Care & Maintenance

- ∅  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.

- ✓  • Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.

- ∅  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.

- ∅  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.

- ∅  • Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.

- ∅  • Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.

- ∅  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.

- ∅  • Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.

- ∅  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

- ∅  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.


Tabletop (A)

Lower Leg Frame (C)


Upper Leg Frame (B)


Step 1



Put the parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2



Attach Upper Leg Frame(B) to Tabletop(A) using Bolts(①), Spring Washers(③) and Washers(④) with Allen Wrench(⑤) as shown above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.


Step 3



Attach Lower Leg Frame(C) to Tabletop(A) using Bolts(①), Spring Washers(③) and Washers(④) with Allen Wrench(⑤) as shown above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.


Step 4



Attach Upper Leg Frame(B) to Lower Leg Frame(C) using Bolts(②) with Allen Washers(⑤) as shown above.


Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Step 5



Adjust the Pre-installed Levelers at the bottom of the Lower Leg Frame(C), and Upper Leg Frame(B) until the DiningTable is level with the ground.

Step 6



Your Dining Table is ready for use.
