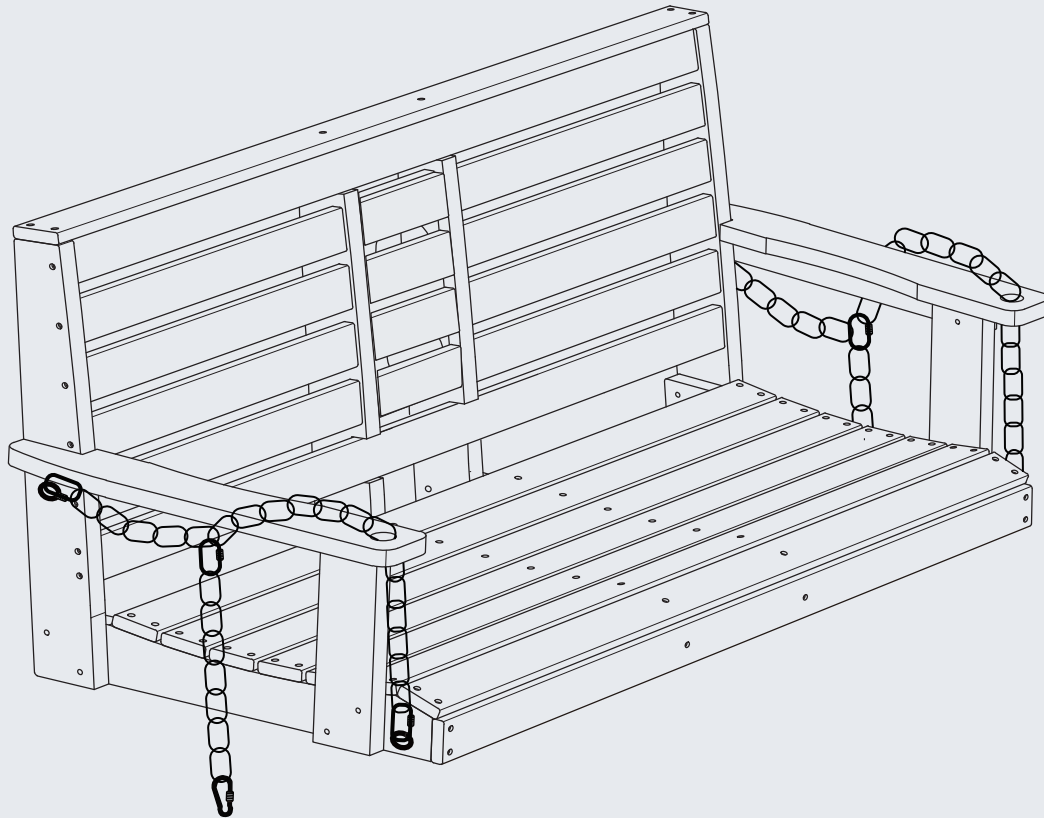

Poly 54" Porch Swing with Folding Cup Holder

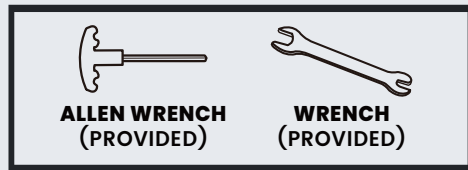

! NOTICE

Do not overtighten screws. (Insert all screws before tightening screws.)

- Please do not exceed the weight limitations of this item.
- Do not stand on or use any part of this item as a step ladder.
- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and nuts before use.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws and nuts are secure every 90 days.
- Do not use or store this item in the proximity of open flame or flammable/combustible chemicals.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- Please adjust the speed slowly when you use electric drill for assembling to avoid screw slipping.

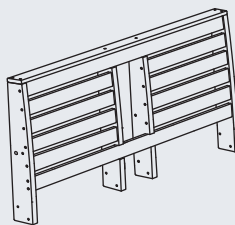

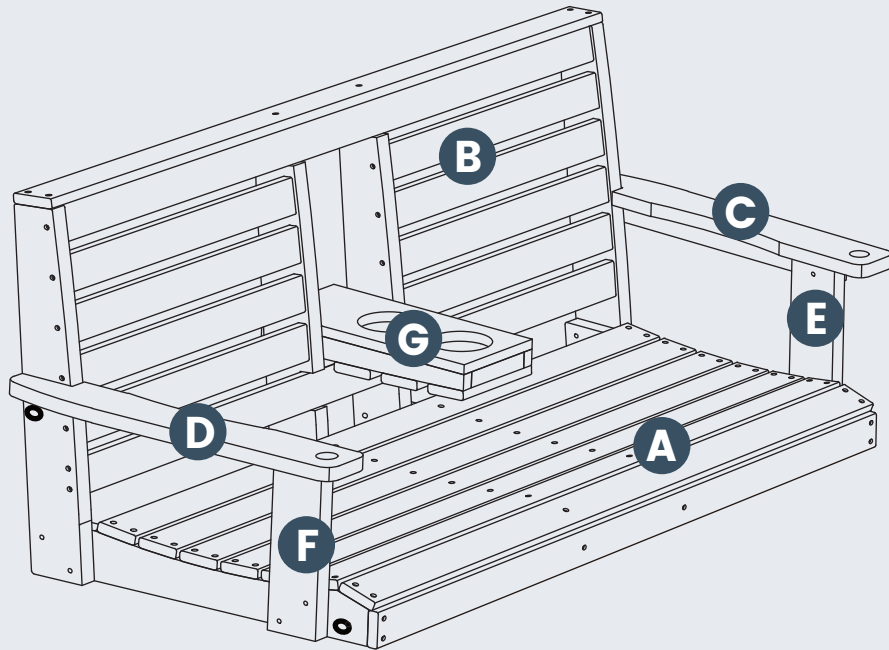

PRODUCT ASSEMBLY – OVERALL VIEW

Look at following overall view of this swing and learn the exact position of each part to be assembled.

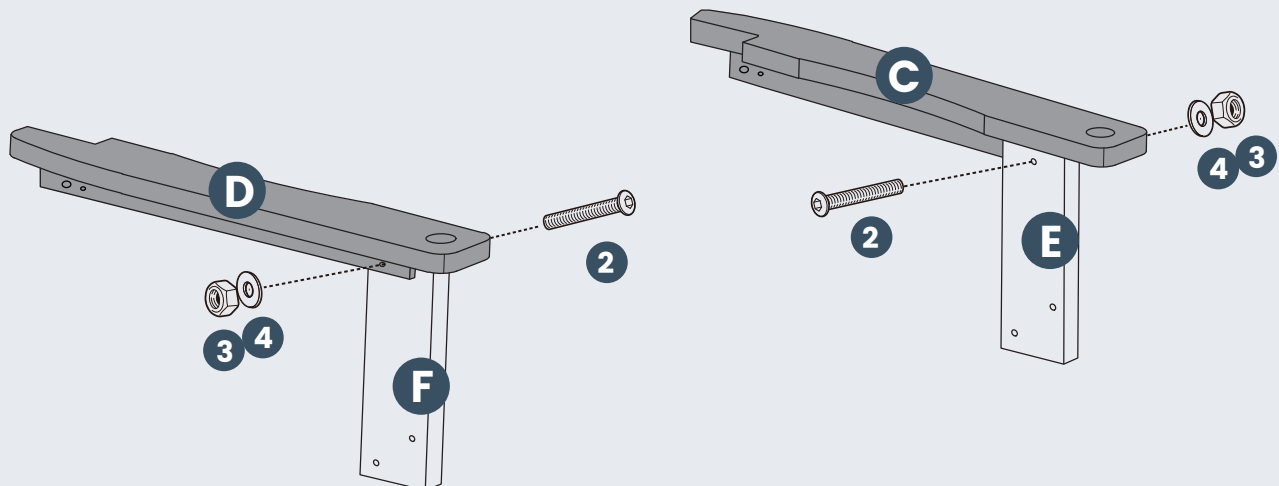

Attach **Part C Left Arm** to **Part E Left Leg** with 1 set of **Hardware #2 Bolt, #4 Washer** and **#3 Nut** (see image below).

Do the same to attach **Part D Right Arm** to **Part F Right Leg** (see image below).

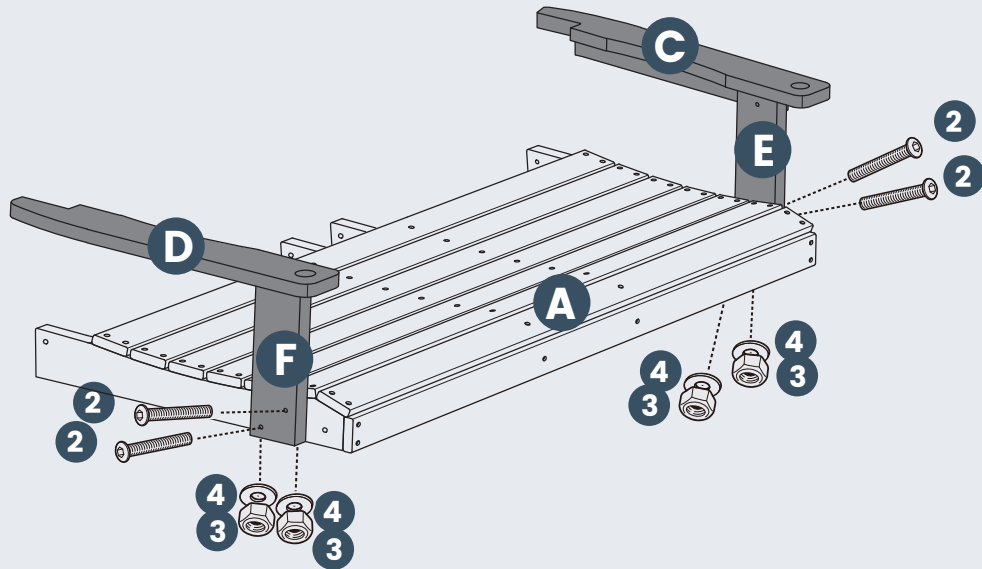

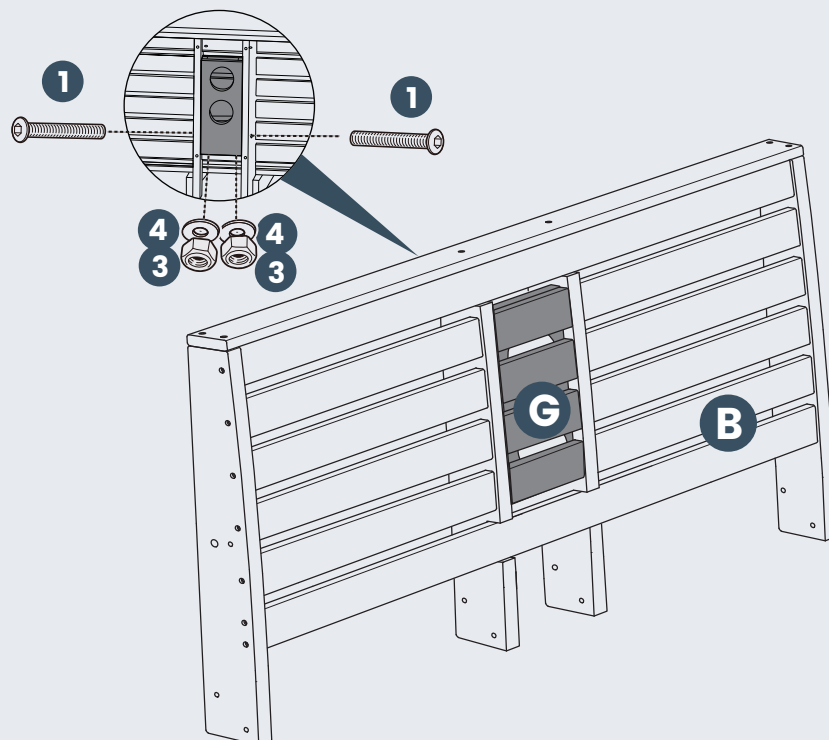
Attach combined **Part F Right Leg** and **Part D Right Arm** to **Part A Swing seat** with 2 sets of **Hardware #2 Bolt, #4 Washer** and **#3 Nut** (see image below).

Do the same to attach combined **Part E Left Leg** and **Part C Right Arm** to **Part A Swing Seat**.

Place **Part G Folding Cup Holder** to **Part B Backrest** as below and attach the cup holder to the backrest with 2 sets of **Hardware #1 Bolt, #4 Washer** and **#3 Nut** from the back side.

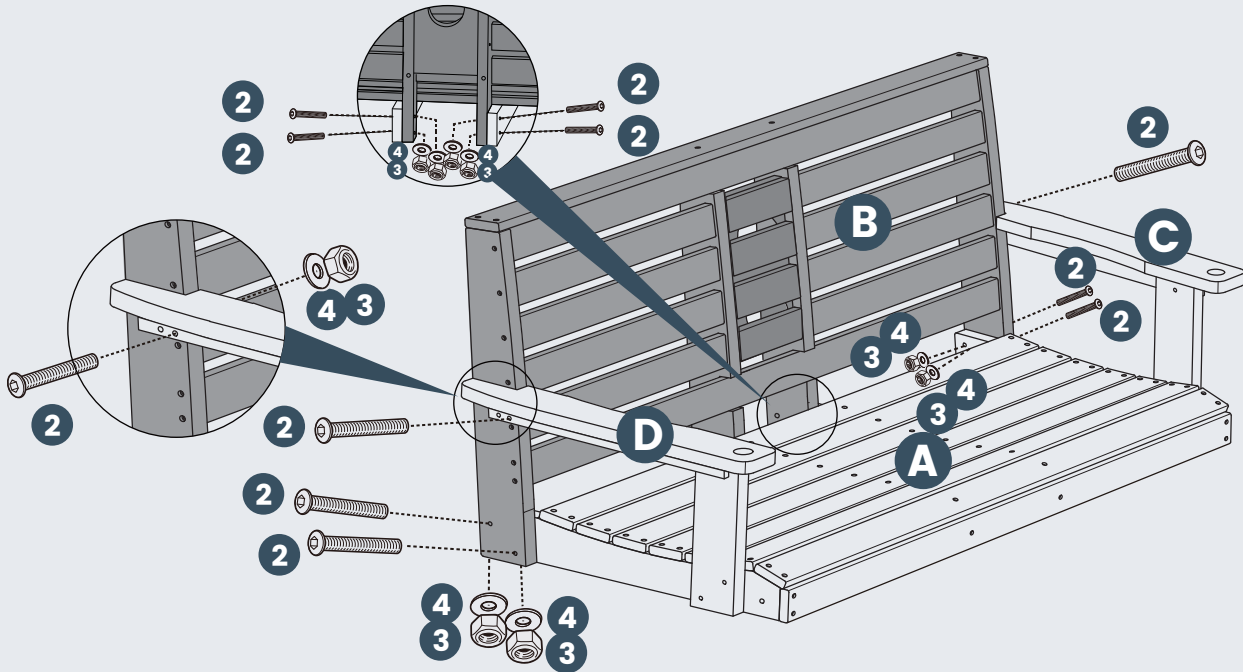

Attach **Part B Backrest** with **Part G Folding Cup Holder** to **Part A Swing Seat** with 8 sets of **Hardware #2 Bolt, #4 Washer** and **#3 Nut** (see image below).

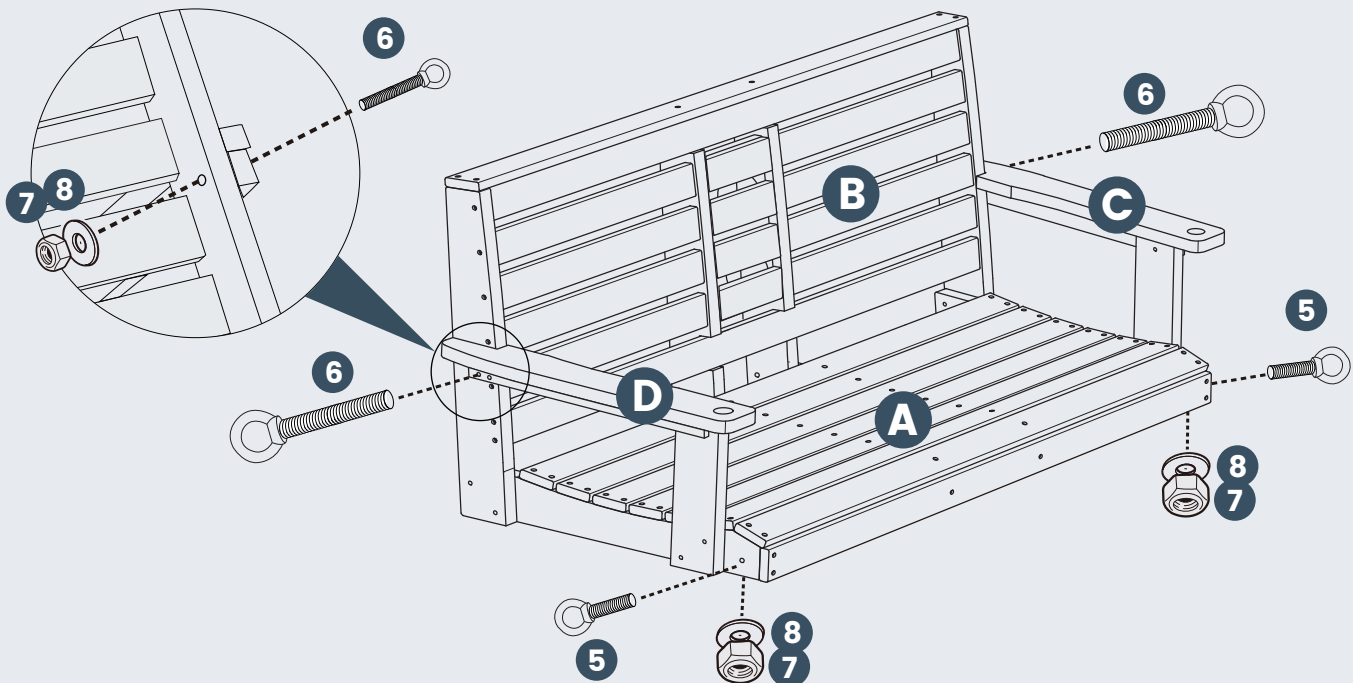
Attach **Part B Backrest** to **Part C Left Arm** and **Part D Right Arm** with 2 sets of **Hardware #2 Bolt, #4 Washer** and **#3 Nut** (see image below).

Attach 2 sets of **Hardware #6 Eye Hook, #8 Washer** and **#7 Nut** to **Part B Backrest**, **Part C Left Arm** and **Part D Right Arm** as below.

Attach 2 pcs of **Hardware #5 Eye Hook** to **Part A Swing Seat** with 2 sets of **Hardware #8 Washer** and **#7 Nut** (see image below).



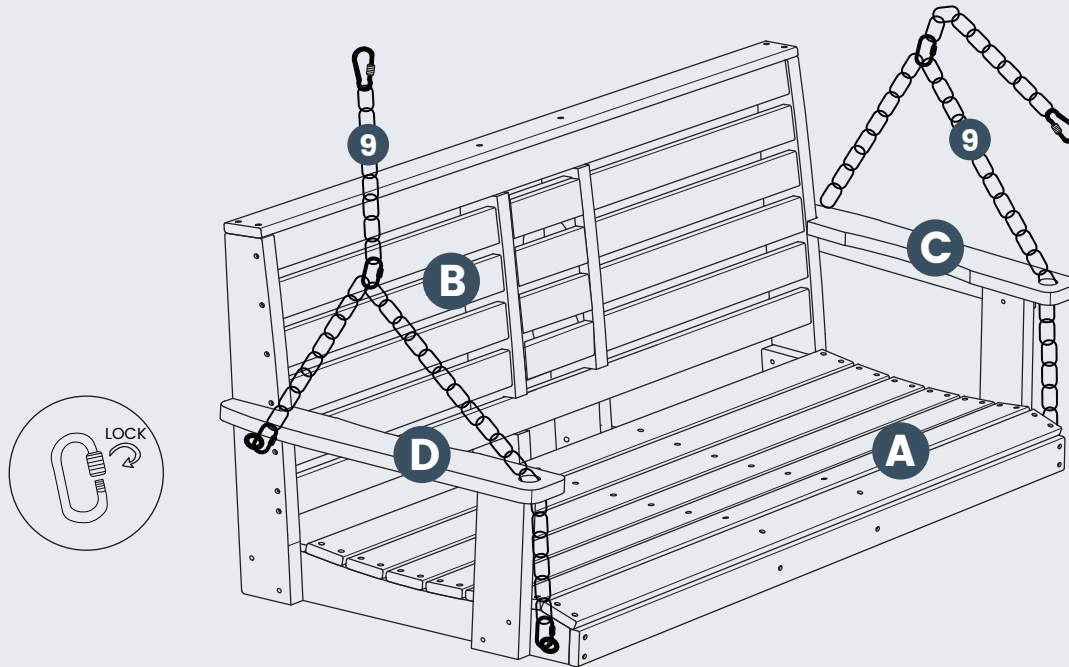

Insert the long end of **Hardware #9 Chain** through the hole in the arm, turn the thread lock to open the carabiner, attach it to the eye bolt on **Part A Swing Seat** and turn back to lock.

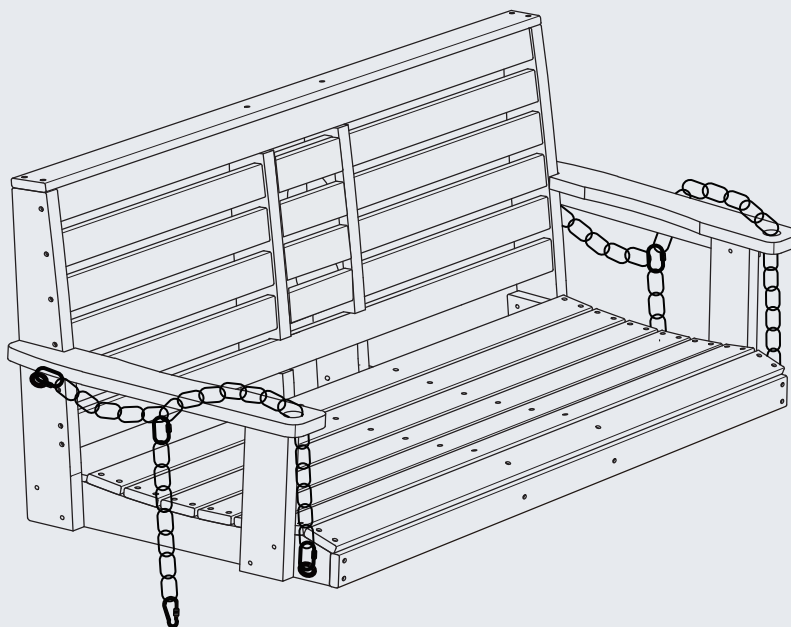
Lock another carabiner to the eye bolt on **Part D Right Arm**.

Do the same to assemble another chain to the other side (see image below).

Tighten all the screws, bolts and nuts to ensure the swing is sturdy enough.



CLEANING TIPS

REGULAR CLEAN: Use a mixture of warm water and mild soap. Gently scrub the surface with a soft bristle brush to remove any dirt or stains.

QUICK CLEAN: You can simply wipe down the furniture with a damp cloth.
