
















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











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








STEP 35

To install the Top (1) to the vanity (2). Apply silicone caulk to the top edge of the wood cabinet. With the help of another adult, gently lower the Sink top with assembled sink onto the cabinet. Make sure the Sink top is flush with the back side of the wood cabinet and the wood cabinet left and right side walls.





HINGE ADJUSTMENTS




1 Sideways / Tilt adjustment

Turn the screw

clockwise to move the door further away from
the side of the cabinet


anticlockwise to move the door closer to the

2 4 Height adjustment

While supporting the weight of the door, turn the screws

clockwise to move the door up anticlockwise to move the door down



3 Forward and back adjustment

If the gap between the back of the door and the cabinet is too small, and the door may not close fully. Turn the screw

clockwise to decrease the gap between the door and the cabinet

anticlockwise to increase the gap between the door and the cabinet
