CAUTION: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.

Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.




- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.







- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.

Please look in underneath of Table Top for hardware packs.






Label	Picture	Description	Qty

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Preparation:

OVERVIEW




This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 10 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner, place the Table Top (A) facing down then attach Leg (B) to Table Top (A) by using Bolts ((3)) and Allen Wrench ((1)) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3




With assistance from your adult partner, attach Support Bar (C) and Bottom Support Bar (D) to Leg (B) of the assembled part in Step 2 as shown above. Then secure Support Bar (C) to Leg (B) by using Screws (②) and Allen Wrench (①).

Secure Bottom Support Bar (D) to Leg (B) and Table Top (A) by using Screws (②) and Allen Wrench (①).

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.

Step 4




With assistance from your adult partner, attach the remaining Leg (B) to the assembled part in Step 3 as shown above, then:

Step 4.1, secure Leg (B) to Table Top (A) by using Bolts (③) and Allen Wrench (①).

Step 4.2, secure Leg (B) to Support Bar (C) and Bottom Support Bar (D) by using Screws (②) and Allen Wrench (①).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Stand the Table right side up.

Then proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner.

When tightening the Bolts and Screws, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any Bolts, Screws fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute this same process.

Adjust Pre-installed Levelers height for balance.

Your Table is ready to use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
