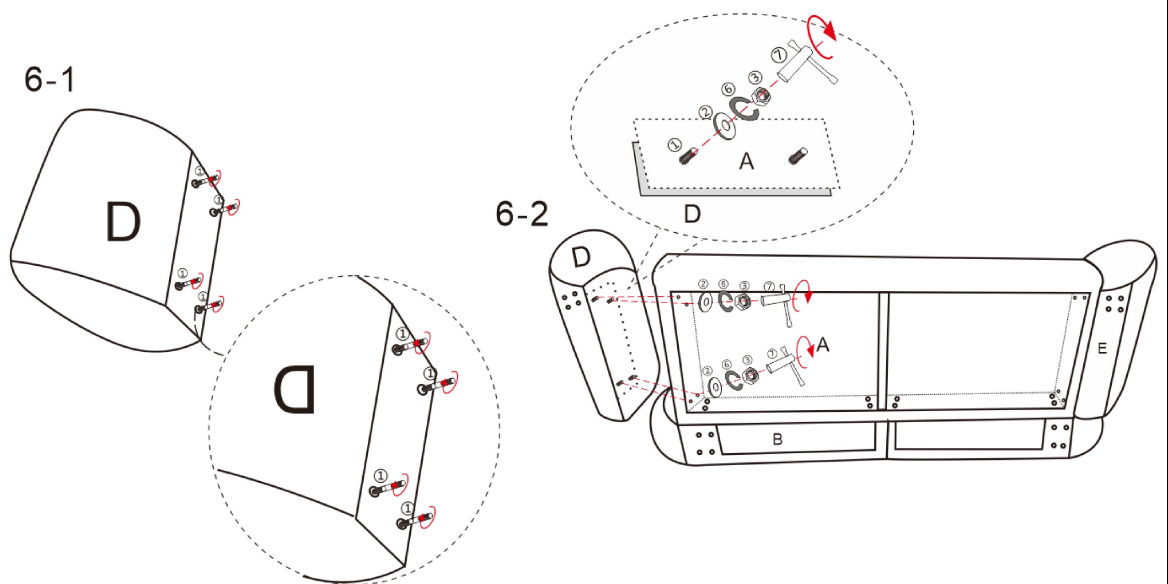
Step 5



5-1: Tilt Right Armrest (E) and screw Double Headed Screw (①) into the four holes in Right Armrest (E).

5-2: Align Right Armrest (E) flush with the right-hand side of Seat Board (A). Pass the Double Headed Screw (①) on Right Armrest (E) through Seat Board (A), then use Wrenches (⑦) to tighten Gaskets (②), Spring Shims (⑥) and Nut (③) in sequence. This step secures Nut (③) in place.

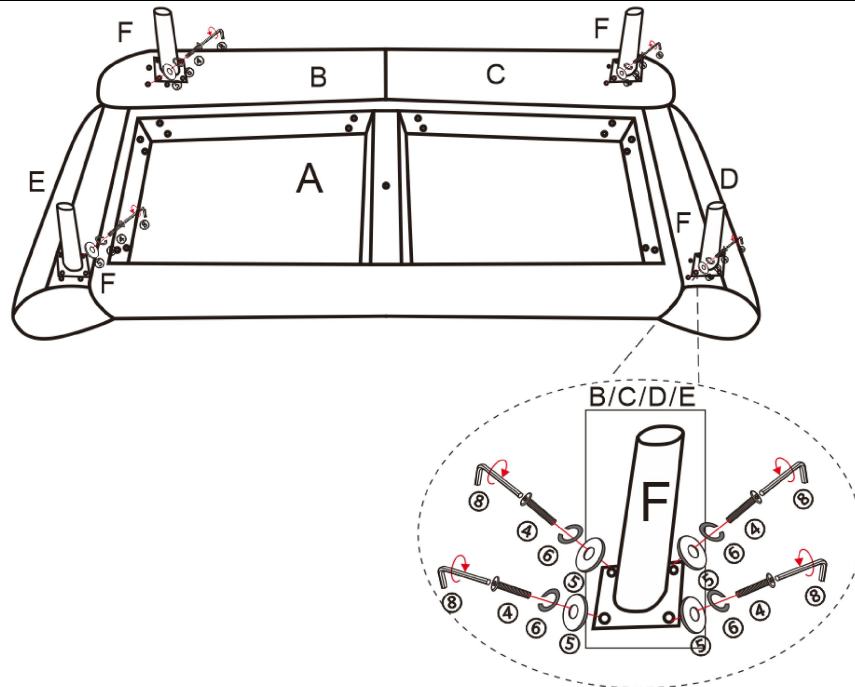
Step 6



6-1: Tilt Left Armrest (D) and screw Double Headed Screw (①) into the four holes in Left Armrest (D).

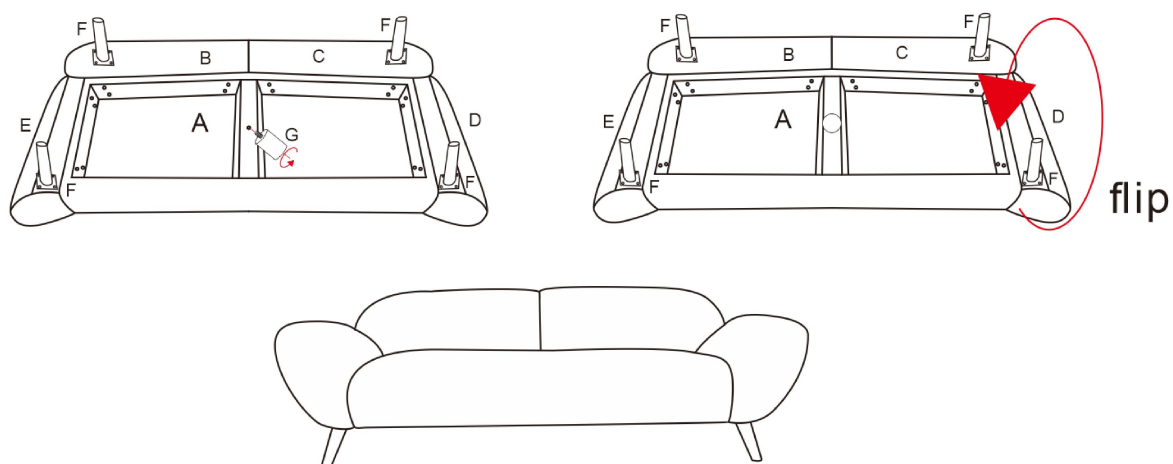
6-2: Align Left Armrest (D) flush with the right-hand side of Seat Board (A). Pass the Double Headed Screw (①) on Left Armrest (D) through Seat Board (A), then use Wrenches (⑦) to tighten Gaskets (②), Spring Shims (⑥) and Nut (③) in sequence. This step secures Nut (③) in place.

Step 7



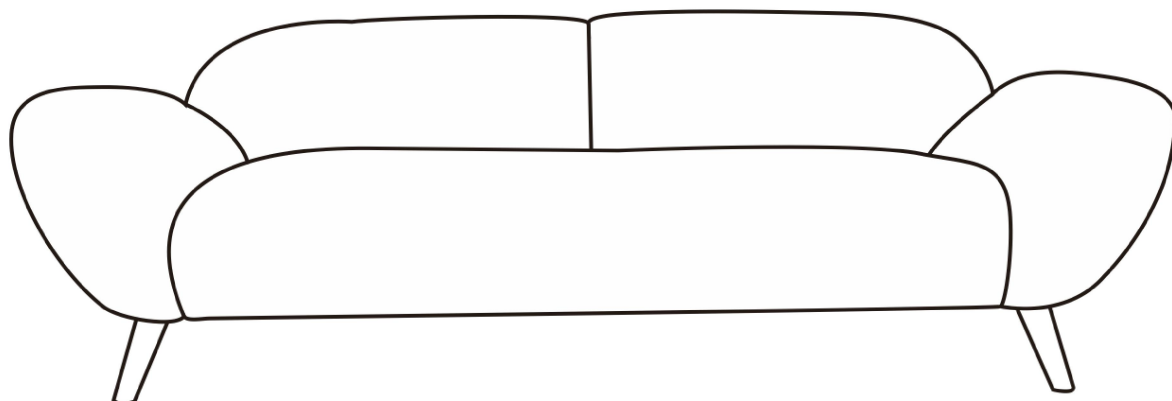
Turn the sofa over and lay it flat, aligning hole Leg (F) with holes Left Backrest (B), Right Backrest (C), Left Armrest (D), and Right Armrest (E). Use Allen Wrench (⑧) to tighten tighten screws Gaskets (⑤), Spring Shims (⑥) and Single Head Screw (④) in sequence. This step will secure Single Head Screw (④) in place.

Step 8



Fit Middle Leg (G) in the centre of the bottom of Seat Board (A) and flip the whole couch back over.

Step 9



Your sofa is ready for use.

This sofa should only be used on flat, level surfaces.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
