

## Care & Maintenance




-  Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
-  Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
-  Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-  Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
-  Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
-  Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
-  Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
-  Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
-  Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
-  Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
-  Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.








Note: Middle Leg (H) is not visible here because it is located under Seat Board (A).


This 3-Seater Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the 3-Seater Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.



### Step 1




Remove the Seat Board (A), Left Backrest (B), Centre Backrest (C), Right Backrest (D), Leg (G), Middle Leg (H), and Cushion (I) from carton 2-1, along with the hardware bag, and place them on a clean, scratch-free surface.




Remove Left Armrest (E), Right Armrest (F) from Carton 2-2 and place them on a clean and unscratched flat surface.




3-1: Place the backrest on a flat surface, Left Backrest (B) fasten the mountain buckle from top to bottom Centre Backrest (C), Right Backrest (D) fasten in the same steps as Centre Backrest (C).


3-2: Lay Left Backrest (B), Centre Backrest (C) and Right Backrest (D) flat, then twist Double Headed Screw (①) into the hole at the bottom of the backrest and tighten the screws in this step.


4-1: Snap Left Backrest (B), Centre Backrest (C), and Right Backrest (D) with Double Headed Screw (①) into the holes on the back side of Seat Board (A), align and flip Seat Board (A) up to expose the bottom of the sofa.

4-2: Put Gaskets (②), Spring Shims (⑥), and Nut (③) into Double Headed Screw (①) in order and tighten them with Wrenches (⑦).


**Note: This step requires two or three people to complete.**




- 5-1: Screw Double Headed Screw (①) into the four holes in Left Armrest (E) by hand and tighten the screws in this step.
- 5-2: Screw Double Headed Screw (①) into the four holes in Right Armrest (F) by hand and tighten the screws in this step.

### Step 6




Align Sofa Wooden Legs (G) with the holes at both ends of the bottom of Right Armrest (F) and use Allen Wrench (⑧) to tighten the Gaskets (⑤), and Single Head Screw (④) in sequential order.  
Do the same for Left Armrest (E).

### Step 7




Place Left Armrest (E) and Seat Board (A) vertically on the ground, put Left Armrest (E) and Seat Board (A) close together, and lock Gaskets (②), Spring Shims (⑥), and Nut (③) on Double Headed Screw (①) with Wrenches (⑦), and tighten the screws in this step.

### Step 8




Place Right Armrest (F) and Seat Board (A) vertically on the ground, put Right Armrest (F) and Seat Board (A) close together, and lock Gaskets (②), Spring Shims (⑥), and Nut (③) on Double Headed Screw (①) with Wrenches (⑦), and tighten the screws in this step.

### Step 9




Fit Middle Leg (H) in the centre of the bottom of Seat Board (A) and flip the whole couch back over.

### Step 10



Put Cushion (I) on the sofa.

Your sofa is ready for use.

**This sofa should only be used on flat, level surfaces.**

### Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
