## Care & Maintenance

• Not for commercial use. For residential use only.




• Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-




Save all packaging until finished-


### **Assembly Steps**



This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instruction below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Unpack and place all part on a clean, non-marring surface



Place the Back Frame (A) facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface.

- 2.1) Attach Seat(B) using Bolt(2) + Lock Washer(3) + Flat Washer(4) with Allen Wrench (5).
- 2.2) Attach Seat(B) using Bolt(1) + Lock Washer(3) + Flat Washer(4) with Allen Wrench (5).


Do not fully tighten the Bolts



Place the face down on the mattress facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface.


- 3.1) Insert Left Side Stretcher(E) Right Side Stretcher(F) into the mountings in the Back Frame(A).
- 3.2) Insert Front Stretcher(G) to the Left(C) Right(D) Chair Leg
- 3.3) Into the mounting in the Seat(B) using Hex Nut(7) + Lock Washer(3) + Flat Washer(4) with Open Spanner(8)

Do not fully tighten the Bolts



Screw up Stretcher(F), (E), (G) with Leg Chair by inserting Screw(6) using the Screwdriver (NOT PROVIDED).

"Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

• What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust. "
