 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.


Attach metal latch( ) to top board(A) with screw( ),attach metal latch( ) to top board(B) with screw( ). Insert metal bar( ) to connect with top board(A) and top board(B) using allen  $key(\widehat{\mathbb{1}})$ .

Step 2




Close metal latch( ) to lock metal latch( ).






Attach the wood support(C) between top board(A) and top board (B) with bolt( $^{\circ}$ ) and washer( $^{\circ}$ ) using allen key( $^{\circ}$ 1).


Step 4




Insert left metal top(D) to right metal top(E), fix them with bolt ( ) using allen key(1).




Attach assembled metal top to side pedestal(F) with bolt( ) and washer( ) using allen key(1).



Attach assembled metal top to pedestal board(G) with bolt( $\$ ) and washer( $\$ ) using allen key(11).








Attach assembled metal base to assembled pedestal with bolt( ) and washer( ) using allen key(1).
