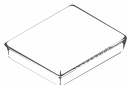

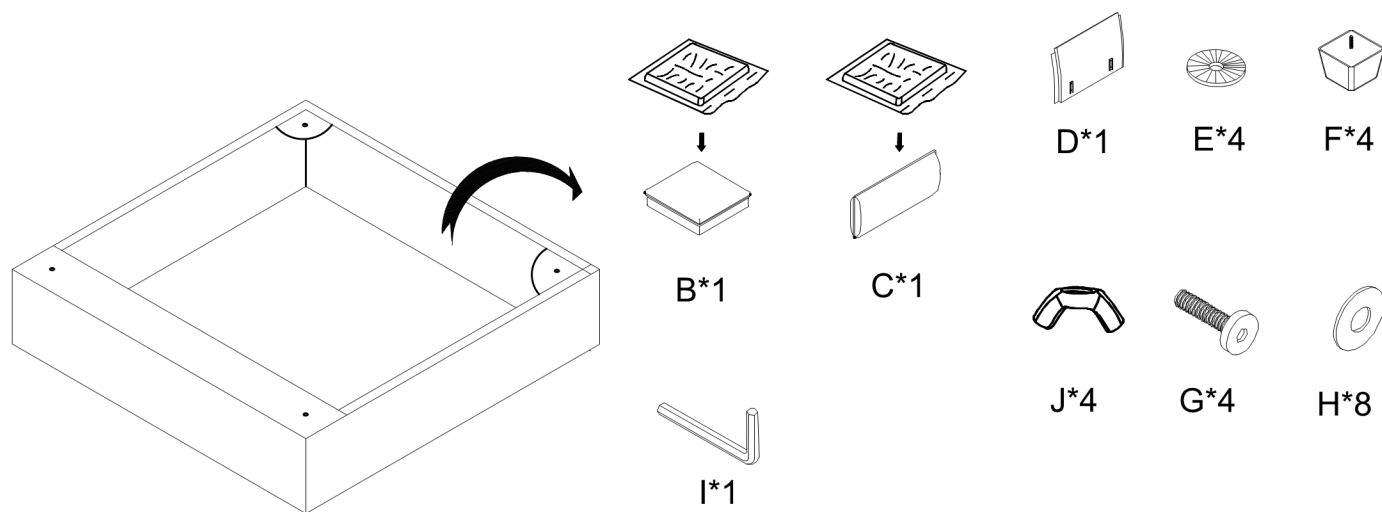
### Armless chair



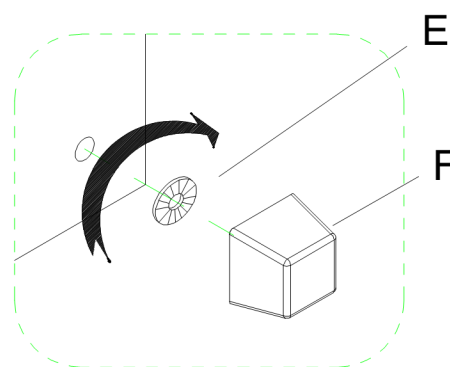
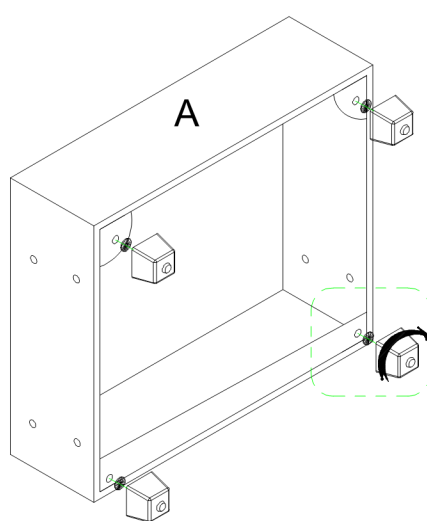
NOTE: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood.

### **Care Instruction for Chenille Furniture:**

**In order to maintain the original appearance of your Chenille furniture, please follow below simple care procedures:**

**Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets.**

**Sunlight and/or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage Chenille. Vacuum or wipe with a soft cloth to remove dust.**

**Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight, Re-tighten if necessary.**

**For item use on wooden floor,hard surfaces or carpets,it is recommended to install protective pads under all legs and supports to avoid/prevent from damages/scratches and discoloration.**
