# Hardware Package (included): Mounting Plate Unit (A) Mounting Screw (B) Wire Connector (C) Bolt Nut (D)


### **Installation Steps**

#### Turn off the power at fuse or circuit box.


- 1. Unscrew the bolt nuts (D), take out the mounting plate unit (A), then attach to the outlet box by using two mounting screws (B).
- 2. Attach the tube onto the threaded pipe of the fixture.
- 3. Rod Connections:
  - a. Thread the fixture wire from the fixture through the lower rod, then secure the lower rod onto fixture using the threaded pipe.
  - b. Thread the fixture wire through the middle rod, and then secure the middle rod onto the lower rod using the threaded pipe.
  - c. Thread the fixture wire through the upper rod, and then secure the upper rod onto the middle rod using the threaded pipe.

Note: Length adjustable from 20" to 74". Use fewer rods if shorter length is desired.

- Thread the fixture wire through the canopy kit, then secure the rod assembly to the set threaded pipe of the canopy kit.
- 5. Pull out the wires and ground wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire connectors (C) as follows:
  - ---Connect the hot wire (black insulation) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
  - ---Connect the neutral wire (white insulation) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
  - ---Attach the fixture ground wire (bare wire) to the mounting plate unit (A) with the green ground screw, then connect it to the house ground wire with the wire connector (C). Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.
- Attach the canopy kit to the mounting plate unit (A) by inserting the fixture mounting screws, then secure it with two bolt nuts (D).
- Install 5 X 60W Max. medium base bulbs (not included).
   See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.








- 8. Secure the threaded pipe into coupling of the fixture and tighten it with hex nut.
- 9. Slip the metal pad, diffuser and decorative cup up through the threaded pipe and then secure them with the finial.


NOTE: The depth of hex nut in threaded pipe may need to be adjusted to properly fit the diffuser. The diffuser should be flatly laid on five brackets, and the frosting of the diffuser should be faced down.

10. Angled mounting recommended for a vaulted or angled ceiling. (See Fig.1)

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit box.

1 Year Warranty
