
Care & Maintenance

- ⊖  ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface
- ⊖  ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊖  ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊖  ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended
- ✓  ● and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and/or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊖  ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊖  ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  ● Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  ● Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Label	Picture	Description	QTY

Hardware

Label	Picture	Description	QTY
1	A standard screw with a flat head and a standard thread.	Screw (M6x40mm)	2
2	A standard screw with a flat head and a standard thread, slightly longer than the first.	Screw (M6x50mm)	4
3	A standard screw with a flat head and a standard thread, the longest of the three.	Screw (M6x70mm)	2
4	A bolt with a hex head and a standard thread.	Bolt (M6x40mm)	4
5	A bolt with a hex head and a standard thread, longer than the first.	Bolt (M6x70mm)	2
6	A standard Allen wrench (hex key).	Allen Wrench	1


Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:	①x2	②x2	③x2	④x4	⑤x2	⑥x1
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• Read instructions, cover to cover-
• Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-
• Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-
• Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-
• Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps

Overview



This Chair can take up to 15 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the table parts, the image above will give you a better idea of each part. Please read the instructions below carefully to familiarize yourself with the parts and steps before assembling.


Step 1



Do not tighten (50%)

Secure the 2 braces D to the right arm A of the chair with screw (2), screw (3), and allen wrench (6)



Step 2



Do not tighten (50%)

Secure the 2 braces D to the left arm B of the chair with screw (2), screw (3), and allen wrench (6)



Step 3



Tighten at this step

Secure the Backrest C to the Seater D of the chair with screw (2) and allen wrench (6)



Step 4



Do not tighten (50%)

Secure the Backrest C and Seater D the right arm A of the chair with bolt (4), bolt (5) and allen wrench (6)

Step 5



Tighten all bolts

Secure the Backrest C and Seater D the left arm B of the chair with bolt (4), bolt (5) and allen wrench (6)

Secure the backrest C to the left arm left B, and arm right A of the chair using the bolt (1) and hex wrench (6)
