#### Care & Maintenance







 Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



• Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



 Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.



Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

### Assembly Steps




This Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the <u>Sofa</u> parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.


Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly. Note:It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly

#### Step 1




Position the Seat Base(A) and Backrest(B),Left Armrest(C),Right Armrest(D),Right Leg(E),Left Leg(F),Foot Cross Dar(G),Seat Cushion(H),Back Cushion(I) onaclean,non-marring surface, as shown. Do not place on surface that can scratch or damage the upholstery.

Take out Middle leg and Hardwares from the bottom of Seat Base(A).



Assemble the hardware with the rings on the Legs (E, F) with Foot Cross Dar (G) using Wooden Tenon(6), Full Thead Bolt (5), Crescent Washer(7), Spring Washer (4), Nut (8), and Open-End Wrench (1), repeat this step to install the other Leg (E, F)

#### Step 3




Use Bolts (1), Washers (3) and Spring Washers (4), Wooden Tenon (6) and the Allen Wrench (11) on top to connect the Seat (A) to the Leg (E, F)

Tighten each bolt completely in order.

Don't tighten one bolt all the and then move on to the next.

Instead, gradually tighten each bolt in order until all the bolts are evenly secured.

#### Step 4




Assemble the base as shown in the picture and then turn it over.

Connect the Foot Cross Dar (G) to the Seat Base (A), Bolts (2), Washers (3), Spring Washers (4) and Angle Iron (9) and the Allen Wrench (11) above.

Ten the bolts in order completely. Assemble the Middle Leg (J) to the Seat Base (A).

Do not completely tighten one bolt at a time and then to the next.


Instead, gradually tighten each bolt in order until all the bolts are evenly secured.



Align the Left Armrest(C) buckle with the Backrest(B) buckle and secure it firmly.

Repeat this step to install another Right Armrest(D)

### Step 6



Assemble the base group according to the picture,


and connect the Armrest (C,D) to the Backrest (B) with Bolts (1), Washers (3), Spring Washers (4) and Wooden Tenon(6) and the Allen Wrench (11) on top.

Tighten the bolts order completely.

Do not completely tighten one bolt at a time and then continue with the next.


Instead, gradually tighten each bolt in order until all bolts are evenly secured

#### Step 7



Turn the sofa unit over and then place the Seat Cushion (H) and the Back Cushion (I).

#### Step 8



Your 3 SEATER SOFA is ready for use.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water. Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?
- If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals. By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
