Care & Maintenance

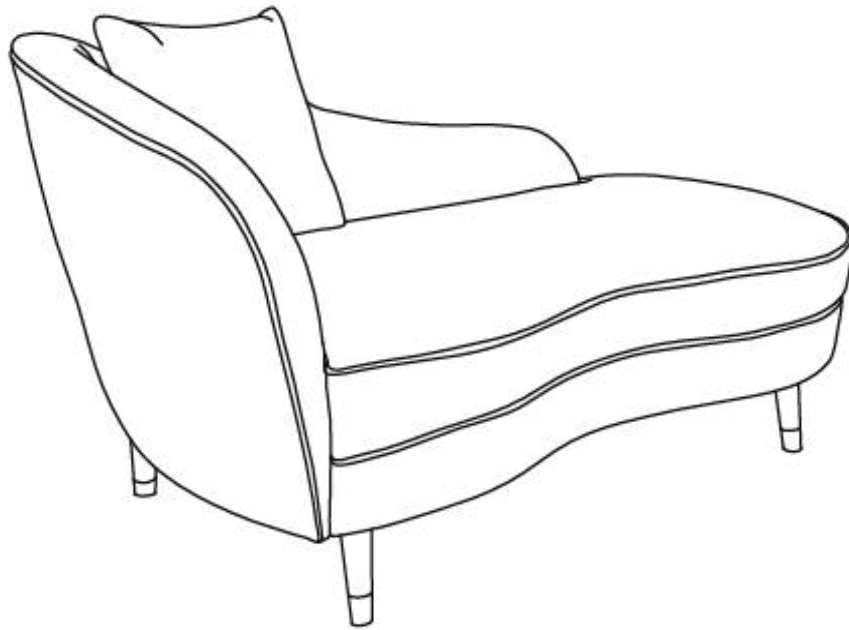
- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ✓  • Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.








- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.






Chaise Longue

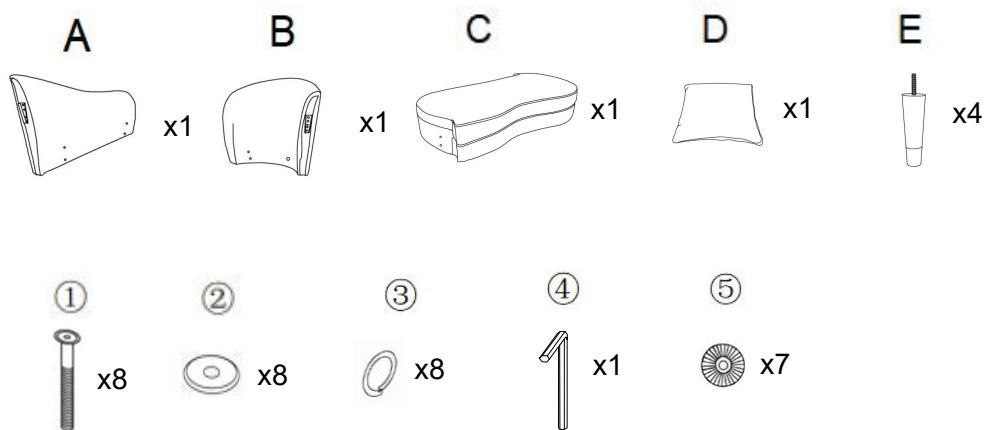

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



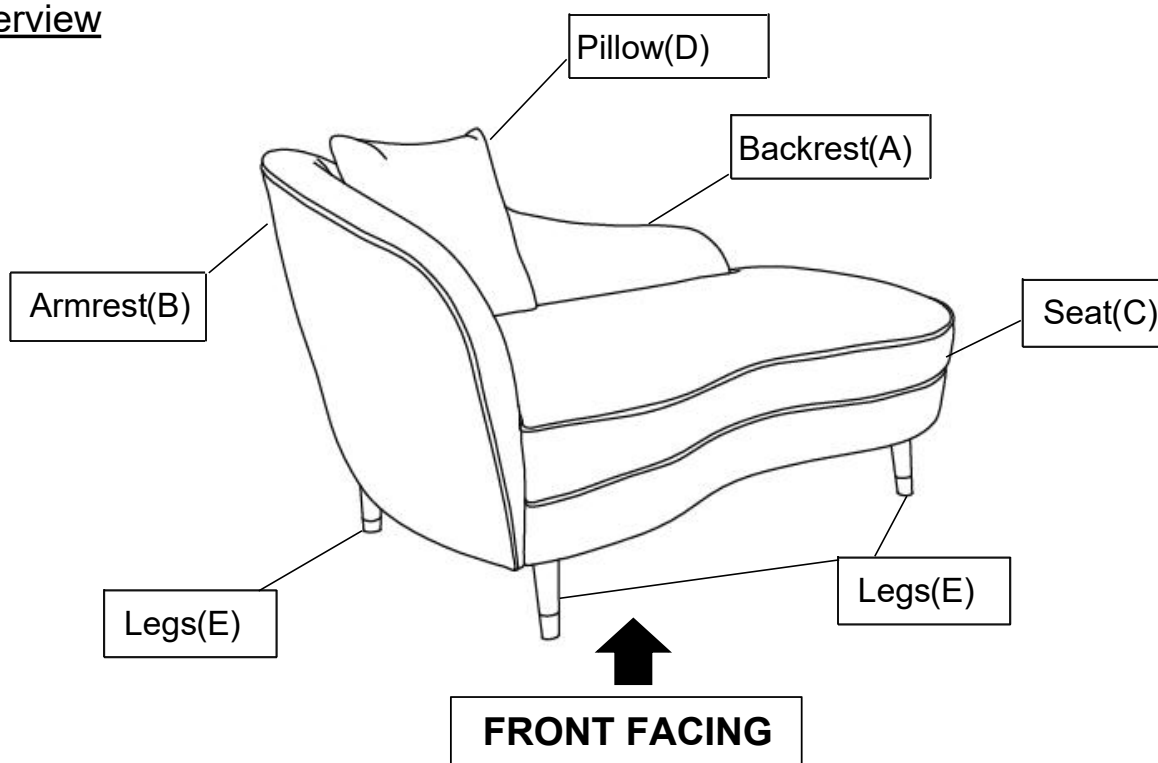
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

Overview

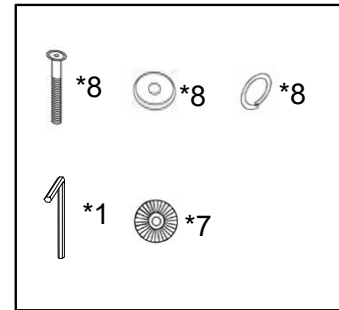
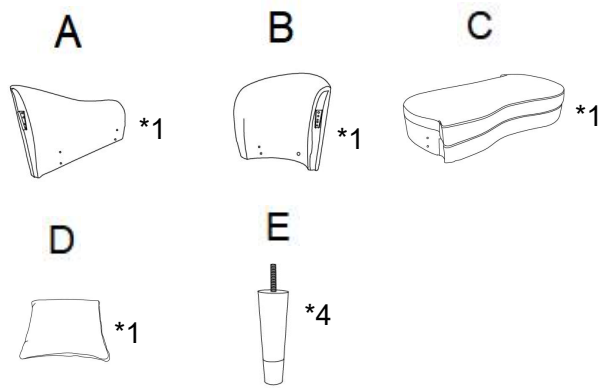


This Chaise Longue has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chaise Longue, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.

Step 1

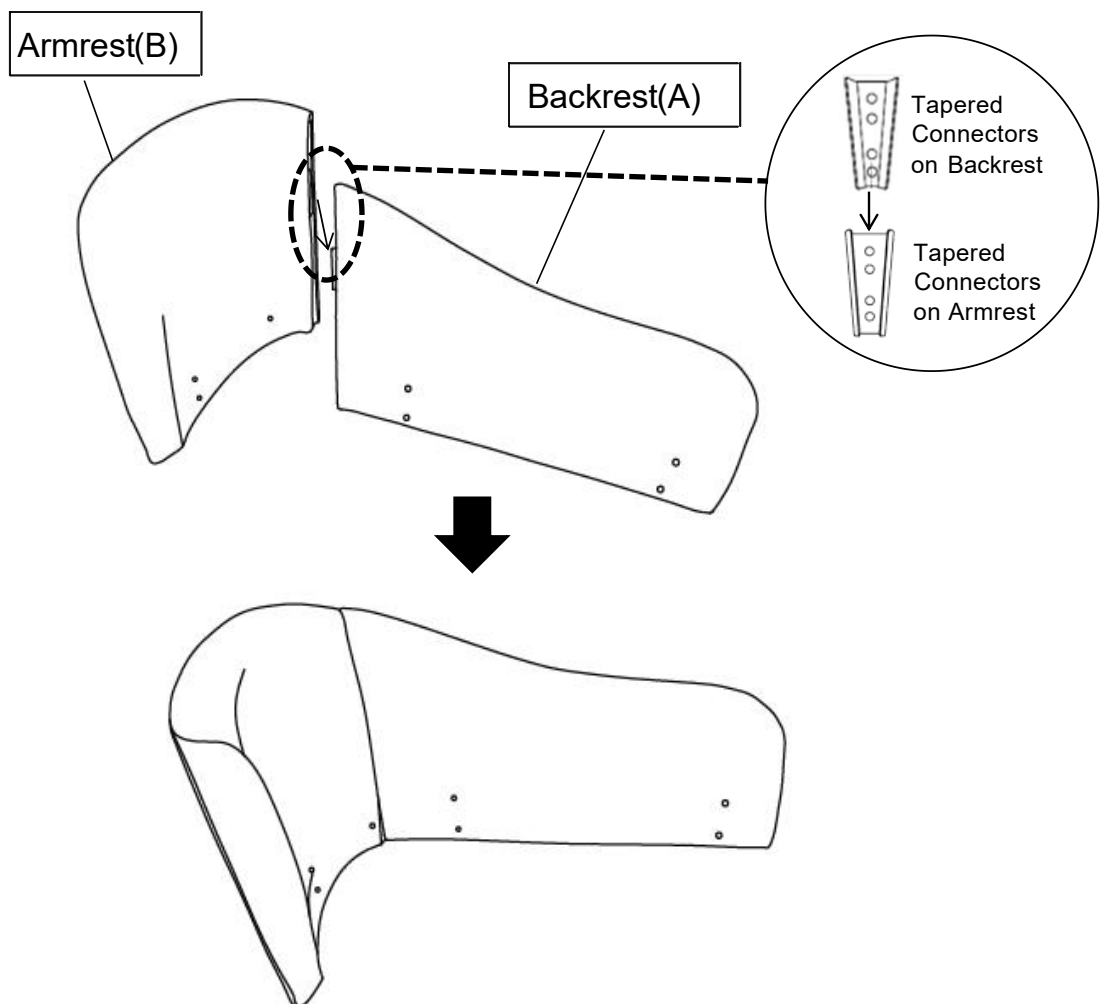


Position the Backrest(A) ,Armrest(B) ,Seat(C),Pillow(D) and Legs(E) on a clean, non-marring surface, as shown.

Do not place on surface that can scratch or damage the upholstery.

Take out the Hardwares from the BOX.

Step 2



With the assistance from your adult partner:

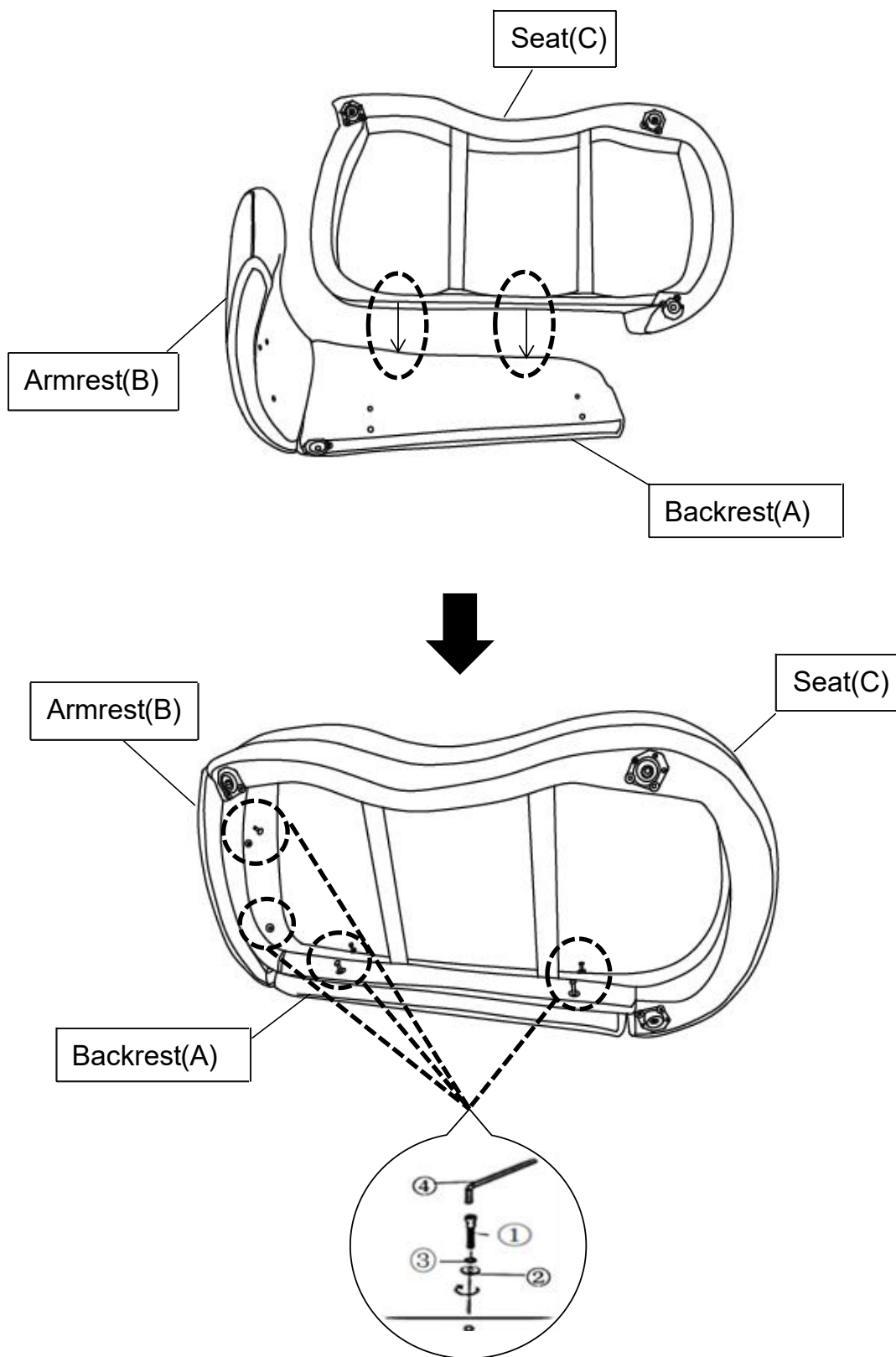
Lift the Armrest (B) up, make sure the Armrest (B) is vertical and aligned to the Backrest (A).

Align the Tapered Connectors on the Armrest (B) with which on the Backrest (A).

Your adult partner may need to push the Backrest in towards the Armrest (B) to allow for better alignment.

Slip and Slide the Armrest, in a gradual and balanced manner into the Tapered Connectors.

Step 3



Turn the assembled Backrest as picture shown.

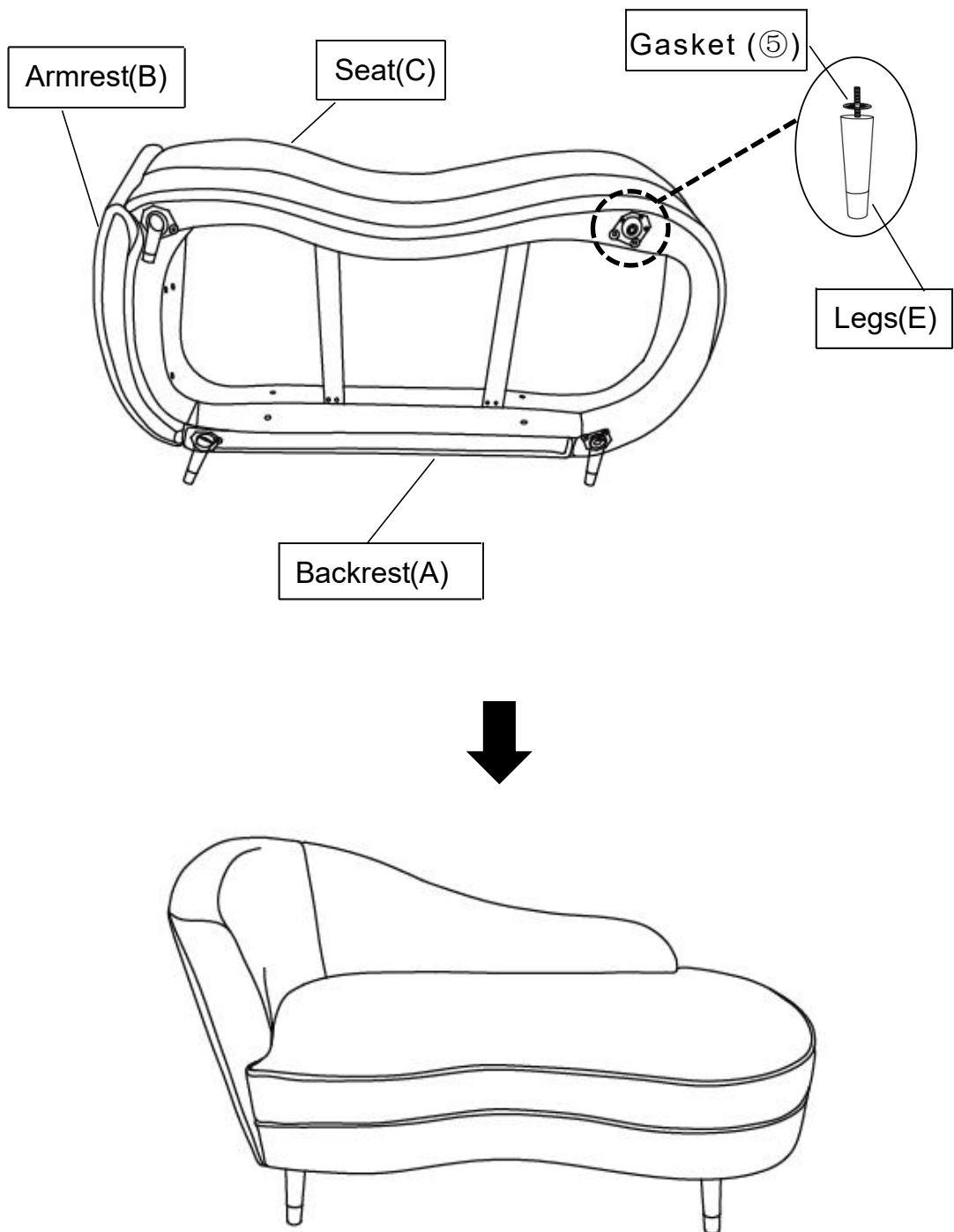
Attach Seat(C) to the Backrest(A) and Armrest(B) using Bolts(①), Washers(②) and Spring Washer(③) with the Allen Wrench (④) as pictured above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured.

Step 4



Install the Leg (E) onto the bottom of the Chaise Longue by placing one Gasket(5) on the threaded stem. Then insert the threaded stem into the threaded mounting position at the corner of the Chaise Longue.

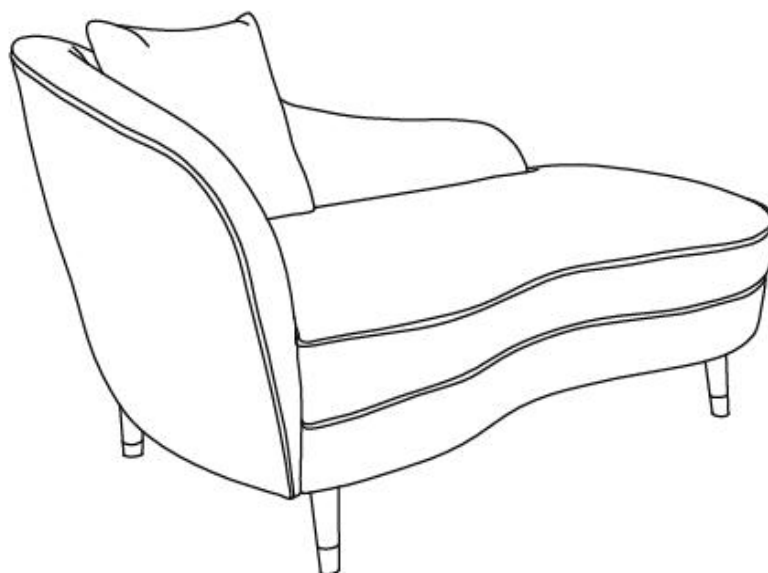
Tighten by turning the Leg clockwise.

Repeat this process with the remaining three Legs.

Note: The use of Gaskets are OPTIONAL and are especially useful to help alleviate slight wobble.

Some Legs may need more than one whilst some legs may not need any.

Step 5



Place the Pillows(D) onto the Chaise Longue.
Your Chaise Longue is ready for use.
This Chaise Longue can only be used on a flat, level surface.
