## Care & Maintenance

- ∅ 
  - Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ✓ 
  - Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
- ∅ 
  - Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ∅ 
  - Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ∅ 
  - Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
- ∅ 
  - Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
- ∅ 
  - Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ∅ 
  - Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
- ∅ 
  - Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ∅ 
  - Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ✓ 
  - Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

NEVER suspend strings over bed.


NEVER place items with astring, cord, or ribbon, such as hood strings or pacifercords, around a child's neck. These items may catch on bed parts.

ALWAYS follow assembly instructions.

Not intended for children under the age of six. INFANTS HAVE DIED FROMBECOMING ENTRAPPED IN BEDs. Openings in and between bed parts can entrap the neck and head of a small child.

NEVER use bed for child under the age of six.

The mattress must be appropriately sized for the bed. If the mattress is undersized dangerous gaps can exits and a person can become entrapped or entangled in the frame and suffocate




## ASSEMBLY STEPS




This bed has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the upholstered bed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.


First step Unpack and place all part on a clean, non-marring surface.

## STEP 2




Next step Right leg headboard ⑥ Left leg headboard ⑦ Assemble Wooden dowel 10\*30mm ⑧ Threaded heads 5/16\*75mm ⑨ as shown

## STEP 3




Next step is to attach Metal link U32\*40MM ⑩ to the Crossbar under the headboard ⑤ using Vis umbrella head 3.5\*15mm ⑪ using screwdriver to tighten

## STEP 4




Next step: Right leg headboard connection ⑥ Left leg headboard ⑦ Crossbar under the headboard ⑤ Use hardware Half moon washer R35mm ⑩ Flat washer 2\*8\*15mm ⑪ Hex nut K12 ⑫ Use key Open wrench K12mm ⑬ to tighten

## STEP 5




Next step is to connect the assembled cluster in step 4 with Headboard 1 ① Headboard 2 ② using Wooden dowel 10\*30mm ⑬

## STEP 6




Next step use the assembly just assembled in step 5 to connect with Headboard back bar 1 ③ Headboard back bar 2 ④ connect with hardware bolt 5/16\*55 ① bolt 5/16\*40mm ① flat washer 2\*8\*15mm ⑤ use Allen wrench L58MM ⑥ to tighten

## STEP 7




Next step is to use the assembly just assembled in step 6, turn it upside down and connect it with the Threaded heads 5/16\*75MM ① Wooden dowel Ø 10 \* 30MM ② as shown in the picture.


Next step to assemble Bed footboard ⑩ use hardware Metal link U32\*40MM ⑬ Vis umbrella head 3.5\*15MM ⑭ use screwdriver to connect two foot ends use Wooden dowel Ø 10\*30MM ⑮ Threaded heads 5/16\*75MM ⑯ as shown

## STEP 9




Next step is to assemble Side rails ⑧ with the headboard and footboard assemblies in steps 7 and 8 using Half moon washer ⑯ Flat washer 2\*8\*15MM ⑰ Hex nut K12 ⑱ hardware using Open wrench K12mm ⑲ to tighten

## STEP 10




Next step to assemble Support middle bar ⑪ Middle leg ⑨ use hardware bolt 5/16\*55mm ⑩ flat washer 2\*8\*15mm ⑫ use Allen wrench L58mm ⑬ to tighten

## STEP 11




Next step assemble the 2 clusters in step 9 and 10 using Vis umbrella head 3.5\*15MM ⑭ hardware use screwdriver to tighten

## STEP 12



Next step assemble slats bar ⑫ into the assembled cluster in step 11 using Vis flat head 4\*30MM ⑭ use screwdriver to tighten

## STEP 13 COMPLETED



In the finishing step, we can adjust the foot support to fit the floor. See illustration.

Inspect the Bed and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Adjust the levelers to desired height to avoid wobbles.

Your bed is ready for use.

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS:**

Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.

Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. To protect finish, avoid the use of chemicals and household cleaners.

## Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
