Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



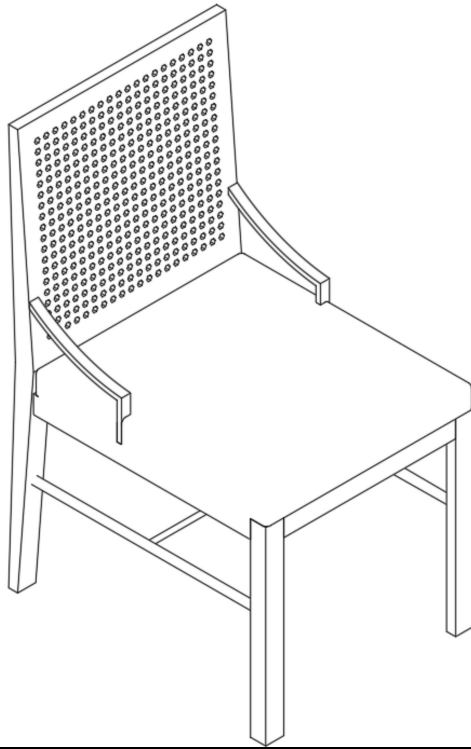
- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.










- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



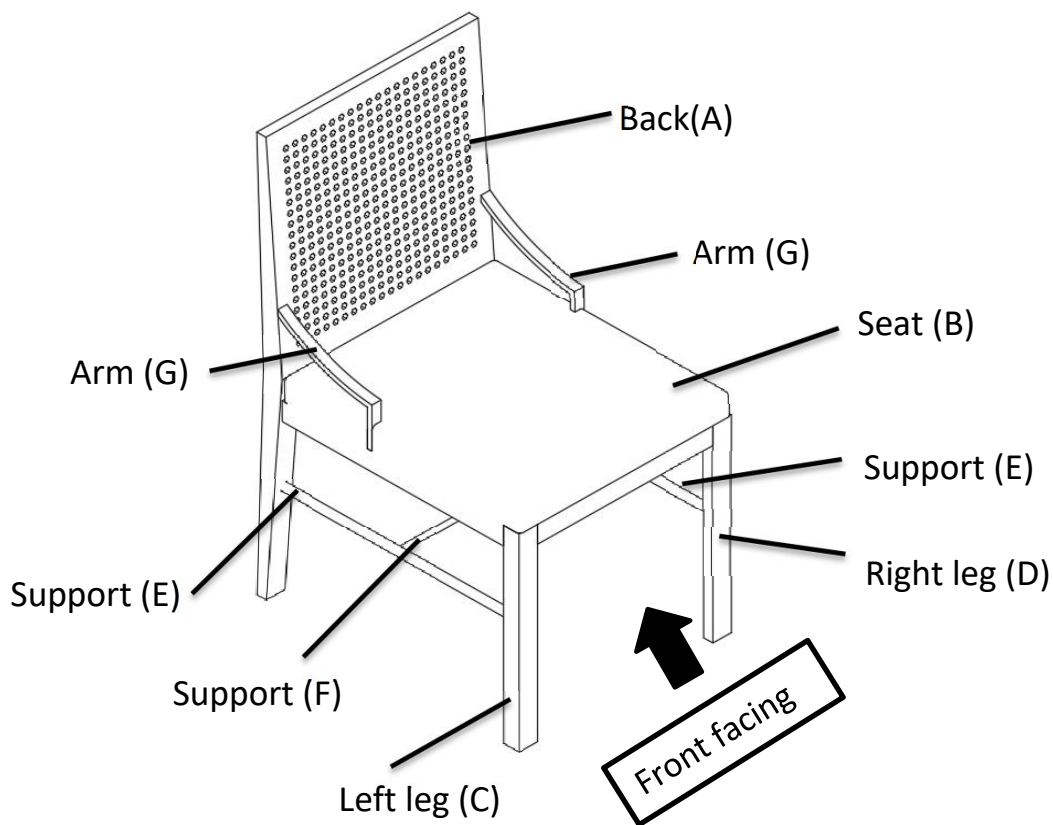
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

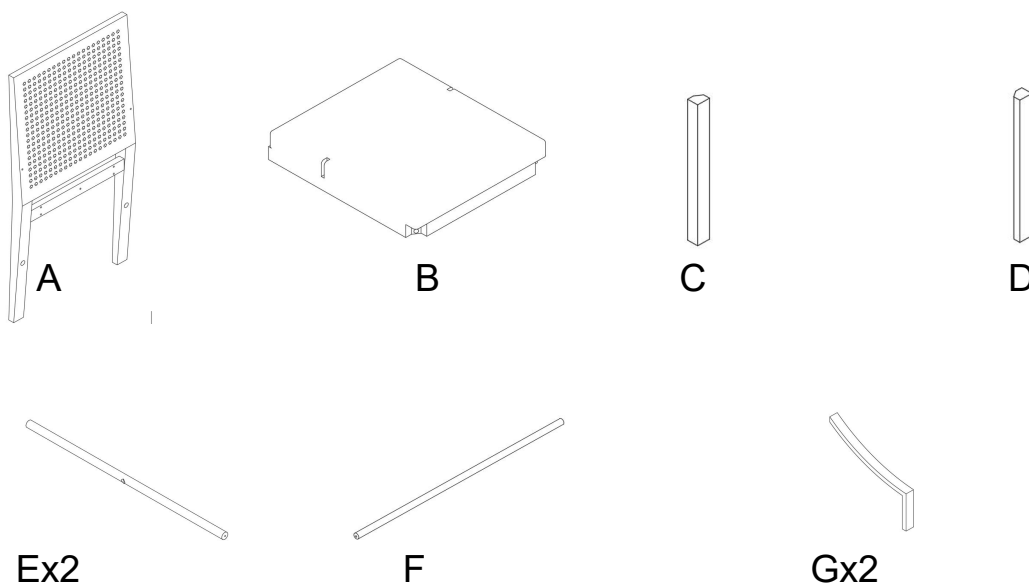
Assembly Steps

Overview



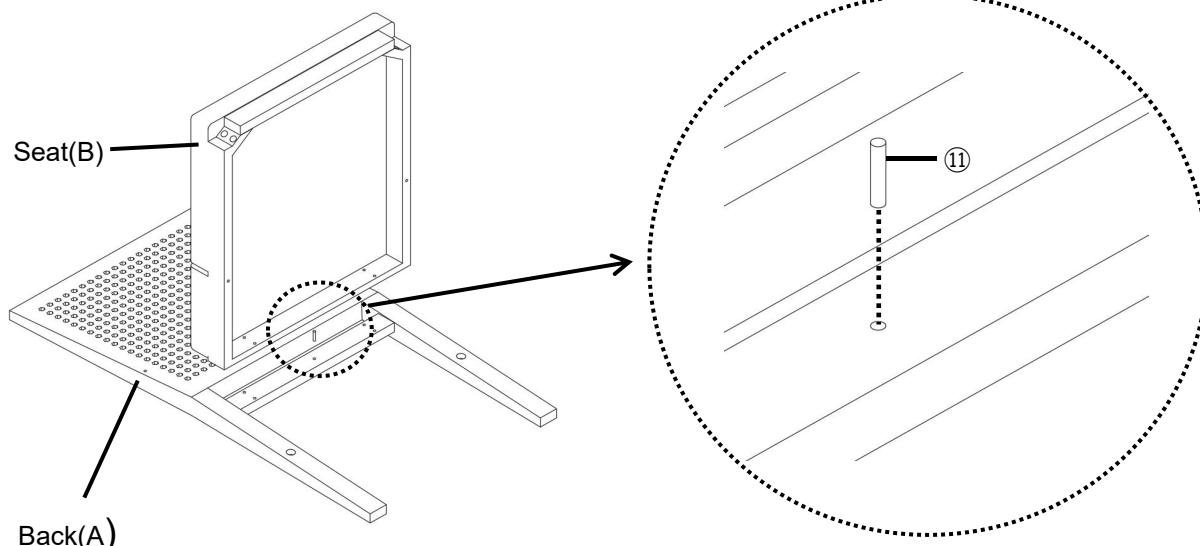
This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



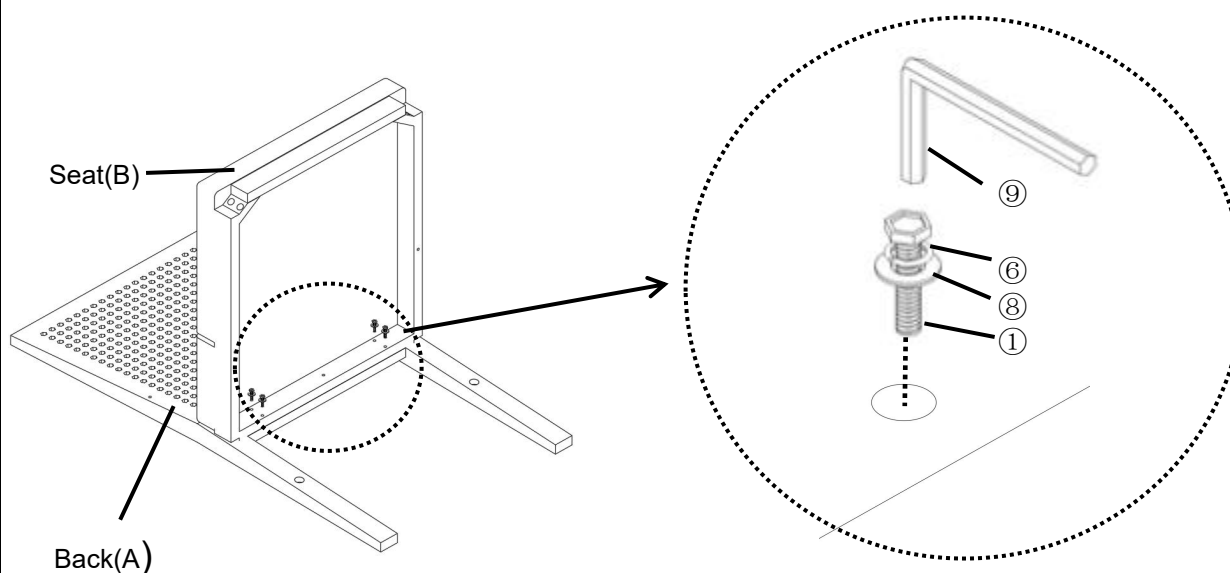
Unpack and place all the parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



Slot the wood plug(Ⓘ) into the position hole on the Back(A) and slot another end of wood plug into the position hole of Seat(B),as shown above.

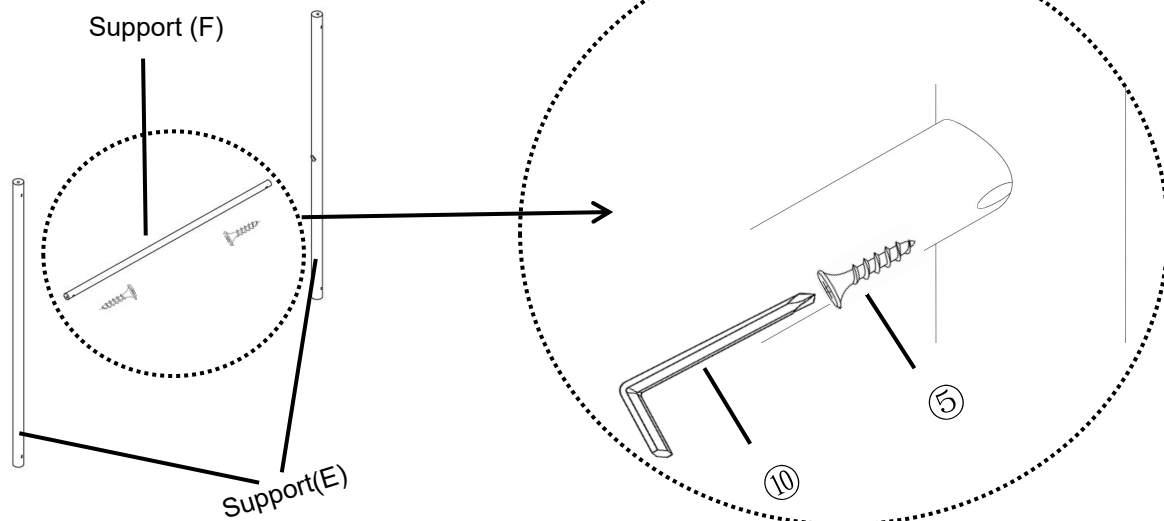
Step 3



Attach the Seat(B) into the Back(A) using bolts(Ⓐ), Spring washer(Ⓖ) and Washer(Ⓗ) with Allen wrench(Ⓘ).

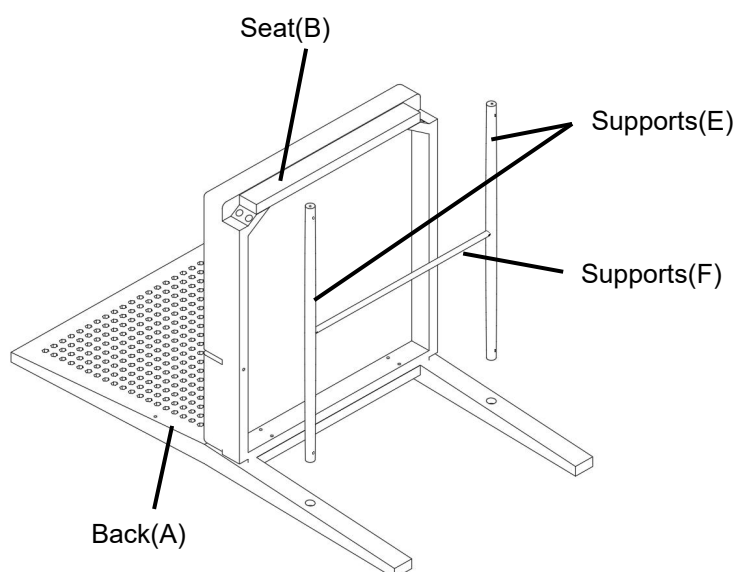
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 4



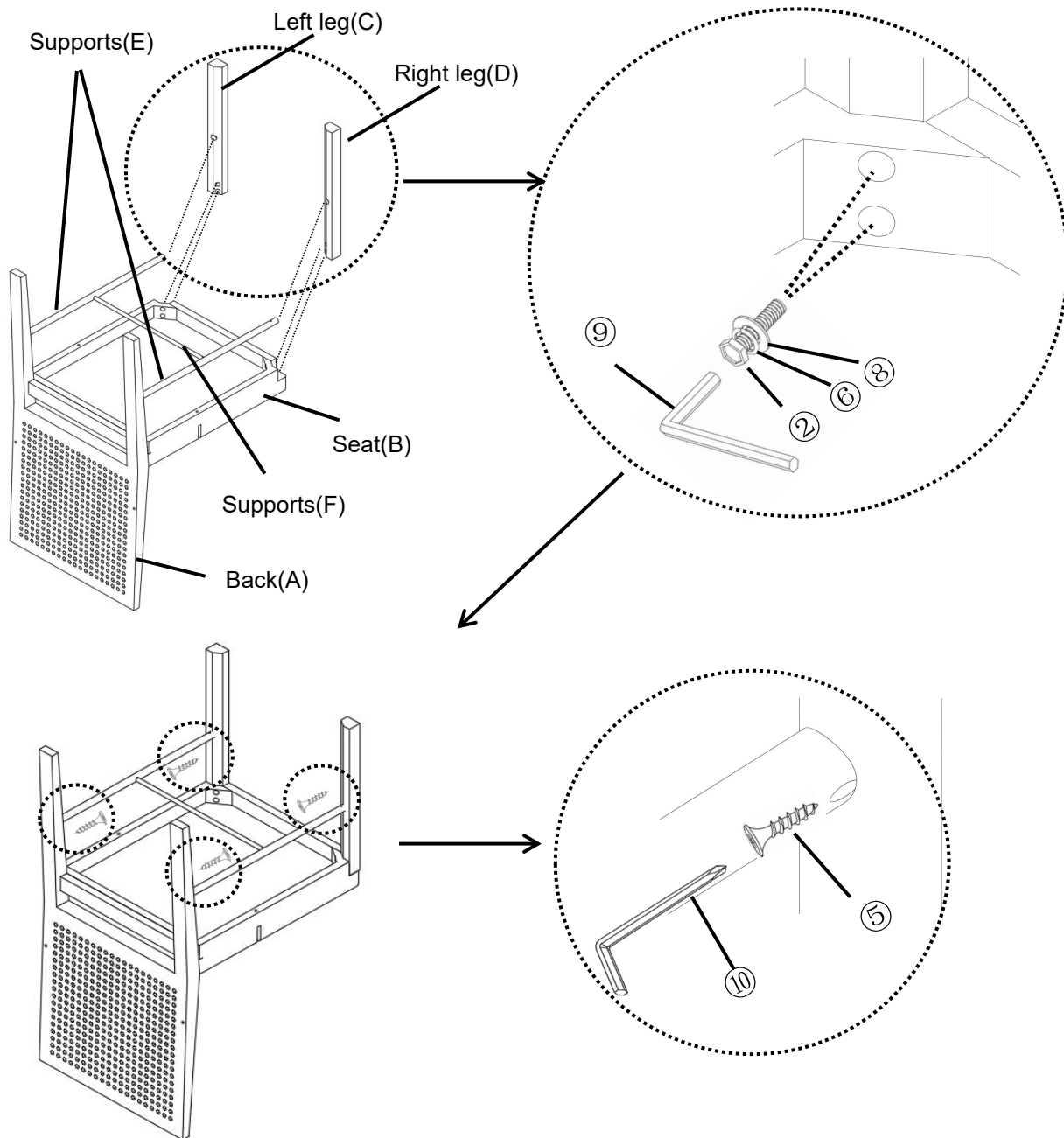
Insert the Support(F) into the mounting positions of the Supports(E) using Screws(⑤), with the Allen wrench(⑩).
Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 5



Insert the Support(E) into the mounting positions of the Back(A).

Step 6

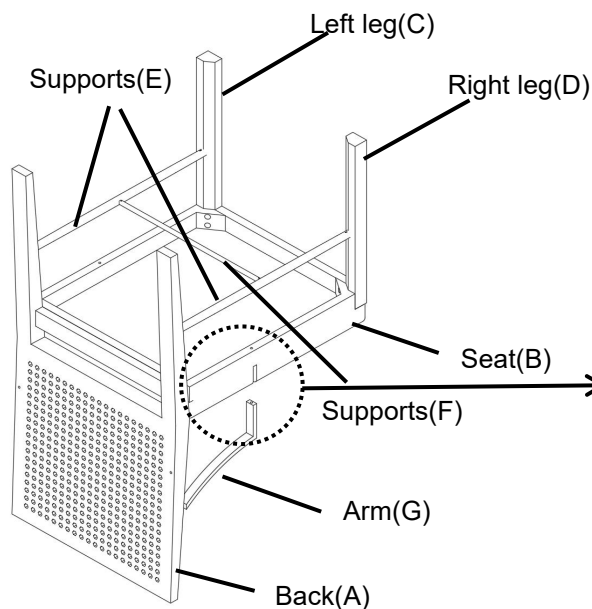


6.1) Attach the Legs(C+D) into the Seat(B) using bolts(②), Spring washer(⑥) and Washer(⑧) with Allen wrench(⑨).

6.2) Attach the Supports(E) into the mounting positions of Legs(C+D) and Back(A) using Screws(⑤) with the Allen wrench(⑩).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

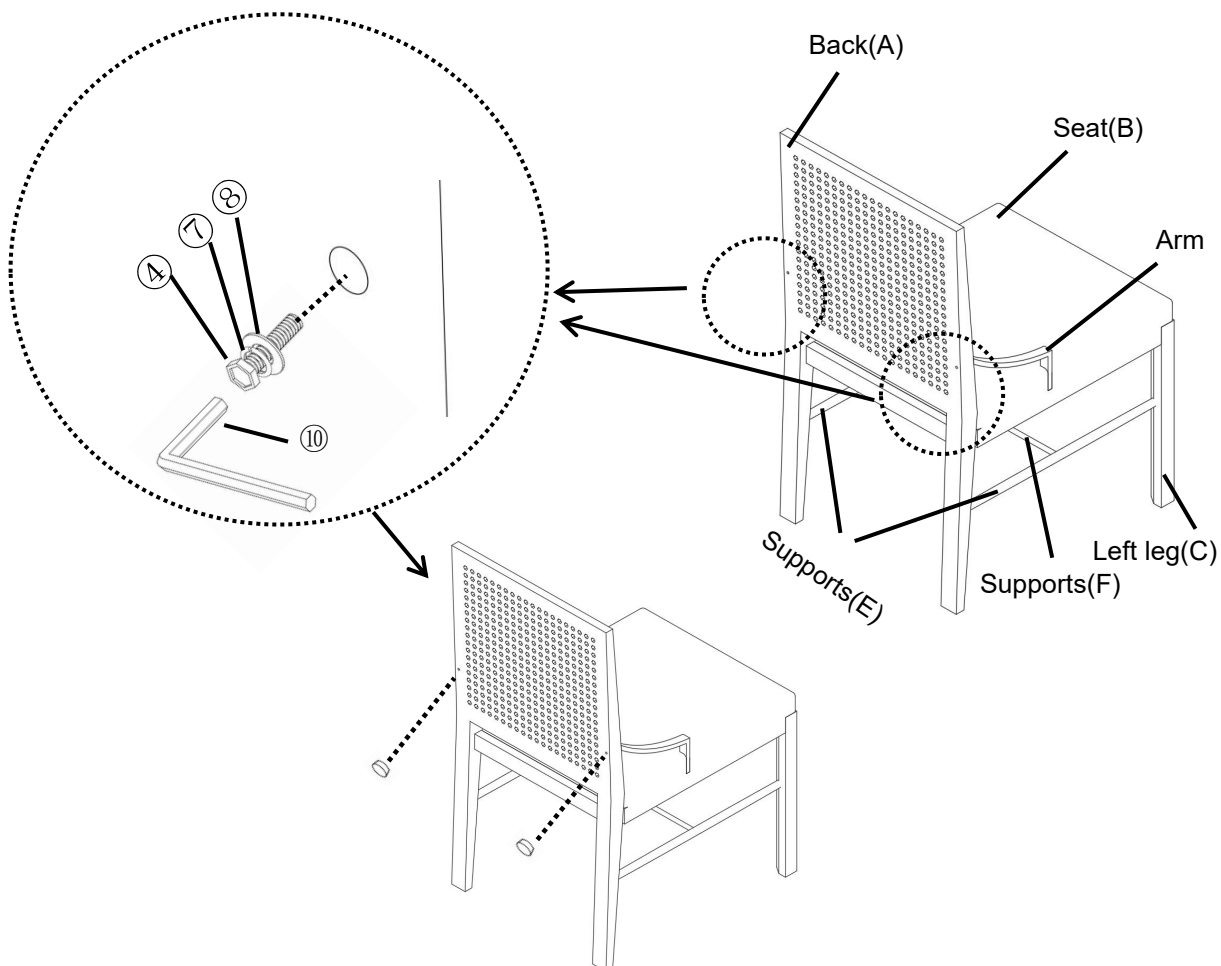
Step 7



Attach the Arms(G) into the Seat(B) using bolts(③), Spring washer(⑦) and Washer(⑧) with Allen wrench(⑩).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 8

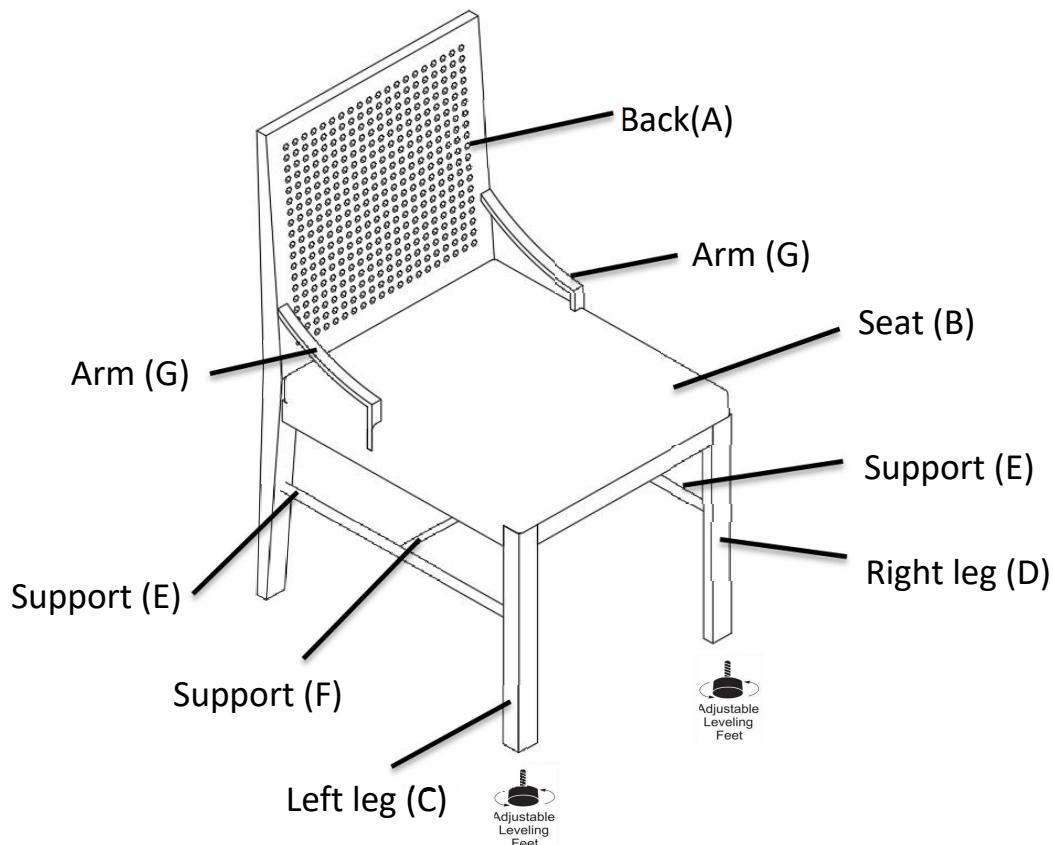


8.1) Attach the Arms(G) into the Back(A) using bolts(④), Spring washer(⑦) and Washer(⑧) with Allen wrench(⑩).

8.2) Cover the mounting positions with the caps(⑫).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 9



9.1) Tighten all the remaining bolts.

DO NOT fully tighten a bolt in one go and then move on to the next. Rather, in a sequential manner, gradually tighten each bolt until all bolts are evenly secured. This methodology will ensure maximum evenness once all bolts are fully tightened.

9.2) Adjust Pre-installed Levellers height to achieve balance.

Your Chair is ready for use.
