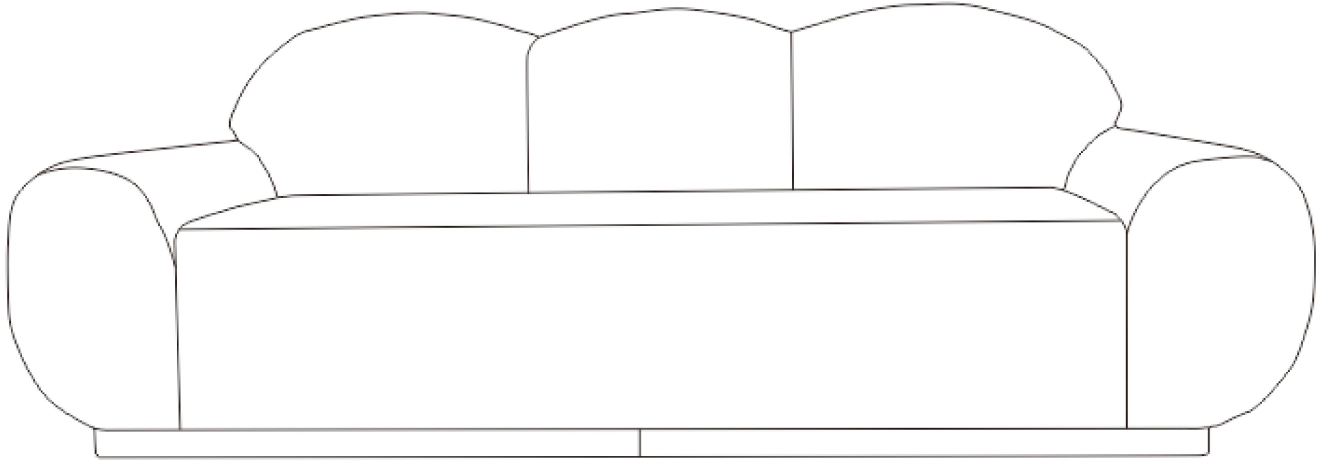

## Care & Maintenance




- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
  - ✓  • Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
  - ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
  - ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
  - ⊘  • Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
  - ⊘  • Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
  - ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
  - ⊘  • Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
  - ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
  - ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.



Please look in sofa for hardware packs and legs.

## 3-SEATER SOFA














## Overview

Three-seater Sponge Sofa (C)



Note: L-type Steel Pipe (D) and U-type Steel Pipe (E) are not visible here because they are located behind and above the Left Wooden Base Frame (A) and the Right Wooden Base Frame (B).

This 3-Seater Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

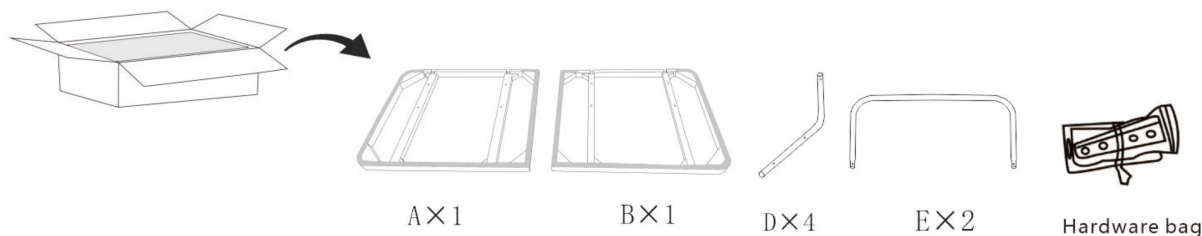
To give you an overview of the 3-Seater Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.

## Step 1

Cardboard box 2-1

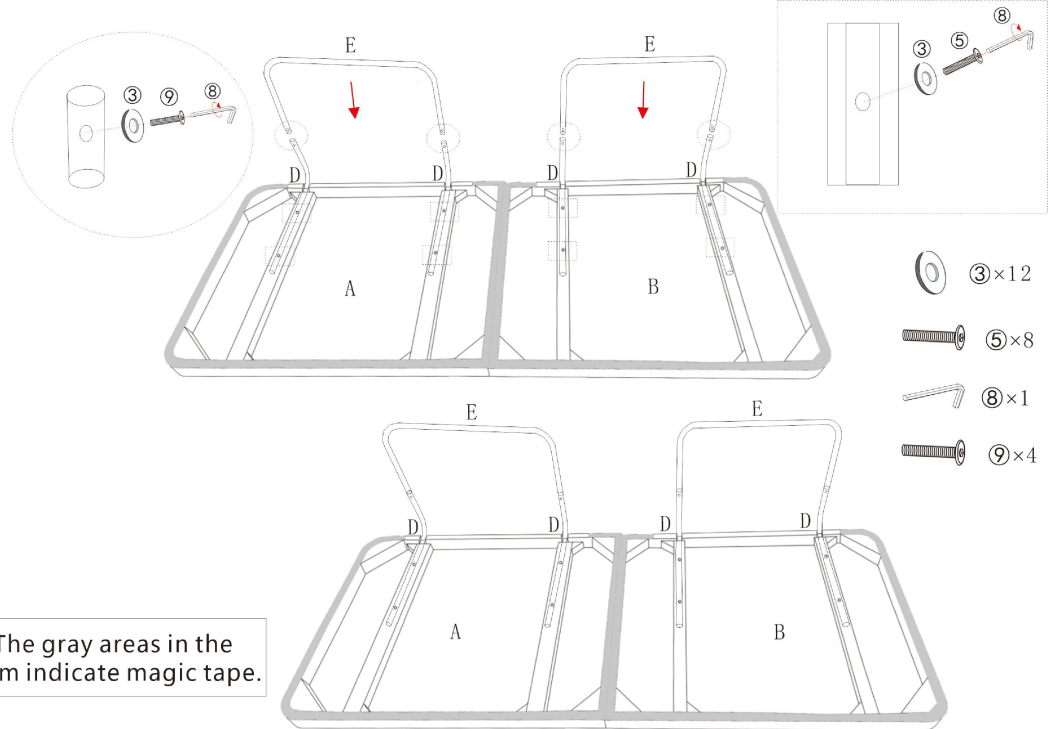


Remove the Left Wooden Base Frame (A), Right Wooden Base Frame (B), L-type Steel Pipe (D), U-type Steel Pipe (E), and hardware accessories bag from carton 2-2. Place them on a clean, flat surface free of scratches.

<p><b>Step 2</b></p>	<p>Cardboard box 2-2</p> 
<p>Remove the compressed package from the cardboard box.</p>	
<p><b>Step 3</b></p>	 <p>Cx1</p>
<p>Unfold the compressed package flat. Use a blade to cut along one edge of the package. Remove the Three-seater Sponge Sofa (C) and place them on a clean, flat surface free of scratches.</p>	
<p><b>Step 4</b></p>	 <p>Note: The gray areas in the diagram indicate magic tape.</p>

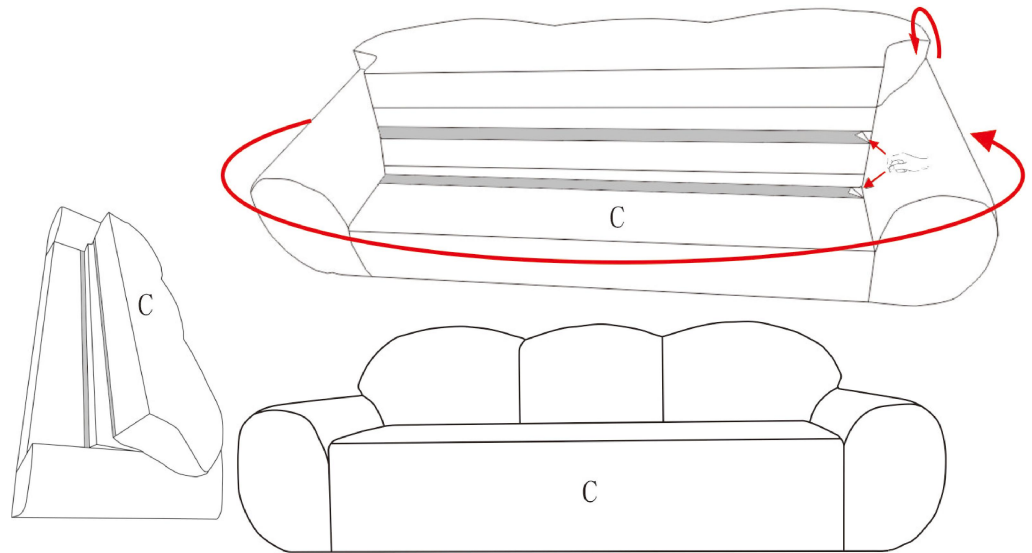
As shown in the figure: Align the holes on both sides of the Left Wooden Base Frame (A) with those on the Right Wooden Base Frame (B). Secure them together using a Single Head Screw (①), Spring Shims (④), and Gaskets(③) on the left side, and a Spring Shims (④), Nut (②), and Wrenches(⑥) on the right side.

### Step 5



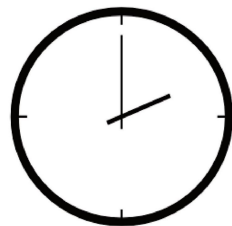
As shown in the figure, align the L-type Steel Pipe (D) vertically with the Left Wooden Base Frame (A) and the Right Wooden Base Frame (B). Insert the Gaskets (③) and Single Head Screw (⑤) into their corresponding overlapping holes in sequence, then tighten them with a Allen Wrench (⑧). Connect the U-type Steel Pipe (E) to the L-type Steel Pipe (D). Insert the Gaskets (③) and Single Head Screw (⑨) into their aligned holes, then tighten them with a Allen Wrench (⑧).

## Step 6



There is a piece of magic tape strips at each connection point between the backrest and the seat panel.

Peel off the protective paper from the two magic tape strips on each of the Three-seater Sponge Sofa (C). Lower the backrest and align it with the lower section, then rotate the Three-seater Sponge Sofa (C) to their front side.

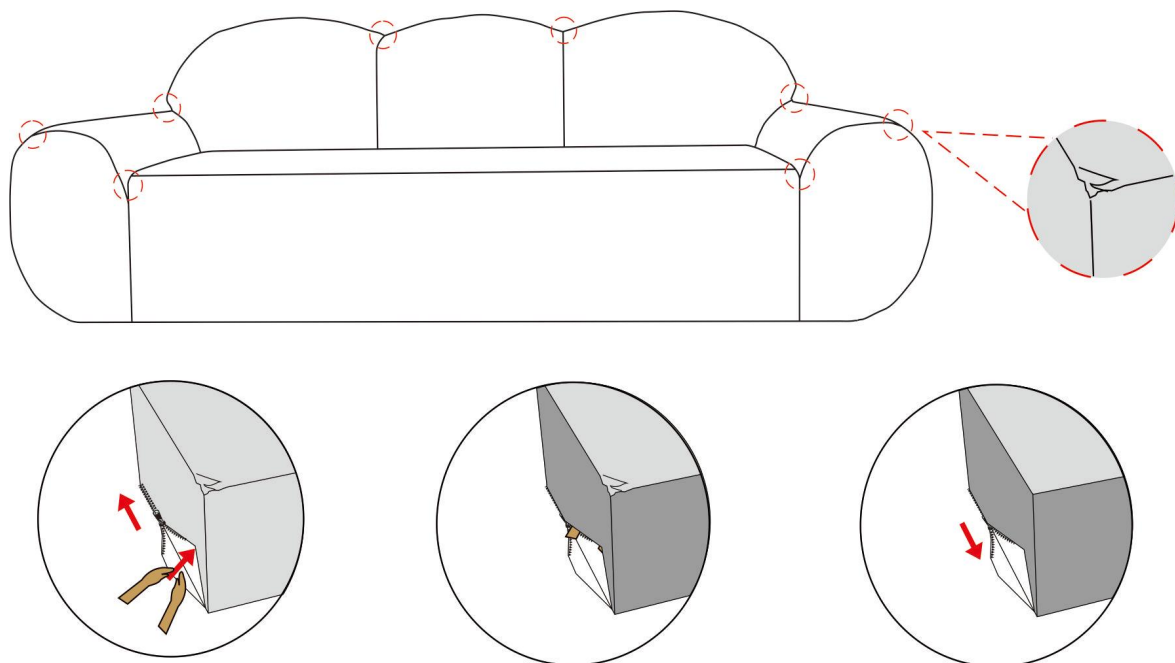

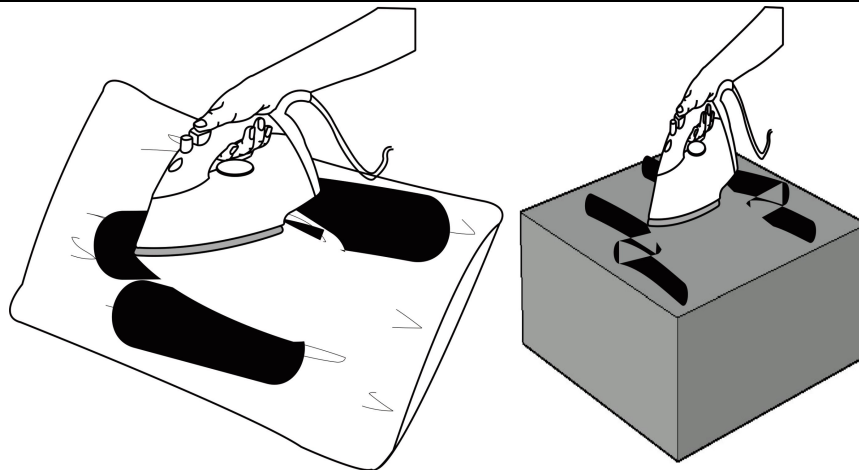
After opening the compression bag (Note: Please do not cut with a knife, so as not to damage to the product), the corners around the cushions if there are wrinkles, you need to wait for about 72 hours, it is recommended that guests pat and knead the corners of the sofa, in order to sponge better recovery.

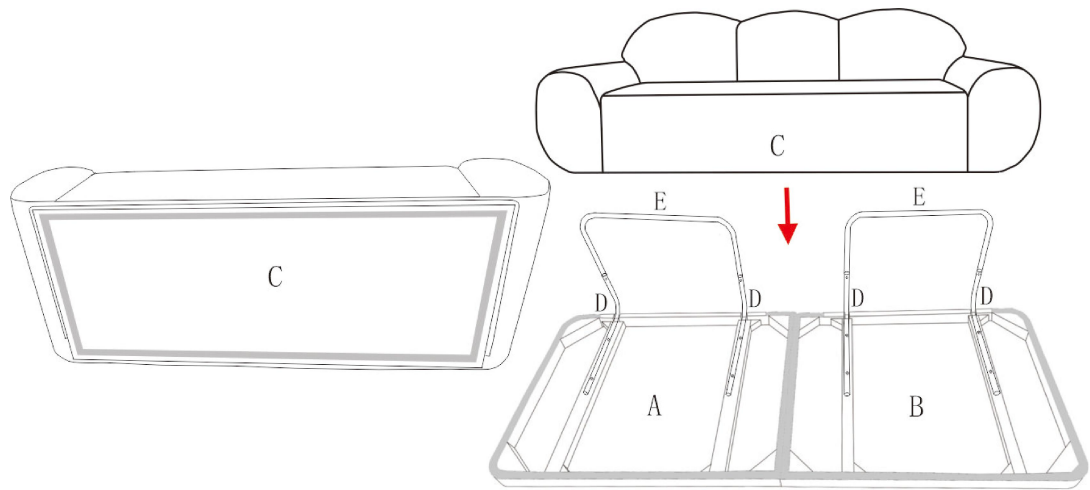


If you see the folds,Unzip the bottom ofthe product,Put your hand in,Gently pat and knead to tidy up theincreased sponge,Wait for the sponge to become fulland flat before Zip up the bottom of the product.



Partial wrinkles on the surface of the fabric can besmoothed out with an iron.

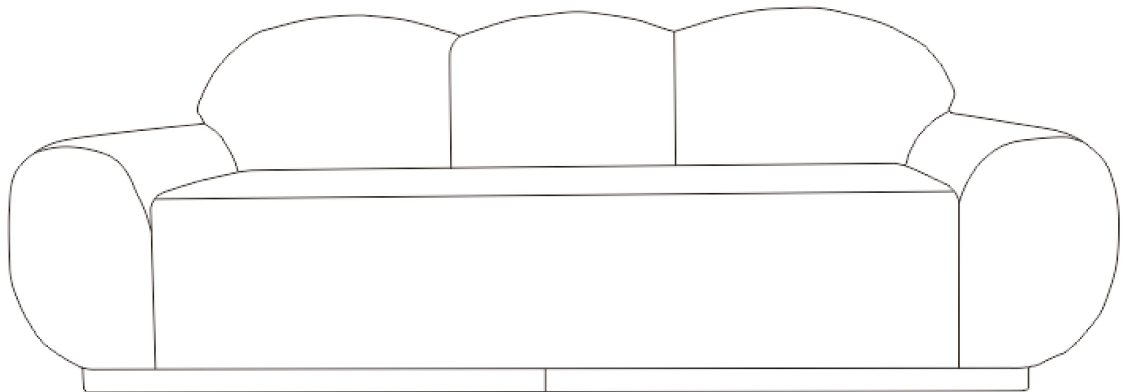
### Step 7



The base of the sofa features magic tape strips fasteners. To install, align these with the corresponding magic tape strips on the base frame.

As shown in the figure, place the Three-seater Sponge Sofa (C) on top of the Left Wooden Base Frame (A) and the Right Wooden Base Frame (B), ensuring they are aligned.

### Step 8



Your sofa is ready for use.

This sofa should only be used on flat, level surfaces.

## Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
